

METHODOLOGY


- The survey of southern Kazakhstan (Kyzylorda, Zhambyl and South Kazakhstan oblasts and Almaty city) was carried out from April 13-22, 2009. The eligibility criteria was based on age (18 years and older). Eight-hundred and twenty-seven Kazakh participants were interviewed face-to-face in their homes.
- The sample design was a multi-stage probability sample.
 - Stage one: the sample was stratified into four regions- three oblasts and Almaty city.
 - Stage two: the sample was further stratified into rural, urban and metropolitan sampling units.
 - Stage three: Primary Sampling Units (PSU) were described.
- The last birthday rule was used for the selection of the respondent. The households were selected using random route method.
- The sample was distributed at the regional level, in rural and urban areas, in all regions of southern Kazakhstan.
- The response rate was 65 percent.
- The margin of error for the survey results does not exceed plus or minus 3.4 percent with a confidence level of 95 percent.
- Fifty-nine interviewers worked on the study, on average completing 10-12 interviews in one PSU. The interviews were done in Russian, Kazakh and Uzbek languages.


Generally speaking, is Kazakhstan going in the right direction or wrong direction?






In the past year, how has your personal financial situation changed?





In the next year, do you expect the economic situation in Kazakhstan to get better, worse or stay the same?










What one effect of the world financial crisis do you feel most?

How well is President Nazarbaev and the government handling the problems caused by the global financial crisis?












In your view, which of the following is mostly to blame for high prices?

Respondents who are very or somewhat concerned about high prices, N=716














How corrupt are the following institutions?




Have you been in a situation over the last 12 months when you had to pay a bribe in order to get a service or a decision that you needed?




How safe do you feel in the city/village where you live?





Are you satisfied with the quality of work provided by the oblast Akim* in your region?









What are the main issues on which local authorities need to focus on in your city/village?


What are the main issues on which local authorities need to focus on in your city/village?


What are the main issues on which local authorities need to focus on in your city/village?





What have been the main events in the country's life since its independence?










Why would you not vote in the parliamentary elections if they were held next week?



Do you agree or disagree with the following statement: It is healthy for Kazakhstan to have an active political opposition?




If the opposition political parties decided to form a Grand Opposition Alliance, would you support this grand alliance or not?




What should be the main priority of this Grand Opposition Alliance?







Which TV stations do you watch regularly?




Which radio stations do you listen to regularly?




Which newspapers do you read regularly?



On average, how many times do you use the Internet per week?






Where do you most often regularly access the Internet?
