
#### Detailed Methodology

- The survey was conducted by <u>Dr. Rasa Alisauskiene</u> of the public and market research company Baltic Surveys/The Gallup Organization on behalf of the <u>Center for Insights in Survey Research</u>. The field work was carried out by <u>SIAR Research and Consulting</u>.
- Data was collected throughout Kyrgyzstan between February 15 and March 2, 2017 through face-to-face interviews at respondents' homes.
- The sample consisted of 1,500 permanent residents of Kyrgyzstan ages 18 and older and eligible to vote and is representative of the general population by age, gender, education, region and settlement size.
- A multistage probability sampling method was used, employing the random route and Kish Method for respondents' selection procedures.
  - Stage one: All districts of Kyrgyzstan were grouped into seven regions plus Bishkek. Each region of Kyrgyzstan was surveyed.
  - Stage two: Settlements were selected at random. The number of selected settlements in each region was proportional to the share of population living in the particular type of the settlement in each region.
  - Stage three: Primary sampling units were described.
- The margin of error does not exceed plus or minus 2.5 percent.
- The response rate was 75 percent.
- Charts and graphs may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding.
- Interviews were conducted in the Kyrgyz, Russian and Uzbek languages.
- The survey was funded by the <u>U.S. Agency for International Development</u>.






# Generally speaking, do you think that things in Kyrgyzstan are going in the right direction or wrong direction?




# Over the last 12 months, how has the economic situation in Kyrgyzstan changed?




# Over the last 12 months, how has the financial situation of your household changed?




# In your opinion, how will the economic situation of Kyrgyzstan change in the next year?








### What are the most important problems your town/village is facing at the moment?





### What are the most important problems facing your household? (Three spontaneous answers)






# How satisfied are you with the way democracy is developing in Kyrgyzstan?




# If you could only choose one or the other, which is more important to you: a democratic system of government or a prosperous economy?



## Are people in Kyrgyzstan afraid to openly express their political views?




# In your opinion, are there groups that do not feel safe to openly express their political views?












#### Do you approve or disapprove of the activity of the President?




#### Do you approve or disapprove of the activity of the Parliament?






#### In your opinion, is corruption a big problem in Kyrgyzstan?




# Do you think the Kyrgyz Government is making a sufficient effort to fight corruption?











### How often do you participate in political party activities? (Members of political parties)



# Why are you not a member of a political party? (Spontaneous answers; respondents who are not members of political parties, N=1,409)






### How likely are you to vote in the upcoming elections? (Disaggregated by age)




# In your opinion, does your financial situation depend on the results of elections in general?










During the last local election, did you know or witness anyone who was offered money, gifts or other incentives in exchange for their vote?






#### Considering that votes are cast electronically, how do people ensure that those they have bribed vote as they promised?




### Why do you think people would accept money or gifts in exchange for their vote?




### In your opinion, what would make people less likely to accept money or gifts in exchange for their vote?




If political parties and their candidates had a distinct ideological platform, would voters be more or less likely to reject money for votes?








#### In the past six months, were you informed of the constitutional referendum?








#### If yes, what prompted you to vote in the referendum? (Respondents that voted in the referendum, N=746)






#### Which politicians or public figures do you trust the most? (Three spontaneous answers)










# Which of these countries do you consider to be the most important economic partners and greatest economic threats to Kyrgyzstan?








#### In your opinion, should more women be active in politics?




#### If yes, why should more women be active in politics? (Respondents who believe more women should be active in politics, N=918)




#### If no, why should there not be more women active in politics? (Respondents who do not believe more women should be active in politics, N=512)






In the next parliamentary election, will your vote be affected by which parties have a fair representation of women on their lists?




### In your opinion, which organizations provide the most opportunities for women to participate in politics?








# In your opinion, should more youth in Kyrgyzstan be active in politics?



## If yes, why should more youth be active in politics? (Respondents who believe more youth should be active in politics, N=1,442)




### If no, why should there not be more youth active in politics? (Respondents who do not believe more youth should be active in politics, N=58)








#### Which of these media outlets do you use for political information?




