Detailed Methodology

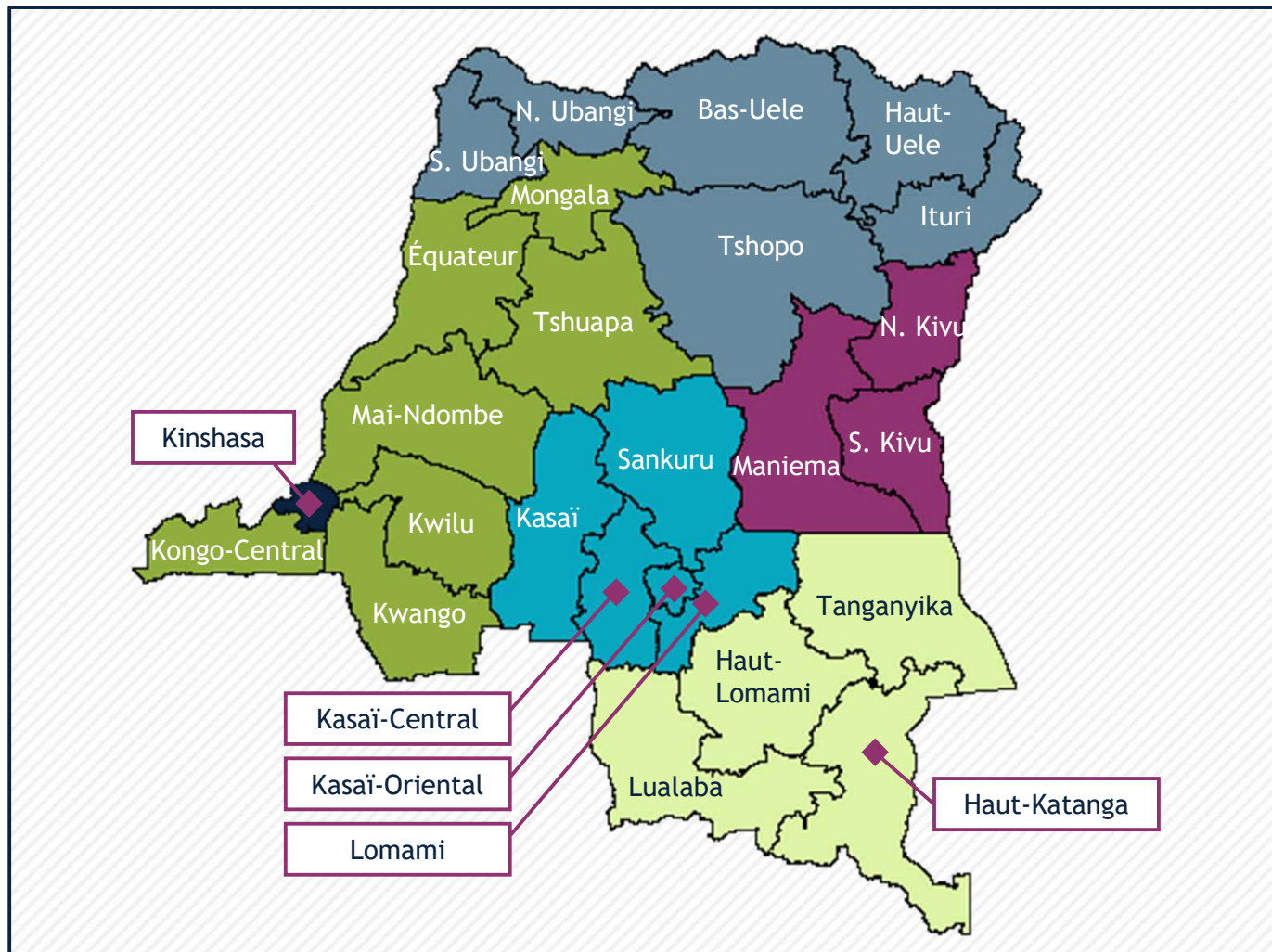
- Data collection for this poll was conducted on behalf by the International Republican Institute's [Center for Insights in Survey Research](#) by Global Research Insights (GRI) between August 8 and September 20, 2019.
- Data was collected using a multi-stage stratified probability sample through in-person, in-home interviews. The sample was stratified by province and by urban and rural locations. The sampling frame was based on the [Commission électorale nationale indépendante \(Independent National Electoral Commission - CÉNI\) elector registration statistics](#) (RFE 2016-2018), administrative units as per 1984 Census, and urbanity as per UNICEF/UNDP data.
- The sample consists of 2,961 respondents aged 18 and older and is representative of voting-age adults nationally.
- Random walk was used to select the appropriate household, and the Kish Grid was used to select respondents 18 years and older.
- The achieved sample skewed female and was post-weighted for gender and urbanity based on gender statistics from *Institut National de la Statistique, République Démocratique du Congo* statistics as well as reliable UN data sources for urbanity.
- The margin of error is plus or minus 1.8 percent at the mid-range with a confidence level of 95 percent. The response rate was 80 percent.
- The information in this report has been compiled in accordance with international standards for market and social research methodologies. Figures in charts and tables may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding.

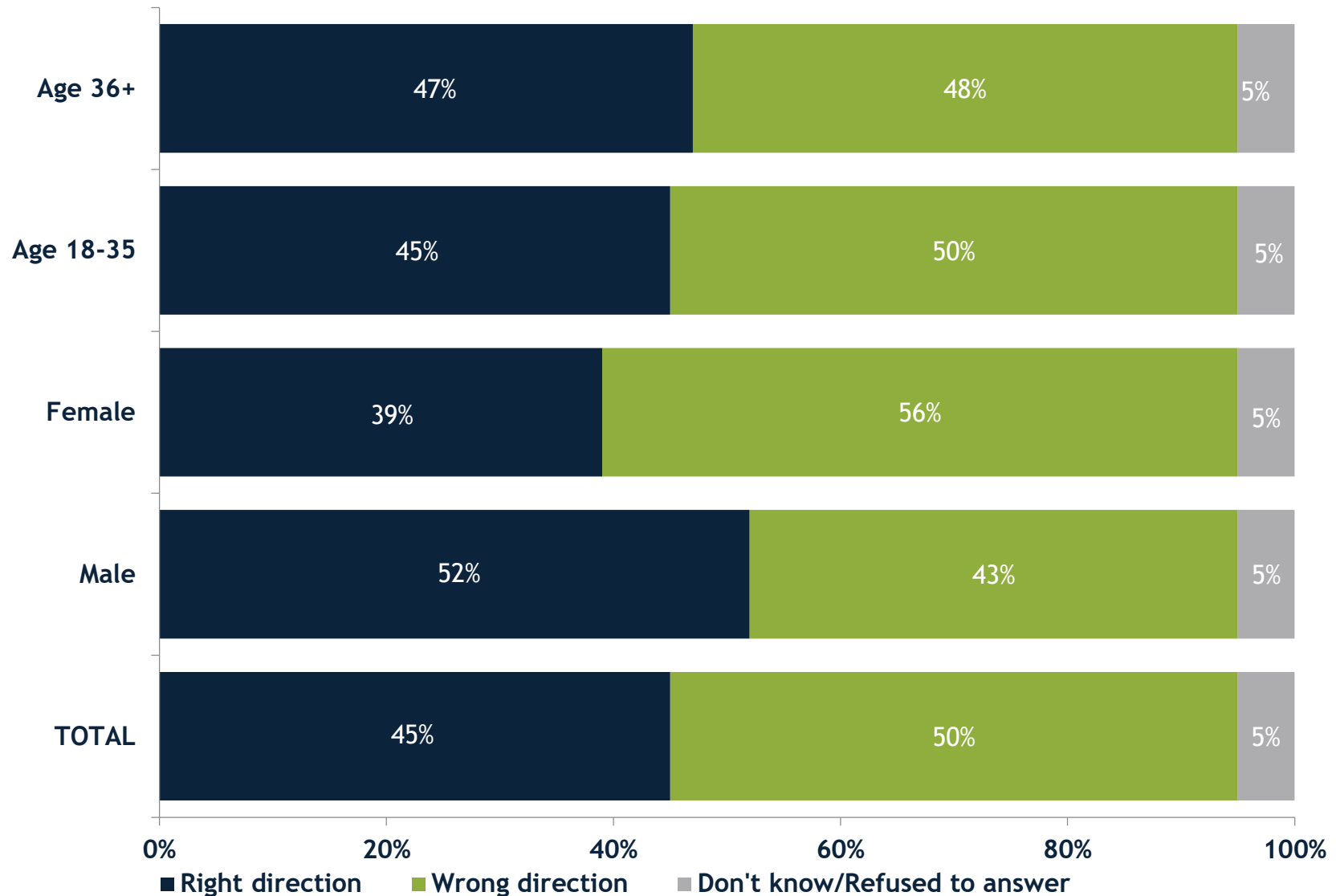

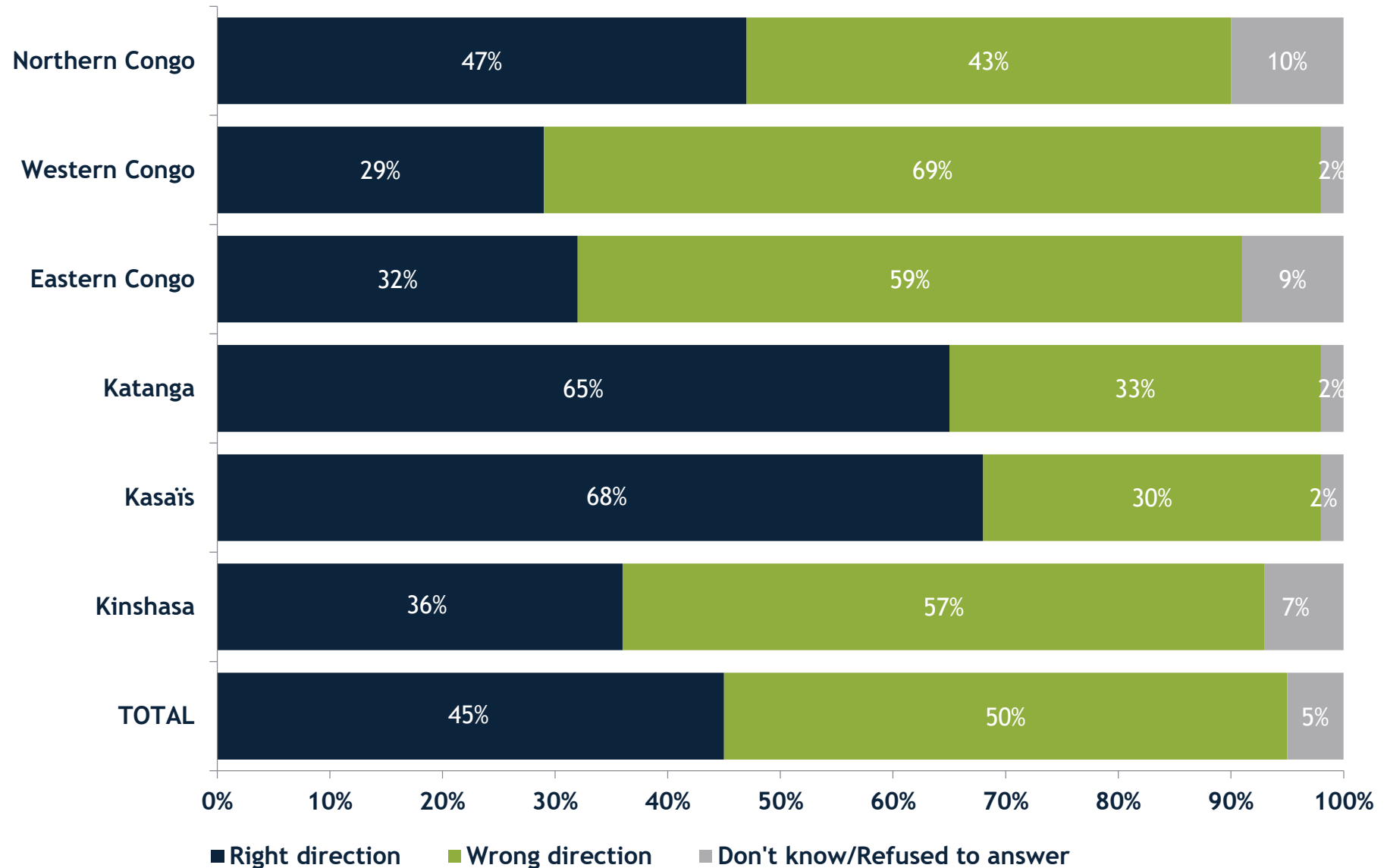

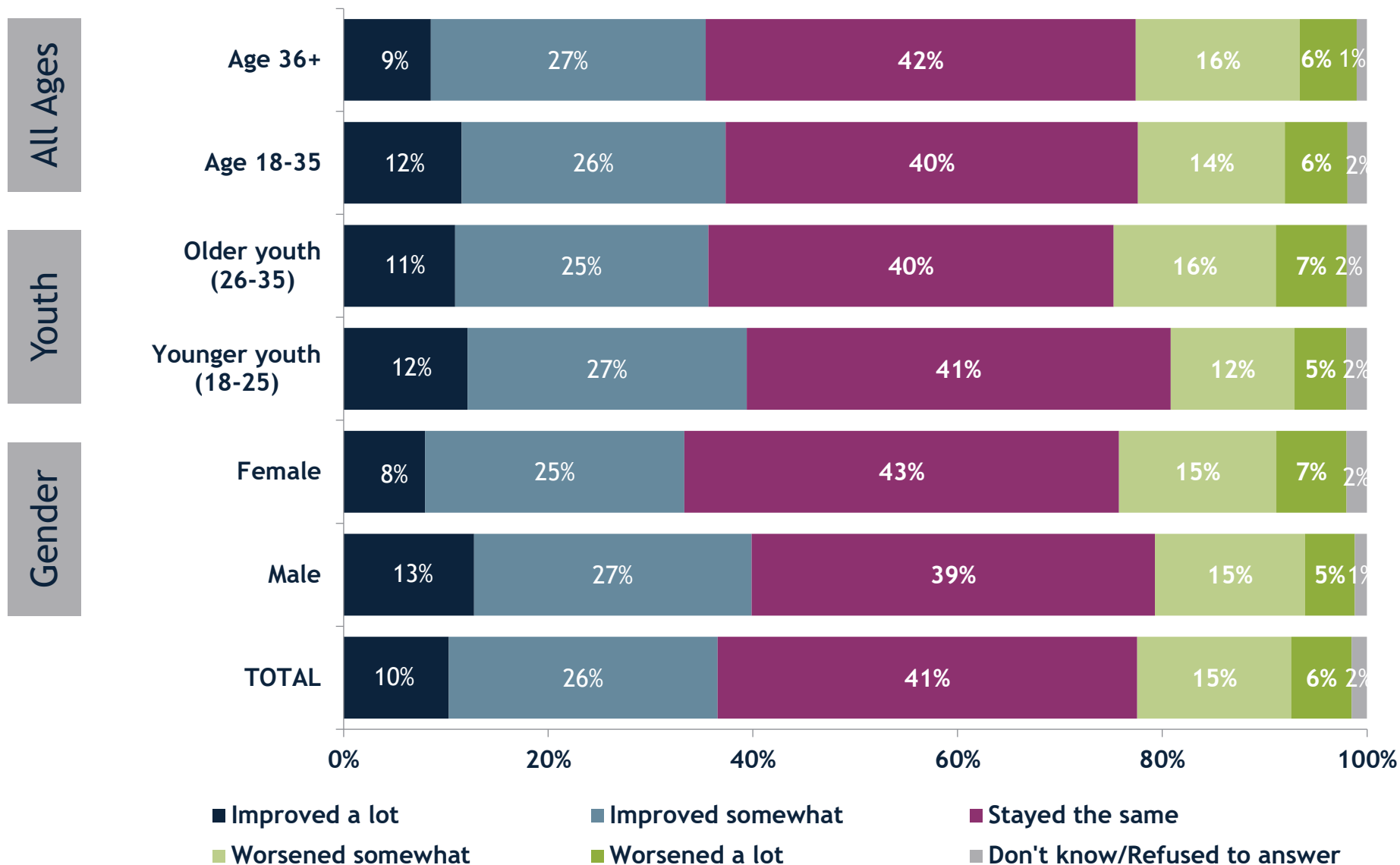
In general, would you say that our country is heading in the right direction or in the wrong direction?
(By gender and age)



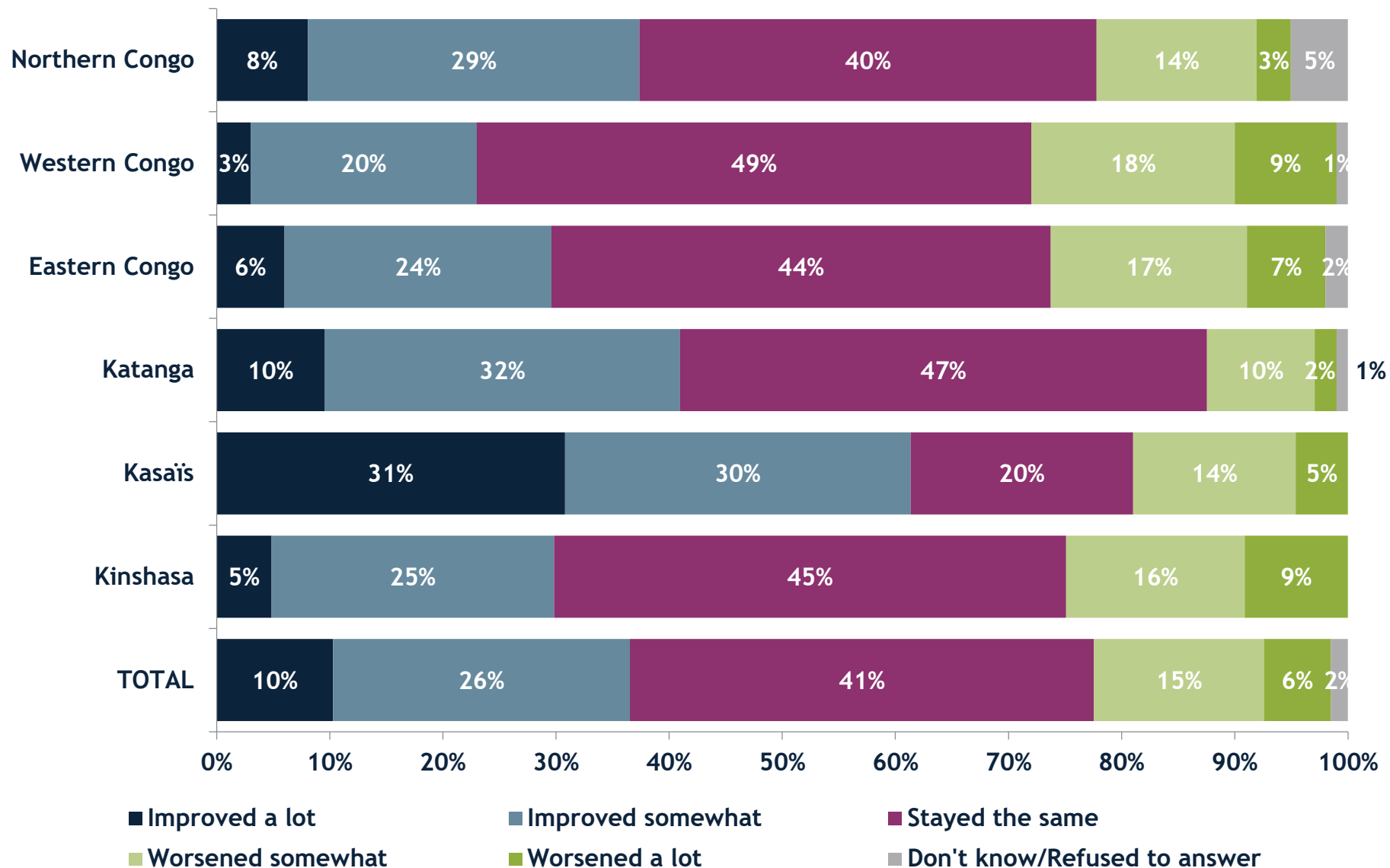

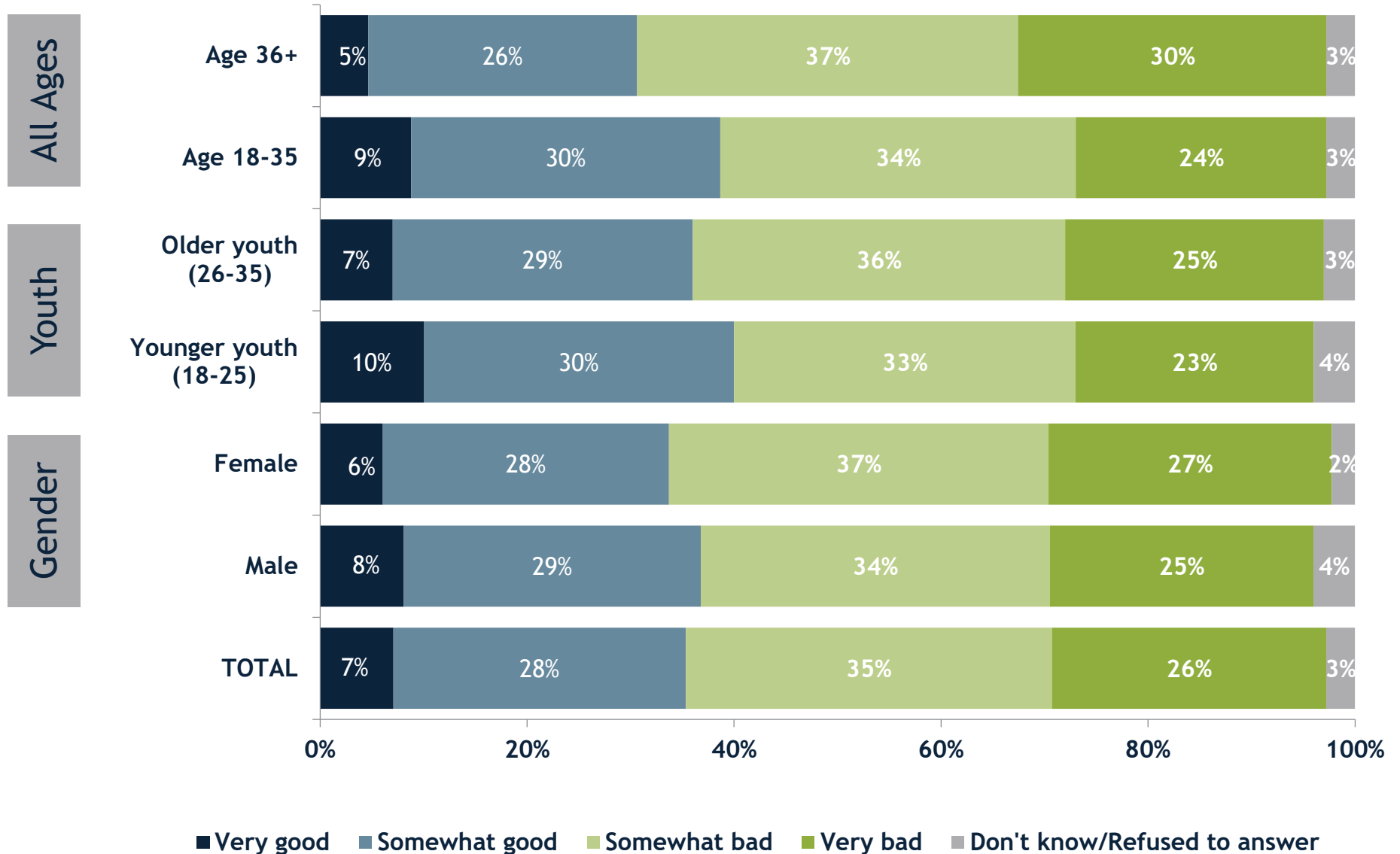
Speaking personally, over the past 12 months, how has your overall quality of life changed? (By gender and age)



