Bosnia and Herzegovina: Attitudes on Violent Extremism and Foreign Influence

January 4 - February 3, 2017



Detailed Methodology

- The survey was conducted by Ipsos in Bosnia and Herzegovina (BiH) on behalf of the International Republican Institute's Center for Insights and Survey Research, and was funded by the National Endowment for Democracy.
- Data was collected between January 4 and February 3, 2017 through face-to-face interviews at the respondents' homes using the CAPI method (computer assisted personal interviewing).
- A total of 1,537 interviews were completed, with an overall margin of error of plus or minus 2.5 percent at the midrange of the 95 percent confidence level. A nationally-representative sample was assembled based on a multistage stratification proportionate to population sample distribution, through the random selection of households and respondents.
- The sample is composed of citizens of BiH, aged 18 and older and was based on the 2013 Census; Vital Statistics 2012 and Ipsos estimations derived from the Central Election Commission database; Agency for Identification Documents; and the Registers and Data Exchange of Bosnia and Herzegovina database.
- The sampling frame consisted of polling station territories (approximate size of census units) within strata defined by municipalities and type of settlements (urban and rural). Polling station territories enable the most reliable sample selection, due to the fact that these units represent the most comprehensive and up-to-date data available.
- Households were selected according to the random route technique. Starting from a given address, interviewers selected the third house down the same side of the street or the next available house for an interview from the starting point. From there, house numbers were followed in ascending order down the right side of the street, and interviewers selected every third house number. At every crossroad, interviewers turned right and continued with this pattern. In the case of apartment buildings, interviewers were permitted to select two apartments in buildings of four or less floors and three apartments in buildings of five or more floors (unless the building is in a village in which case only two apartments may be selected).
- Respondents were selected using the "Kish method".








Do you strongly support, somewhat support, somewhat oppose or strongly oppose the purchase of land and property in BiH by foreign citizens?






Does the country of origin of these buyers matter to you?










Do you agree or disagree that maintaining strong relations with the United States, Russia, Turkey, the European Union, Germany and United Kingdom is in BiH's national interest?




Do you agree or disagree that maintaining strong relations with the United States, Russia, Turkey, the European Union, Germany and United Kingdom is in BiH's national interest?


In your opinion, which of the listed countries is BiH's greatest ally?


To what extent do you support or oppose BiH's accession to NATO?



How do you view the role of NATO in the world: mostly positive, somewhat positive, somewhat negative or mostly negative?




NATO is most closely associated with which of the following?


Do you have a very favorable, somewhat favorable, somewhat unfavorable or very unfavorable opinion of the following world leaders or have not heard of him/her at all?




Do you have a very favorable, somewhat favorable, somewhat unfavorable or very unfavorable opinion of the following world leaders or have not heard of him/her at all?


Would you support or oppose the introduction of the Turkish language as mandatory in BiH high schools?


Would you support or oppose the introduction of the Russian language as mandatory in BiH high schools?


What is your opinion of the Russian economic presence in BiH?


In your opinion, what are the motives behind Russia's investments in BiH?











How would you evaluate the level of influence of religious communities in the country?




In your opinion, does religion have too much influence on Bosnian politics, too little influence, or exactly the right amount of influence?


















Have you heard of the Islamic State (IS)?




What is your first impression when you hear the term "Islamic State" (IS)?




















Do you support or oppose the possible prosecution of BiH citizens who return from fighting in foreign conflicts?






Can you name one or more public personalities in BiH with whom you associate the fight against violent extremism?








If you could have only one or the other, which is more important to you: a democratic system of government or a prosperous economy?






Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? "Politicians do not listen to the needs and ideas of women."




How likely, if at all, are you to vote in the next elections?



Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? "Politicians do not listen to the needs and ideas of young people."




What is your primary source of information?






