Public Opinion Survey of Residents of Bilhorod-Dnistrovskyi

Wave 1: May 13-28, 2019 Wave 2: August 10-September 2, 2019



Methodology

- Both waves of this poll were conducted by <u>Rating Group Ukraine</u> on behalf of the International Republican Institute's <u>Center for Insights in Survey Research</u>.
- Both waves of this poll were conducted in Bilhorod-Dnistrovskyi through face-to-face interviews at respondents' homes May 13-28, 2019 (wave 1) and August 10-September 2, 2019 (wave 2).
- Both waves' samples consisted of 1,200 residents of Bilhorod-Dnistrovskyi aged 18 and older and eligible to vote. Samples are representative of the general population by gender and age.
- Both waves have a margin of error of ± 2.8 points. The response rate for wave one was 60.7%. The response for wave two was 59.8%.
- The distribution of the population by region of the city is based on statistical data from the Central Election Commission from the 2014 parliamentary elections, which divided the city into electoral districts.
- A multistage probability sampling method was used with the random route and last birthday methods for respondent selection.
- Both waves' samples are weighted to the distribution of Bilhorod-Dnistrovskyi's population by gender and age in accordance with data from the State Statistics Committee of Ukraine from January 1, 2018.
- Charts and graphs may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding.
- Cited bases are weighted.
- The survey was funded by the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID).






Generally speaking, do you think that things in Ukraine are going in the right direction or wrong direction?








Over the last 12 months, how has the economic situation in Ukraine changed?




Over the last 12 months, how has the economic situation of your household changed?






Has the establishment of the housing association (OSBB) helped to solve problems in your building?



Has the establishment of the body of self-organization of the population helped to solve problems in your building, block, micro-district?






Do you approve or disapprove of the activities of the Mayor of Bilhorod-Dnistrovskyi?*














In your opinion, should more rights be transferred from the central authorities to local authorities and communities?










How would you rate the service you received from the local authorities?




How would you rate the ease of accessibility of information about your communal enterprises?




How would you rate the ease of accessibility to information about your mayor?*


