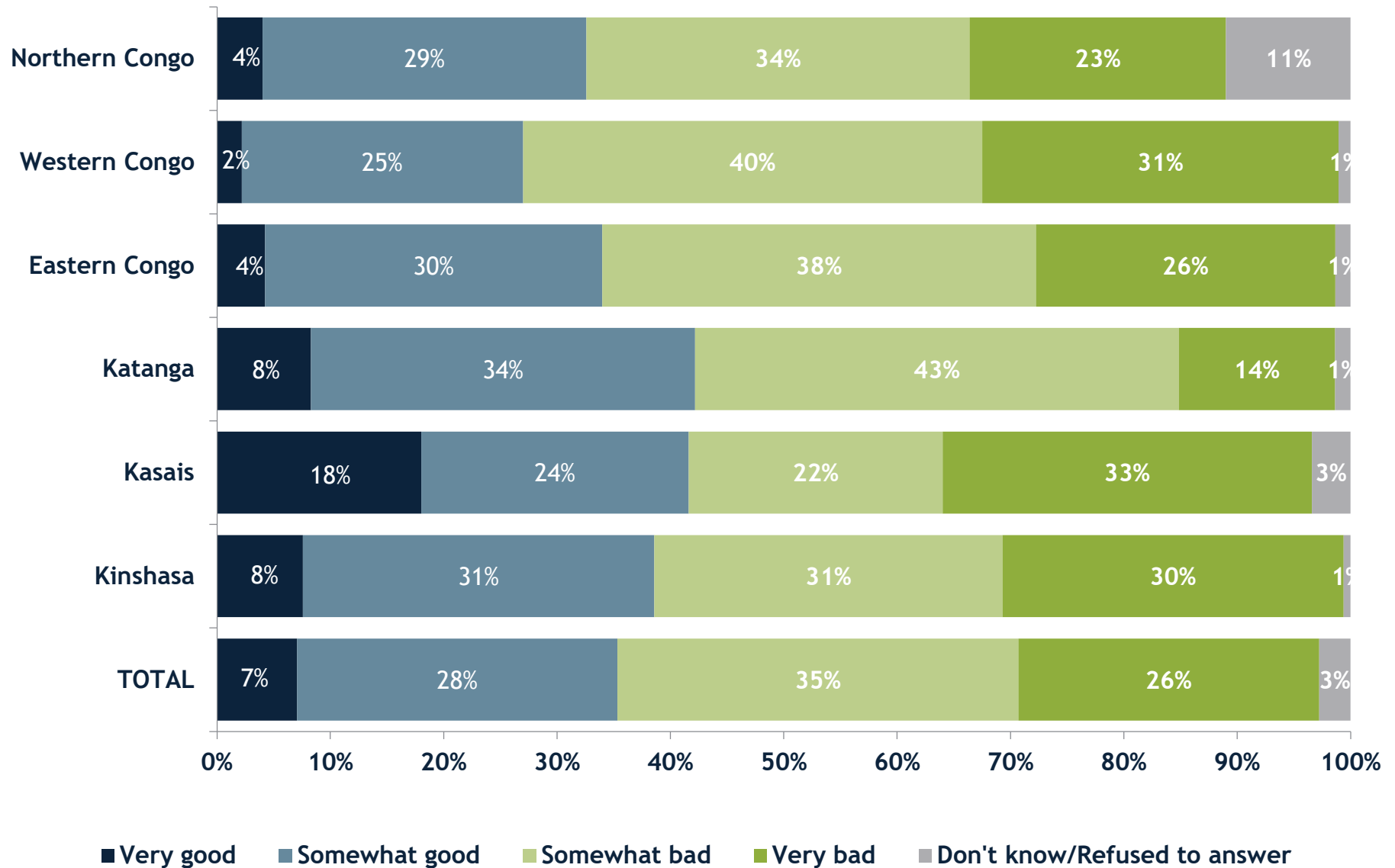

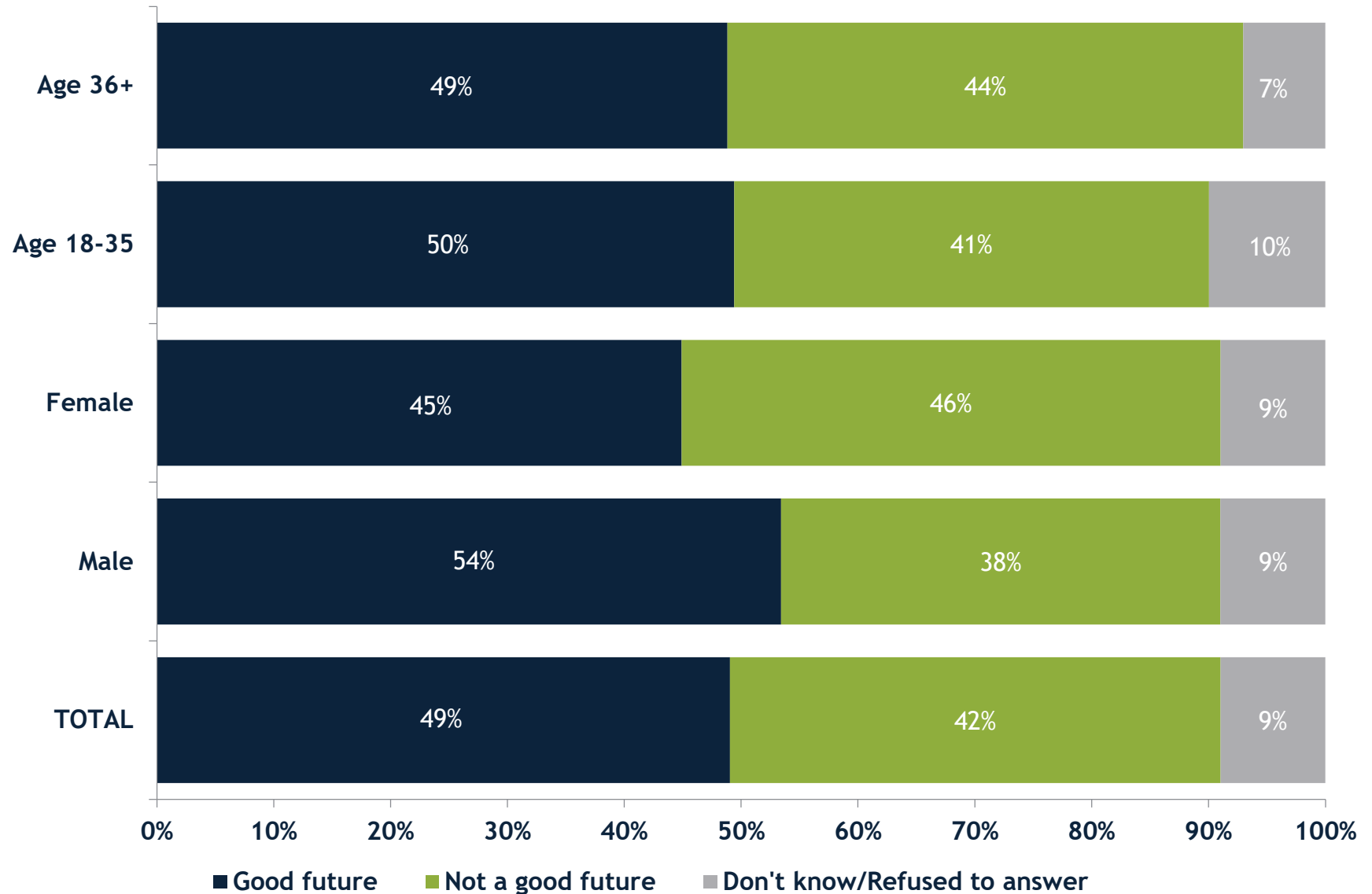
How would you describe the current economic situation of your household? (By gender and age)



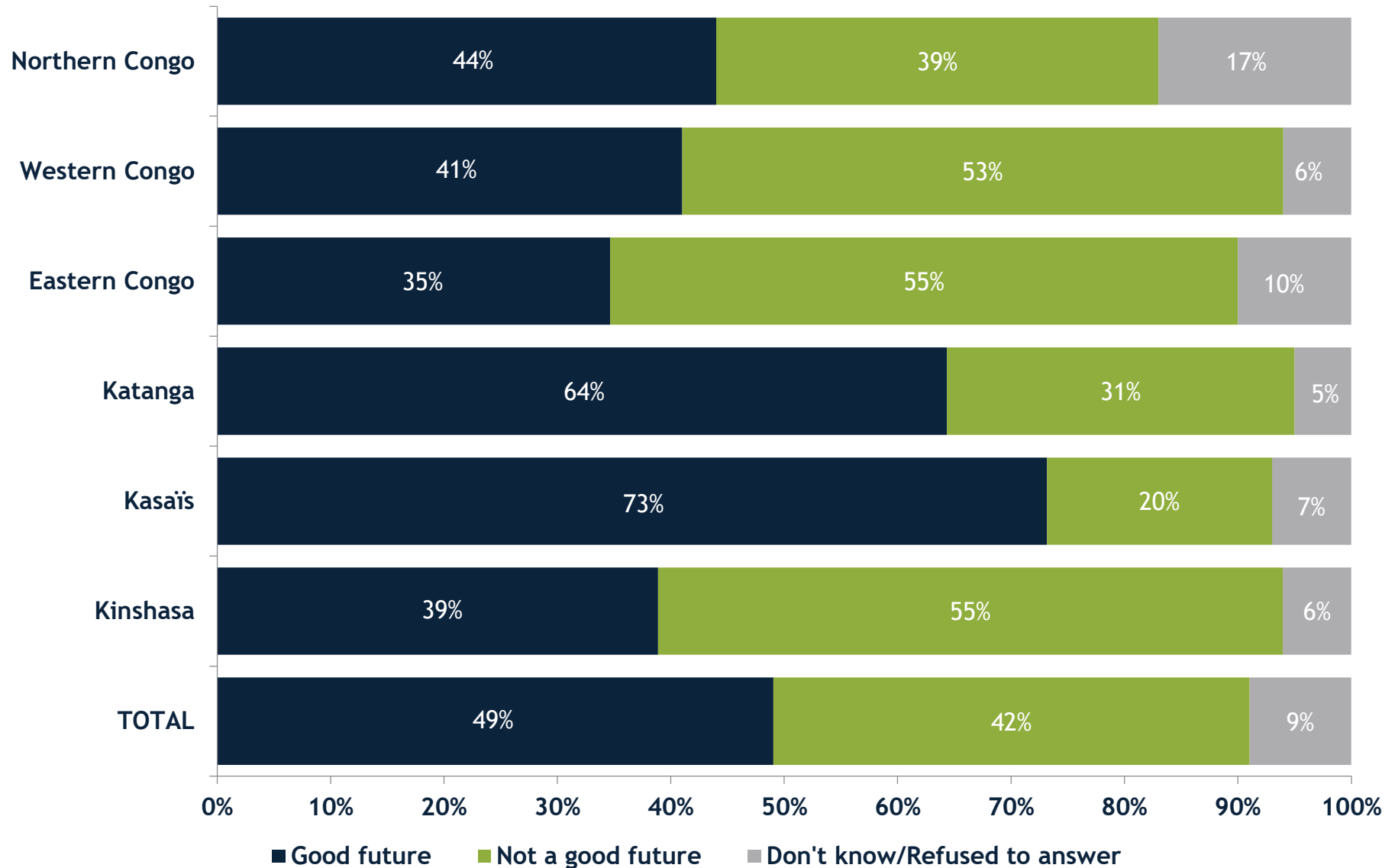

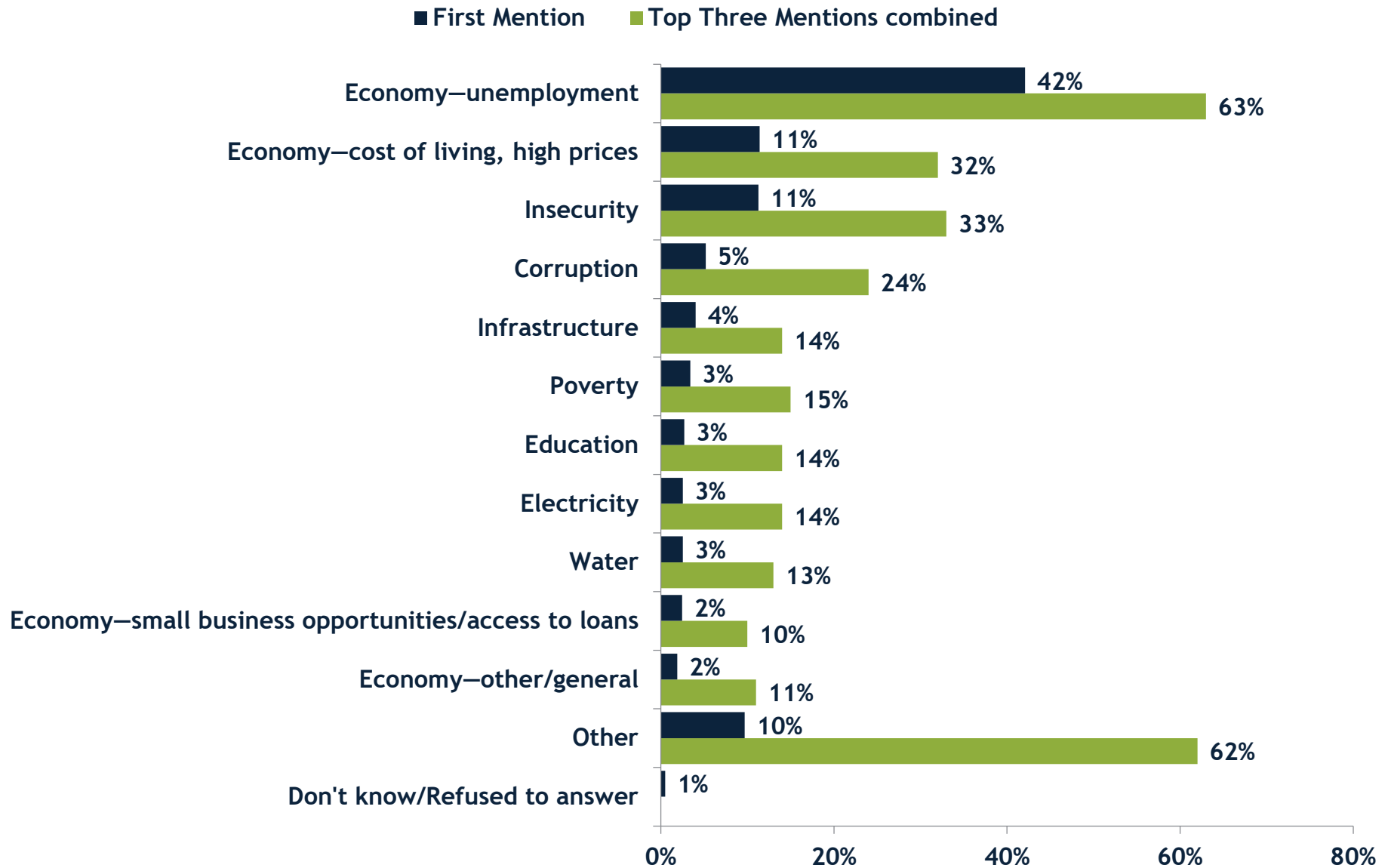
Do you think that today's generation of young people has a good future in our country or not? (By gender and age)

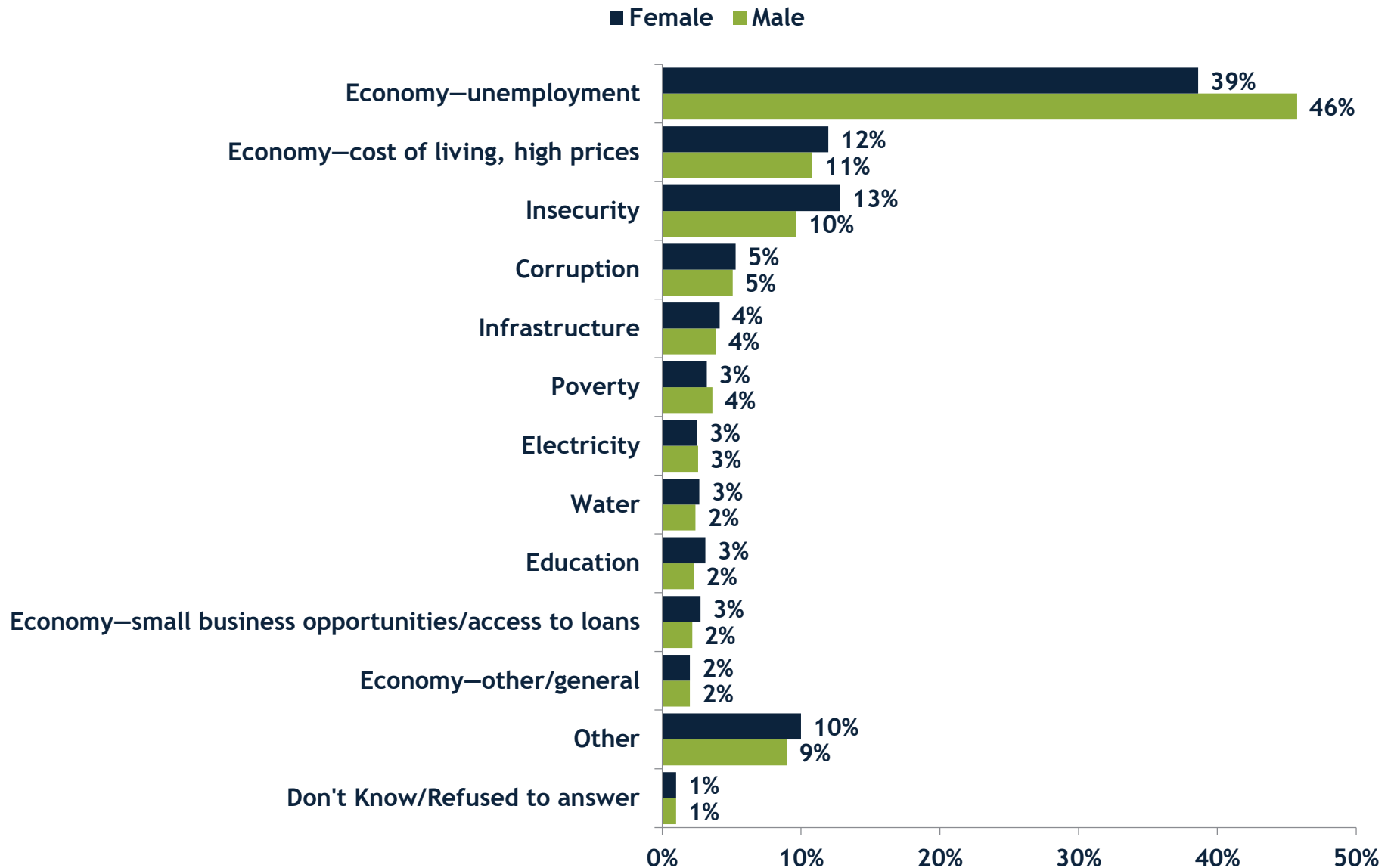


What is the most important problem facing our country today?



