July 15 - August 7, 2009



#### Survey Methodology

- In-person, in-home interviews
- National representative sample of adult residents of Pakistan.
- n = 4,900
- Conducted between July 15 August 7, 2009
- Margin of error  $\pm$  1.41 percent overall.
- A multi-stage probability sample was used. In the first stage, the sample was stratified into four provinces. In the second stage, the sample was further stratified into districts within each province by rural and urban categories. In the third stage, each district was further stratified by Union Councils.
- The sample was distributed at the provincial level, rural and urban, in all four provinces of Pakistan (except for the Federally Administrative Tribal Areas, Chitral and Kohistan). The sample was then post-weighted to make it proportionate to national representation by province.
- The eligibility criteria is age, 18 years and older.
- The response rate was 74 percent.
- The interview teams were comprised of both of males and females; the female respondents were interviewed by female interviewers and male respondents by male interviewers.
- Kish method was used to select respondents 18 years and older within the randomly selected household. The left hand method was used to select every third household in localities selected through area probability sample.
- The information in this report has been compiled in accordance with international standards for market and social research methodologies. Figures in charts and tables may not sum to 100 percent due to rounding error.






Do you think that Pakistan is heading in the right direction or in the wrong direction?






In the past year, has your personal economic situation improved, worsened or stayed the same?





Thinking about next year, do you expect the economic situation in Pakistan to get better, get worse or stay the same?








#### What is the single most important issue facing Pakistan?





#### What is the most important issue facing Pakistan? (Comparison)





Religious extremism is a serious problem in Pakistan.






# Agree or Disagree? The Taliban and Al-Qaeda operating in Pakistan is a serious problem.






#### Agree or Disagree? I support the army fighting extremists in Malakand division.






# Agree or Disagree? I support the U.S. making military incursions in the tribal areas.






#### Do you think that Pakistan should cooperate with the United States on its war against terror?












#### In your opinion, which of the following countries have good relations with Pakistan?






Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of the nation of India?








#### Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of the nation of Afghanistan?






#### Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of Afghan President Hamid Karzai?





#### Do you think that the Karzai government in Afghanistan is pro-Indian?






#### How has Prime Minister Gilani's government performed on the issues most important to you?








Agree or Disagree? The army should have no role in the civilian government.






The 1973 Constitution of Pakistan states the military should work for the civilian leadership. In your opinion, how much control should civilian leadership have over the military?






Some people believe the military has the right to take over from civilian leaders when they have become too corrupt or fail to govern. Under what circumstances should the military be able to do this?






## Which one leader do you believe will be able to handle the problems facing Pakistan most effectively?






### Who would you rather see as the President of Pakistan, Nawaz Sharif or Asif Zardari?







Do you approve or disapprove of the job the President is doing?





# Do you support amending the Pakistan constitution removing some of the powers granted to the President of Pakistan?








### Would you say you liked or disliked the following political personalities?

(Percent Favorable)






If the elections for national assembly were held next week, for which party would you vote?






# If the elections for national assembly were held next week, for which party would you vote? (Tracking Major Parties)








# If the elections for national assembly were held next week, for which party would you vote? NWFP








To what extent should religion play a role in politics?






What is the one thing the PPP government could do that would convince you to vote for them?






If there was another parliamentary election held next week and the following were your choices, for whom would you vote?

If the party you vote to solve your problems does not fulfill its promises after being elected, what are the chances that you will still vote for the party in the next elections?






