Detailed Methodology


- The survey was conducted under the supervision of Rob Varsalone of <u>Global Strategic</u> <u>Partners</u> (GSP) and the International Republican Institute (IRI) between August 21-September 7, 2014.
- Data was collected using a multi-stage stratified probability sample and through inperson, in-house interviews. The sample was stratified by the seven administrative divisions, by district and by urban and rural locations.
- The sample consisted of 2,550 respondents (response rate: 58 percent) aged 18 and older, and was representative of voting-age adults nationally.
- The sample was distributed into 255 primary sampling units (PSU) from all 64 districts of all seven divisions. PSUs were defined as *mouza* in rural areas and as *mahalla* in urban areas.
- The probability-proportional-to-size method was used to select localities. After identifying a centrally located starting point, the Date Method was used to select the first house and then Systematic Random Sampling was used to select the appropriate household. Within each household, the Kish Grid was then used to select respondents 18 years and older.
- Interview teams were comprised of both males and females.
- The margin of error does not exceed plus or minus two percent at the mid-range with a confidence level of 95 percent.
- The information in this report has been compiled in accordance with international standards for market and social research methodologies. Figures in charts and tables may not sum to 100 percent due to rounding.



In Bangladesh, if you could only have one or the other, which is more important to you: a democratic system of government or a prosperous economy?




Apprehension of Violence Divides Bangladeshis



Which comes closest to your own opinion?




When would you like to see the next national parliamentary elections occur?






What are the top three issues in Bangladesh? (Open-ended, First Choices Shown)



Should a non-party, caretaker government be brought back before the next parliamentary elections?




In your opinion, what is the main reason for election-related threats and intimidations in Bangladesh?

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Do you believe things in Bangladesh are heading in the right direction, or are they heading in the wrong direction?








Thinking some more about the personal economic situation of you and your family, in the coming year do you think it will improve, worsen or stay the same?





Do you and your family have enough income to afford basic commodities (rice, milk, eggs, fish, *dhal**, etc.) in the market?




Overall, how would you rate the current economic conditions in Bangladesh?




Overall, how would you rate the current security conditions in Bangladesh?






What or who influences your voting decision the most?




Where do you believe candidates for elections receive most of the money for their campaigns?


Have you ever personally witnessed incumbent candidates using government offices or vehicles during their campaigns?




Have you ever been asked to contribute money or free services to a candidate or political party for an election campaign?




Have you attended any rallies, meetings or events in your area for any of the candidates for national parliamentary elections or *upazila* elections?






Does it bother you if a candidate spends on his/her campaign more money than allowed by the law?




Does it bother you if a candidate spends his/her personal money on campaign expenses?







Do you believe the election commission is capable of tracking and regulating money spent on campaigns?




Thinking about the election law, as far as you know, is it illegal for candidates to provide food and small gifts to voters during the campaigns?






During the elections process, have you ever been....? (Choose all that apply)




During the elections process, have you ever witnessed other people being....? (Choose all that apply)




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Do you approve or disapprove of the job being done by the...?




Do you believe the Bangladesh Election Commission is completely fair and independent?

Whom do you trust to impartially resolve disputes that may arise between residents of your locality?






Women are equally represented in political decision-making positions in Bangladesh.
