
Detailed Methodology

- The survey fieldwork was carried out by <u>Magenta Consulting</u> on behalf of the International Republican Institute's <u>Center for Insights in Survey Research</u>.
- Data was collected throughout Moldova (with the exception of Transnistria) between November 16, 2019 and December 8, 2019 through face-to-face interviews in respondents' homes.
- The sample consisted of n=1,204 permanent residents of Moldova aged 18 and older and eligible to vote and is representative of the general population by age, gender, region and settlement size.
- Sampling frame: Moldova Statistical Databank. Weighting: Data was weighted for age groups and gender using newly released population figures by the National Bureau of Statistics.
- A multistage probability sampling method was used, with random route and next birthday respondent selection procedures.
 - Stage one: All districts (*raions*) of Moldova are grouped into 11 groups; all regions (with the exception of Transnistria) were surveyed.
 - Stage two: Selection of the settlements (cities and villages).
 - Settlements were selected at random.
 - The number of settlements selected in each region was proportional to the share of population living in the particular type of settlement in each region.
 - Stage three: Primary sampling units were described.
- The margin of error does not exceed plus or minus 2.8 points at the 95% confidence level.
- The response rate was 62 percent.
- Charts and graphs may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding.
- The survey was funded by the <u>United States Agency for International Development</u>.






In general, would you say that Moldova is heading in the right direction or in the wrong direction?






Over the last 12 months, how has the economic situation of Moldova changed?




How would you describe the current economic situation of your household?




What is the most important problem facing Moldova today?








How would you the describe the current status of each of the following items in our country?








Do you consider our country to be governed in the interest of the majority of people or in the interest of some groups?



To what extent, if any, has corruption had a negative impact on you?




In the past 12 months, how often, if at all, have you had to do a favor, give a gift or pay a bribe?




Whom did you have to do favors for, give gifts or pay bribes to?




What, in your opinion, is the greatest cause of corruption in our country?






How likely or unlikely are ordinary people able to influence decisions made in our country?




How important or unimportant is it that all members of our country's adult population, including women, youth, minorities, and people with disabilities, are included in political decision making?




Do you believe that democracy is the best possible form of government for our country or not?




The rule of law in a democracy could be understood as "a state when all people and institutions are accountable to the law and the Constitution, and the Constitution and the law are equally applied towards all."


How strongly do you agree or disagree that rule of law exists in our country?



Which politician or public person do you trust the most?




What is your opinion of the following Moldovan politicians or members of the Moldovan government?






Do you approve or disapprove of the activities of the President of Moldova Igor Dodon?




Do you approve or disapprove of the activities of the President of Moldova Igor Dodon?




Do you approve or disapprove of the activities of your local government (i.e. mayor, local councilors and *raion* councilors)?




Do you think the Moldovan Parliament is responsive to the needs of voters like you?




What specific issues should be the top priority for the government to address?


How do you view the dismissal of the Sandu government through the vote-of-no-confidence?


Which political party do you think is the best to address each of the following issues?








If parliamentary elections were held this coming Sunday, for which party, if any, would you vote?




Do you feel that the October 20/November 3 local elections were free and fair or not?




Do you feel that the October 20/ November 3 local elections were free and fair or not?

Do you feel that the February 24 parliamentary elections were free and fair?






Have you seen any political party activists working in your area in the last 12 months?




Which political parties did the activists in your area represent?


Would you be willing to engage in any of the following support activities for a political party or political movement you support?




Which of these countries do you consider to be the most important economic partner(s) and political partner(s) for our country?




Which of these countries do you consider to be the most important economic partner(s) and political partner(s) for our country?




If Moldova could only join one international economic union, which one should it be?




If Moldova could only join one international economic union, which one should it be?

(Disaggregated by age)






If a referendum was held today on Moldova joining NATO, how would you vote?


To what extent do you support or oppose deepening our country's integration with Europe?






Do you think that today's generation of young people has a good future in Moldova or not?




Do any members of your household currently live or work abroad?




In which country or countries members of your household currently live or work abroad?




Does your household receive remittances sent by household members abroad?

(Respondents who have household members abroad)




If you had the opportunity, would you choose to go abroad, not just for a vacation, but for a longer period?



If yes, why you would choose to go abroad for a long period?






In general, what is the influence of each of these forms of election campaigning on you?




Which sources of information do you use most frequently to gain political news and information?


Which specific media outlets, such a specific TV channel, radio station, newspaper, website, etc. do you consider most trustworthy for political information?

Which television channels do you watch for political information?




What television channels do you watch for entertainment?


Which of the following is the primary channel you usually watch most of the time if you had to choose one?








Do you own a smartphone which can access the internet?





How often do you use social media as a source of daily news?






How frequently do you encounter information in the media, including social media, that you believe is misleading or false?

To what extent is misleading or false information in the media problematic for our country?




