



Public Opinion Poll of Residents of Uzhhorod

Wave 1: May 10-23, 2019
Wave 2: August 14-27, 2019



Methodology

- Both waves of this poll were conducted by [Rating Group Ukraine](#) on behalf of the International Republican Institute's [Center for Insights in Survey Research](#).
- Both waves of this poll were conducted in Uzhhorod through face-to-face interviews at respondents' homes May 10-23, 2019 (wave 1) and August 14-27, 2019 (wave 2).
- Both waves' samples consisted of 1,200 residents of Uzhhorod aged 18 and older and eligible to vote. Samples are representative of the general population by gender and age.
- Both waves have a margin of error of ± 2.8 points. The response rate for wave one was 65.3% the response rate for wave two was 62.5%.
- The distribution of the population by region of the city is based on statistical data from the Central Election Commission from the 2014 parliamentary elections, which divided the city into electoral districts.
- A multistage probability sampling method was used with the random route and last birthday methods for respondent selection.
- Both waves' samples are weighted to the distribution of Uzhhorod's population by gender and age in accordance with data from the State Statistics Committee of Ukraine from January 1, 2018.
- Charts and graphs may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding.
- Cited bases are weighted.
- The survey was funded by the [U.S. Agency for International Development \(USAID\)](#).

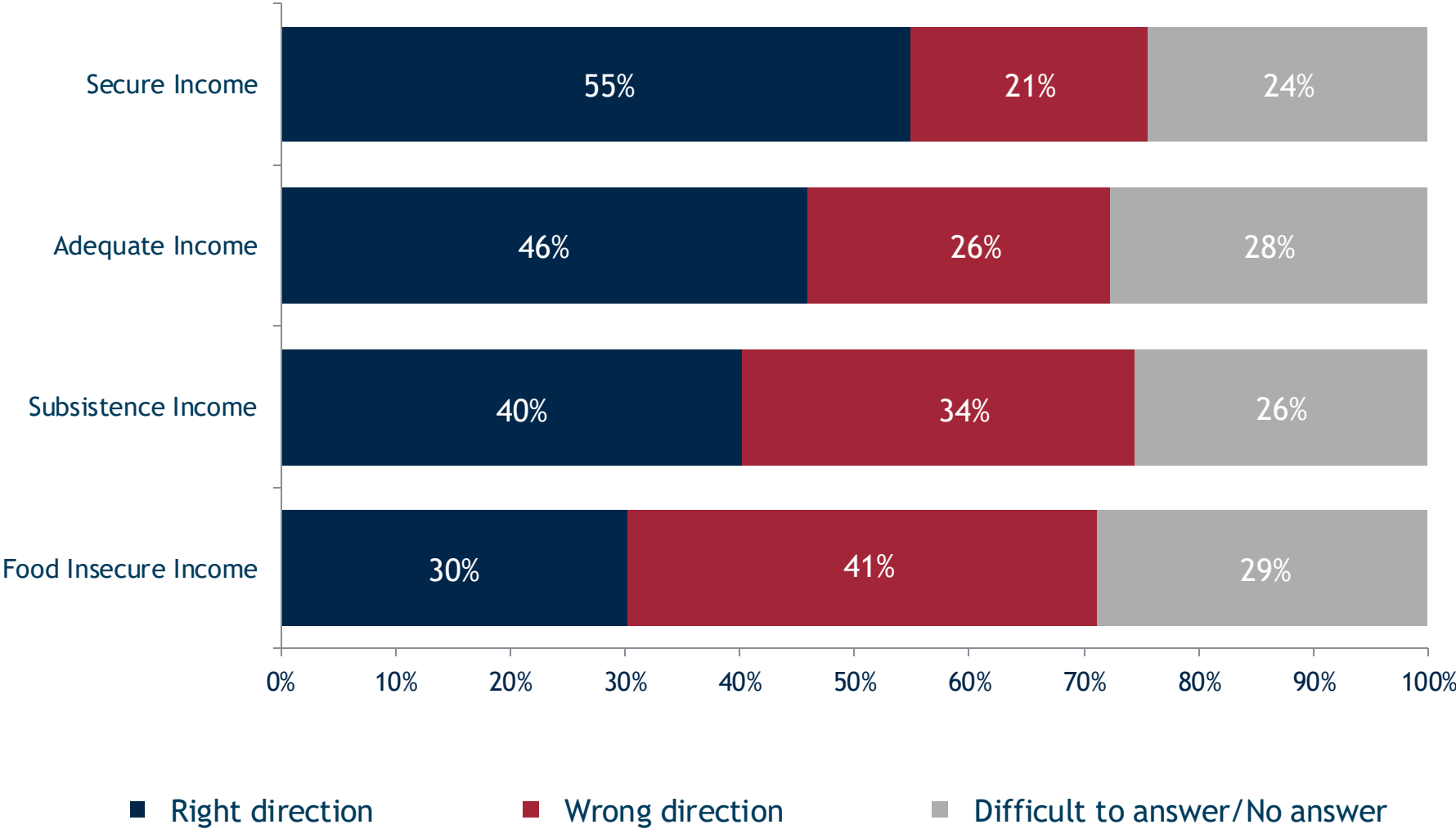

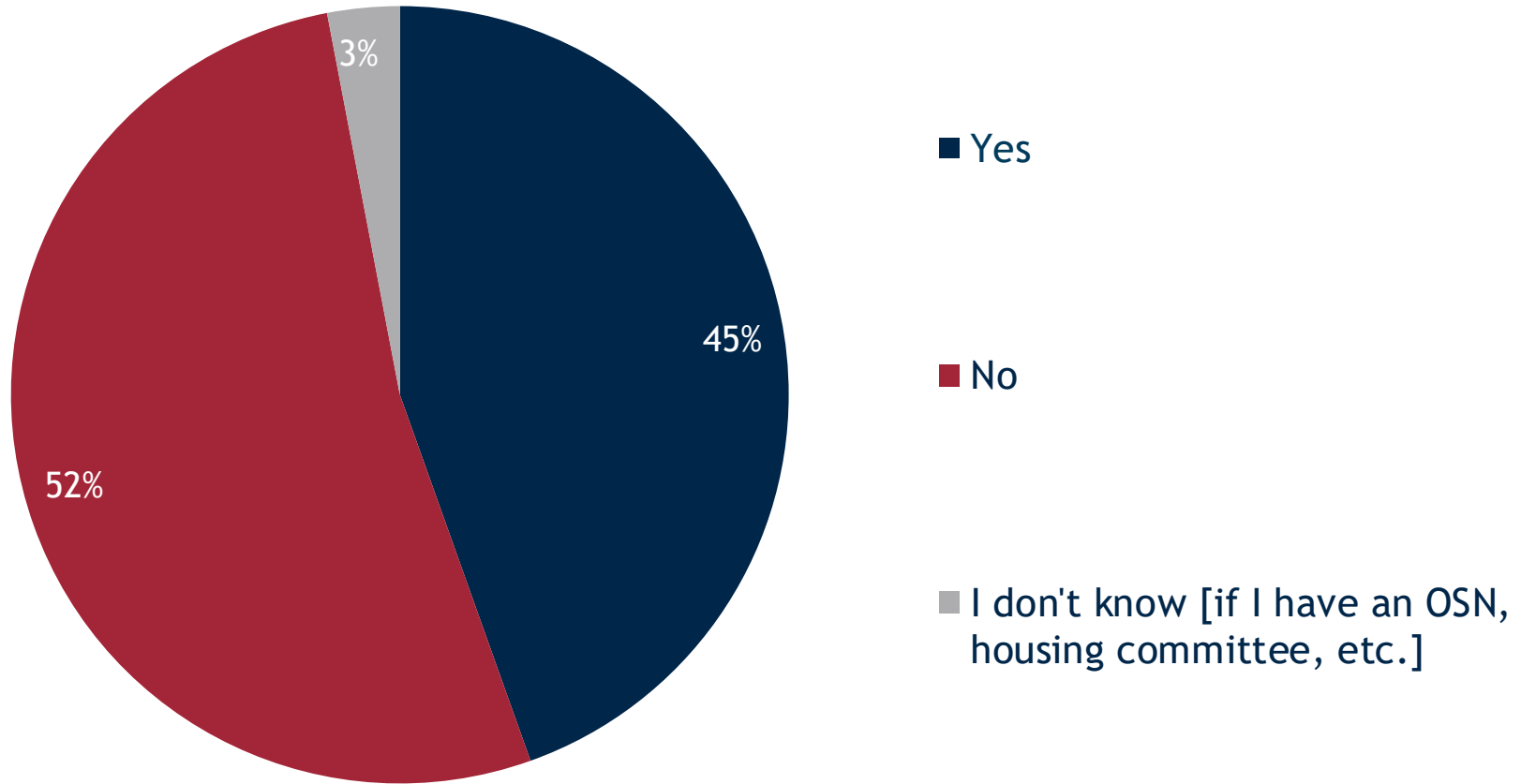

If you live in an apartment building, do you have a housing association established there (OSBB)?