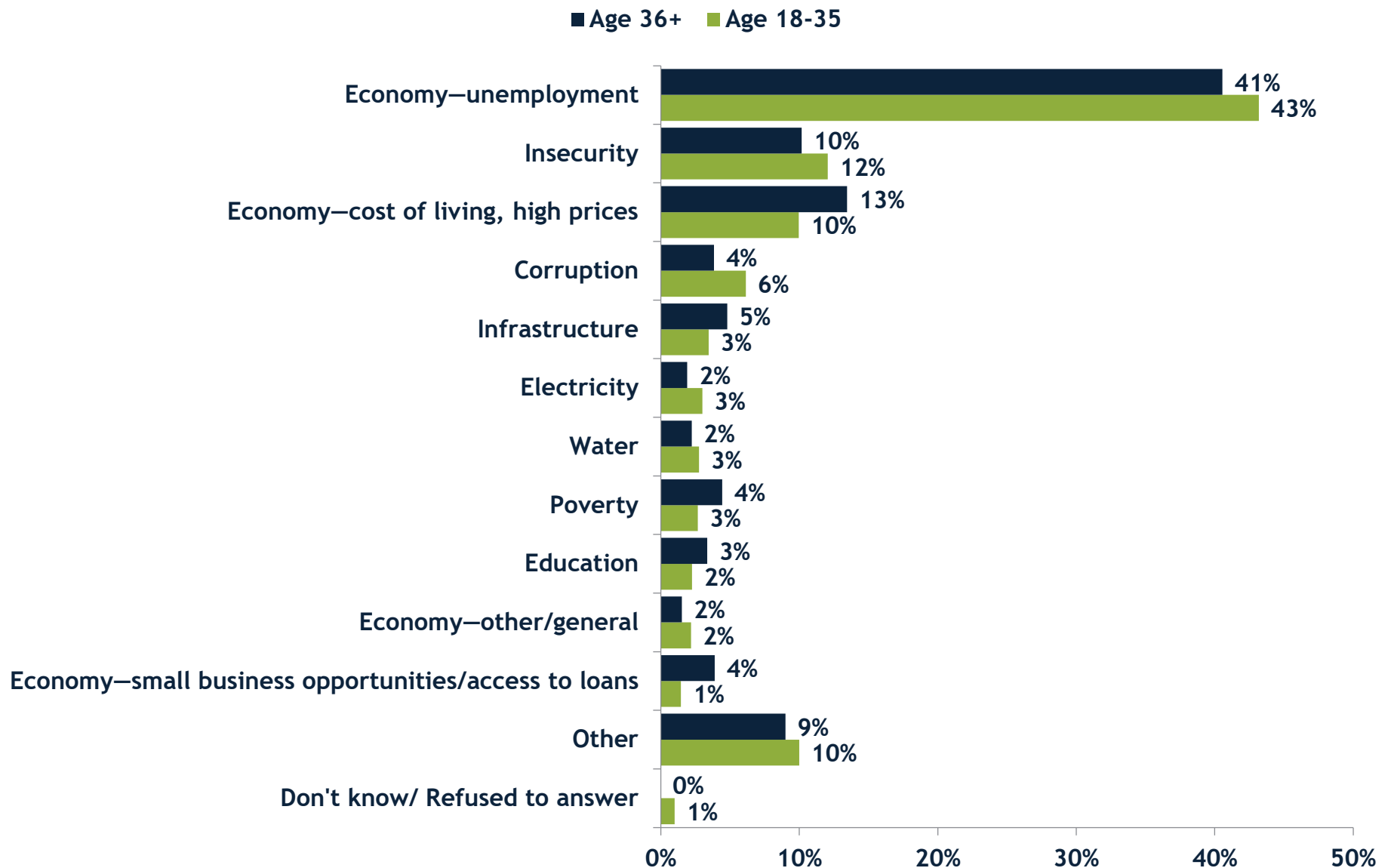

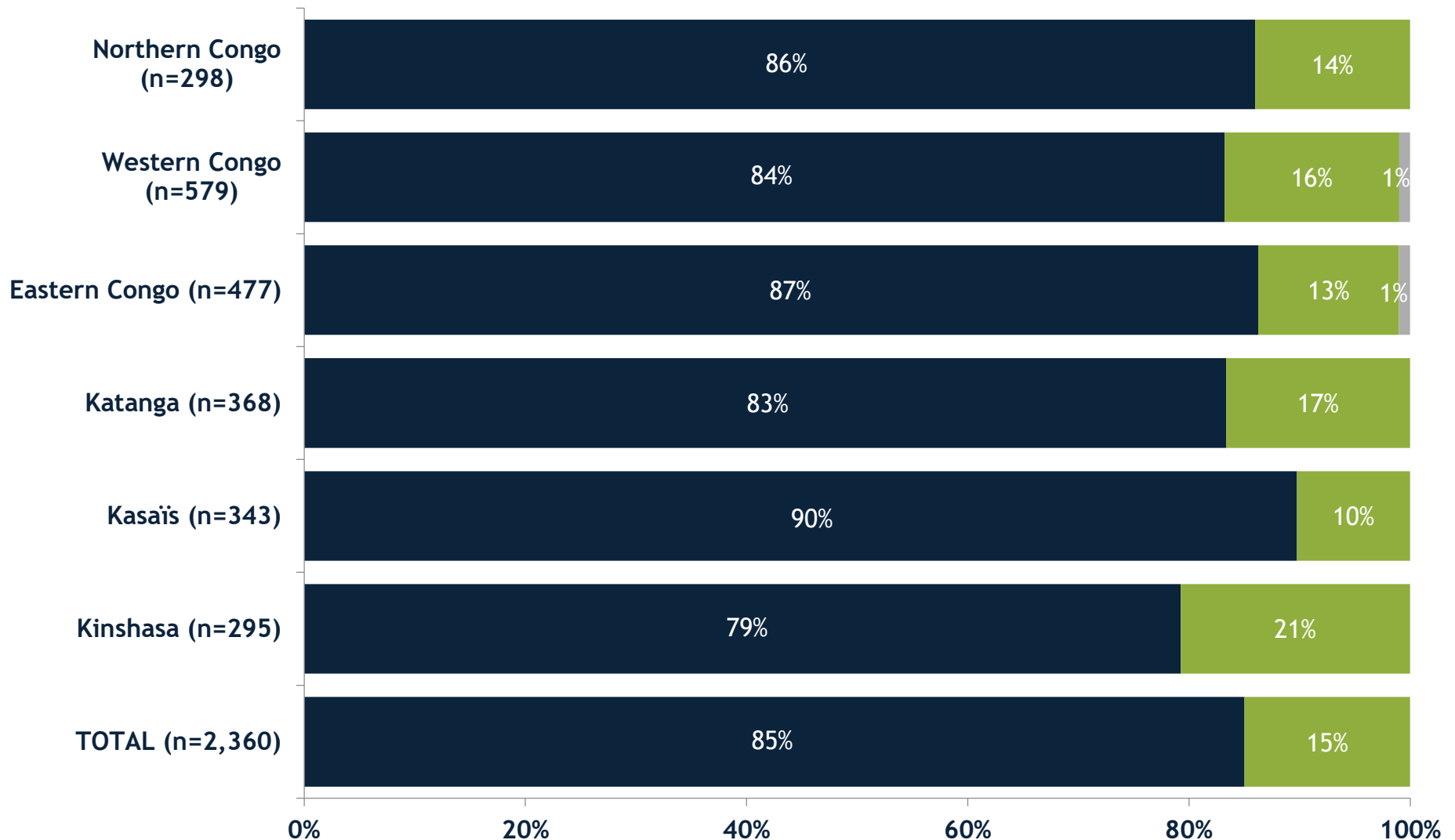

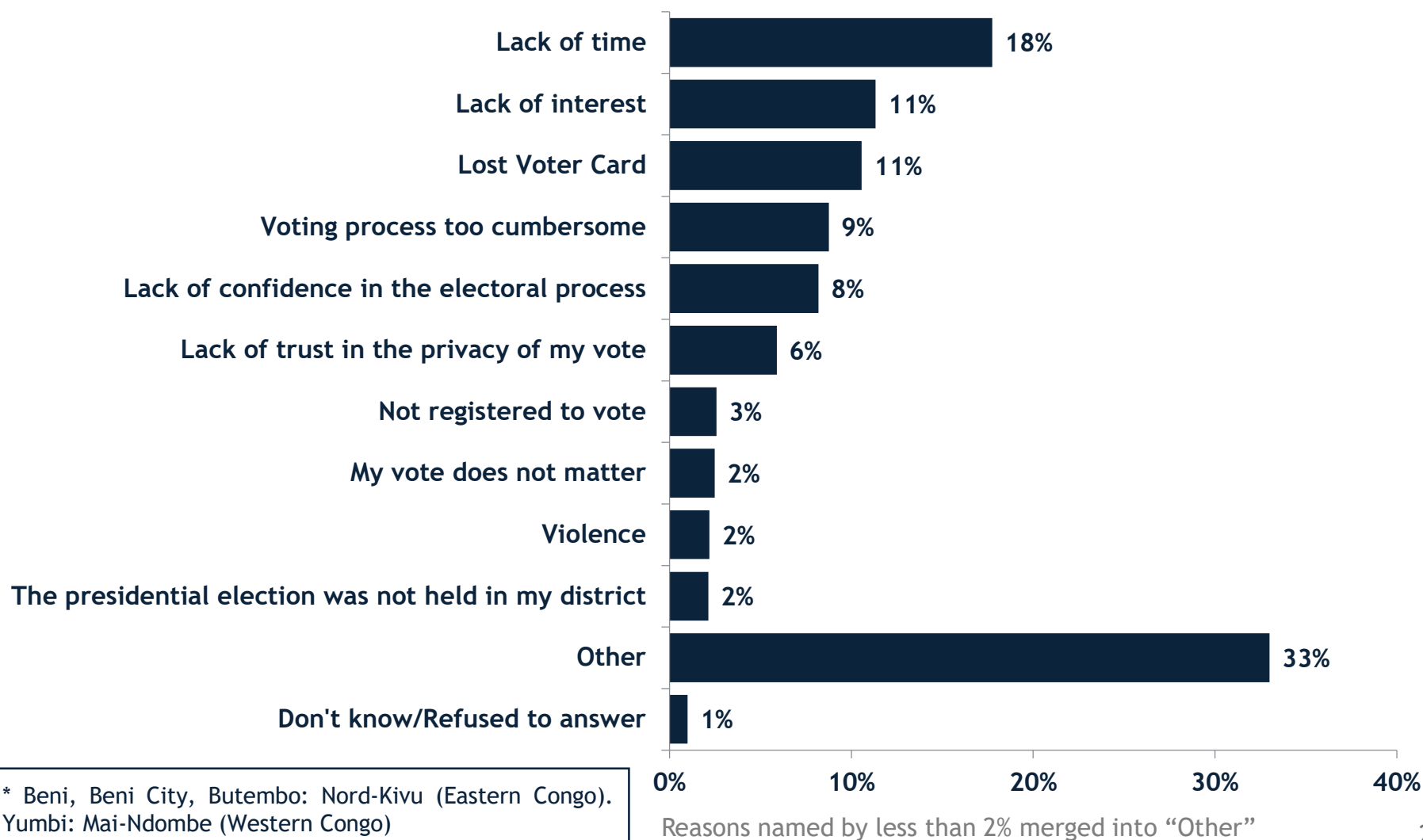

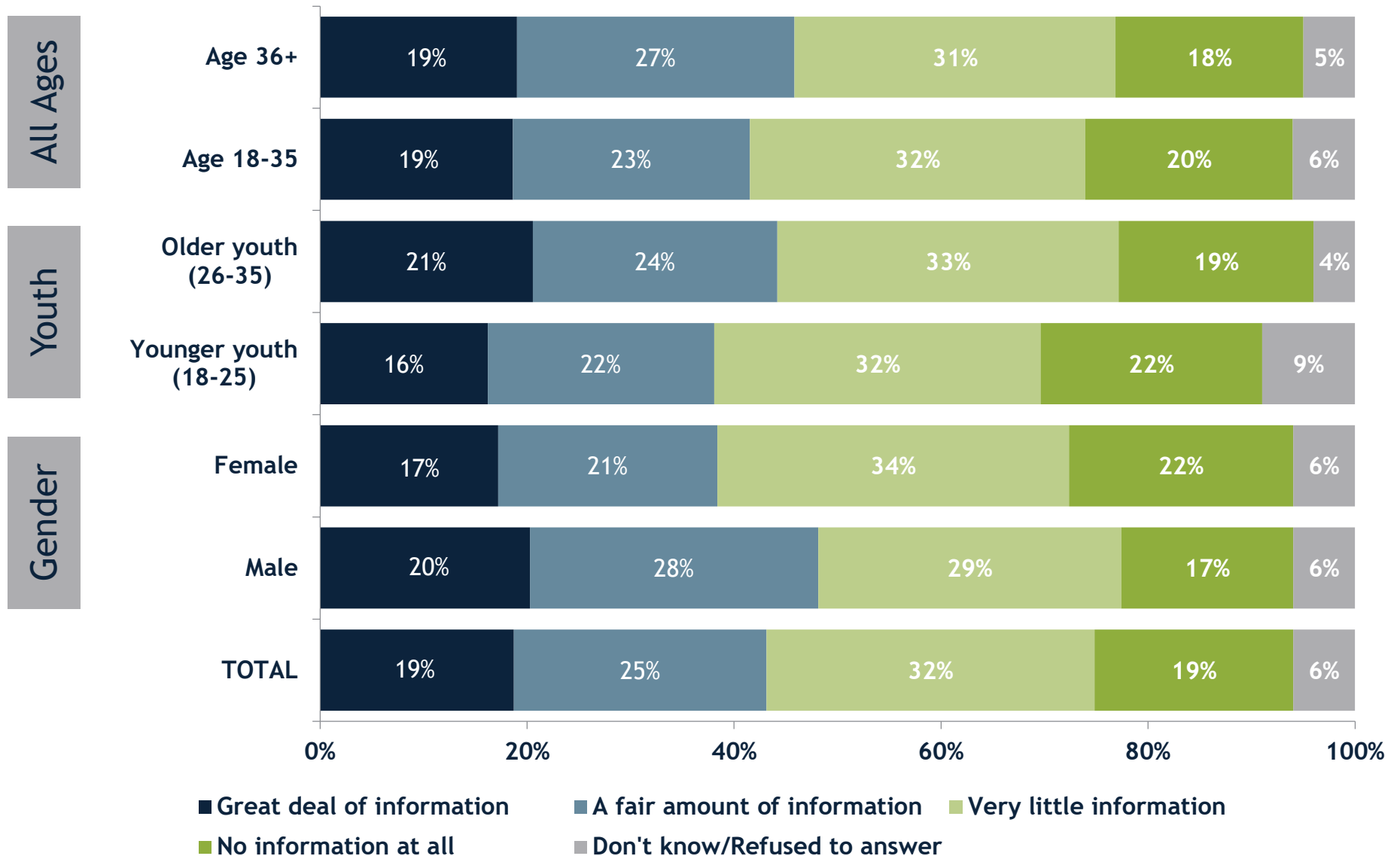

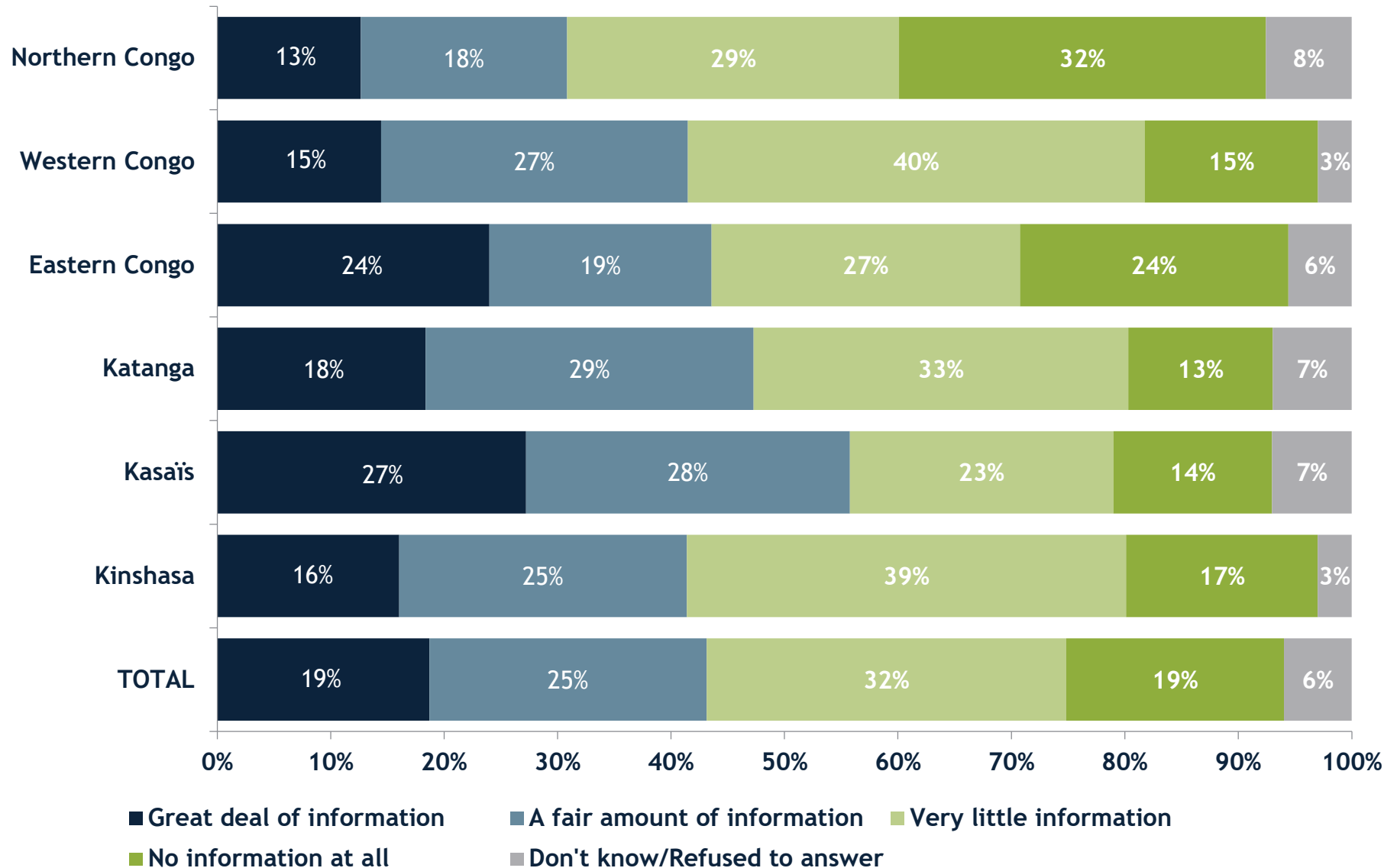
What is the primary reason you did not vote in the December 2018

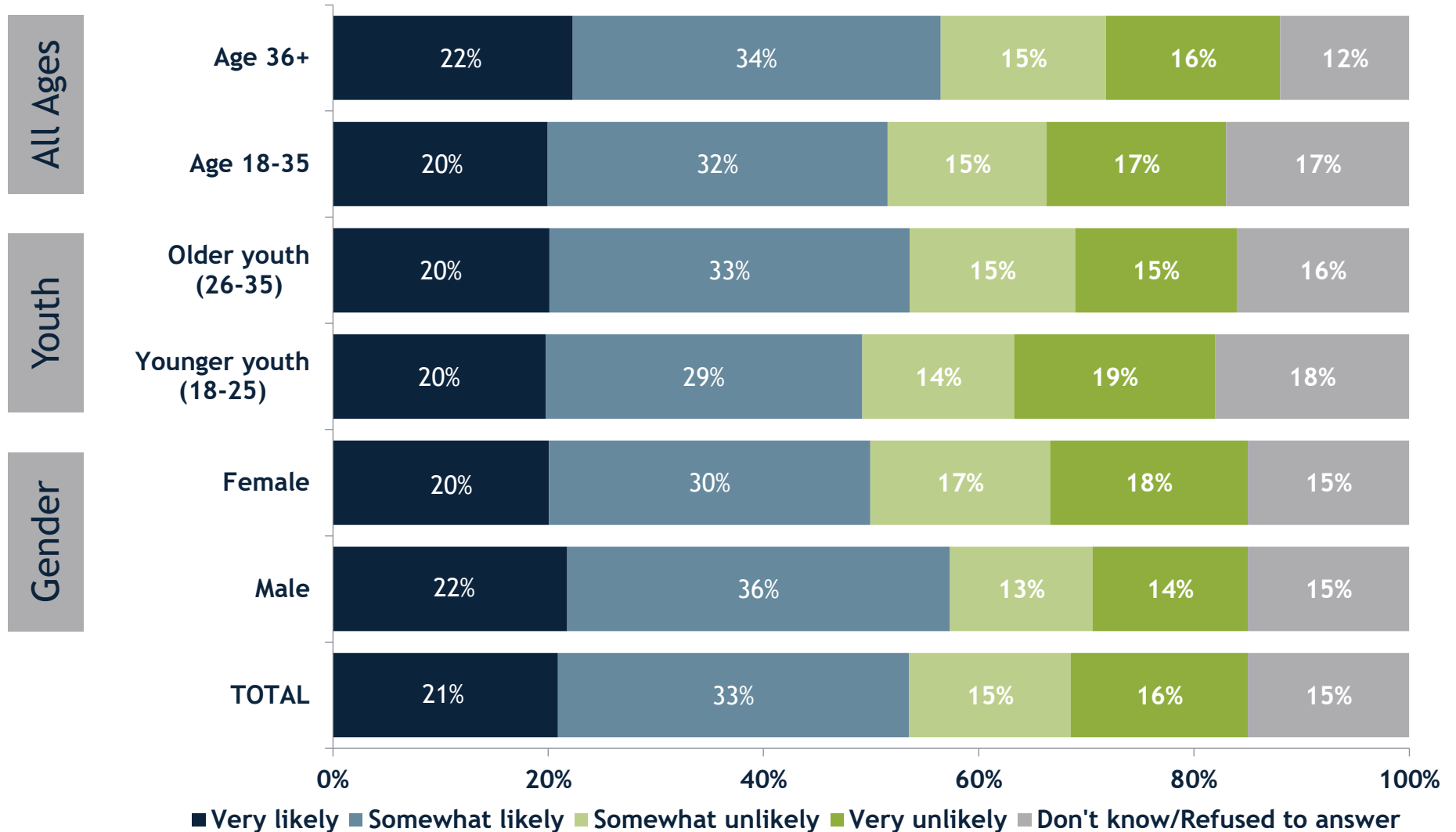
How much information did you have about the 2018 election process? (By gender and age)



