Public Opinion Survey: Residents of Kosovo

September 3-18, 2021



Detailed Methodology

- The survey was conducted on behalf of the International Republican Institute's <u>Center for Insights for Survey Research</u> by KANTAR Index Kosova.
- Data was collected between September 3 and September 18, 2021, through computer-assisted telephone interviews (CATI) administered via mobile numbers.
- The sample consists of n=1,200 residents of Kosovo aged 18 and older.
- Numbers were randomly selected from a database of 7,000 active mobile numbers that Kantar Index Kosova obtained from a third-party vendor.
 - To achieve a representative sample by different demographic criteria, the data collection was monitored during fieldwork. The comparison of data during monitoring was based on the national census from 2011 (updated estimates in 2016), including region, type of residence (urban vs. rural), gender and age.
 - The sample was weighted according to age, gender, region, residence and ethnicity using the latest data from the Census conducted in 2011, as well as the most reliable and updated estimates in 2016 of the Kosovo Agency of Statistics.
- The response rate was 36%.
- The margin of error for the mid-range of the full sample does not exceed ± 2.8 points at the 95% confidence level.
- Charts and graphs may not sum to 100% due to rounding.









In general, would you say that our country is heading in the right direction or in the wrong direction?




Speaking personally, over the past 6 months, how has your overall quality of life changed?




How satisfied or dissatisfied are you with the way democracy is developing in our country?



Do you consider our country to be governed in the interest of the majority of people or in the interest of some groups?




Do you think that today's generation of young people has a good future in our country or not?




What is the most important problem facing our country today, and what is the second most important problem?




What is the most important problem facing our municipality today, and what is the second most important problem?


How would you describe the current economic situation of your household?


How likely or unlikely are you to vote in the October 2021 municipal and mayoral elections?


Why are you unlikely to vote in October 2021 municipal and mayoral elections?




For which party's candidate do you intend to vote in the October 2021 municipal and mayoral elections?




How likely or unlikely are ordinary people able to influence decisions made in our country?




Would you like to see new political parties in future elections or are you satisfied with the current choices?



Do you agree or disagree that political parties are doing enough to address the needs of voters like you?




To what extent do you trust or distrust each of the following institutions?




What is the most important accomplishment of the current national government?




Which level of government should get most of the credit for this accomplishment?

(respondents who named an accomplishment, n=228)




What is the most important failure of the government? (Spontaneous responses)




Which level of government should get most of the blame for this failure?

(Respondents who named a failure, n=867)








In general, is the national government doing a lot, enough, little, or nothing to address the needs of people like you?




In general, is the municipal government doing a lot, enough, little, or nothing to address the needs of people like you?




How important or unimportant is it that all members of our country's adult population are included in political decision making? Specifically...




How important is that women are included?










If candidate is female, would make you more likely or less likely to vote for the candidate, or if it would not matter?




If candidate is 35 years old or younger, would make you more likely or less likely to vote for the candidate, or if it would not matter?






Do you believe that democracy is the best possible form of government for our country or not?



Thinking about our country's current political system, do you believe it is a:




How strongly do you agree or disagree that rule of law exists in our country?*




Would you say that our country's politics are moving toward more consensus or more polarization?




If asked to make concessions on issues in order to make our country's politics more functional, on which types of issues should political leaders make these concessions, and on which issues should they not compromise?


What should our country's foreign policy course be?




What should our country's foreign policy course be in regard to China?




If a referendum were held today on our country joining NATO, how would you vote?




If a referendum were held today on our country joining the European Union, how would you vote?



Which media platform do you use most frequently to gain political news and information, and what is your second most frequently used media platform?