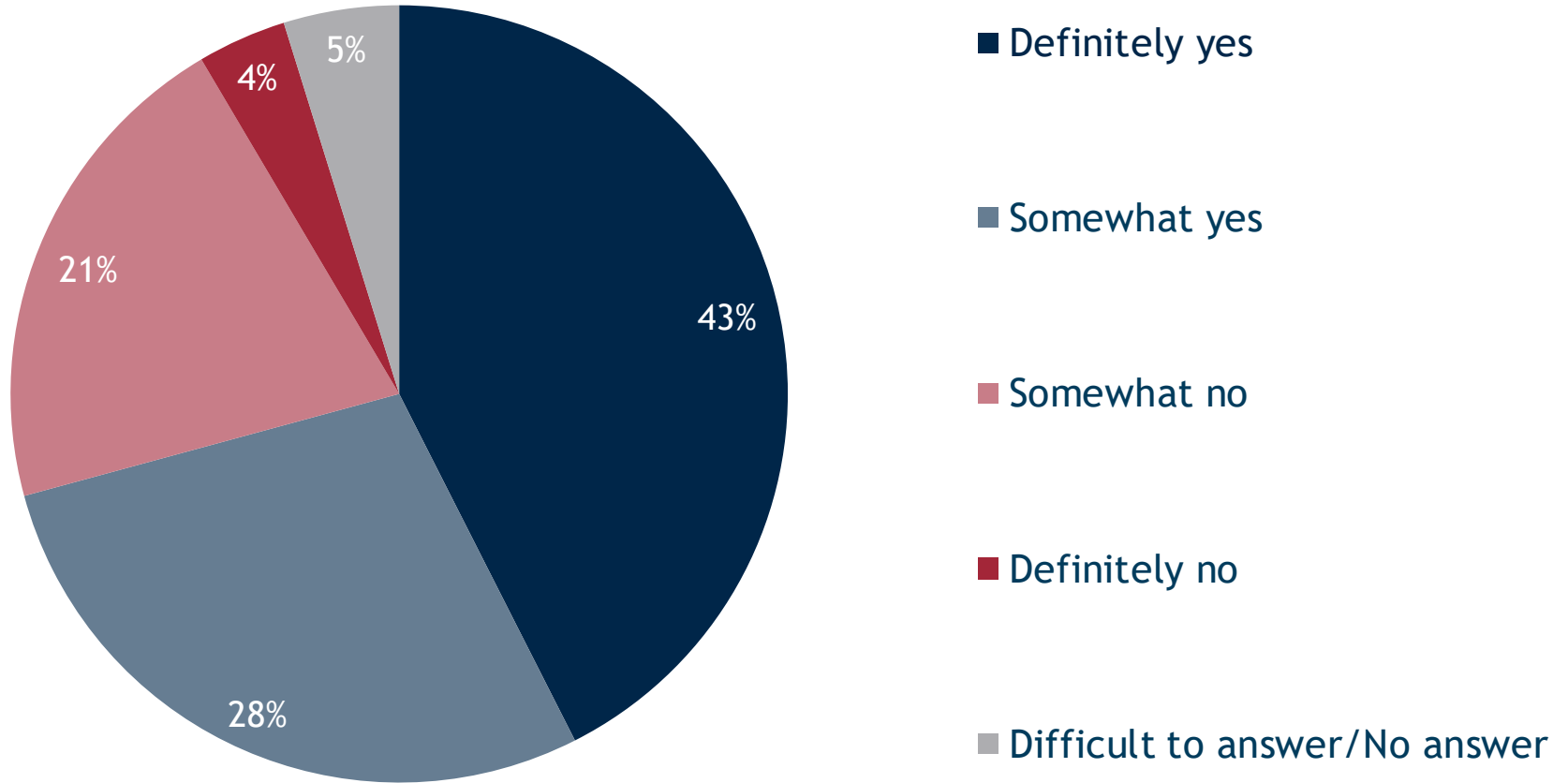

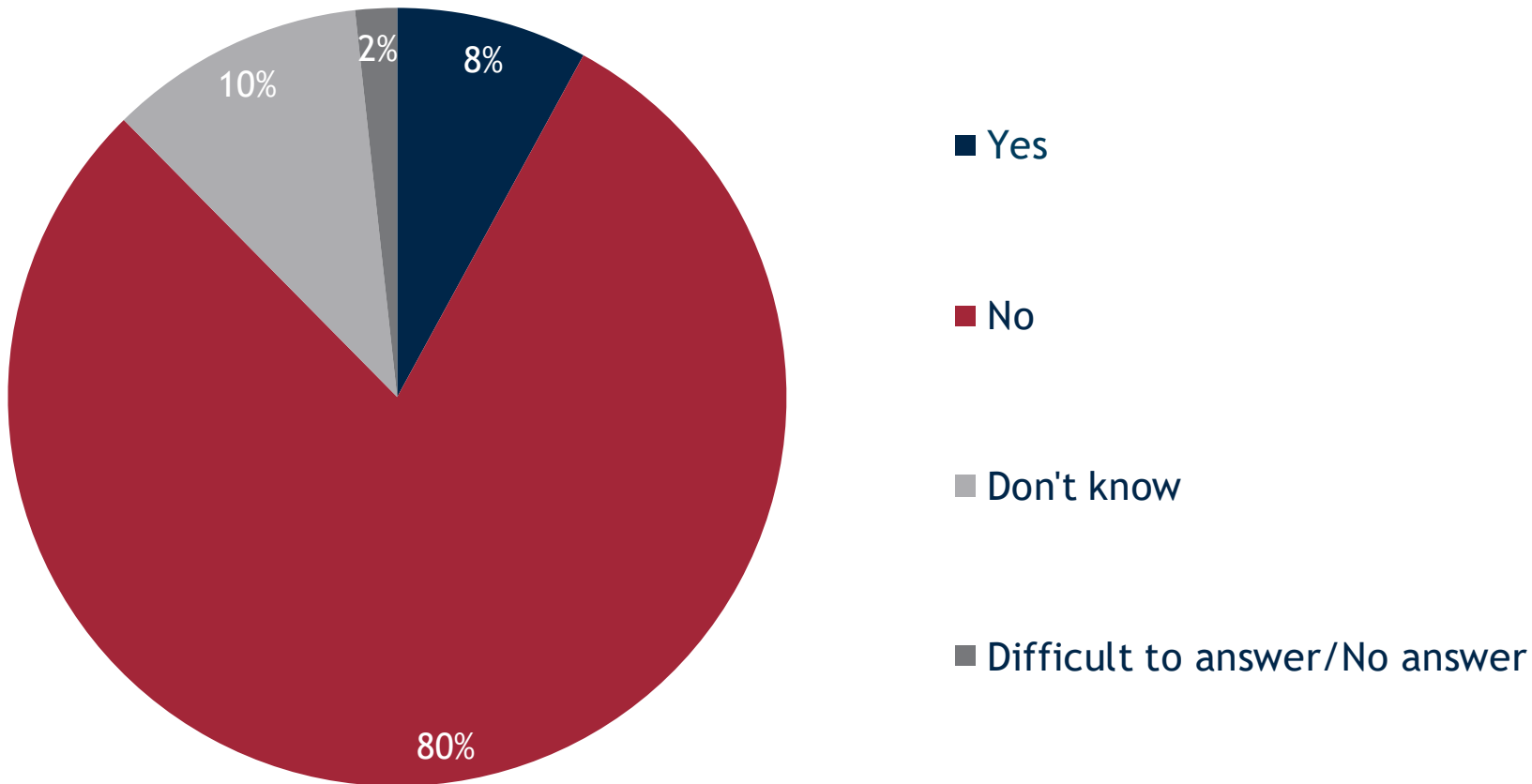

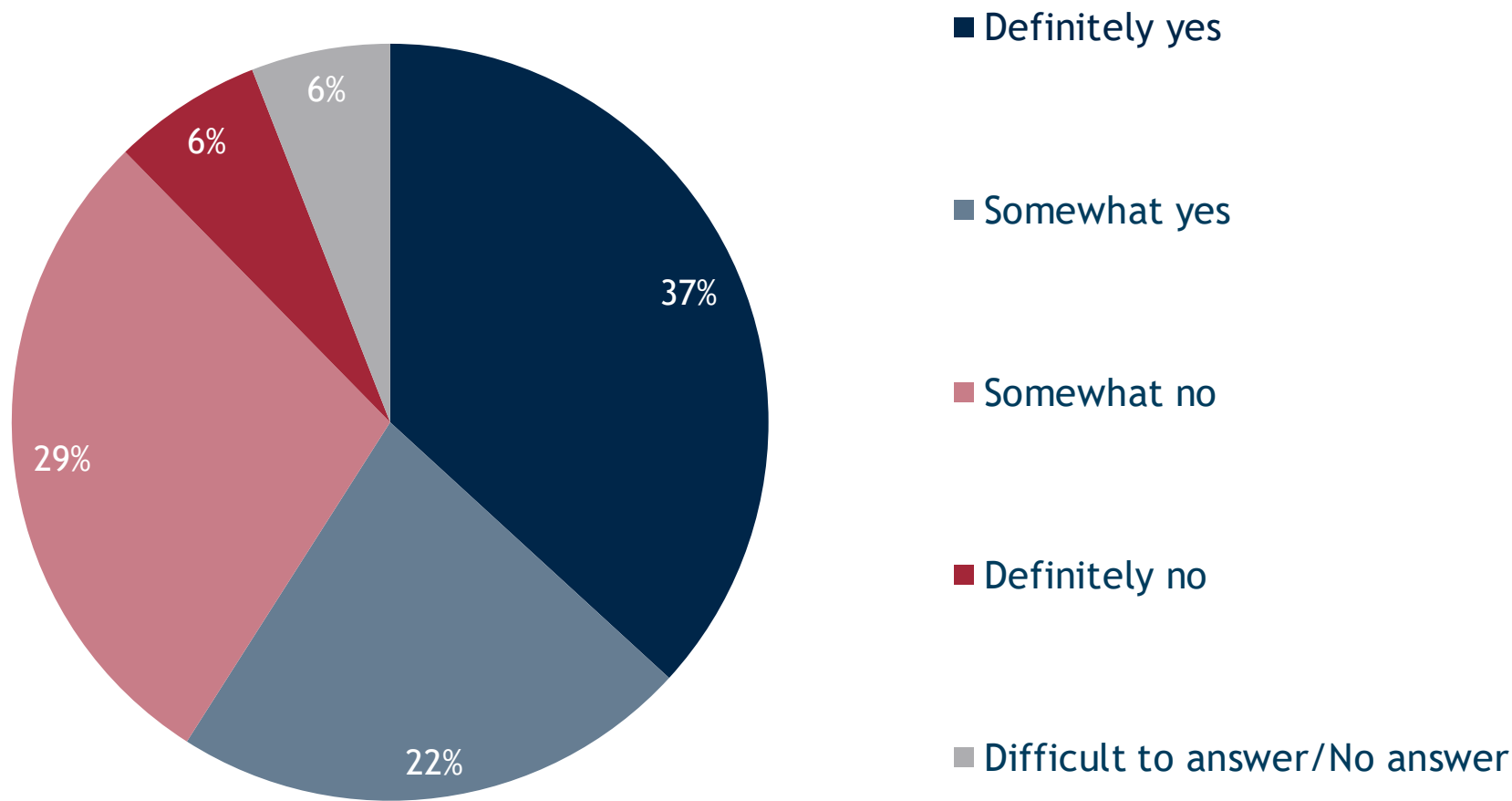

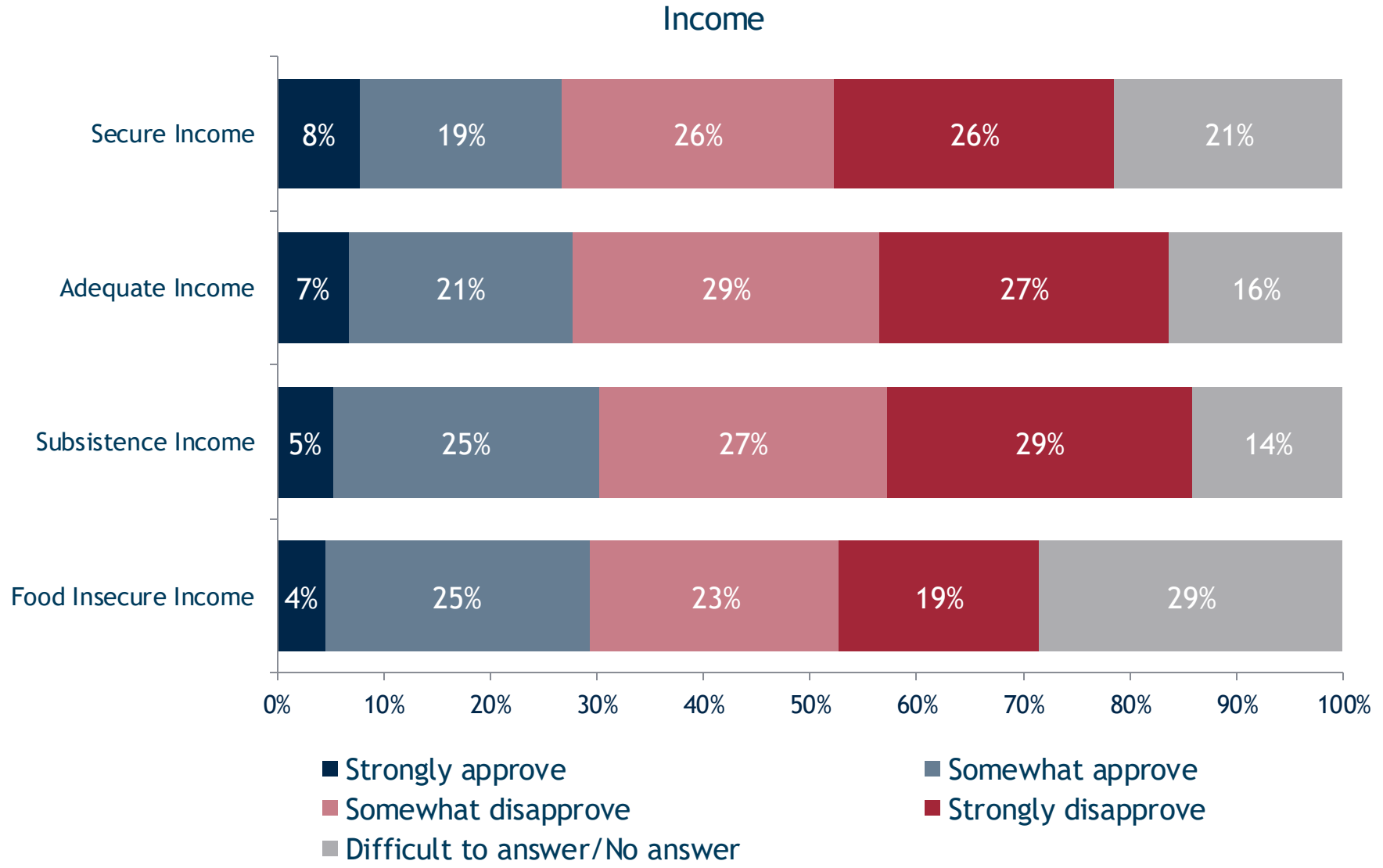

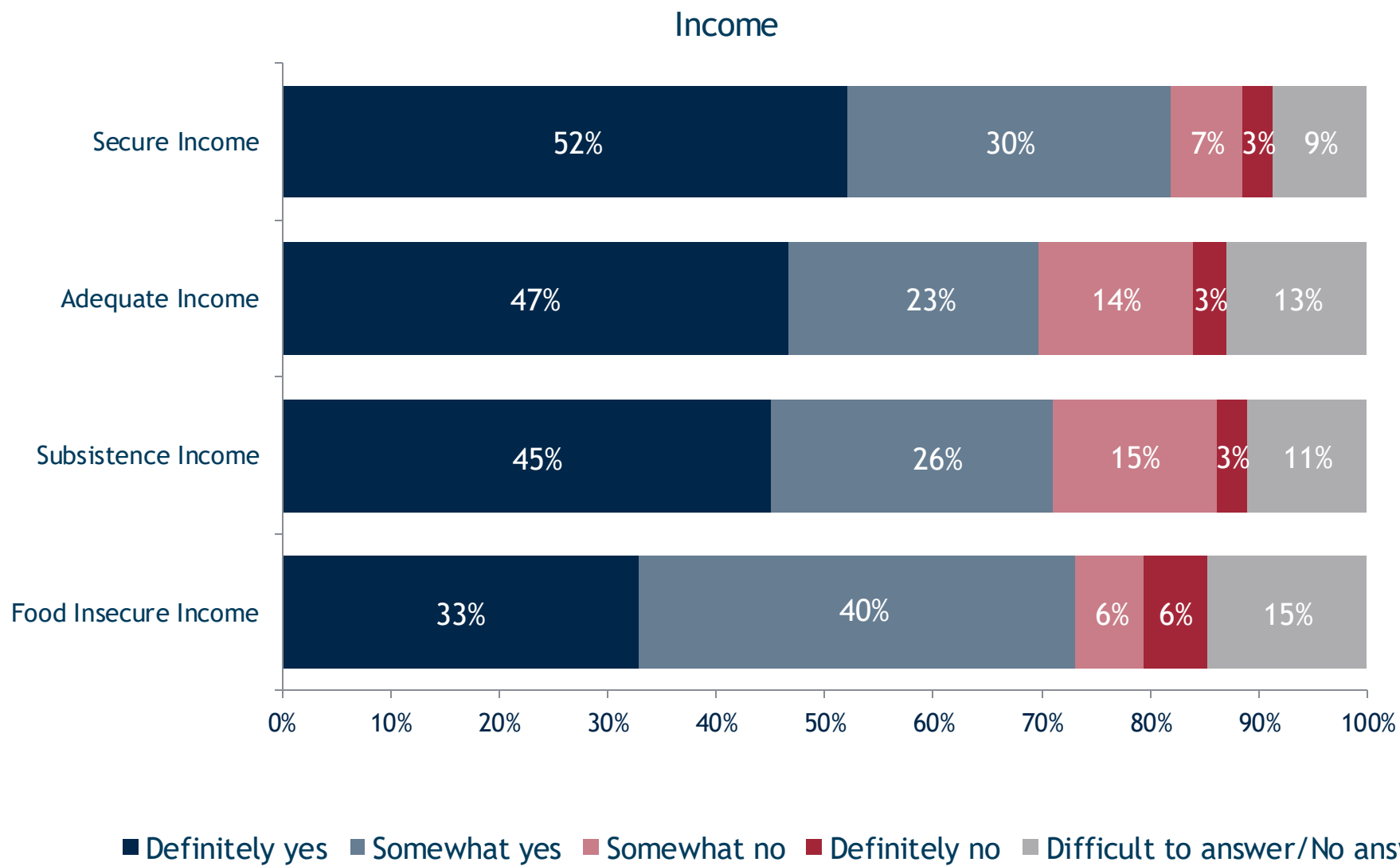