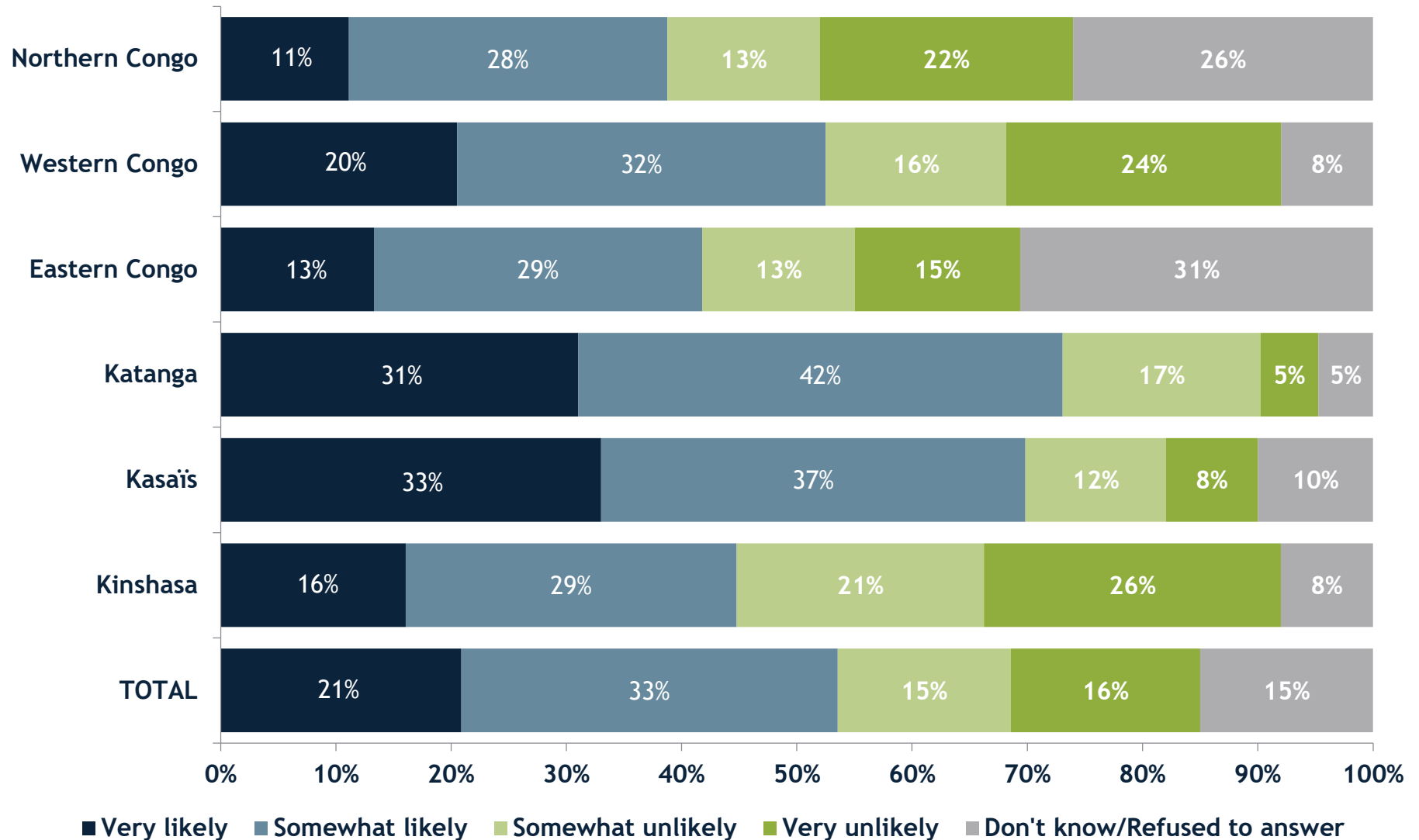

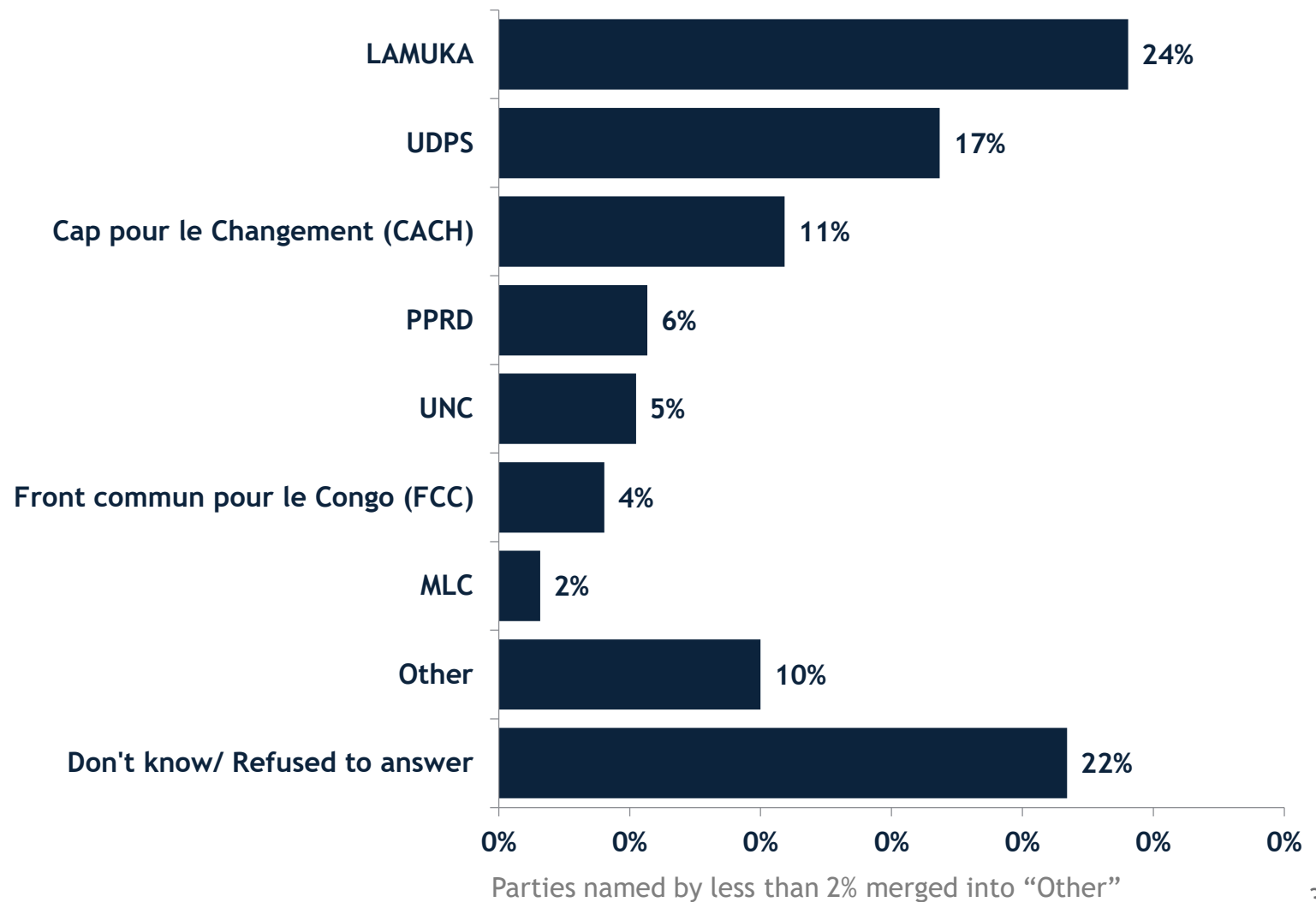
How likely or unlikely are you to vote in the local elections expected in 2019? (By gender and age)

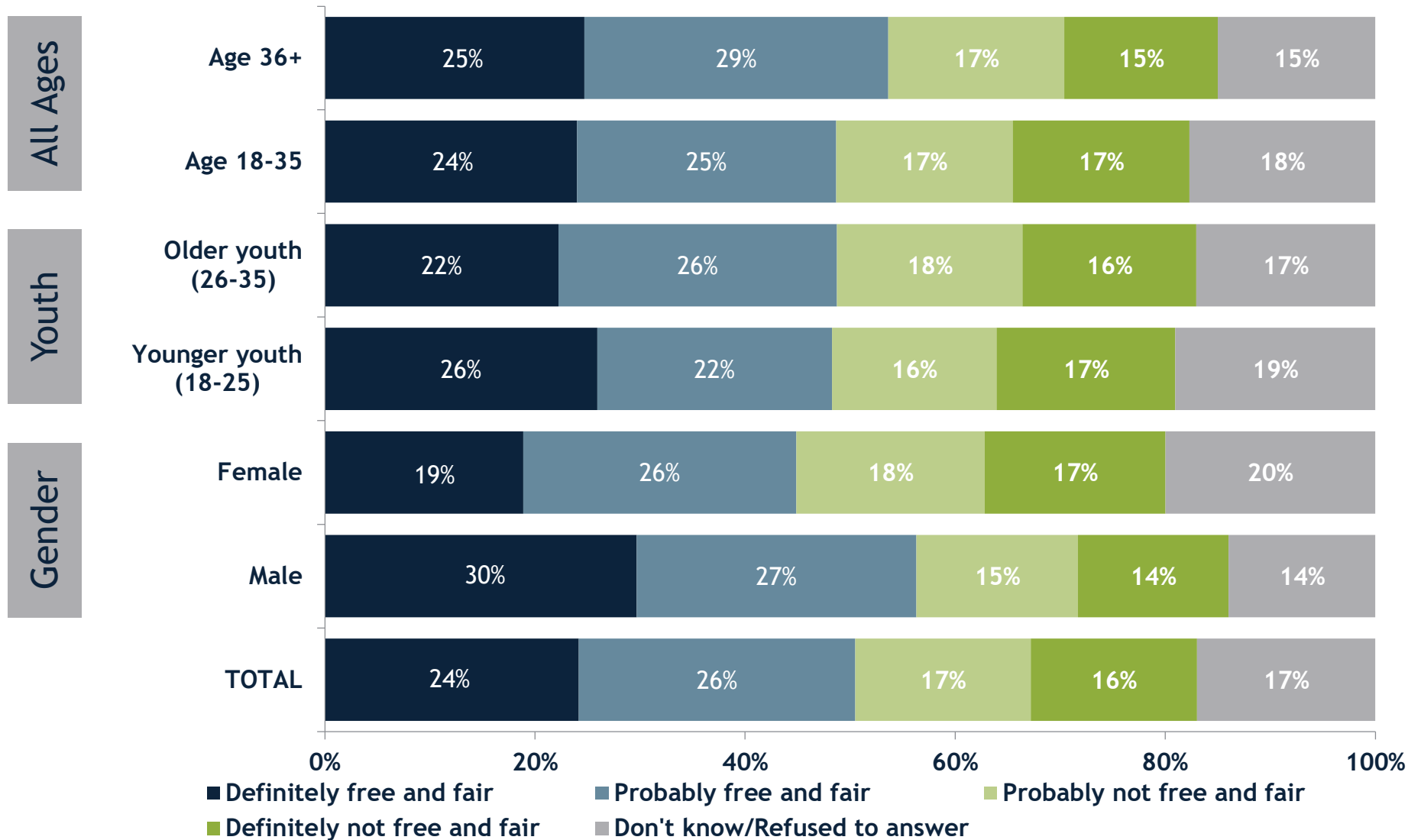

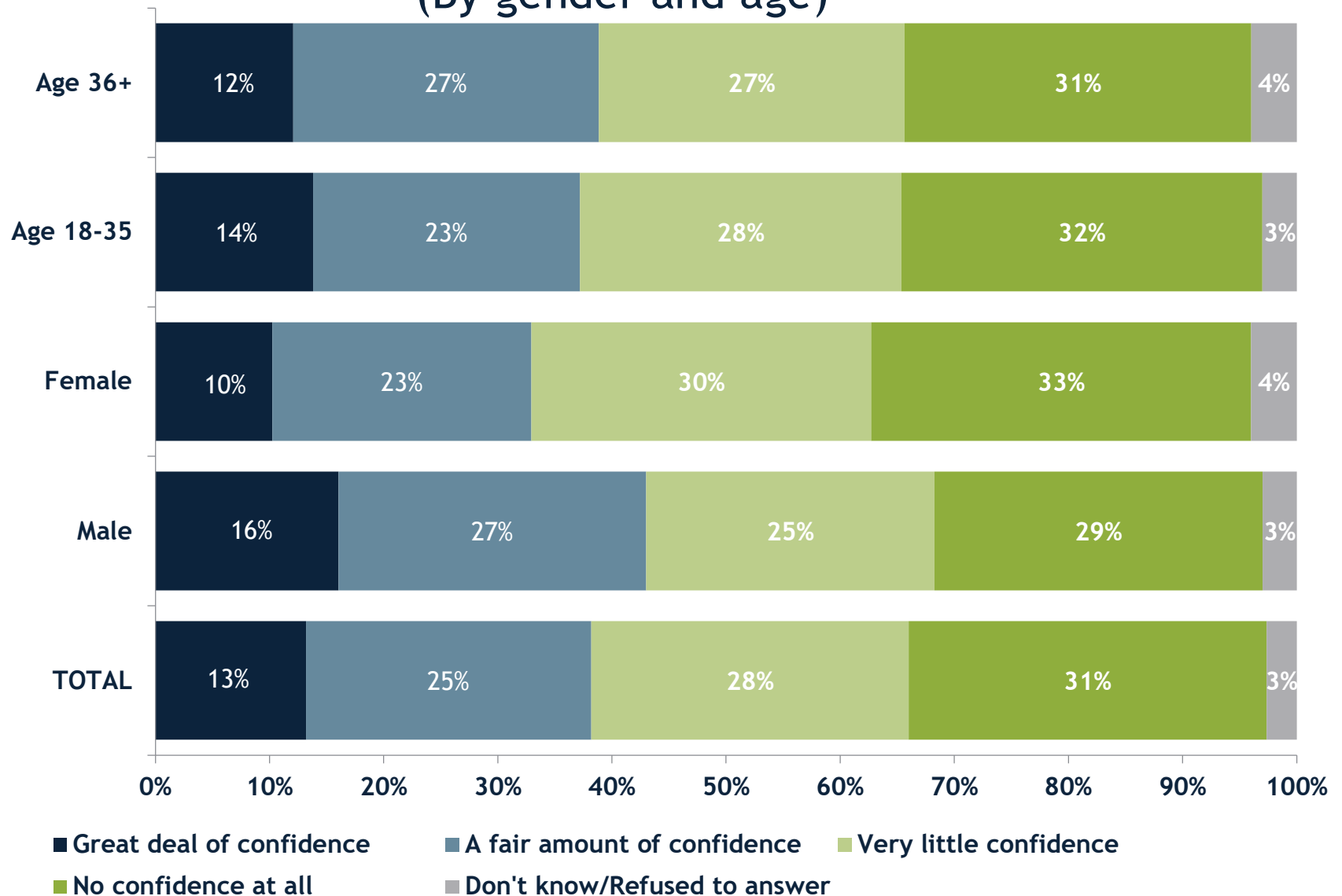

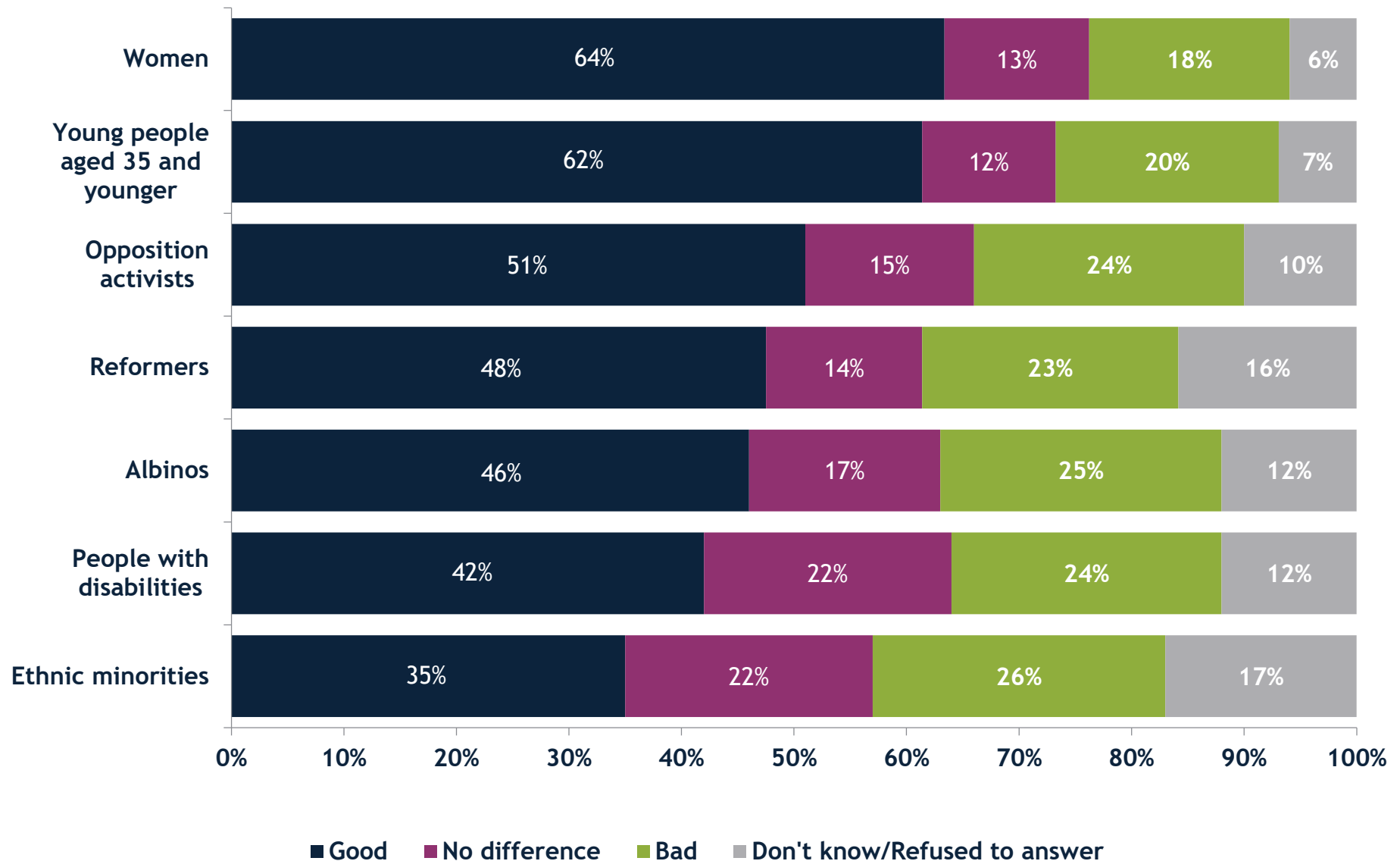
How much confidence do you have in the ability of the CÉNI to organize credible elections? Do you have... (By gender and age)

If more people representing the following groups were elected to the government, do you think that would be good, bad or would it not make a difference?



