Methodology: Survey Facts

- 3,230 face-to-face interviews conducted across all 18 governorates
- Survey conducted from July 24 to August 2, 2004
- Response rate of 88% rendering a valid sample of 2,846
- Minimum of 150 interviews conducted in every governorate
- Margin of error of +/- 2.57%



Methodology: Sample Weighting

Why was weighting necessary?

- IRI wanted to be able to more accurately breakdown poll results by governorate, religion and ethnic group.
- Drawing a sample based on census data, some governorates required very few interviews, far less than the number needed to draw statistically valid conclusions
- IRI interviewed at least 150 people in every governorate and adjusted the nation-wide results to reflect a representative national sample






Unemployment by Province

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


Thinking about the last two months, do you feel that the following have gotten better, worse or stayed the same?







Have you heard about the national security law passed by the Interim Government during the first week of July?





Which one of the following do you think would be the best solution to the problem of unemployment?





Many people have cited rebuilding Iraq's infrastructure as one of the most pressing issues in the country. Which of the following are the most important to you?




Interim Government






Which of the following types of government do you think would best serve your interests?




Which of the following statements best describes your feelings about Iraqi you think the country SHOULD BE? Iraq is/must . . .




Thinking about the type of political party you are most likely to support, regardless of whether or not it exists in Iraq today, which of the following do you find closest to your own views?






*Among those who said that they currently supported a political party, 48.6% said that they would consider donating money to a campaign or candidate.

<u>ACCEPTABLE</u> way for political parties or movements to finance themselves?




In your opinion, which of the following would be the <u>BEST</u> way for a party to get you attention?





Thinking about the number of political parties in Iraq, to what extent do you agree or disagree with each of the following statements?