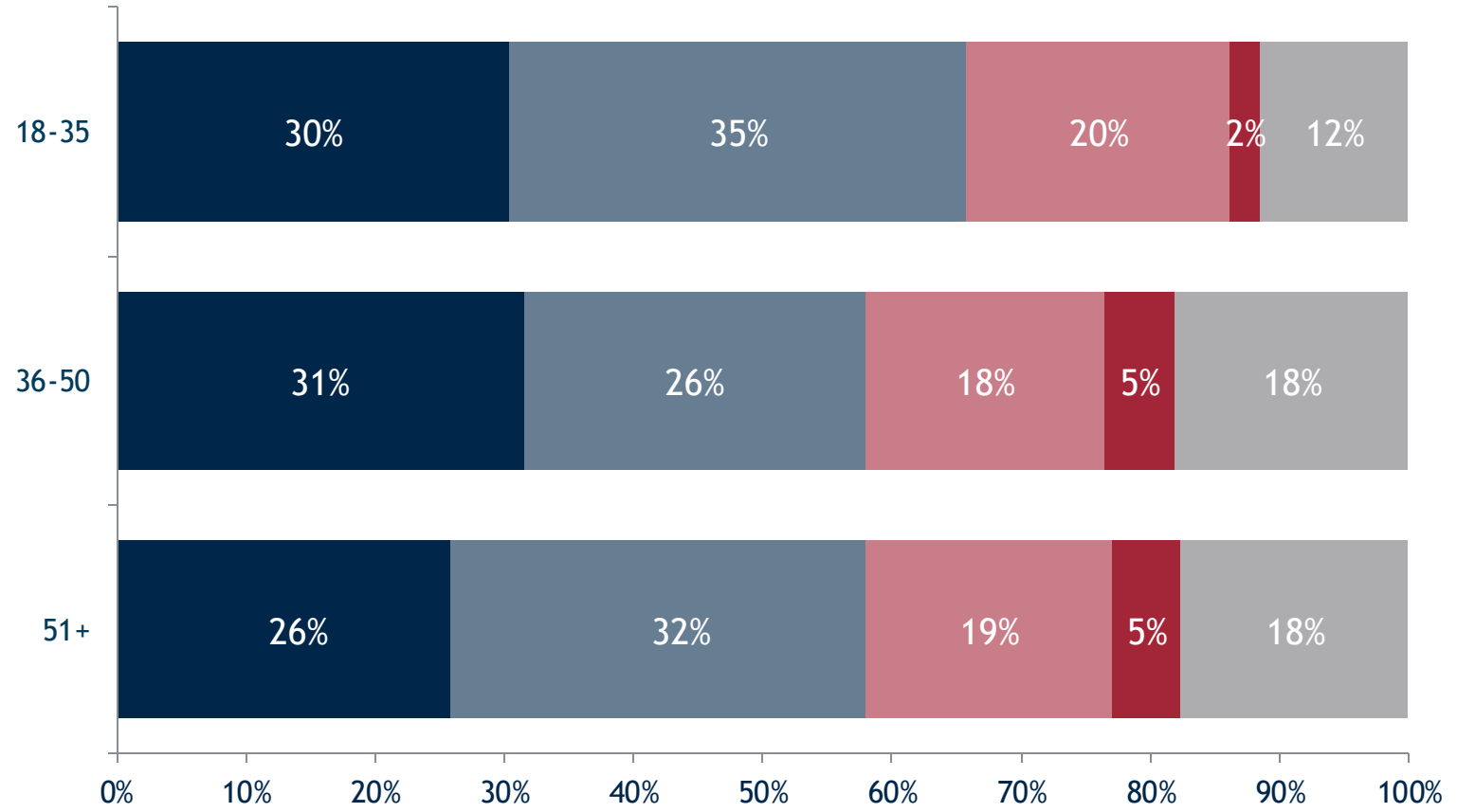

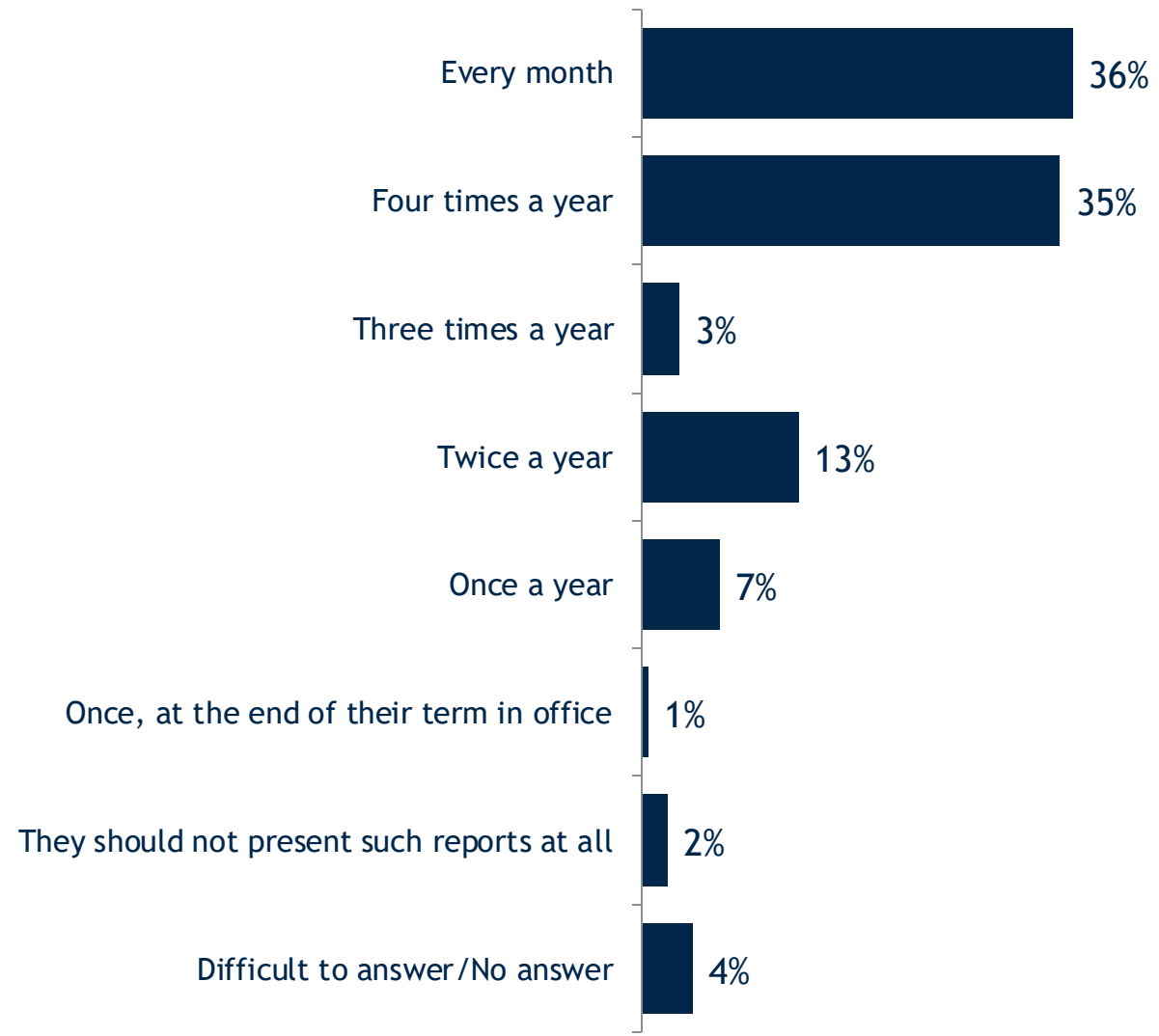

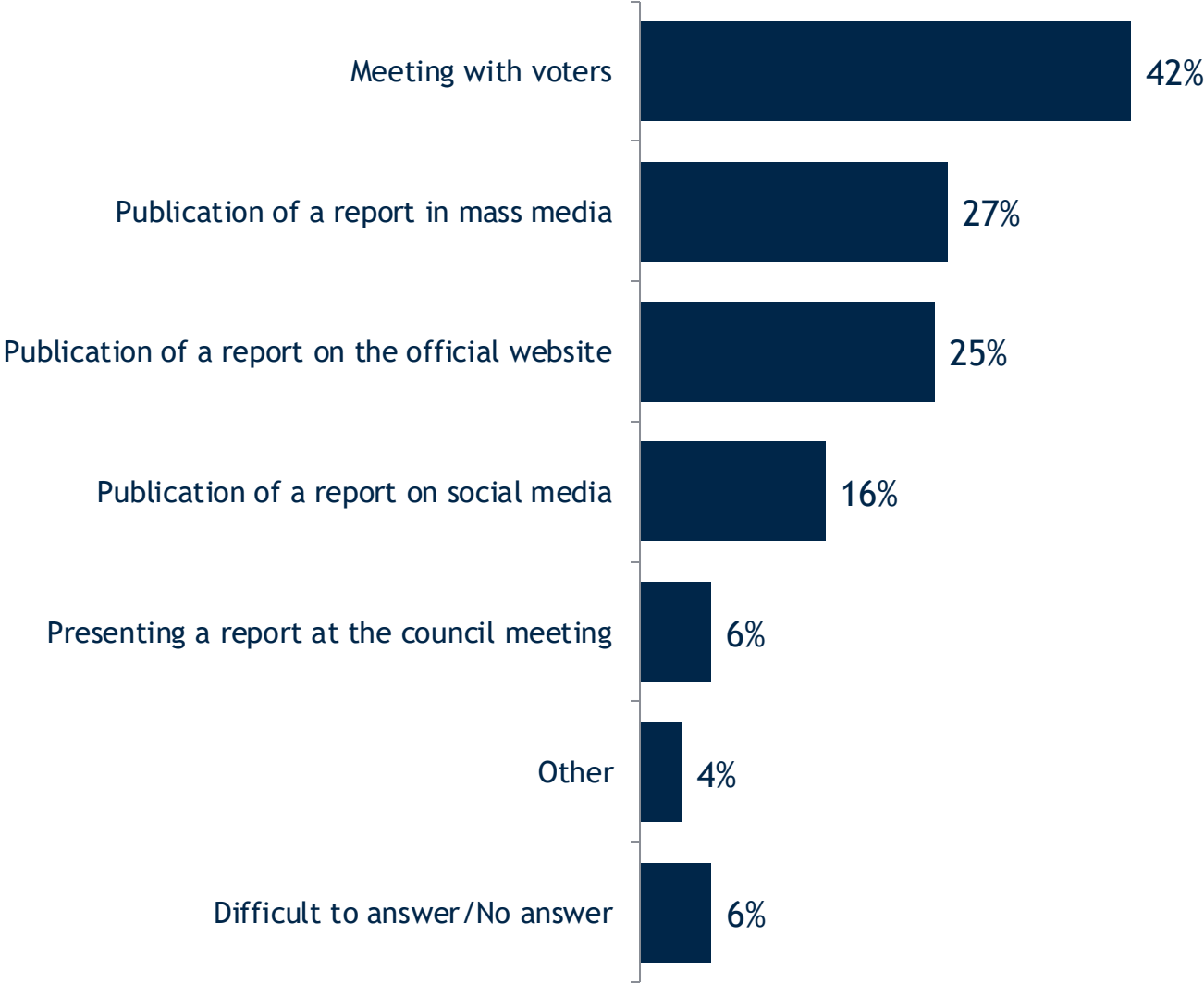


In your opinion, how often should local councilmembers present reports on their activities to their voters?