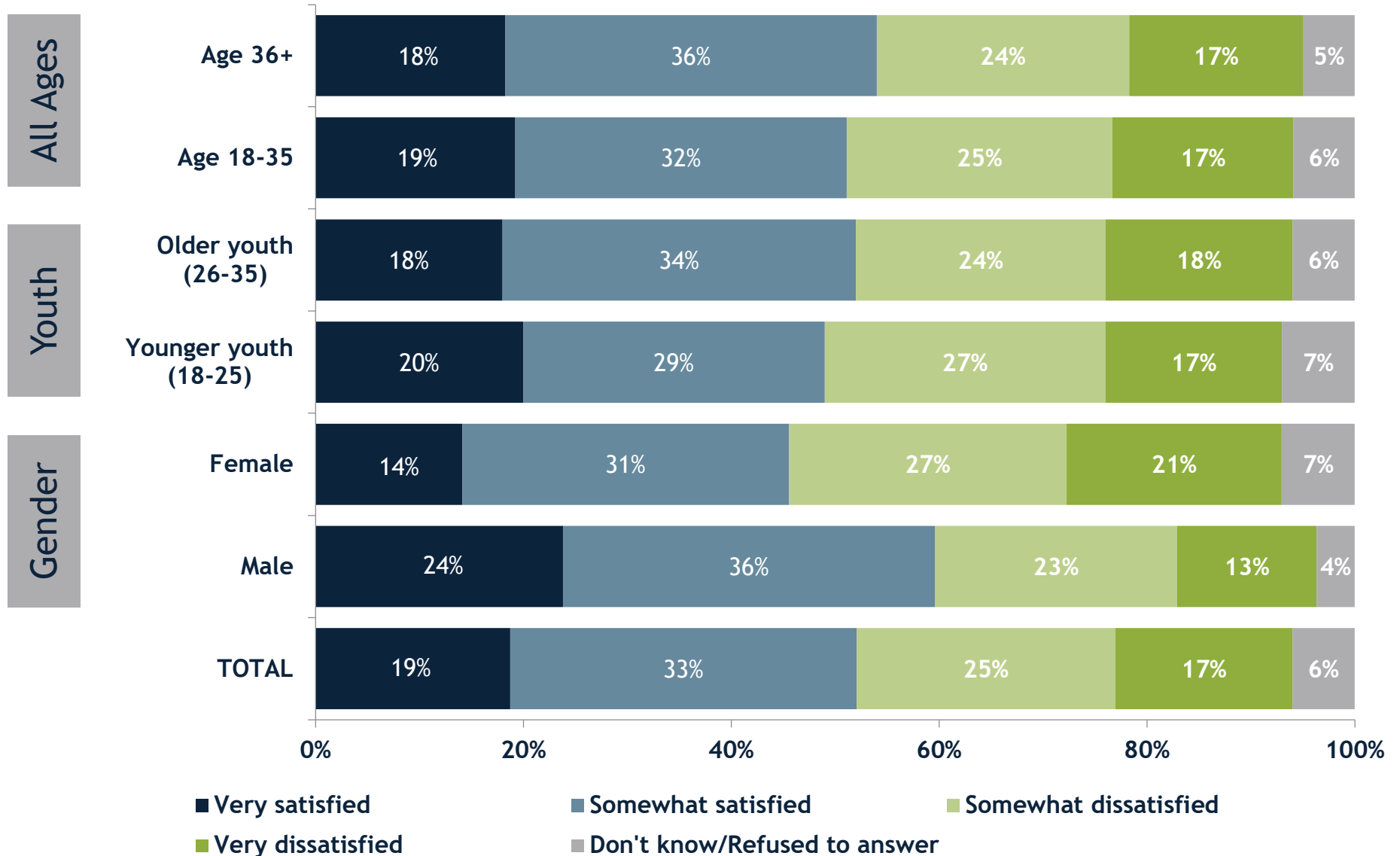

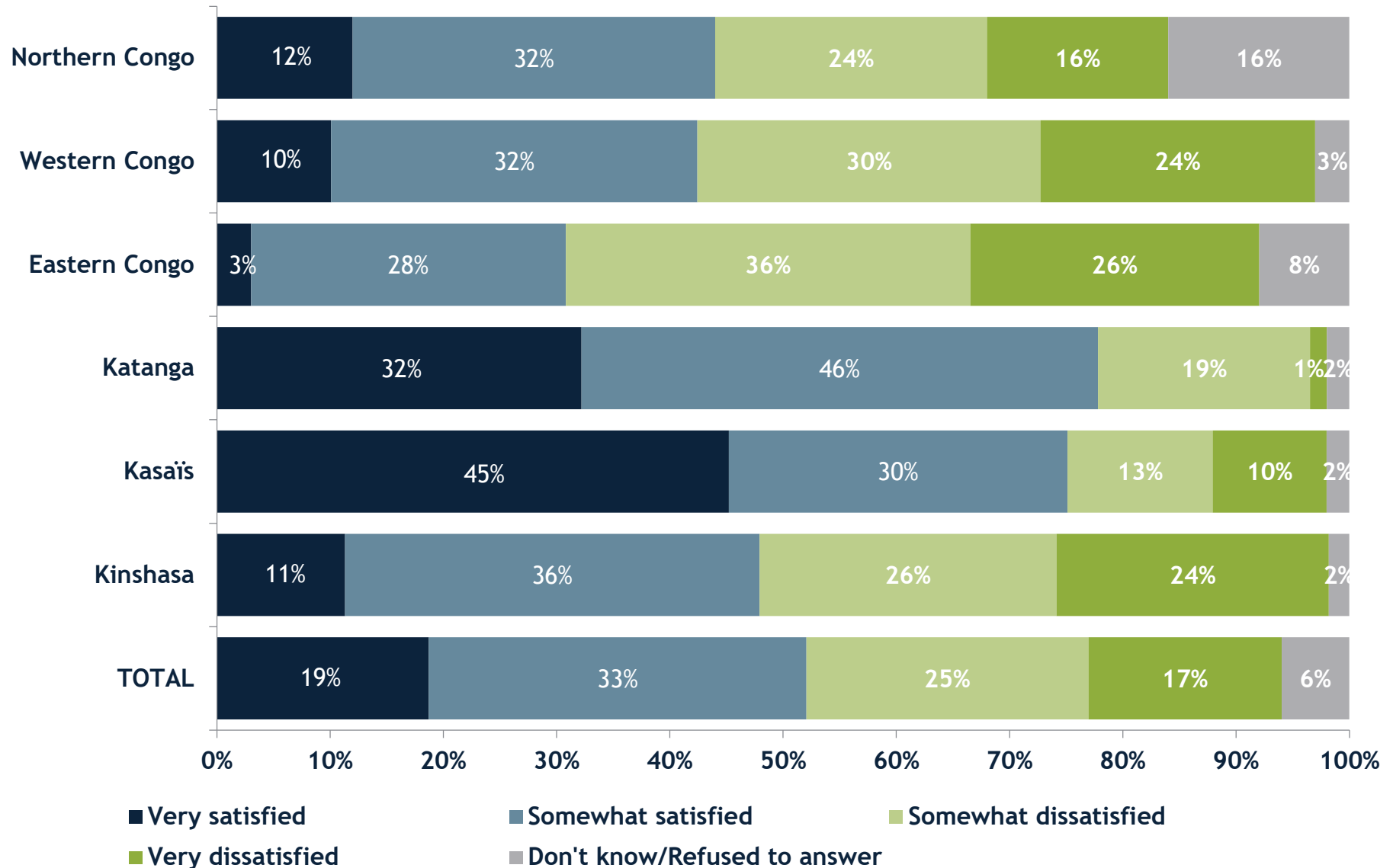

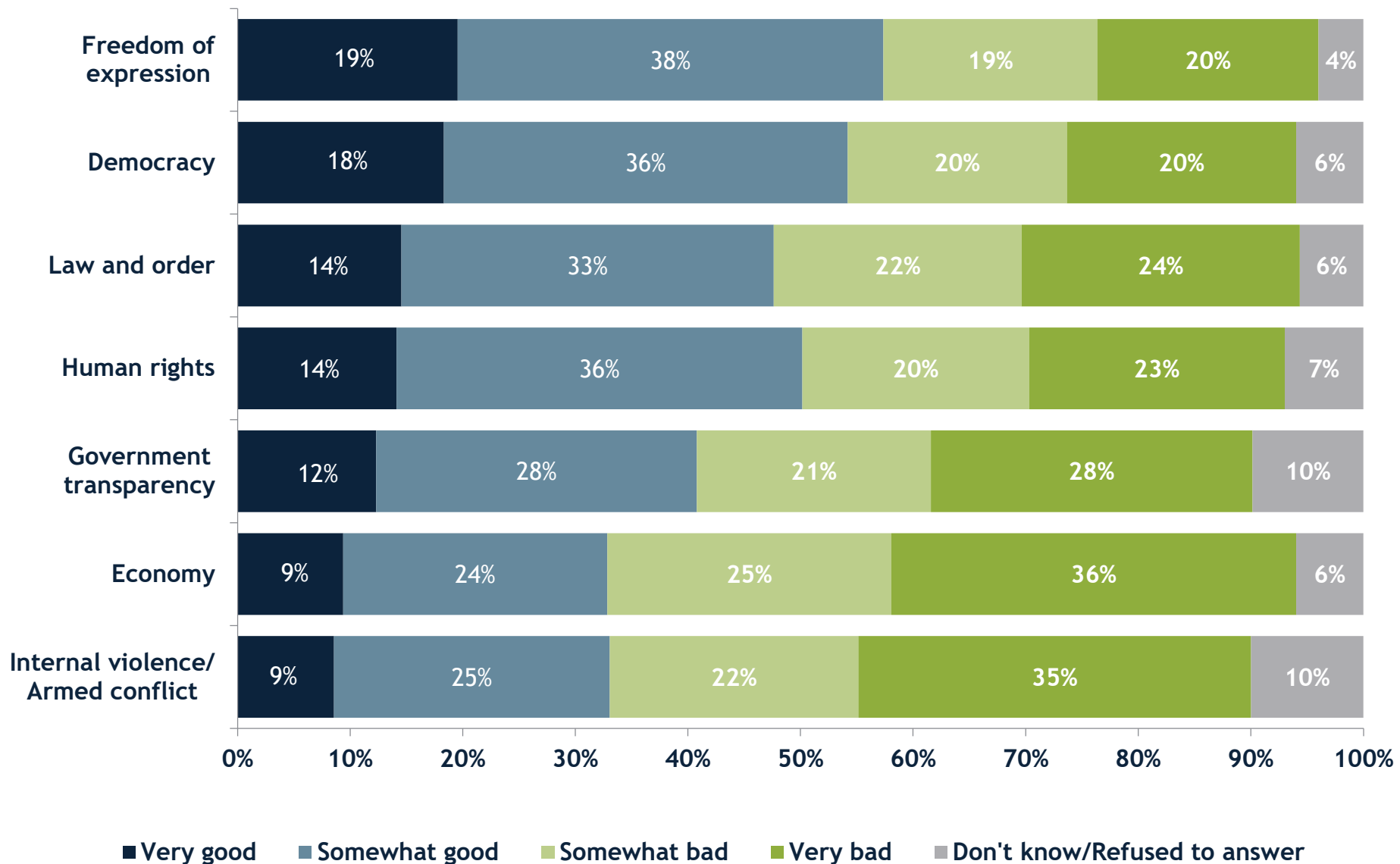
How satisfied or dissatisfied are you with the way democracy is developing in our country? (By gender and age)



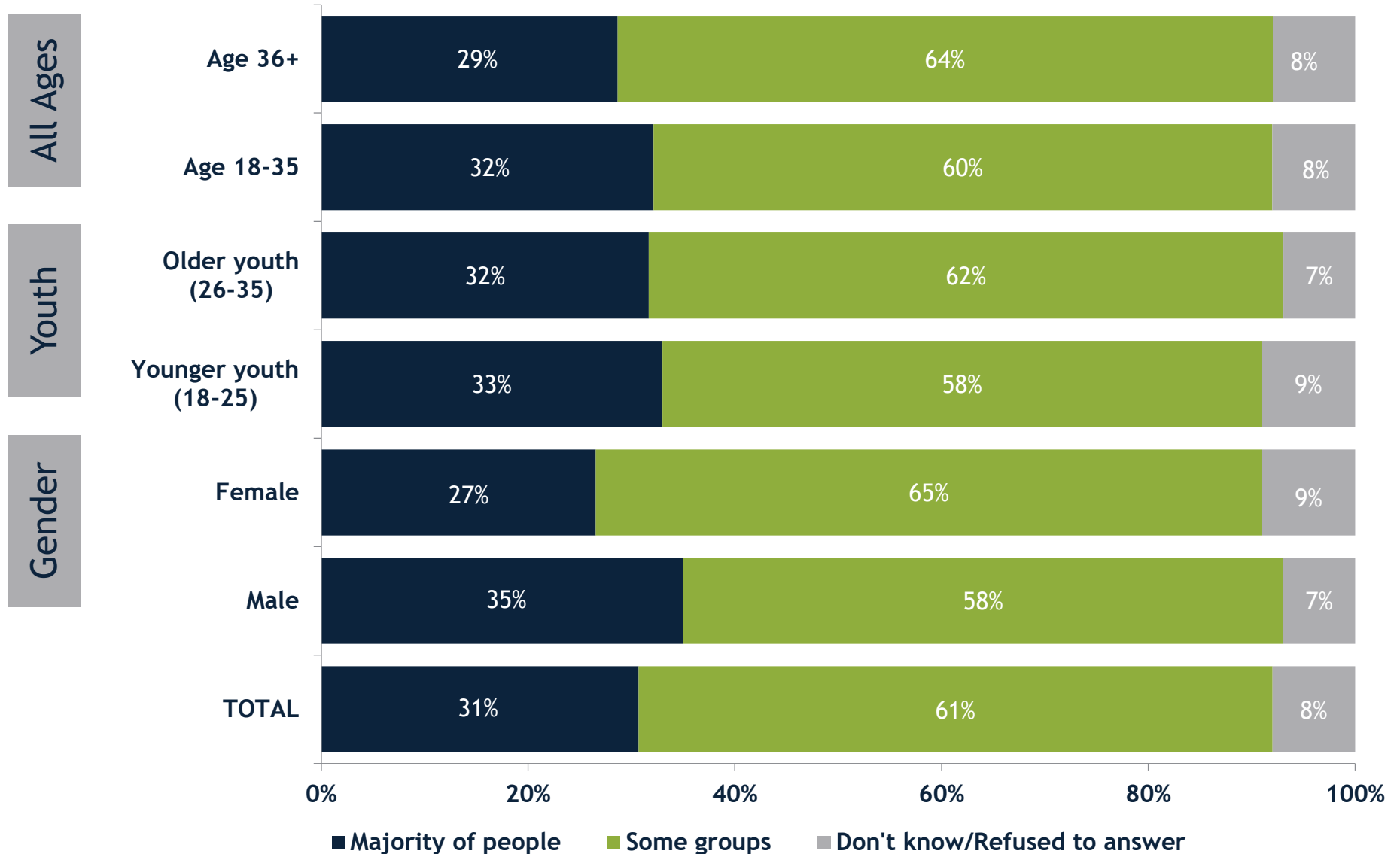

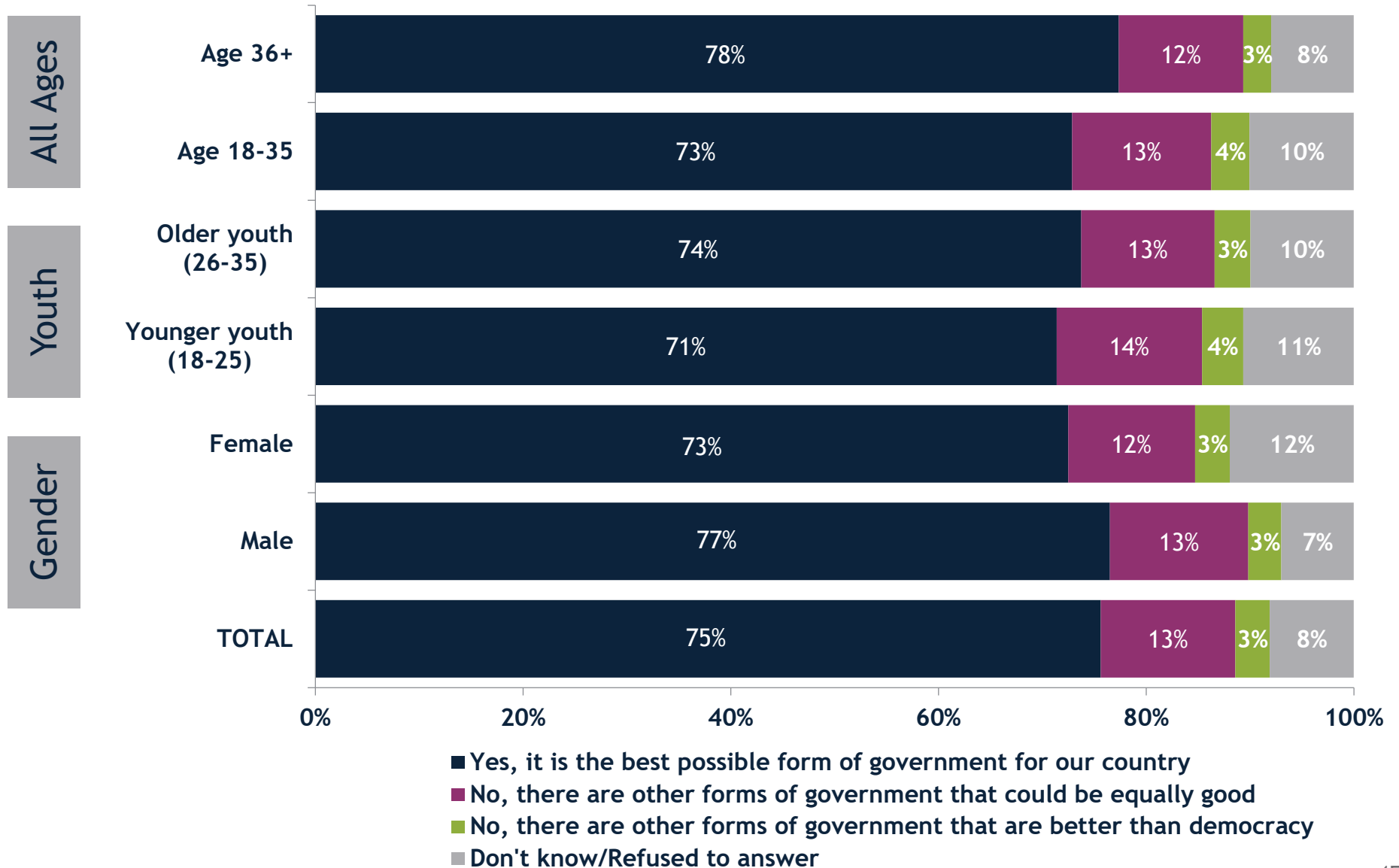

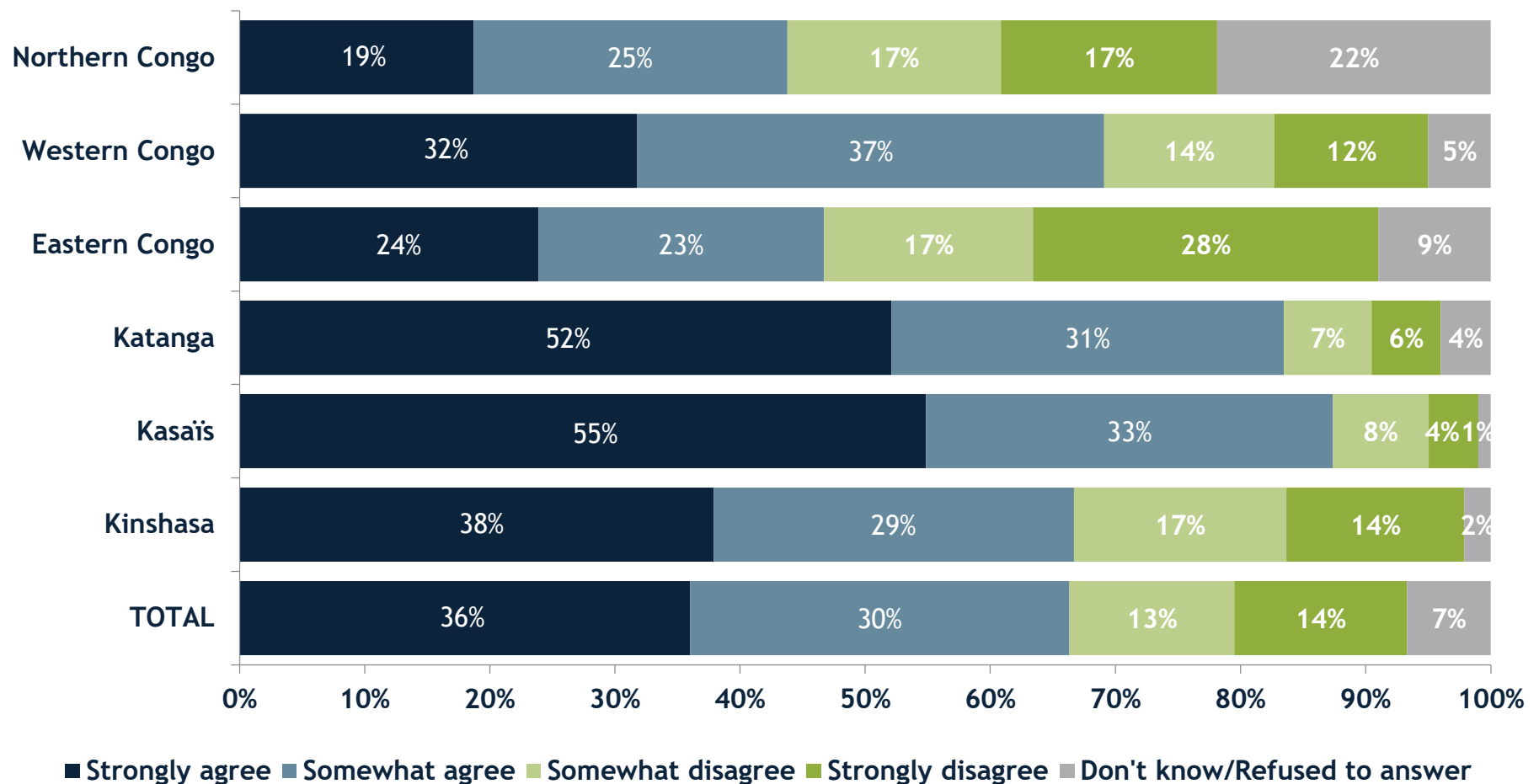
How important or unimportant are each of these elements in making any country a democracy?

