



# National Survey of Bangladeshi Public Opinion

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August 1 - September 16, 2019



# Methodology

- The survey was conducted by IRI's [Center for Insights in Survey Research](#) with a local research partner under the supervision of Redstone Scientific between August 1, 2019 and September 16, 2019.
- Data was collected using a multi-stage stratified probability sample through in-person, in-home interviews. The sample was stratified by division, by district and by urban and rural locations.
- The sample consists of 4,993 respondents aged 18 and older, and is representative of voting-age adults nationally.
- The sample was distributed into 500 primary sampling units (PSU) from all 64 districts of all eight divisions. PSUs were defined as *mouza* in rural areas and as *mahalla* in urban areas.
- PSUs were selected using the Probability-Proportional-to-Size (PPS) method. In each PSU, after identifying a centrally-located starting point, a skip pattern was used to select the appropriate household. Within each household, a respondent was selected using the Kish Grid. A gender quota was implemented at the PSU level in order to enhance representativeness.
- The margin of error is plus or minus 1.4 percent at the mid-range with a confidence level of 95 percent. The response rate was 67 percent.
- The information in this report has been compiled in accordance with international standards for market and social research methodologies. Figures in charts and tables may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding.


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
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In general, would you say that things in Bangladesh are heading in the right direction or are they heading in the wrong direction?




In general, would you say that things in Bangladesh are heading in the right direction or are they heading in the wrong direction?




# In general, why do you think that things are heading in the right direction?

Asked of those responding “right direction”; spontaneous response; n=3,815




# In general, why do you think that things are heading in the wrong direction?




Thinking now about the following, would you rate the situation with each as good or bad? And would you say very good or very bad?




# Thinking now about the economy, would you rate the situation as good or bad? And would you say very good or very bad?




# Thinking now about security, would you rate the situation as good or bad? And would you say very good or very bad?




Thinking now about political stability, would you rate the situation as good or bad? And would you say very good or very bad?




Thinking more about this, in the coming year, do you think that the situation with each is going to get better, worse or stay the same?




Thinking more about this, in the coming year, do you think that the situation with the economy is going to get better, worse or stay the same?








Thinking now about the personal economic situation of you and your family, over the past year has it gotten better, stayed the same or worsened?

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

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


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
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Thinking now about the following institutions and people, would you say you approve or disapprove of the job they are doing?

Total “approve” shown




Thinking now about the following institutions and people, would you say you approve or disapprove of the job they are doing? Total “good job” shown





Thinking now about the member of parliament who was elected to represent your area, do you think that person is doing a good job or a bad job? And would that be a very or somewhat good/bad job?




# On each of these issues, how would you rate the national government's performance?

Percentages shown are total responding “strongly approve” and “somewhat approve”




# On each of these issues, how would you rate the national government?



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





















Asked only of respondents 35 years of age and younger; n=2,063




What is the primary reason why you would be unlikely to run for office?

# Are you a member of a political party?








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# From which type of media are you most likely to get your news?




## Do you have access to the internet?




# How often do you use the Internet?