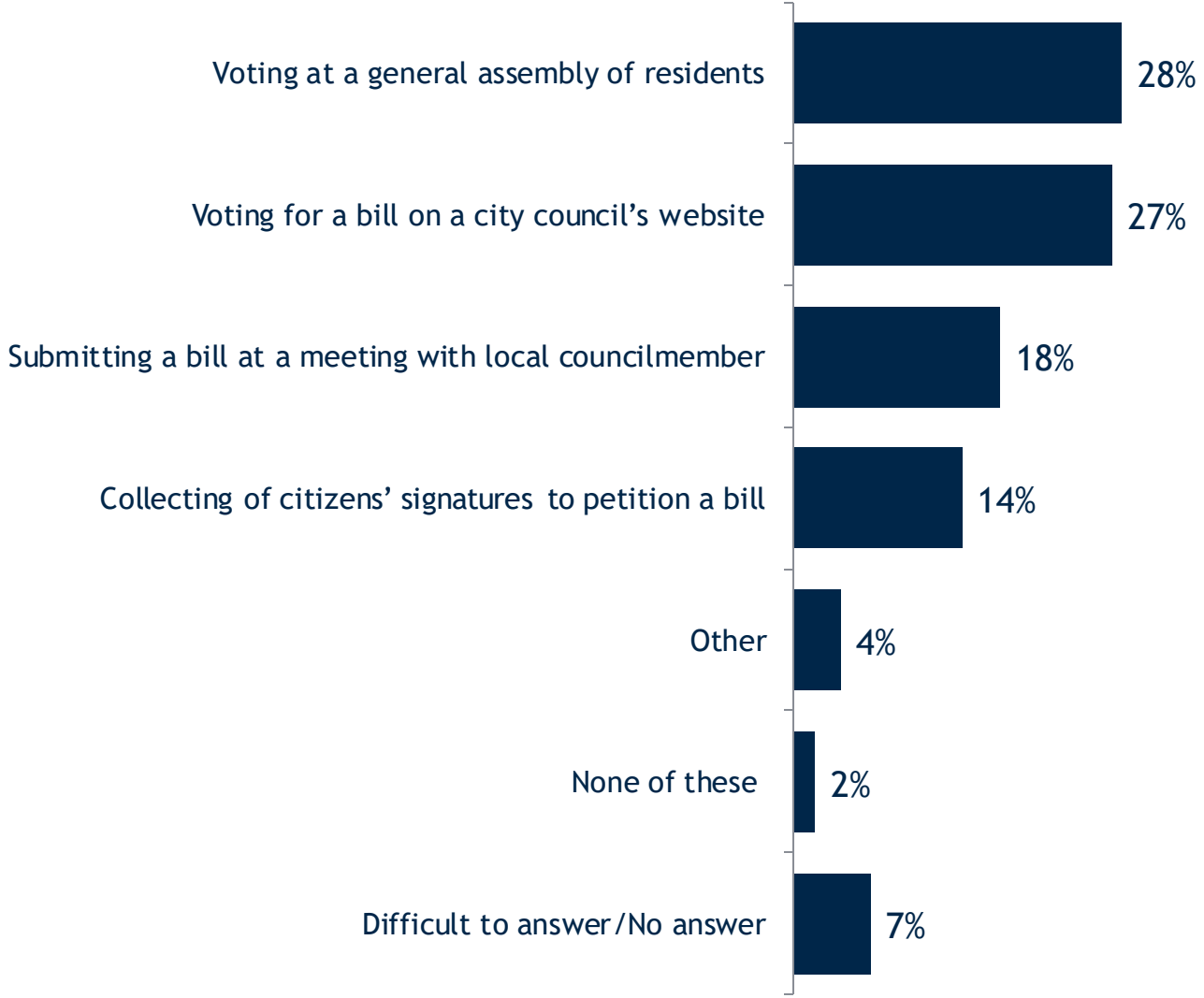

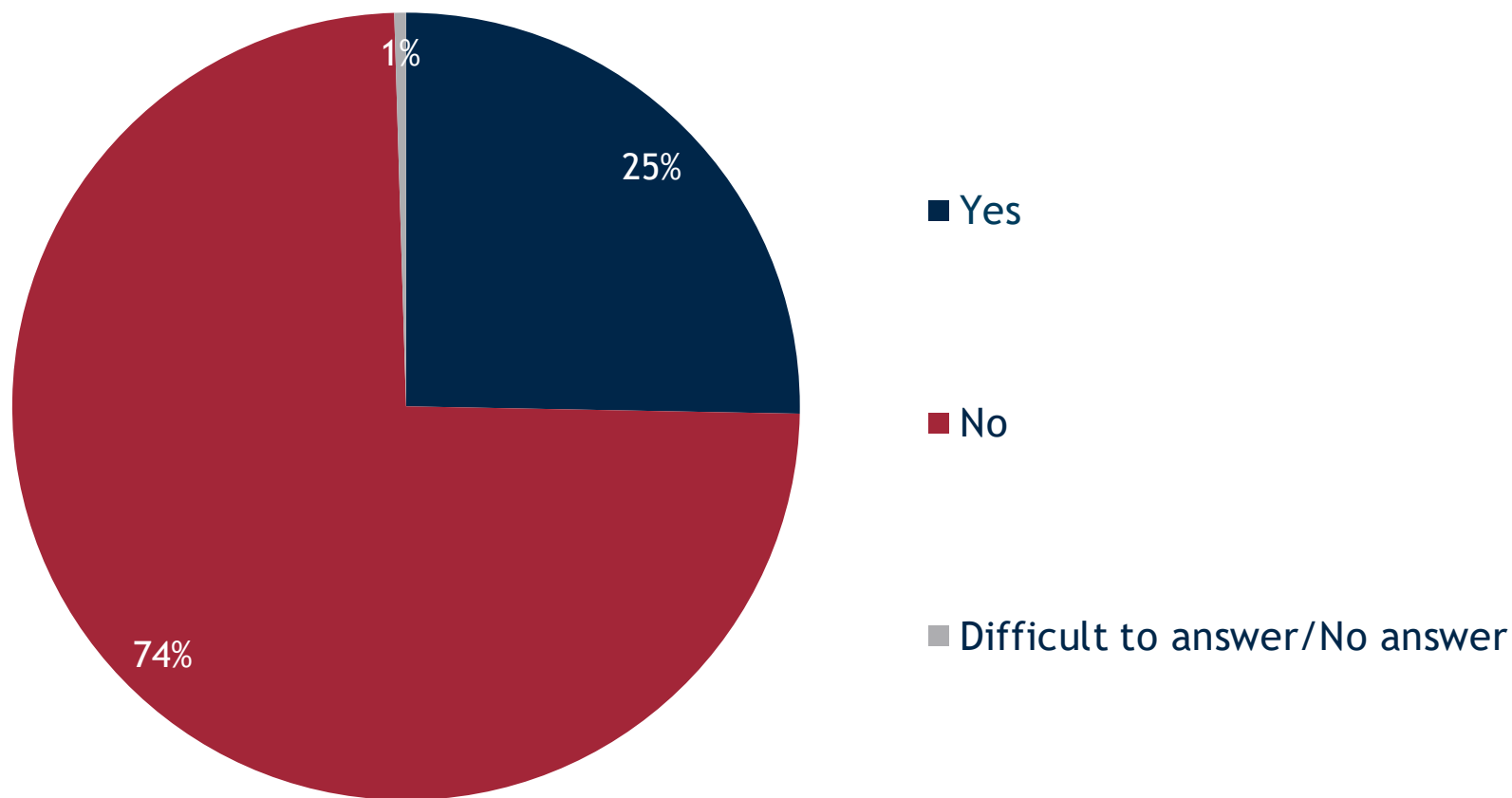

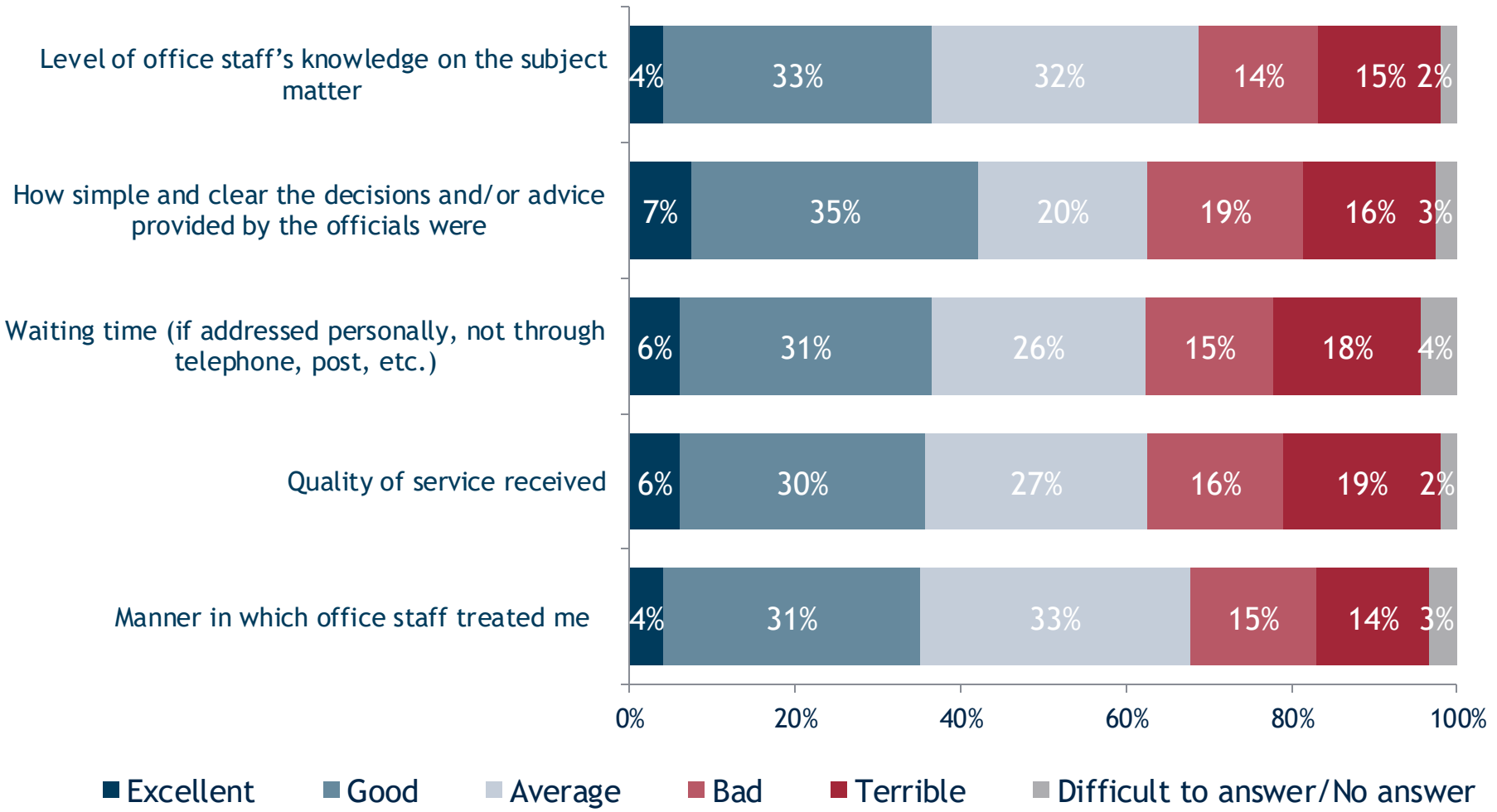

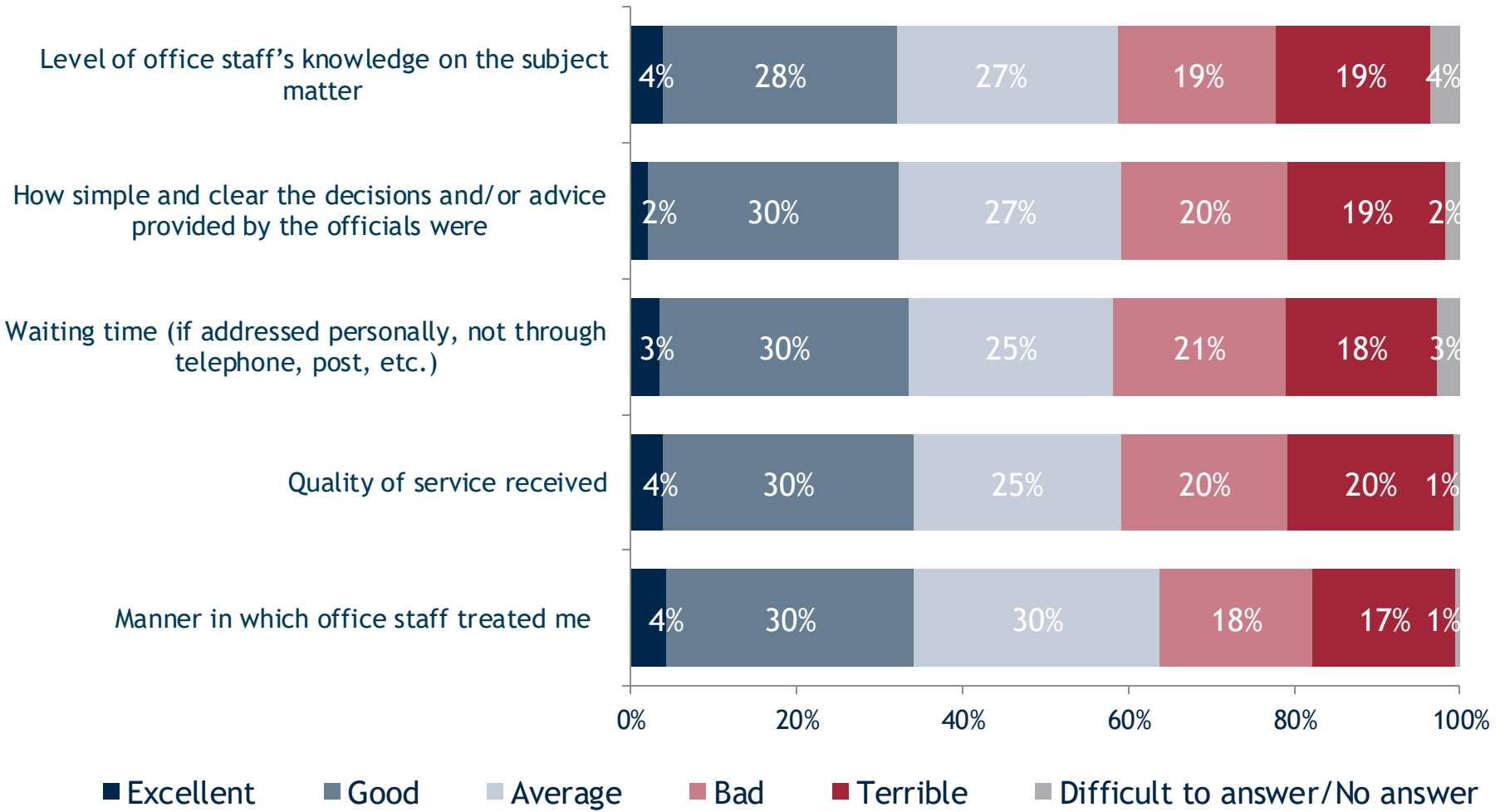