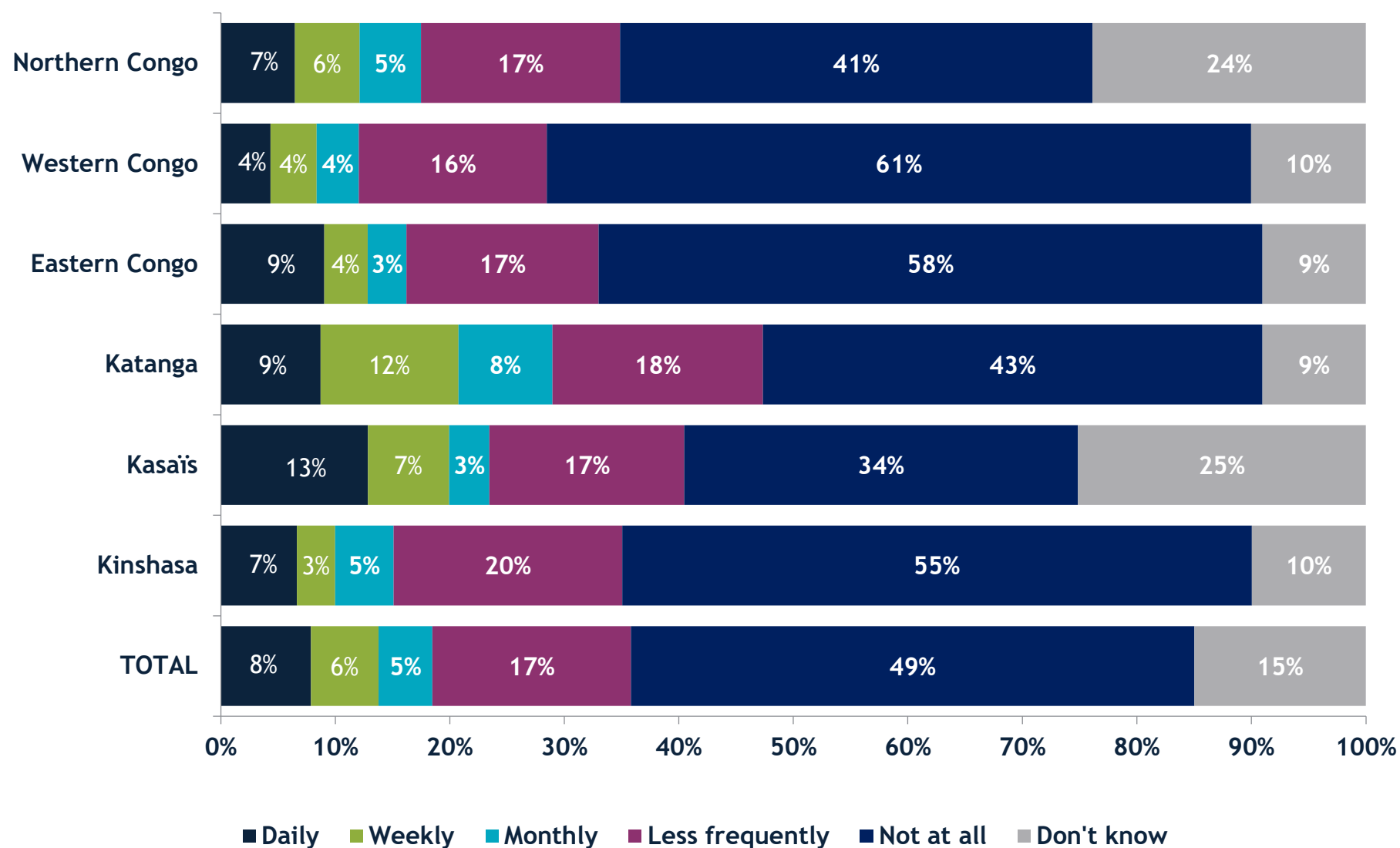

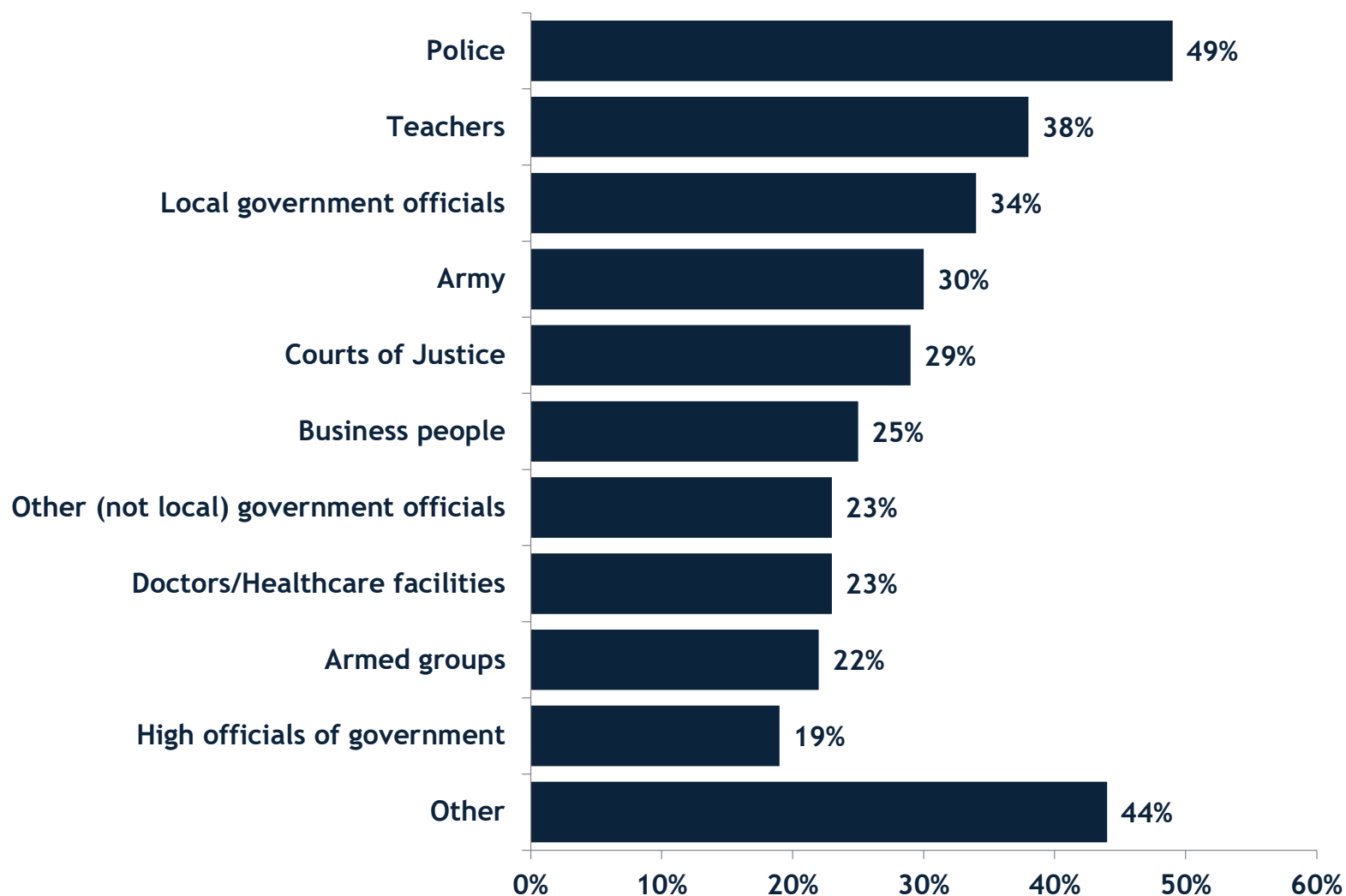
In the past 12 months, how often, if at all, have you had to do a favor, give a gift or pay a bribe?

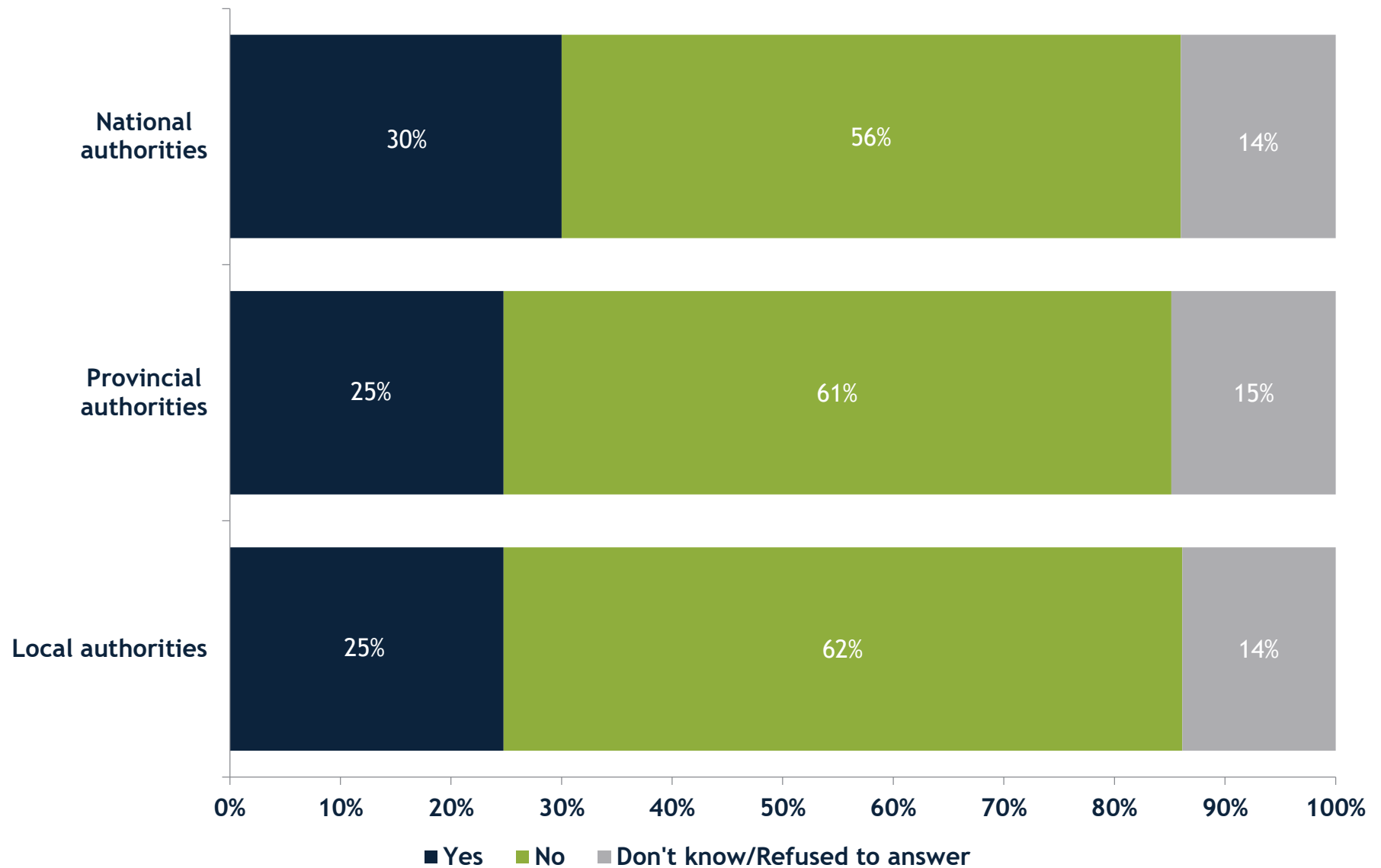

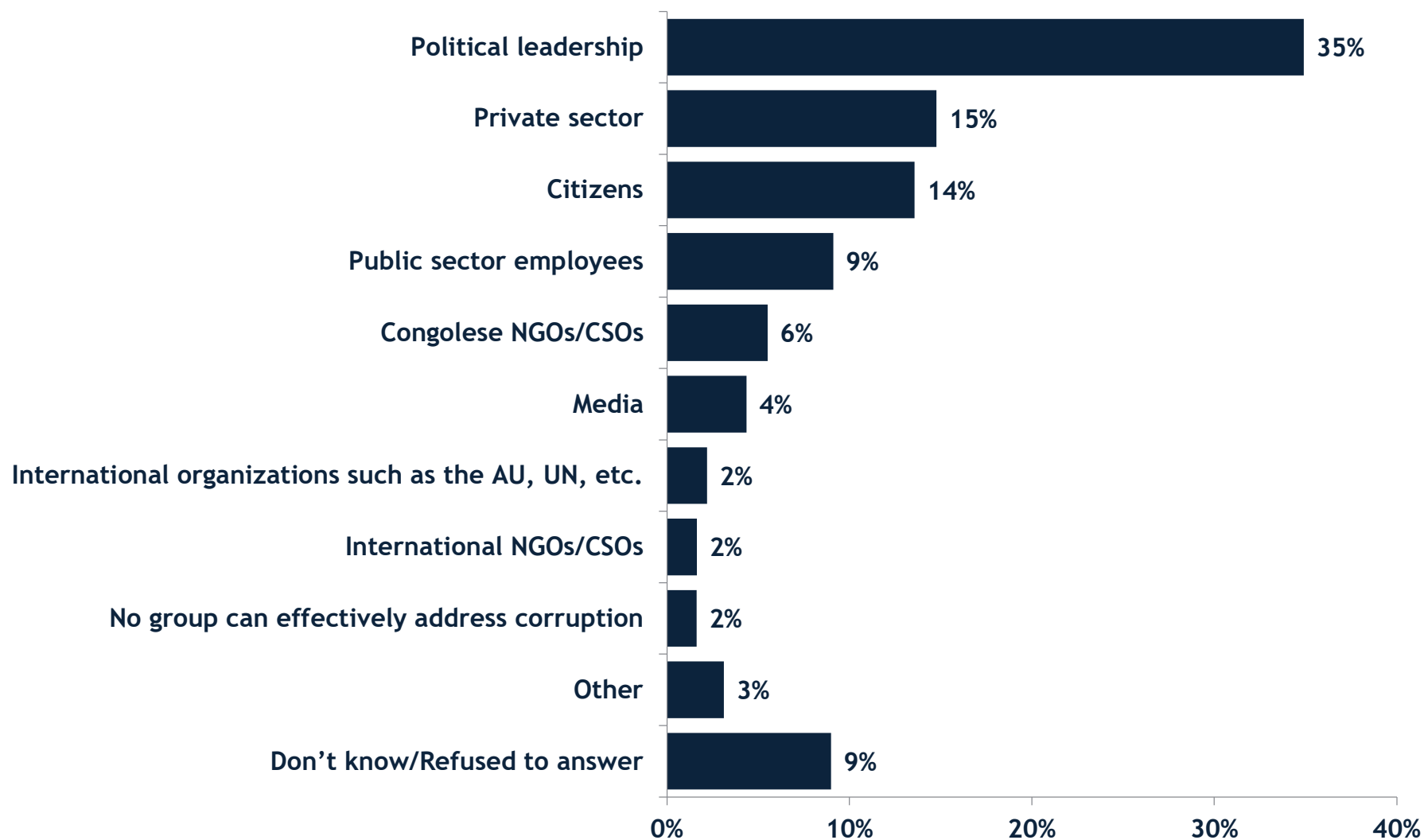
Whom did you have to do favors for, give gifts or pay bribes to?

