
Survey Methodology


- ✓ <u>Dates of interviewing</u>: November 8 30, 2008
- ✓ <u>Data Collection Method:</u> Stratified-intercept methodology based on personal, face-to-face interviews in Cuba.
- ✓ <u>Sample size:</u> 592 Cuban adults (age 18 and older).
- ✓ <u>Sample:</u> Interviews were conducted in every Cuban province (14). Los Piños Island, a region that is statistically irrelevant and not officially considered a province, was not included.
 - ✓ The sample was stratified by province, then by sub-units within each province. Interviewees were allocated by gender and age quotas. The final selection of each interviewee was random.
- ✓ Respondents: The sample selection for province, gender and age are based on the last available Cuban census data, released in 2002.
- ✓ <u>Maximum sample margin of error:</u> For entire sample of n=592 respondents ± four percent for a 95 percent level of confidence.


Demographics: Gender and Age









Demographics: Province




Demographics: Profession or Job






In general, do you think that things in Cuba are going...?












What do you think is the biggest problem in Cuba?






Do you believe the current government will succeed in resolving Cuba's biggest problem in the next few years? (N = 571)








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
The cross tabulation indicates how Cubans rank the country's five biggest problems according to age group.



Do you believe a democratic government – one elected by the people in free elections – would solve the country's biggest problem in the next few years?




Among respondents who do not believe the current government can solve Cuba's biggest problem (N=393)





Do you believe a democratic government – one elected by the people in free elections – would solve the country's biggest problem in the next few years?





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The Impact of the Hurricanes




Have the recent hurricanes affected you personally?






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
What do you most urgently need? (N=65)







The cross-tabulation indicates how Cubans feel about political changes according to level of education.






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


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


How have recent changes — legal access to more goods at the shops, hotels, the possibility to lease land — affected you? Have they improved your personal situation?




Opinion about Political Candidates

If you could vote next week in free and fair elections and choose between candidates from the Communist Party or from other parties, who would you be likely to vote for?




If you could vote next week in free and fair elections to decide who should be the President of Cuba, would you vote for Raúl Castro or a leading member of the internal opposition?





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


The cross-tabulation indicates Cubans' voting intentions in a free and fair election for president according to age. 34



If you could vote next week in free and fair elections to decide who should be the President of Cuba, would you vote for Raúl Castro or a leading member of the internal opposition?




If you could vote next week in free and fair elections to decide who should be the President of Cuba, would you vote for Raúl Castro or a leading member of the internal opposition? (N=565)