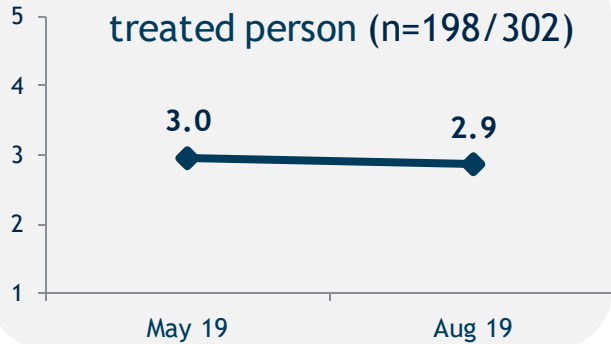

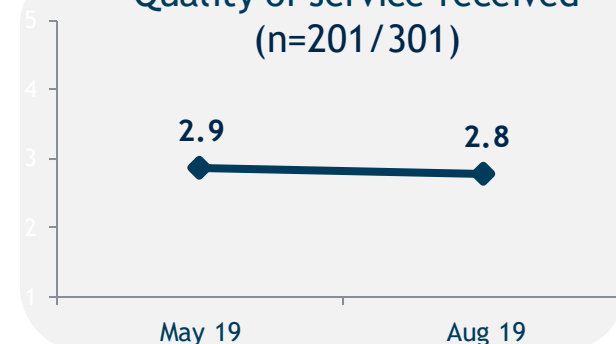

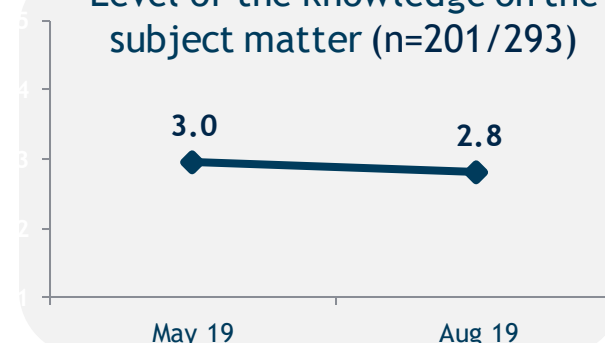

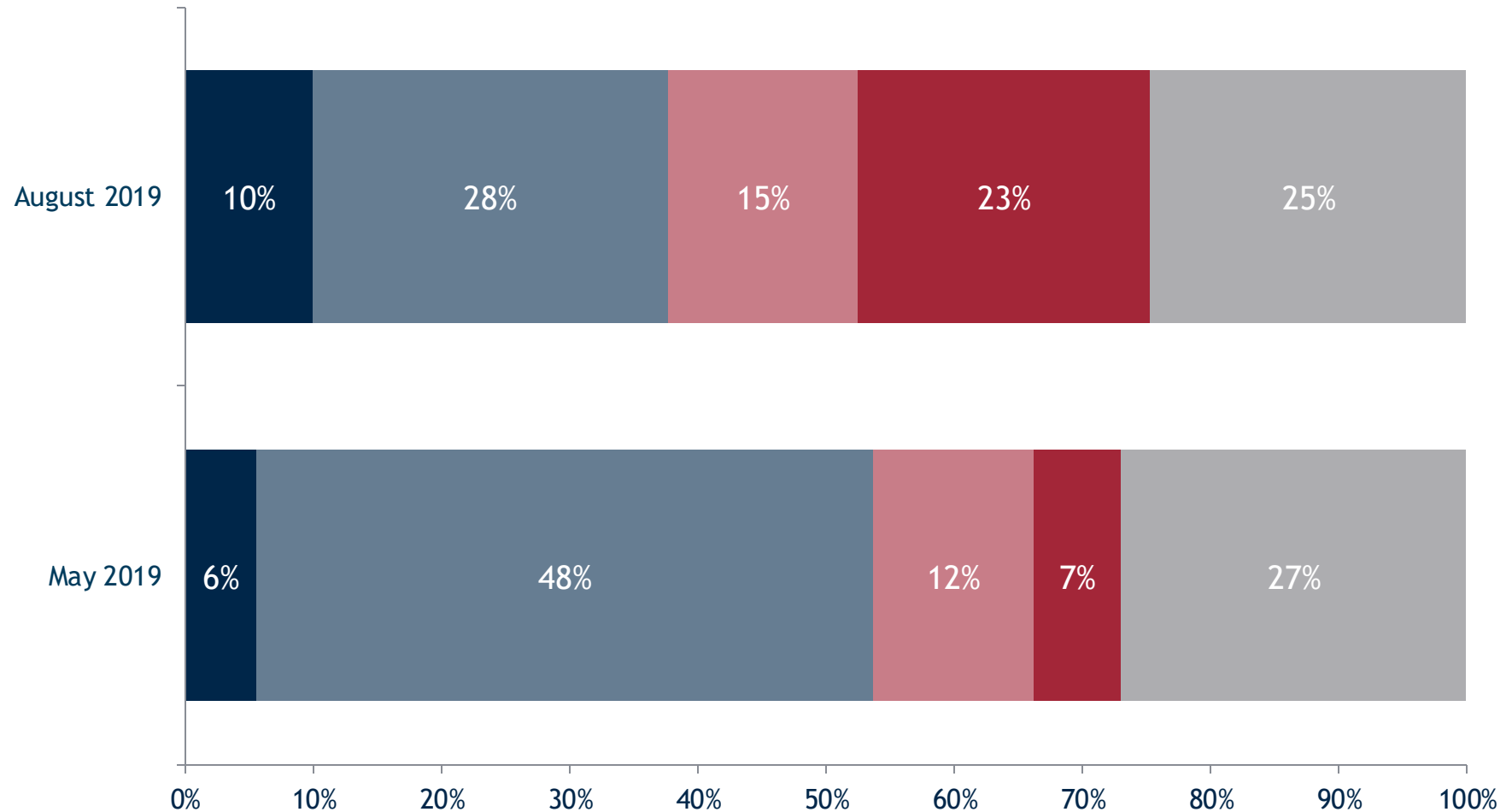

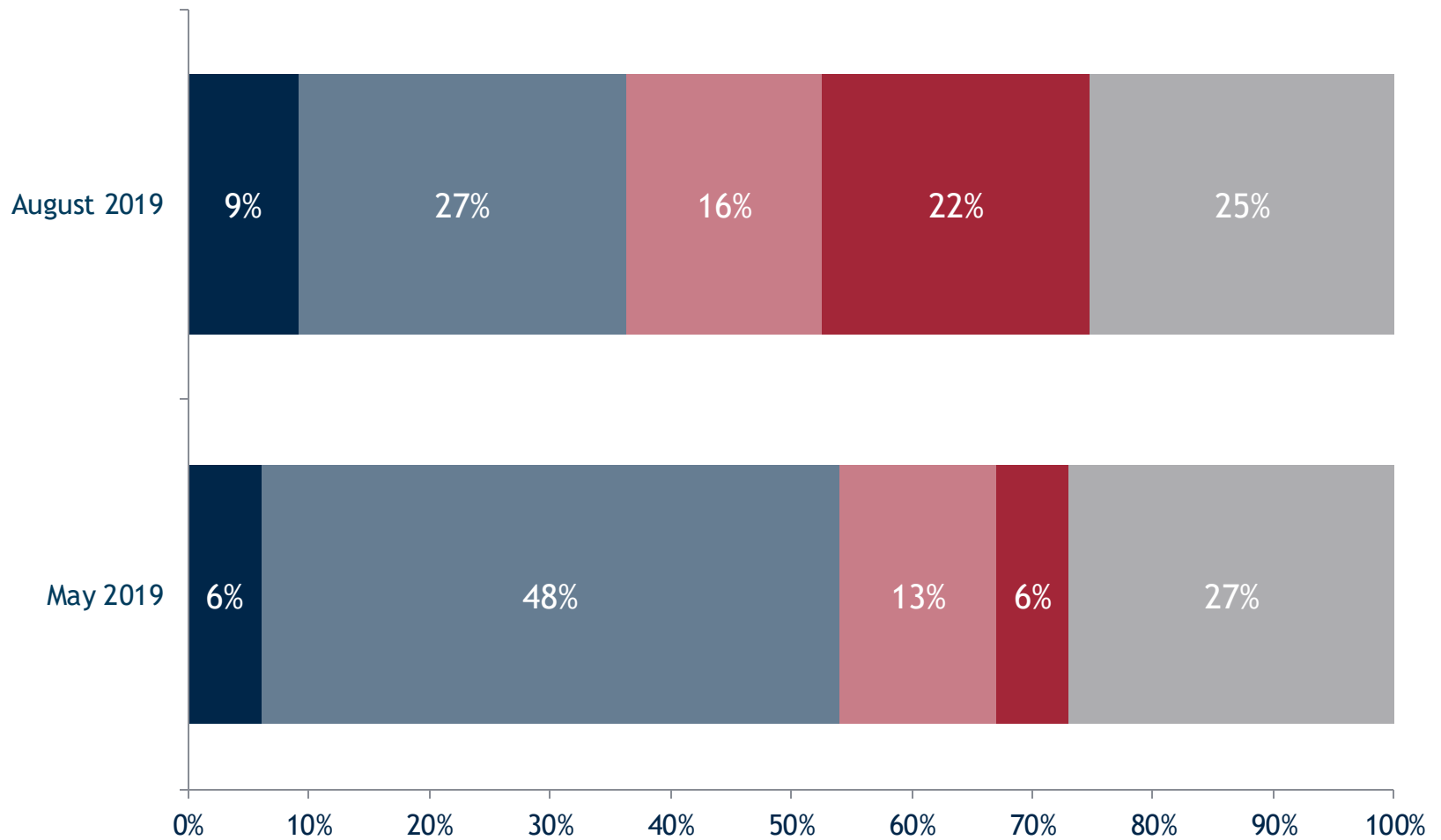