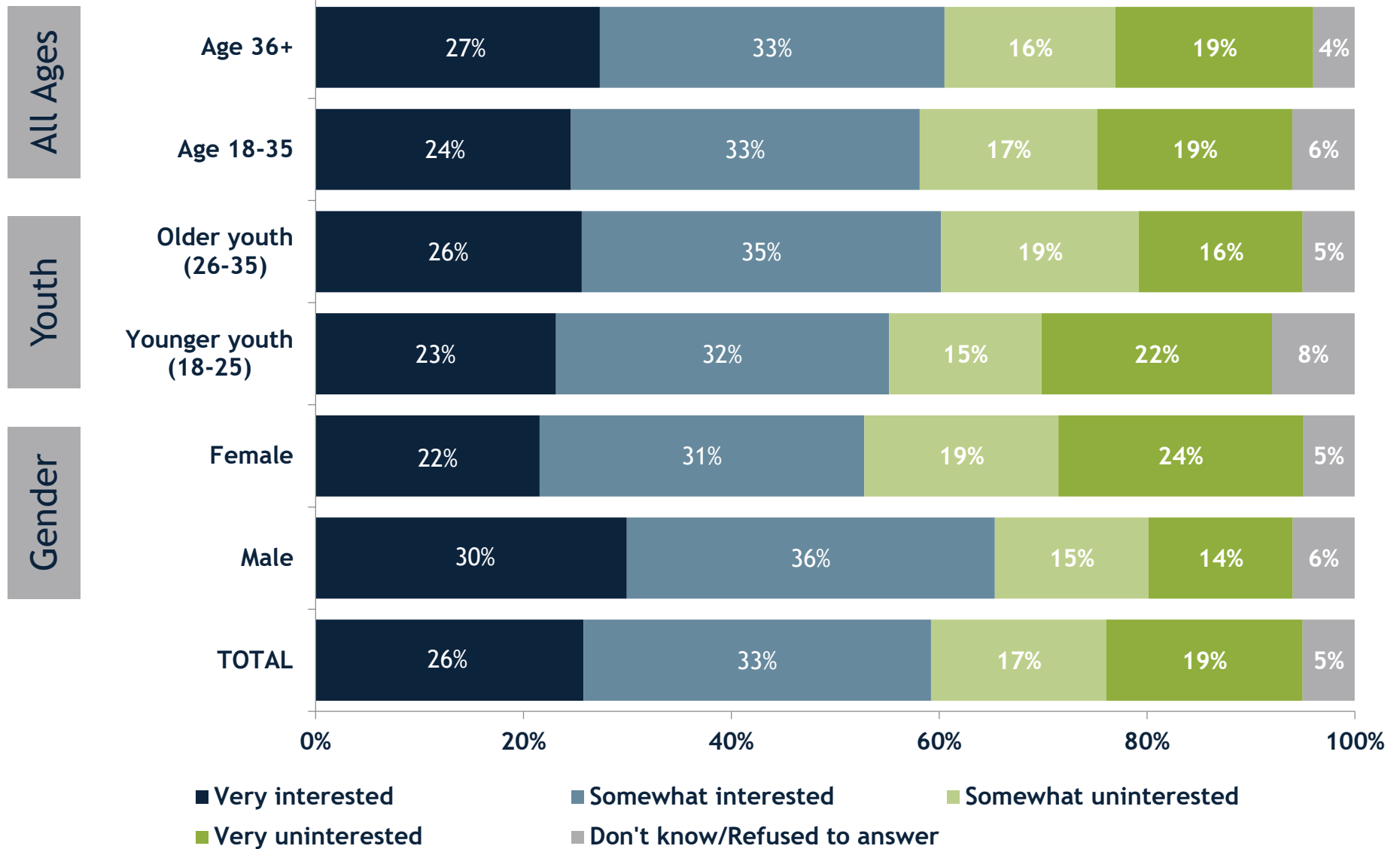

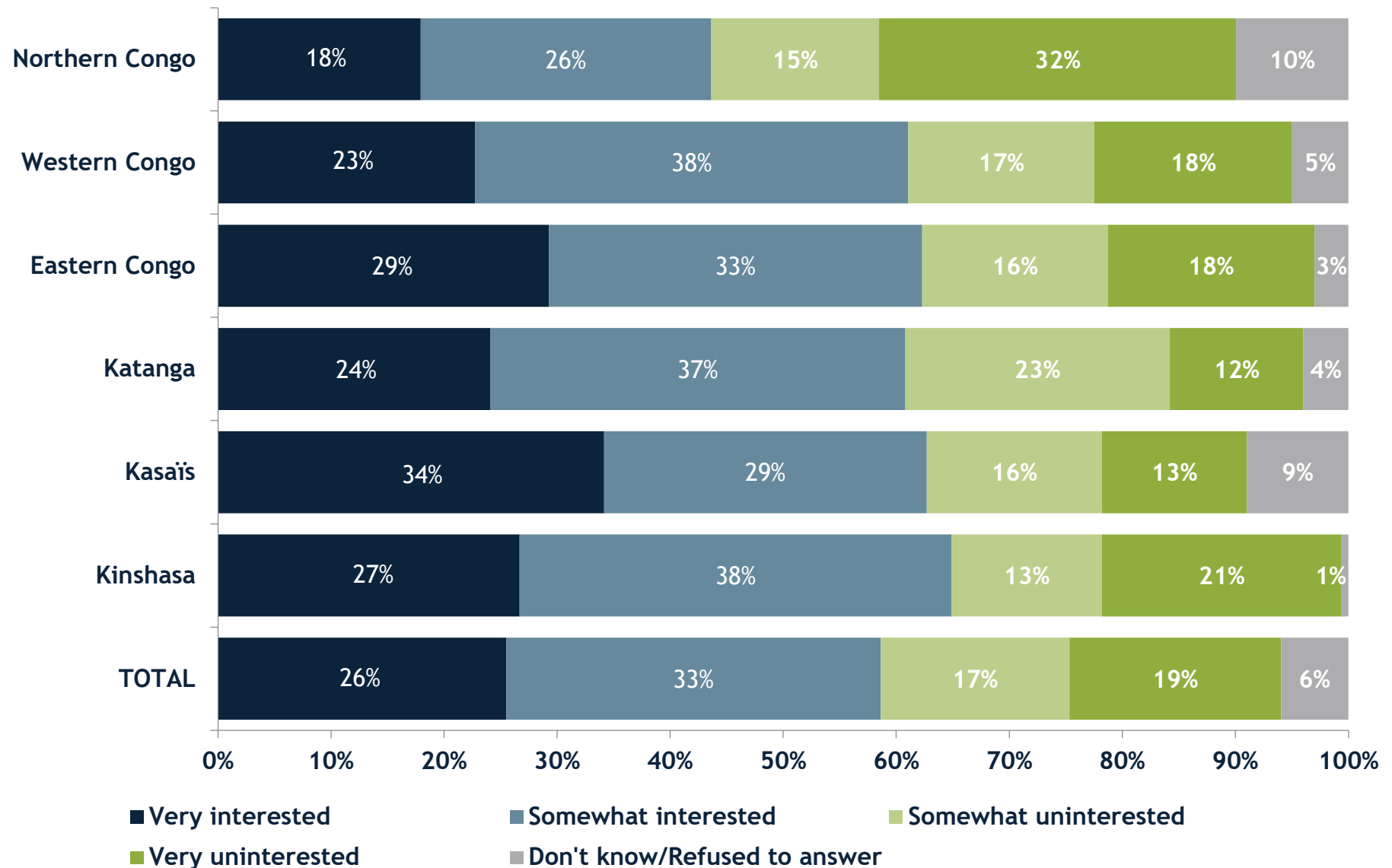

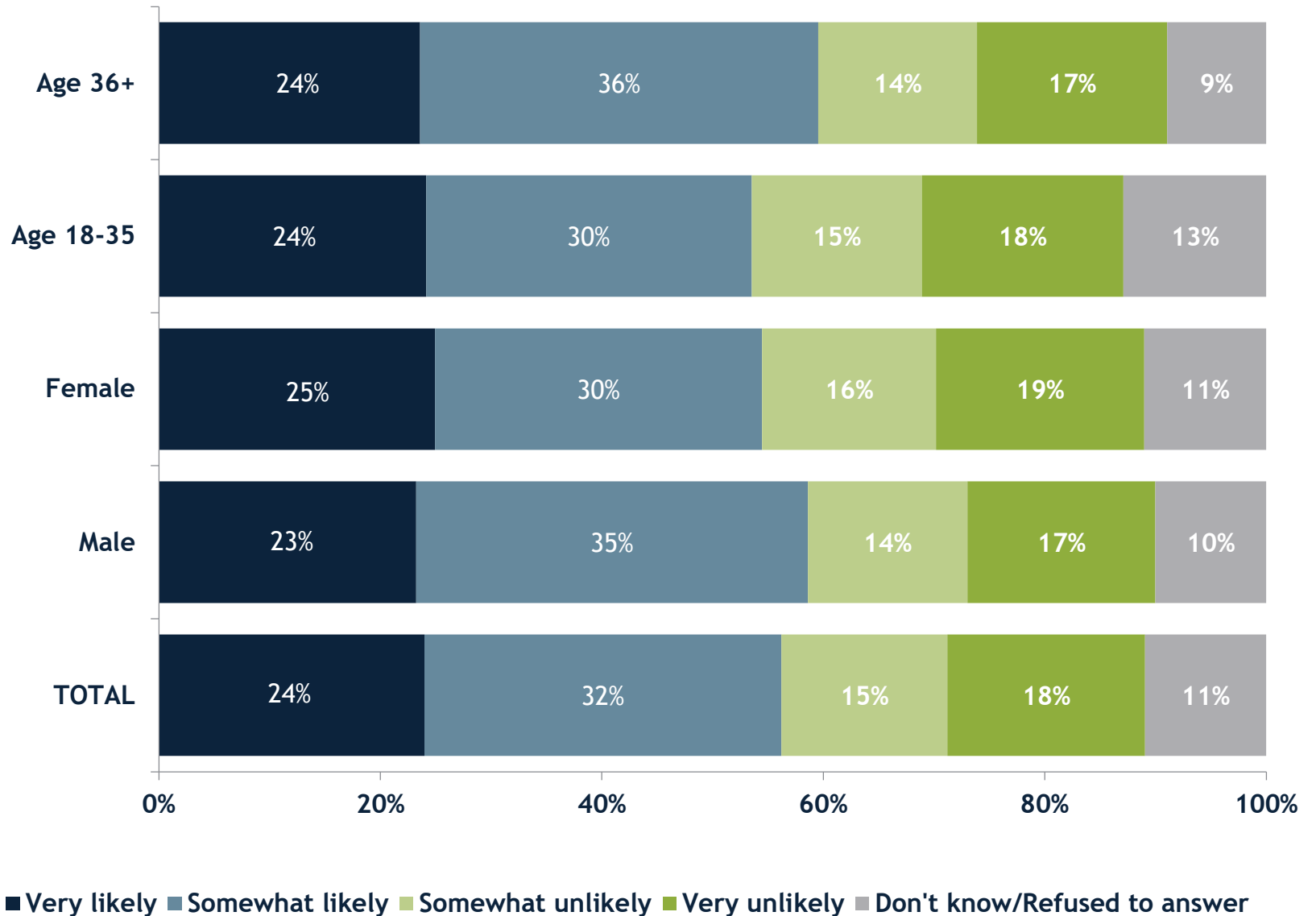
How interested or uninterested are you in political news and information? (By gender and age)



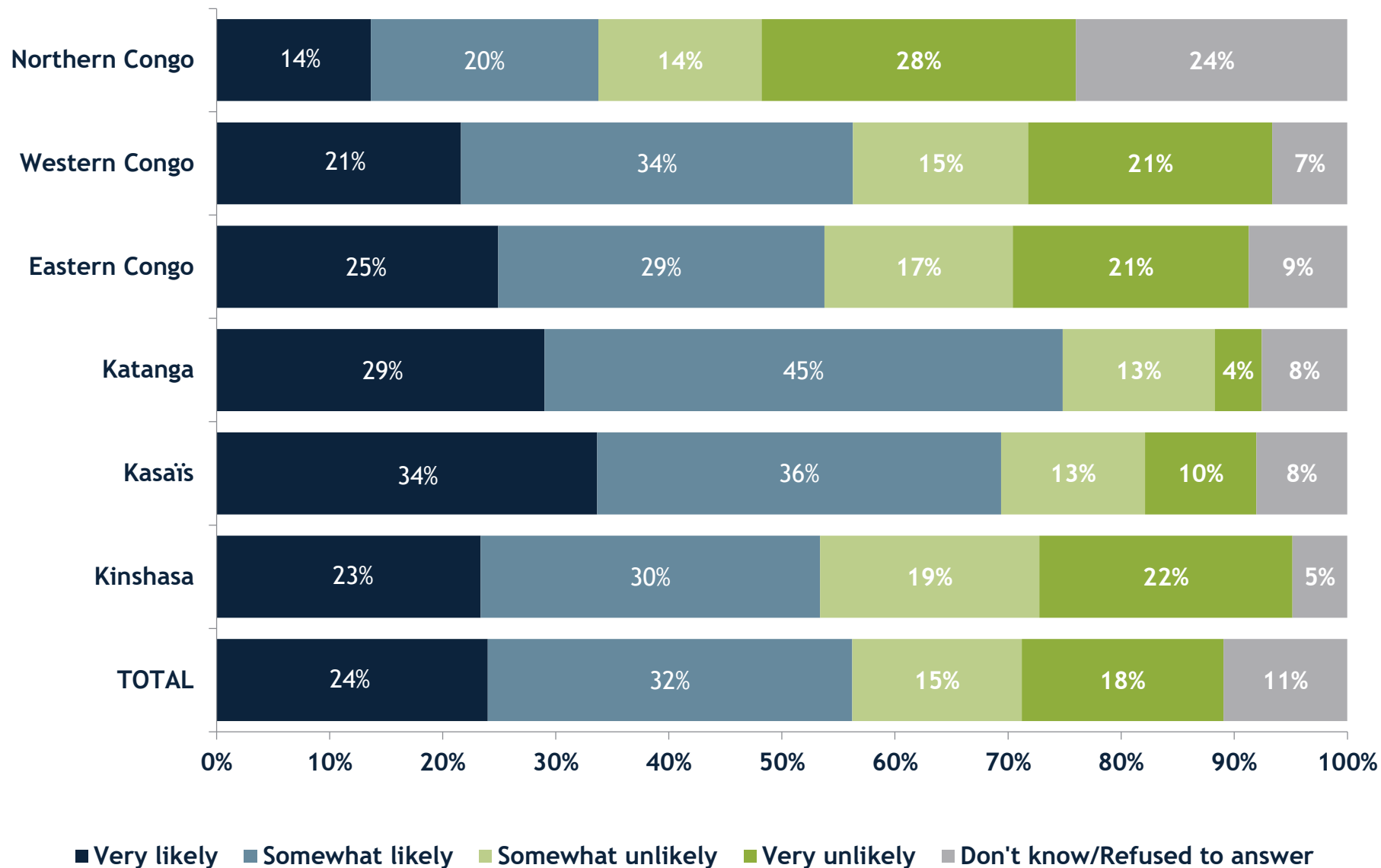
How interested or uninterested are you in political news and information? (By region)



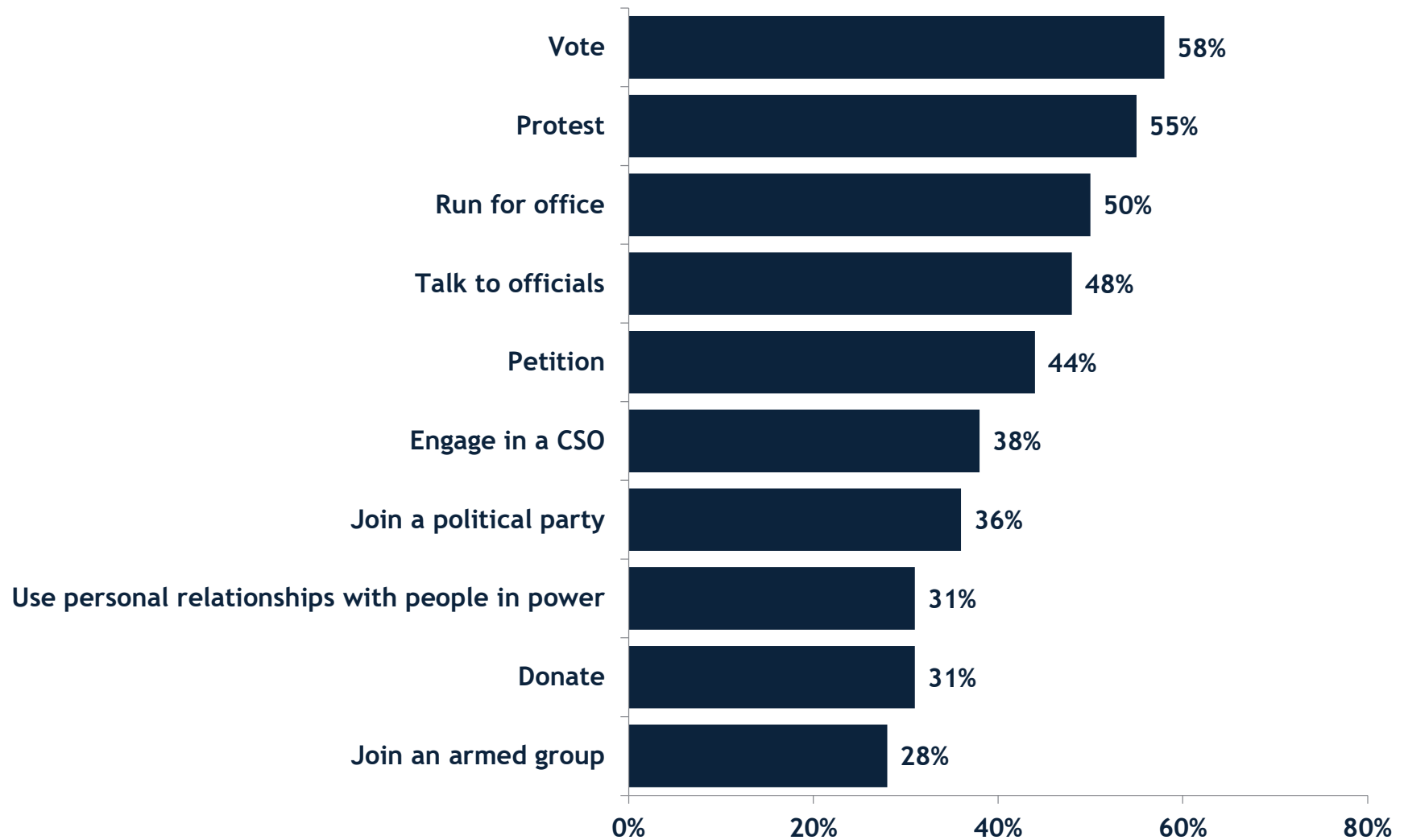
How likely or unlikely are ordinary people able to influence decisions made in our country? (By gender and age)



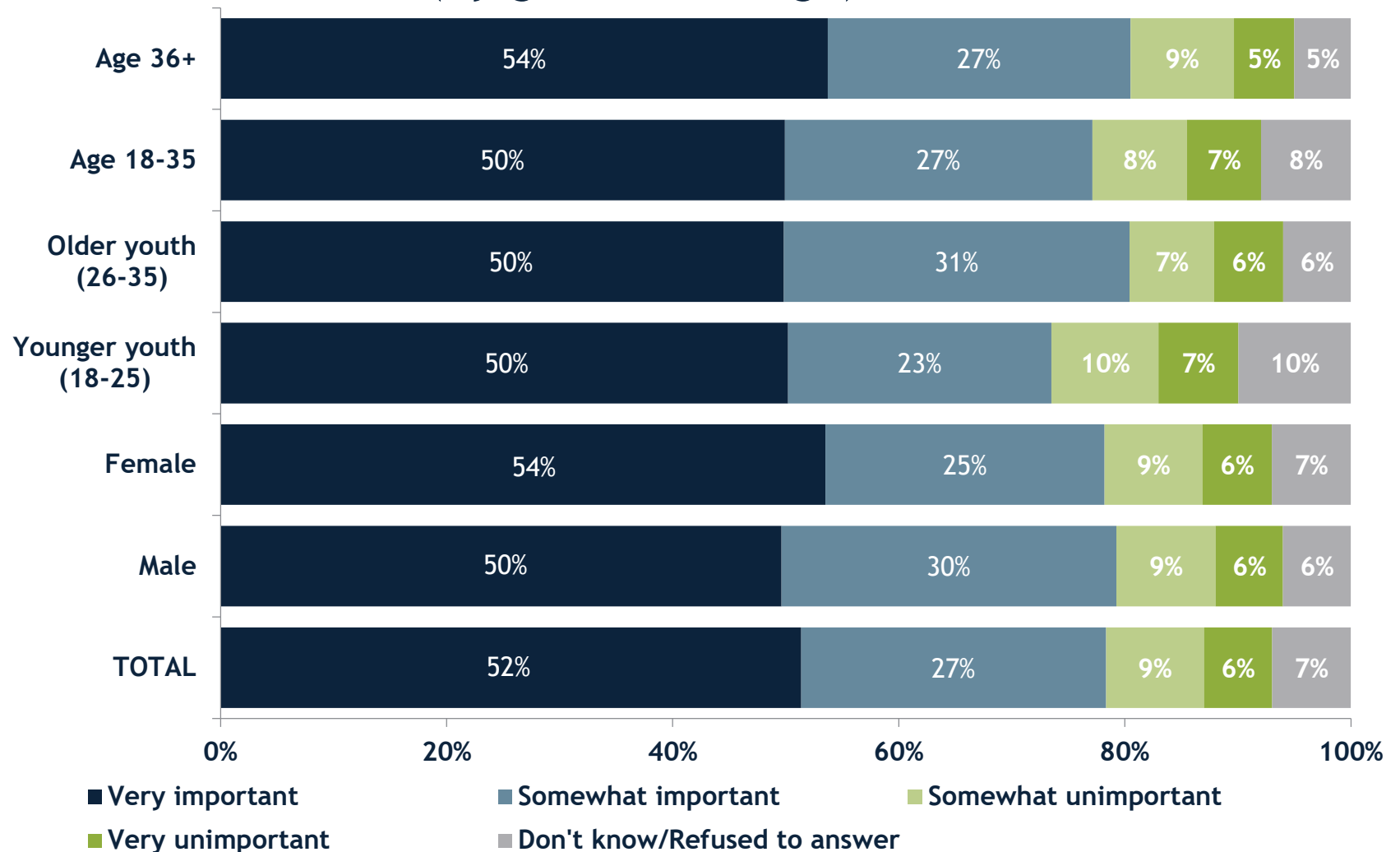

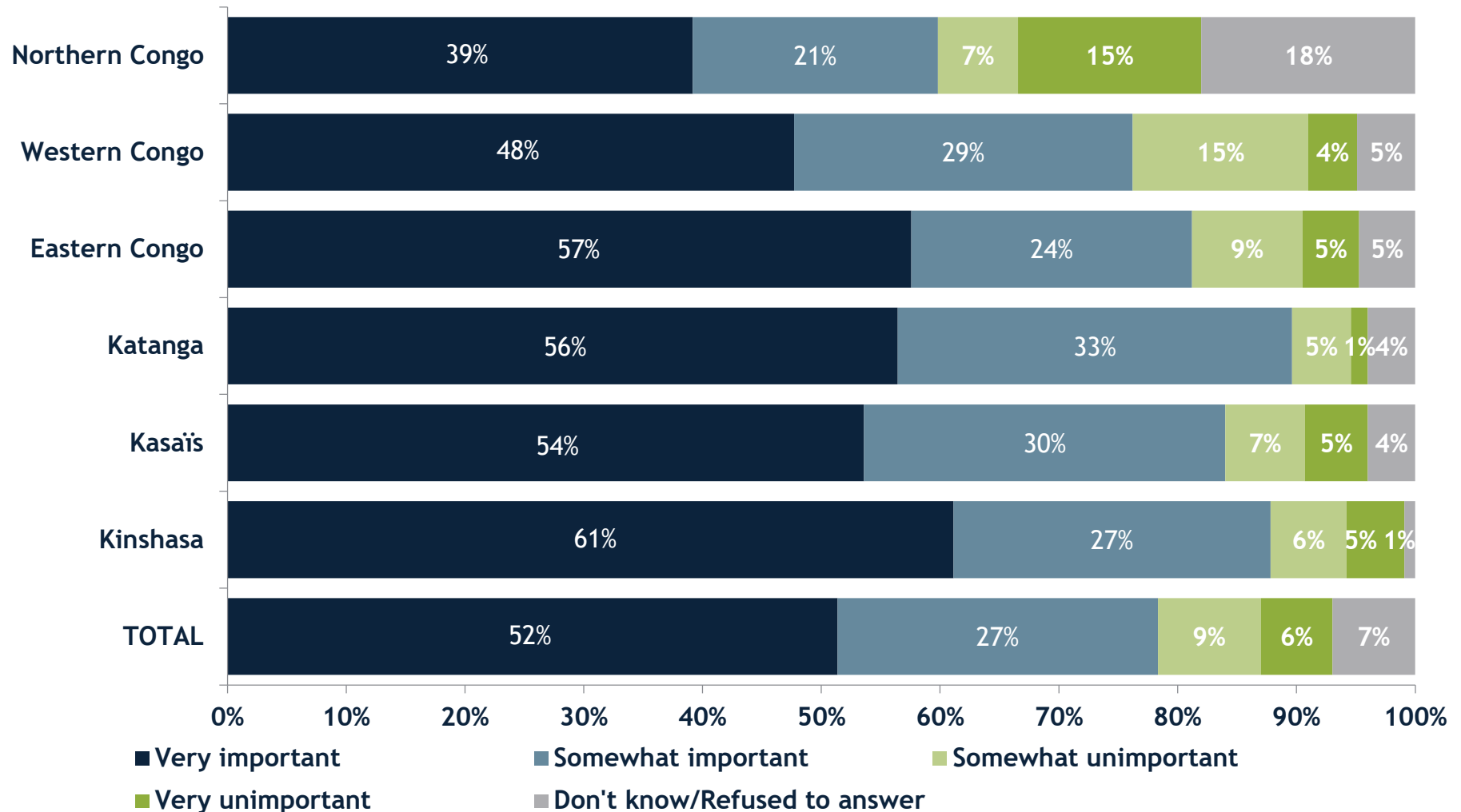
How can ordinary people influence decisions made in our country? (Spontaneous, among n=2,030 who think ordinary people are somewhat likely/very likely to influence decisions)



