Methodology

The survey was conducted by the Public Opinion and Market research company Baltic Surveys/Gallup on behalf of the International Republican Institute. The field work was carried out by Rating Group Ukraine. The sample consisted of 1,201 permanent residents of Ukraine older than the age of 18 and eligible to vote and is representative of the general population by age, gender, education and religion.

The sample design was a multi-stage random sample:

<u>Stage one</u>: Ukraine is divided into 27 official administrative regions (25 regions of Ukraine, Kyiv and Sevastopol). All regions of Ukraine were surveyed.

<u>Stage two</u>: selection of the settlements - towns and villages. Towns were grouped into subtypes according to the size of population (City more than one million, 500,000-999,000, 50,000-499,000, 50,000-99,000, 50,000 and less, village)

Settlements were selected at random. The number of selected settlements in each region was proportional to the share of population living in a particular type of the settlement in each region. The survey was conducted in 90settlements.


<u>Stage three</u>: primary sampling units were described. The closest birthday rule was used for selection of the respondent. The households were selected using the random route method.

Data were collected on February 17 – March 7, 2012, through face-to-face interviews with the respondents. The margin of error does not exceed plus or minus 2.8 percent.


Response rate – 56 percent.


Generally speaking, do you think that things in Ukraine are going in the right direction or wrong direction?






Over the last 12 months, how has the financial situation of your household changed?






In the next 12 months, how do you expect the economic situation in Ukraine to change?






Regardless of your passport, what nationality do you consider yourself to be?






Should Ukraine cooperate with the United States on the following issues or not?










^{*}It is unprecedented that a President would appoint officials to regional positions across Ukraine almost exclusively from one *oblast*, which happens to be his home *oblast*.




What is your opinion about the idea that heads of state administrations should be elected by the citizens, not appointed by the president?




Would you support the international community freezing the international assets of and suspending visas for Ukrainian officials, including judges, engaged in corrupt practices?






If Ukraine was able to enter only one international economic union, who should it be with?





Do you think Ukraine should give away part or its entire gas transportation system to Russia if it would mean a reduction in the import price Ukraine pays for gas?






Which candidate are you more likely to support in the parliamentary elections from your district?






If you learn that a candidate you support in the parliamentary elections from your district is involved in corruption how would this affect you?




If you learn that the list of the political party you support in the parliamentary elections contains candidates involved in corruption, how would this affect you?








How many times per week do you access the Internet? Ukraine




How many times per week do you access the Internet?