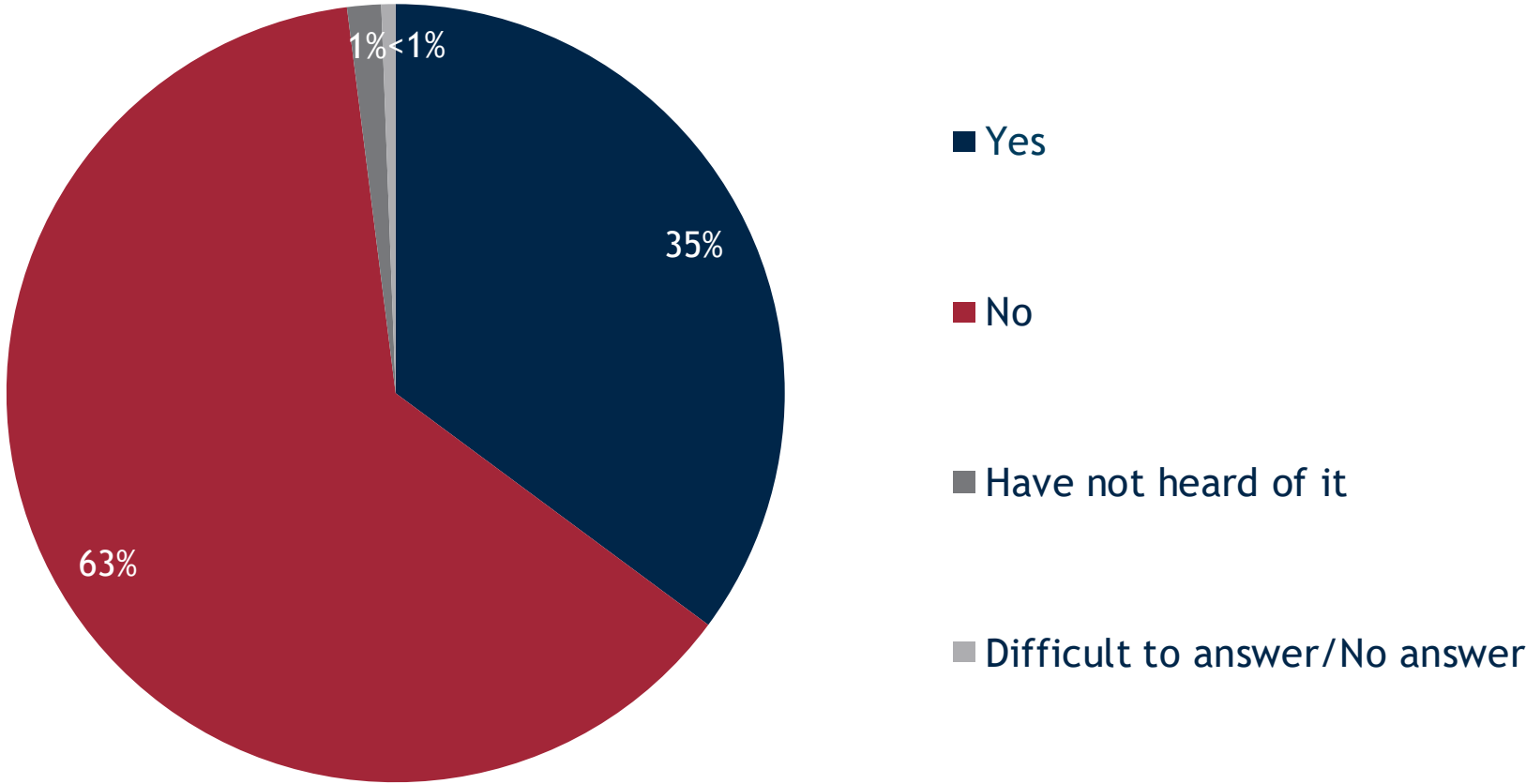

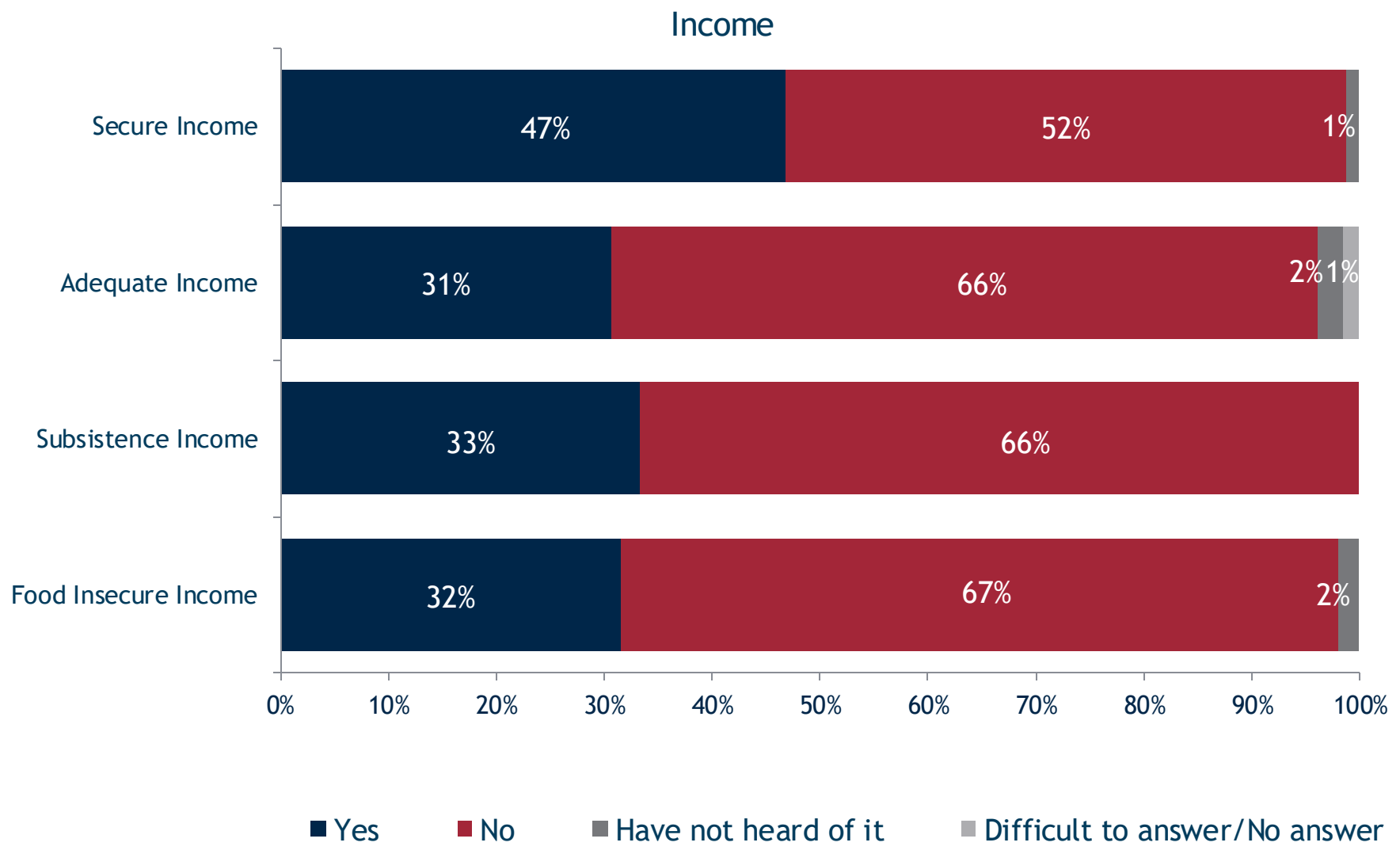

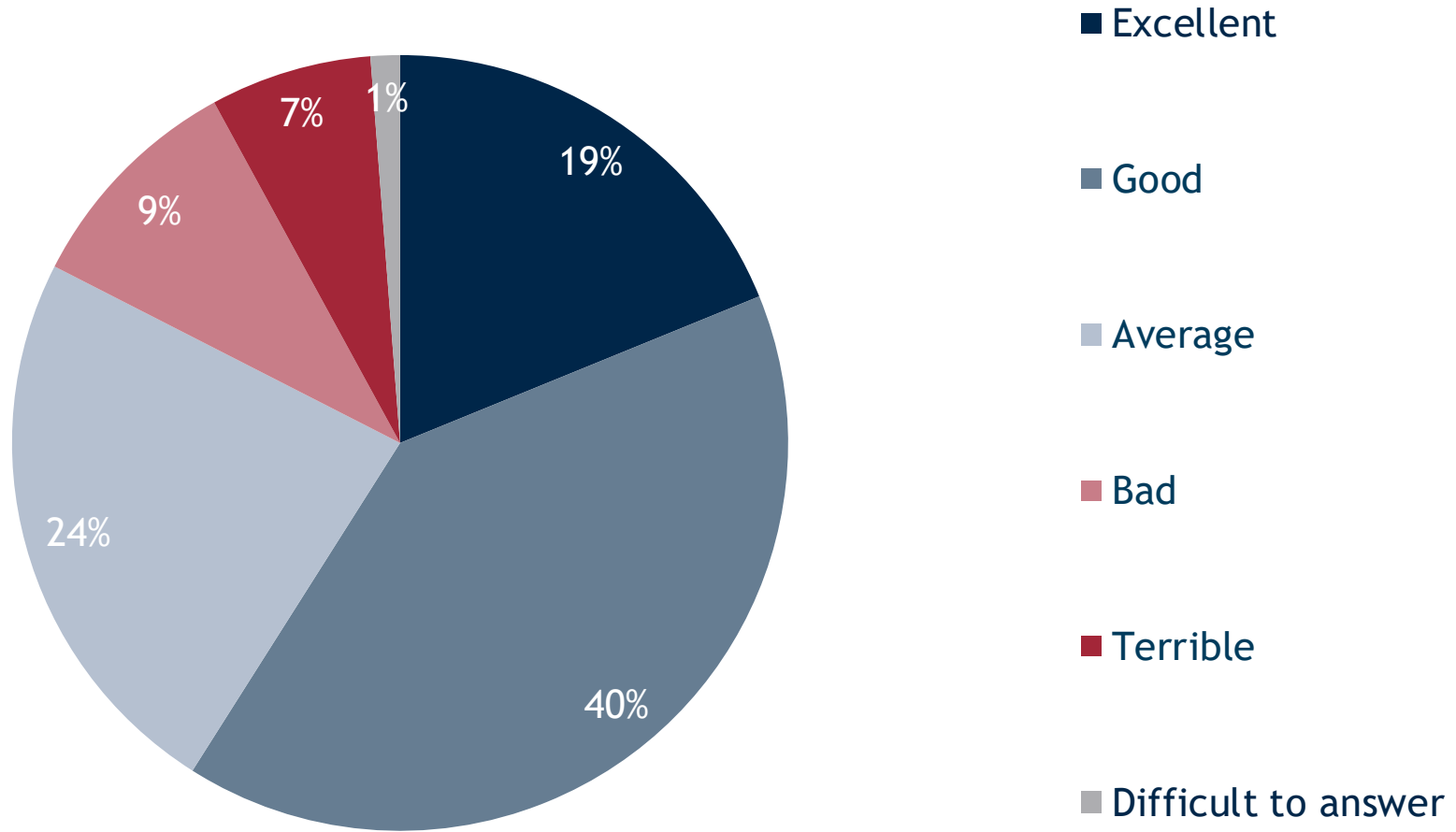

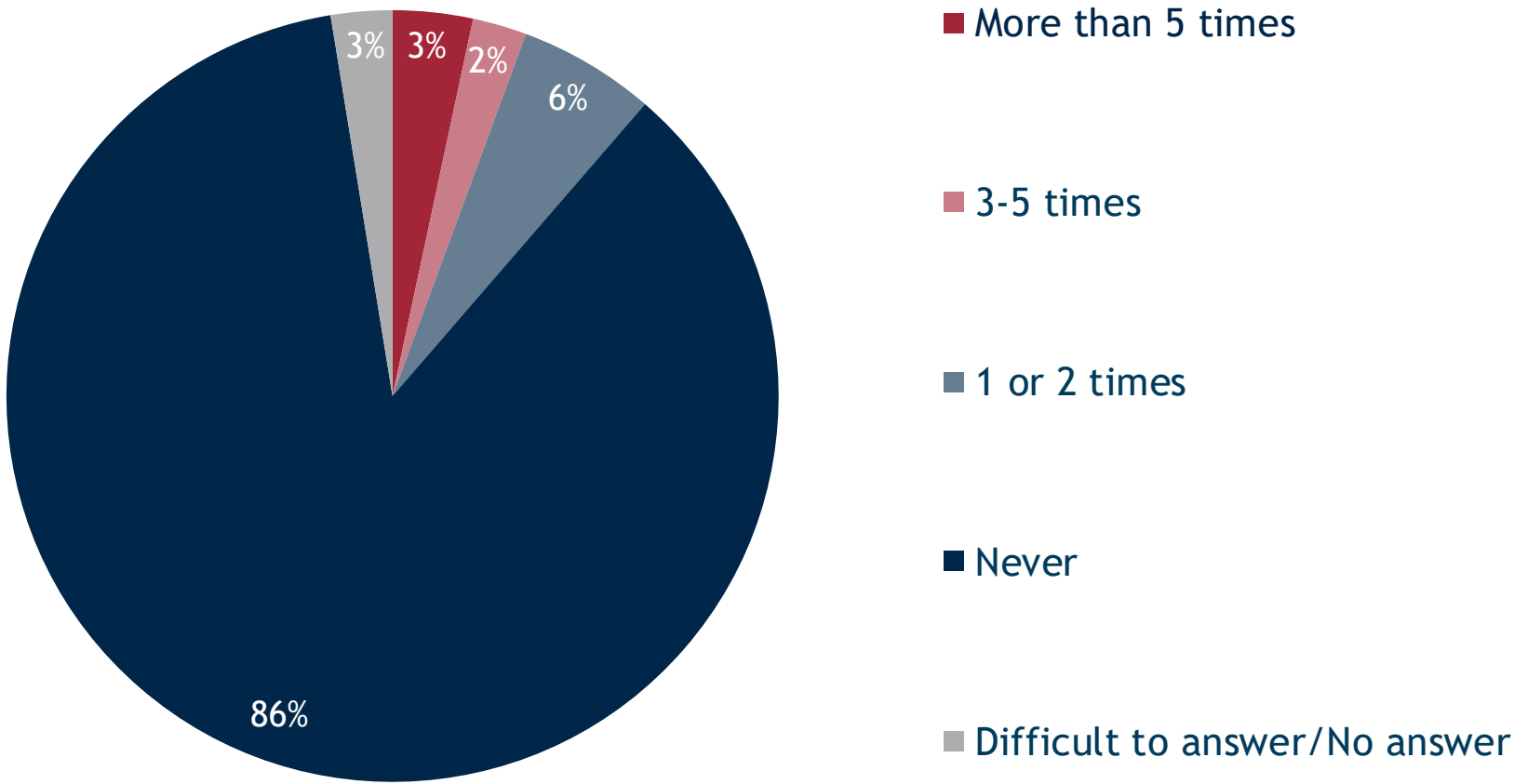

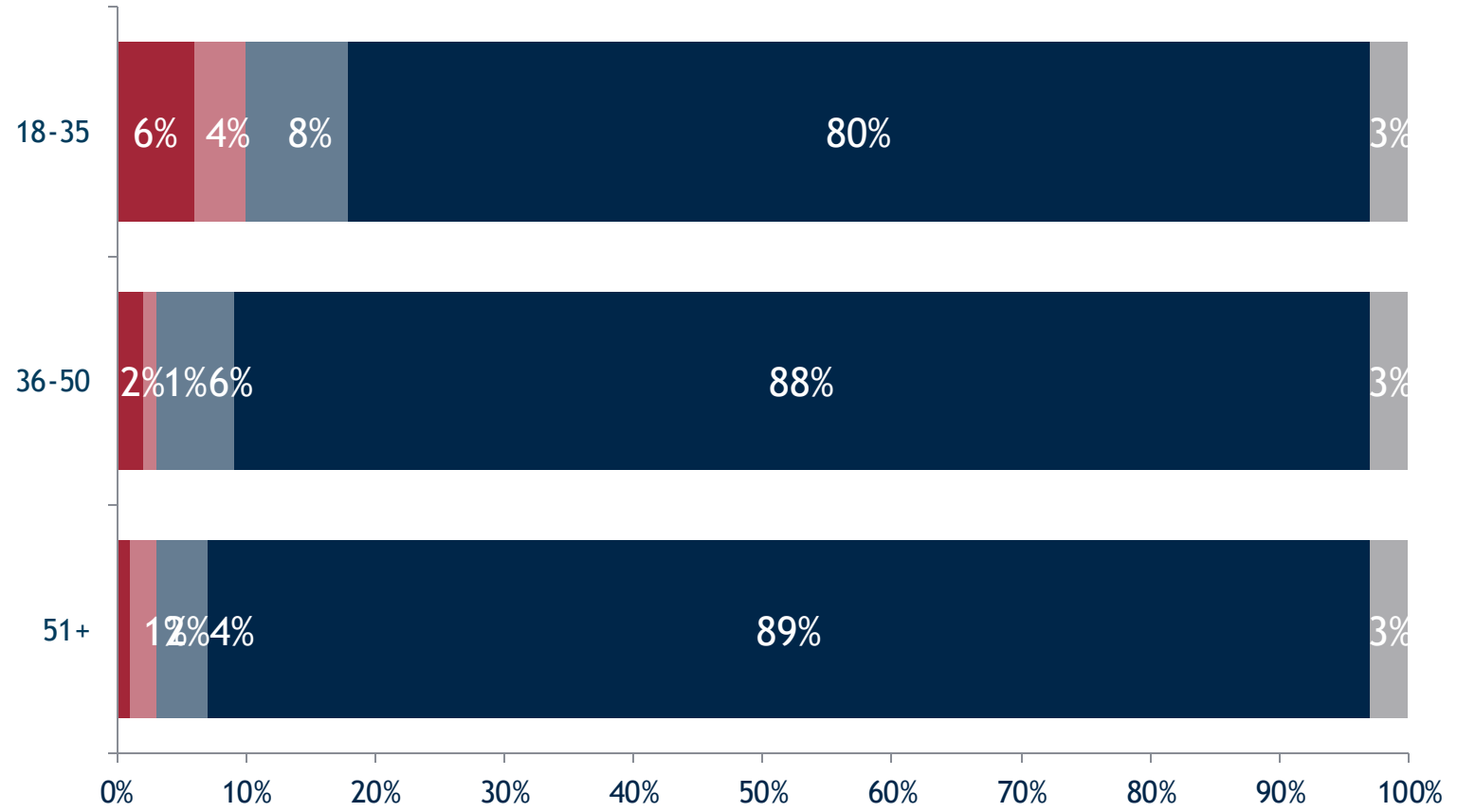

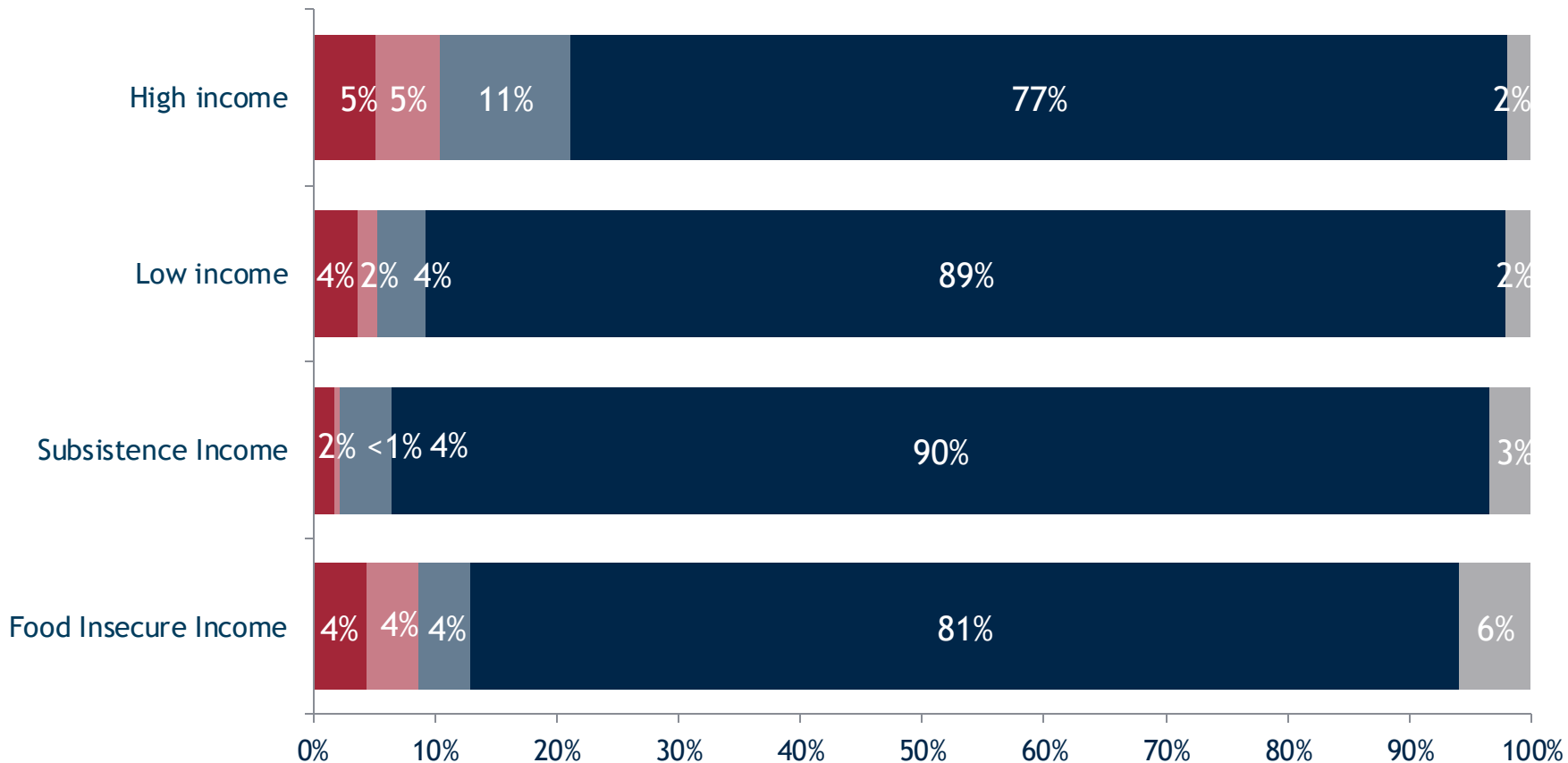

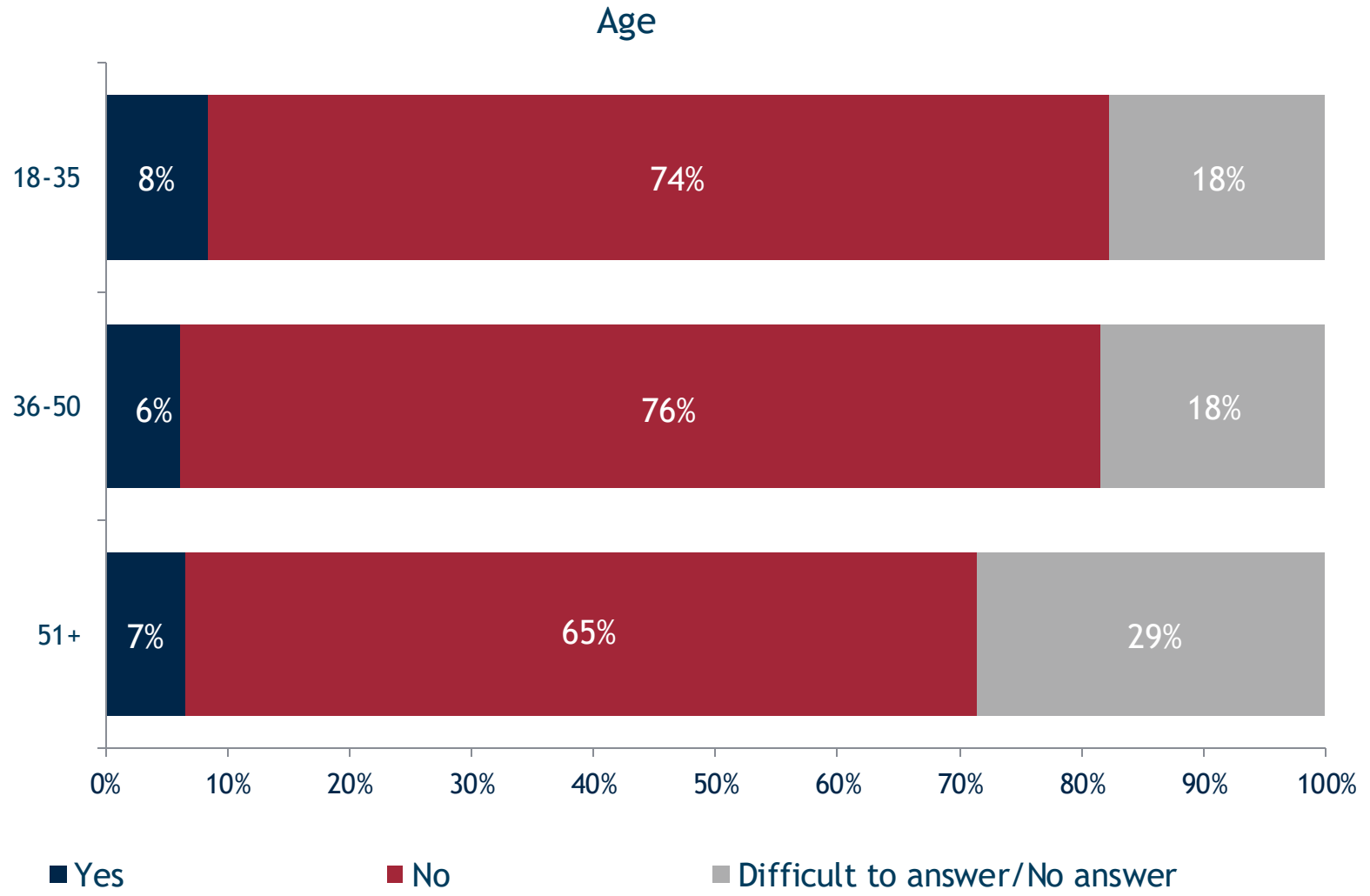

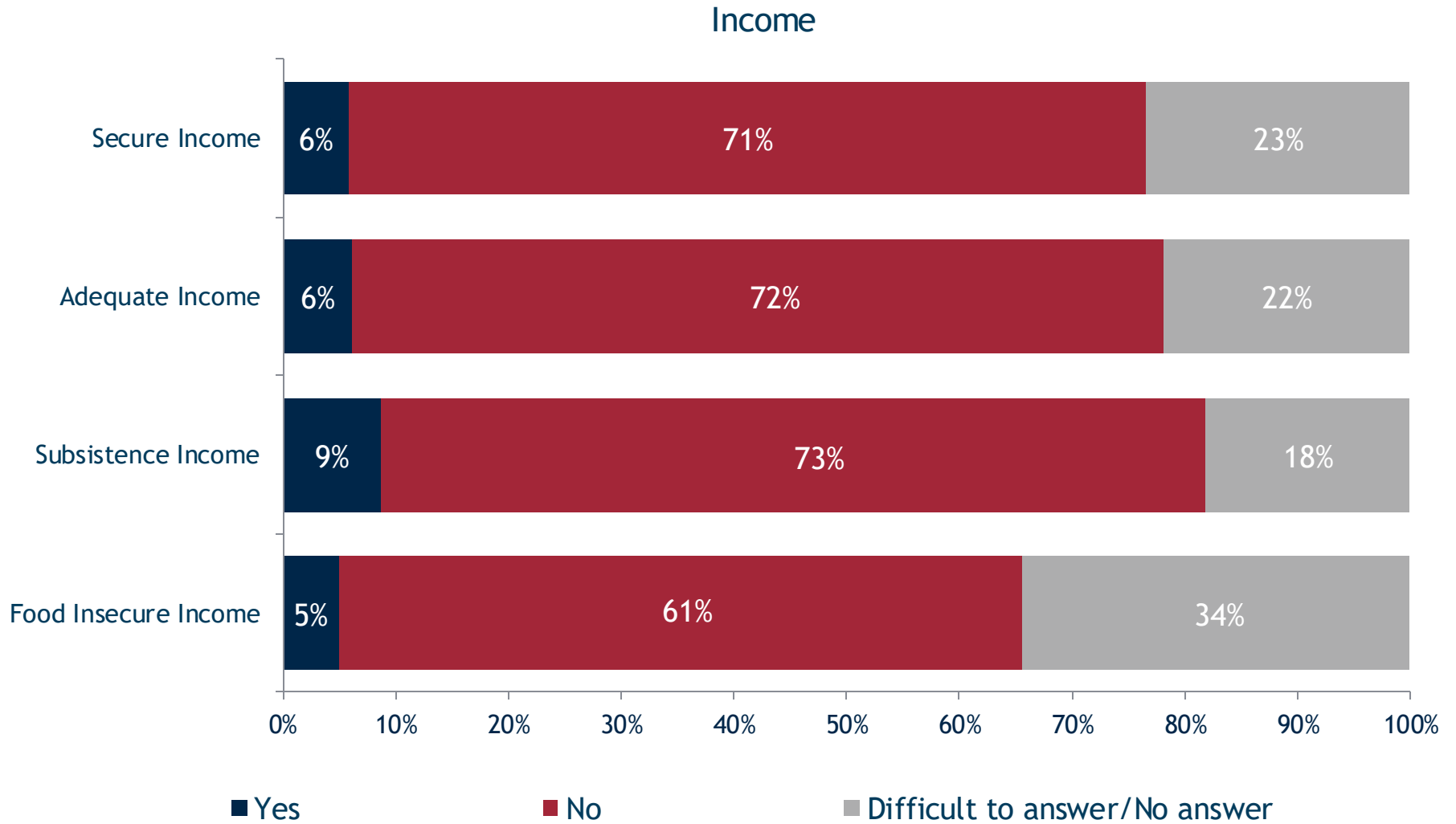

Do you support or oppose keeping languages other than Ukrainian as languages of instruction in primary schools?

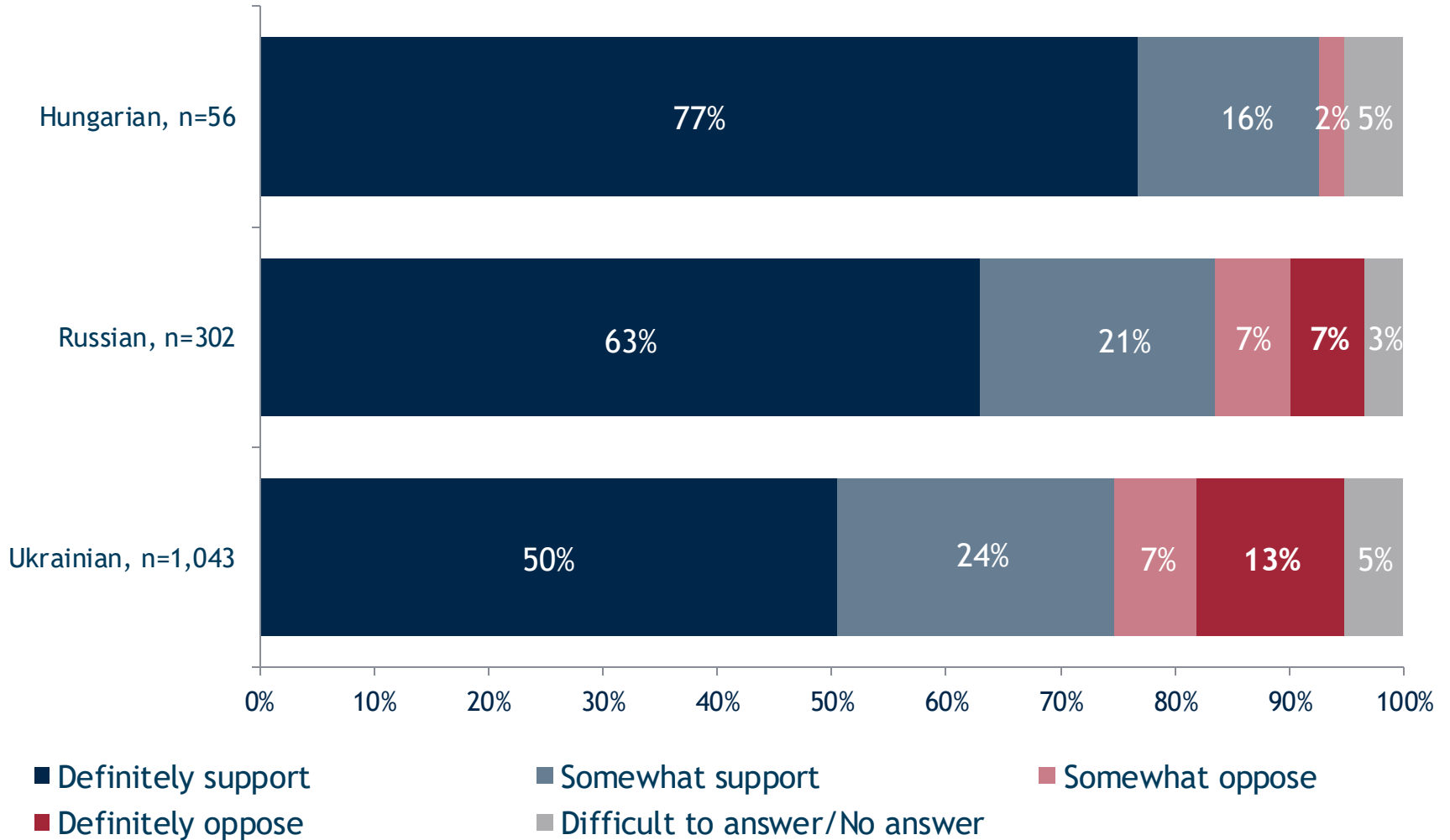

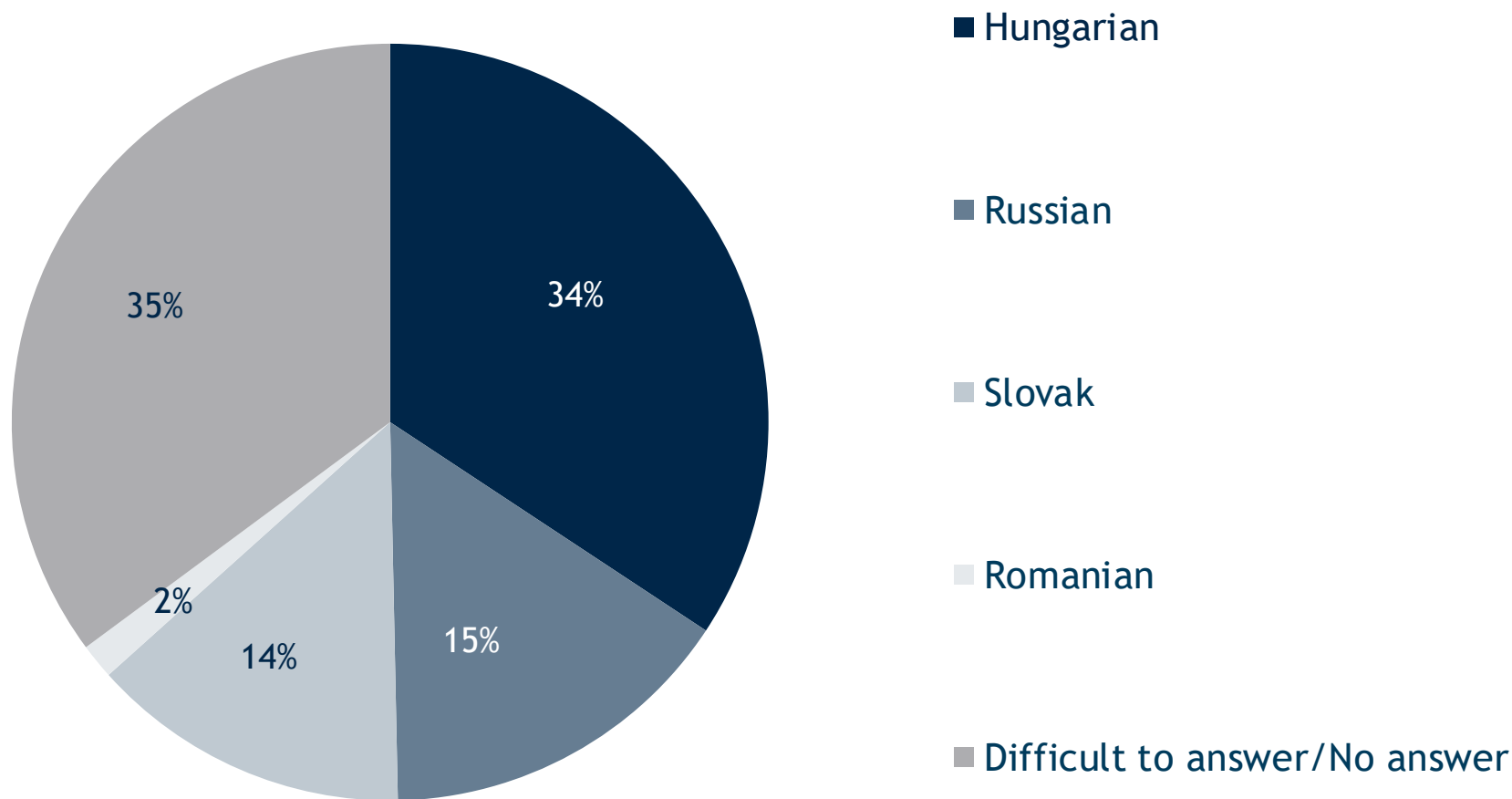