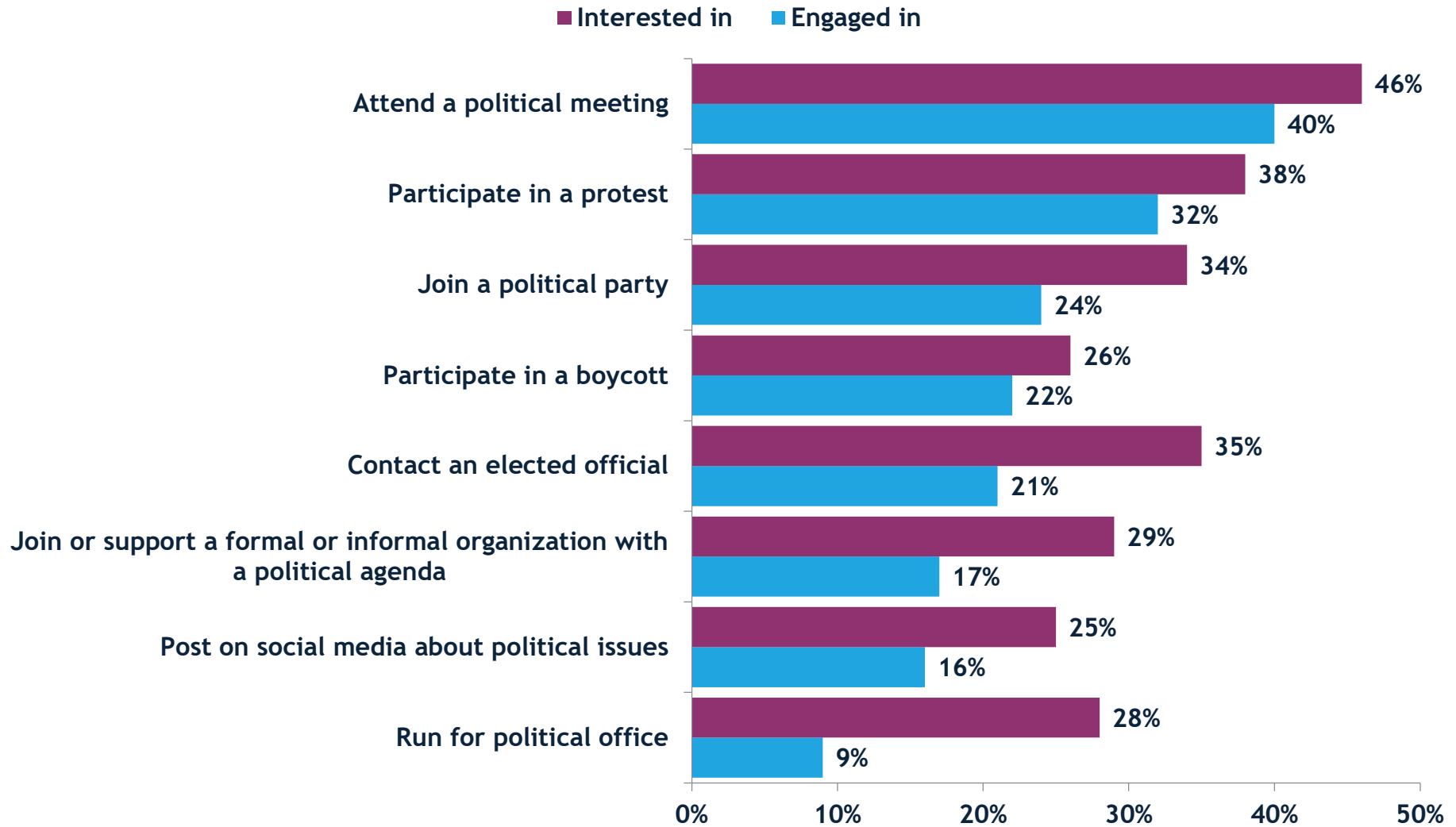
How important or unimportant is it that all members of our country's adult population, including women, youth, minorities, and people with disabilities are included in political decision making? (By gender and age)

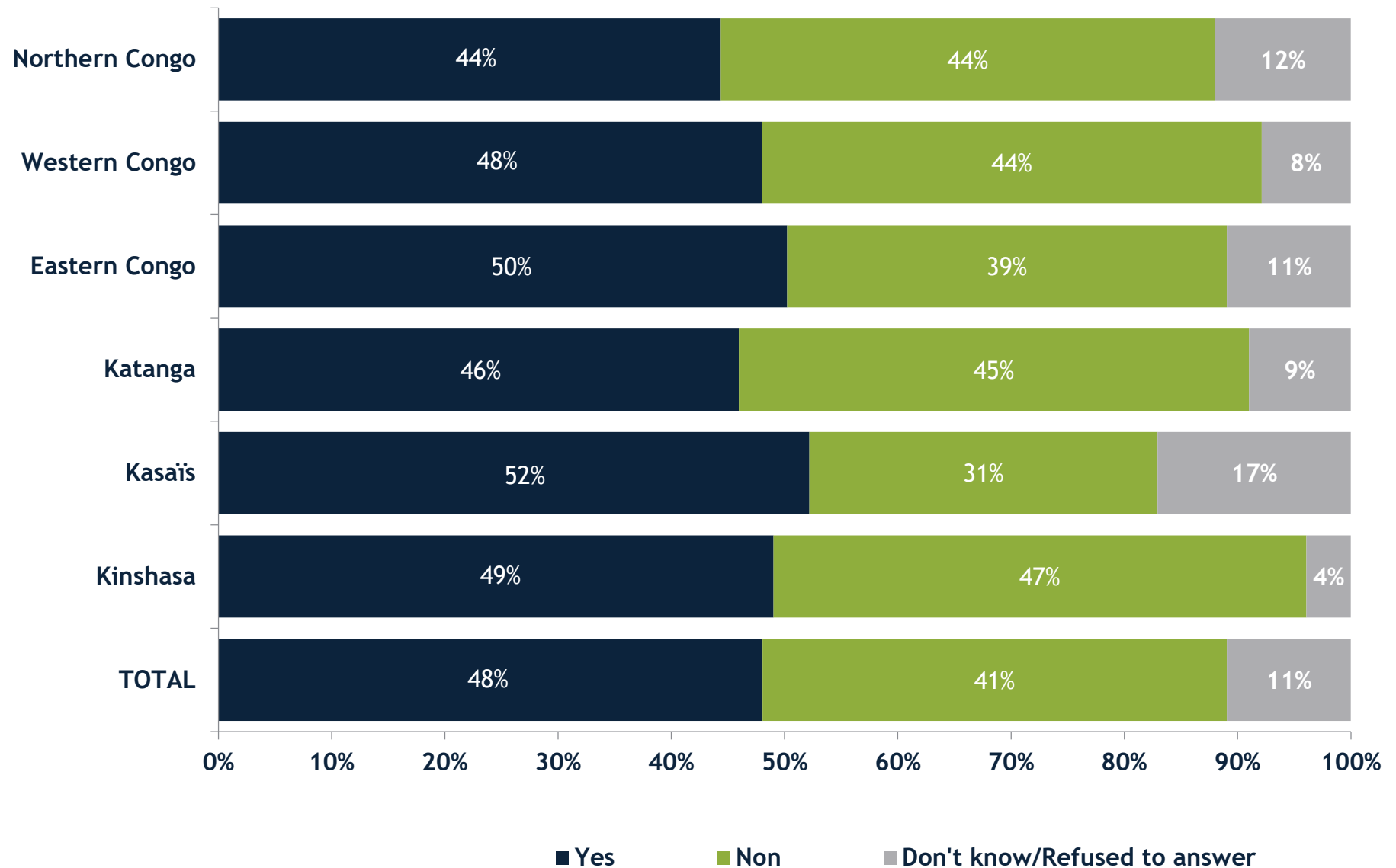
Which of these countries do you consider to be the most important economic partner or partners for our country?

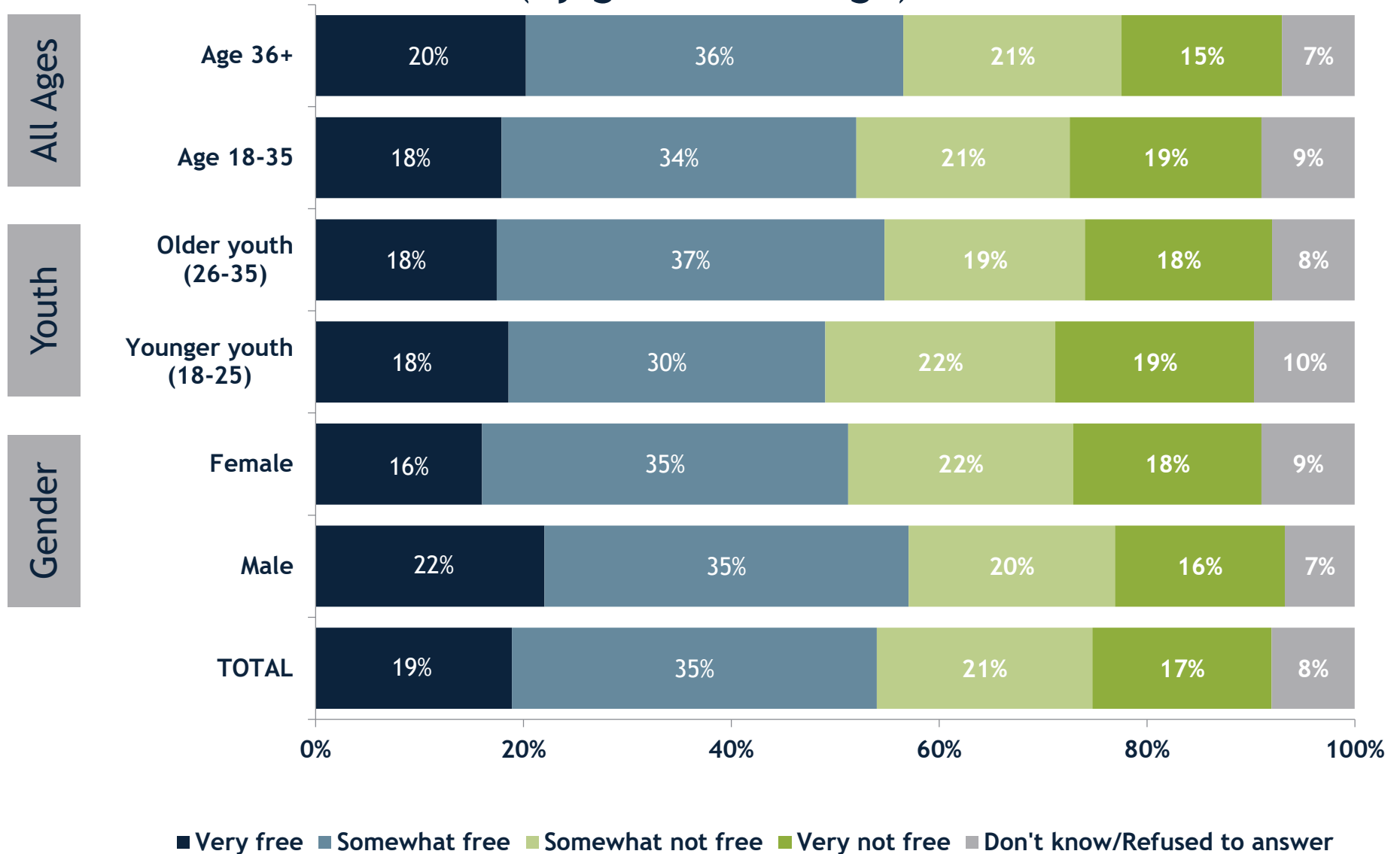

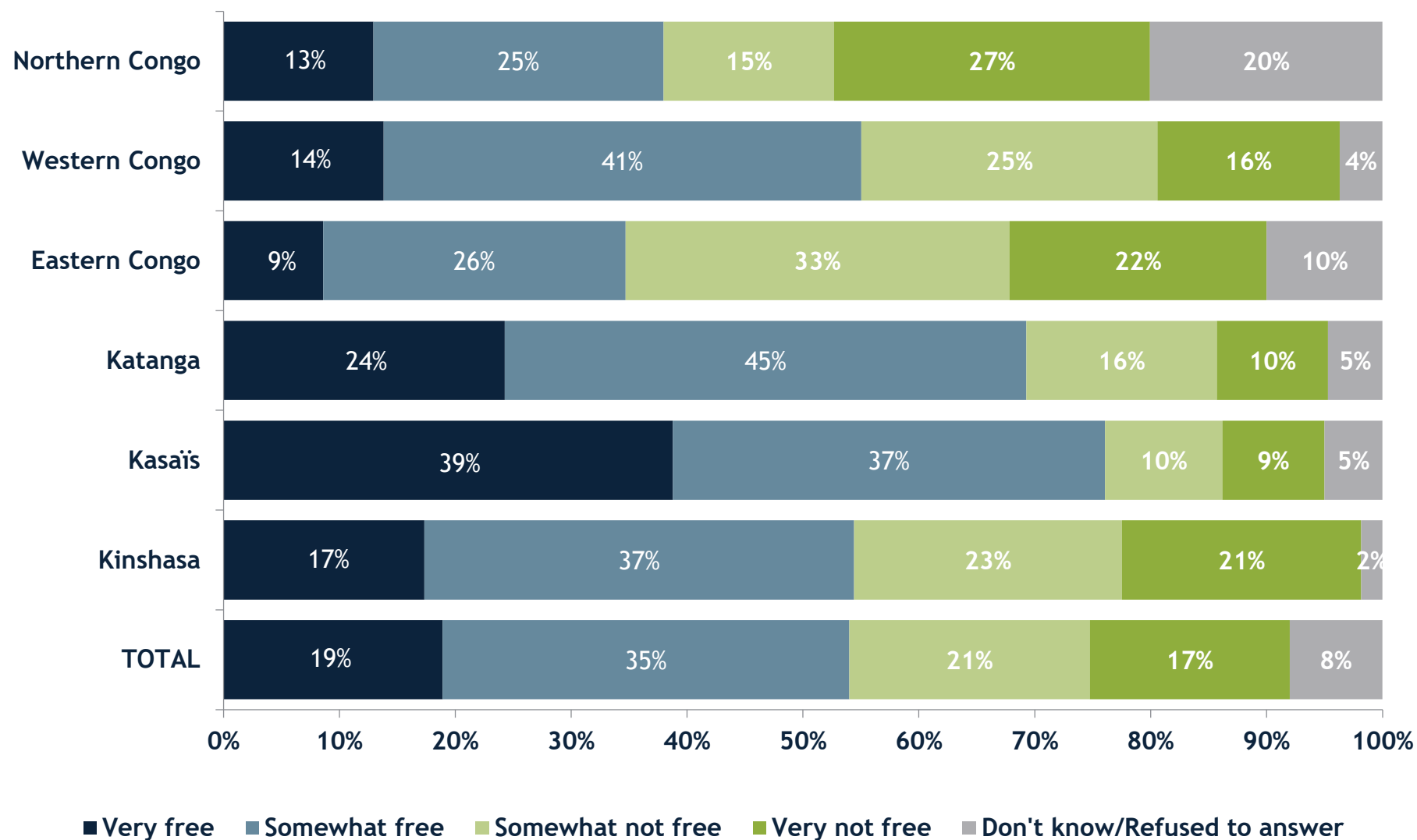

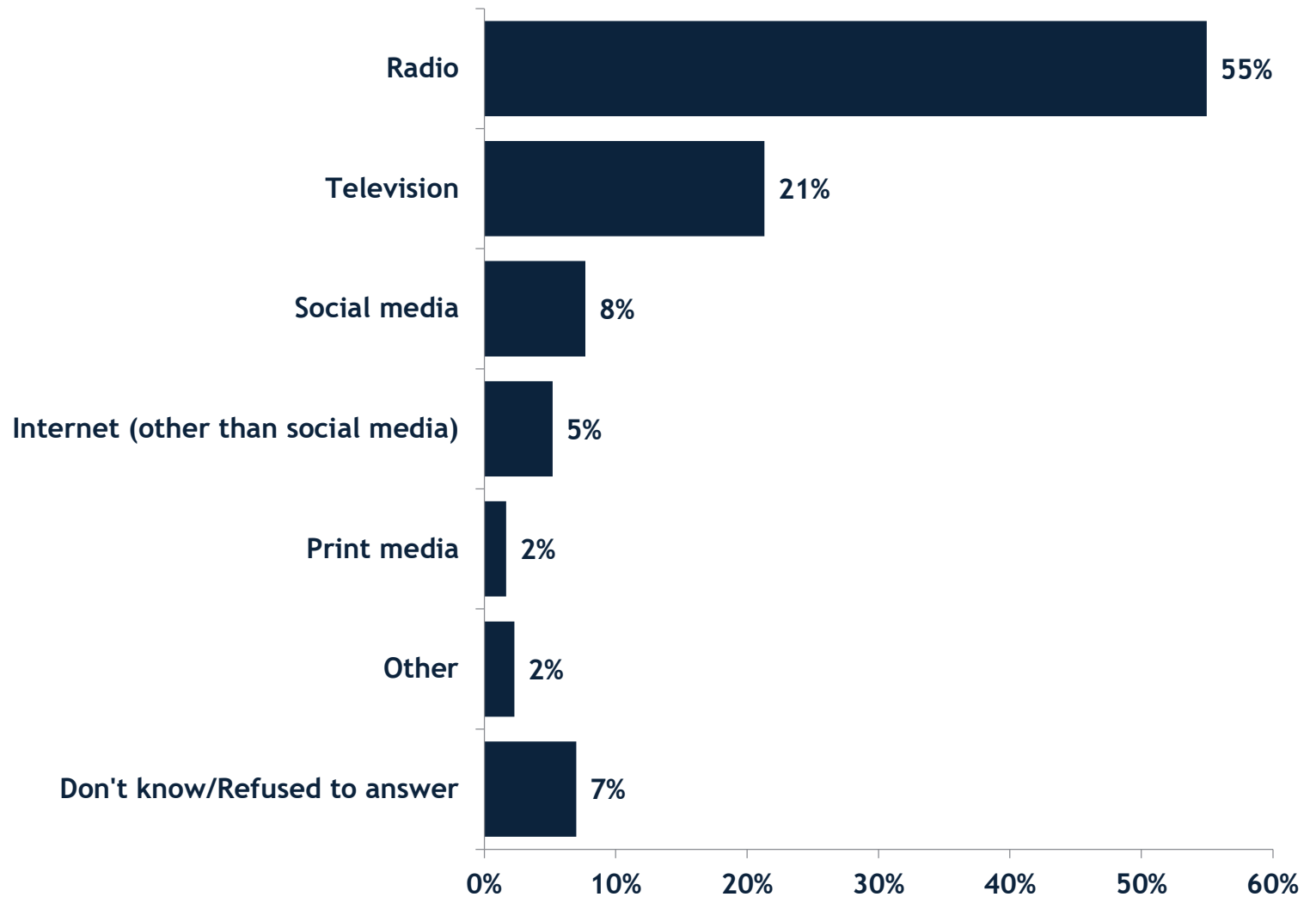
Are the media in our country free to independently cover any issue or not? (By gender and age)



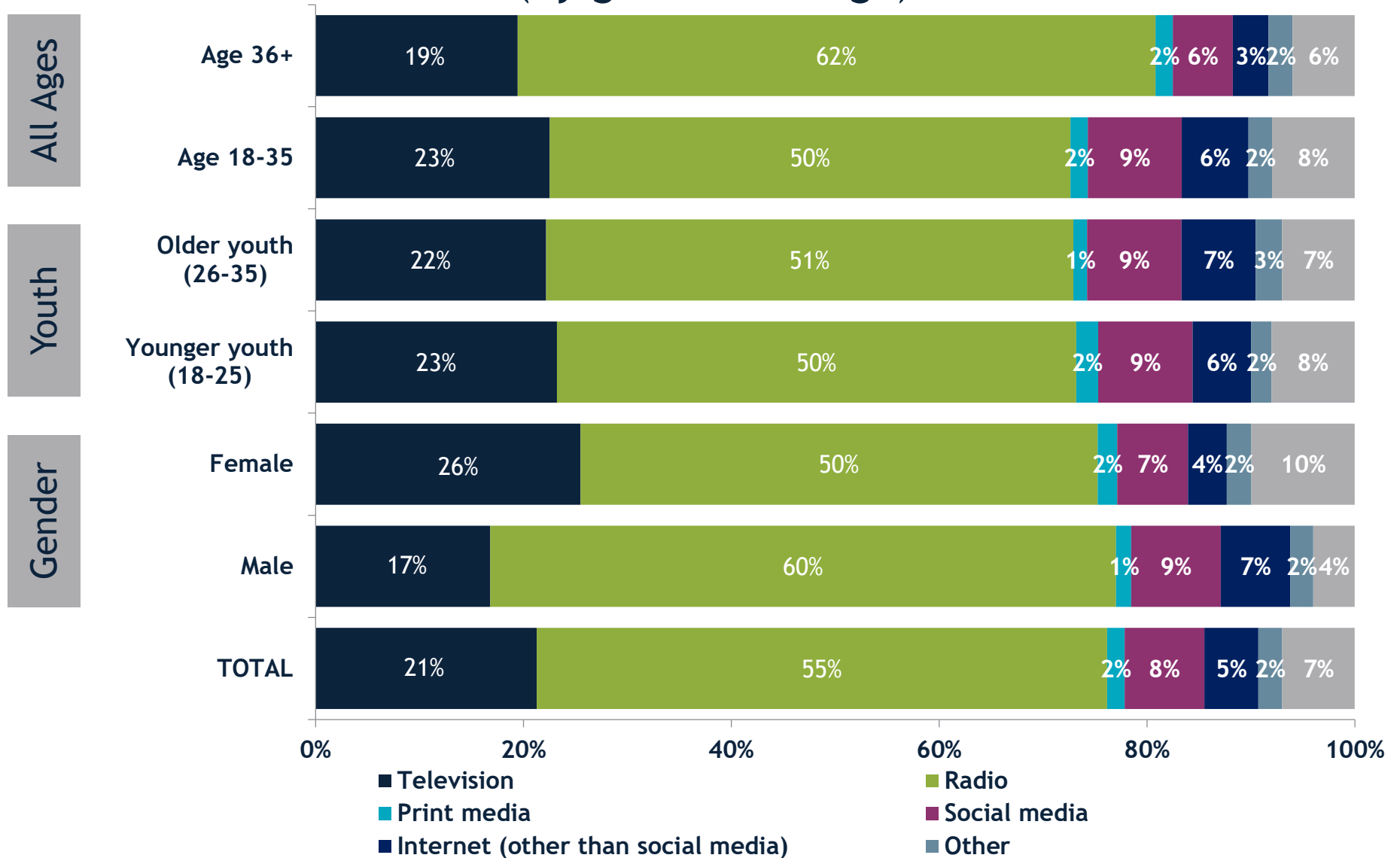

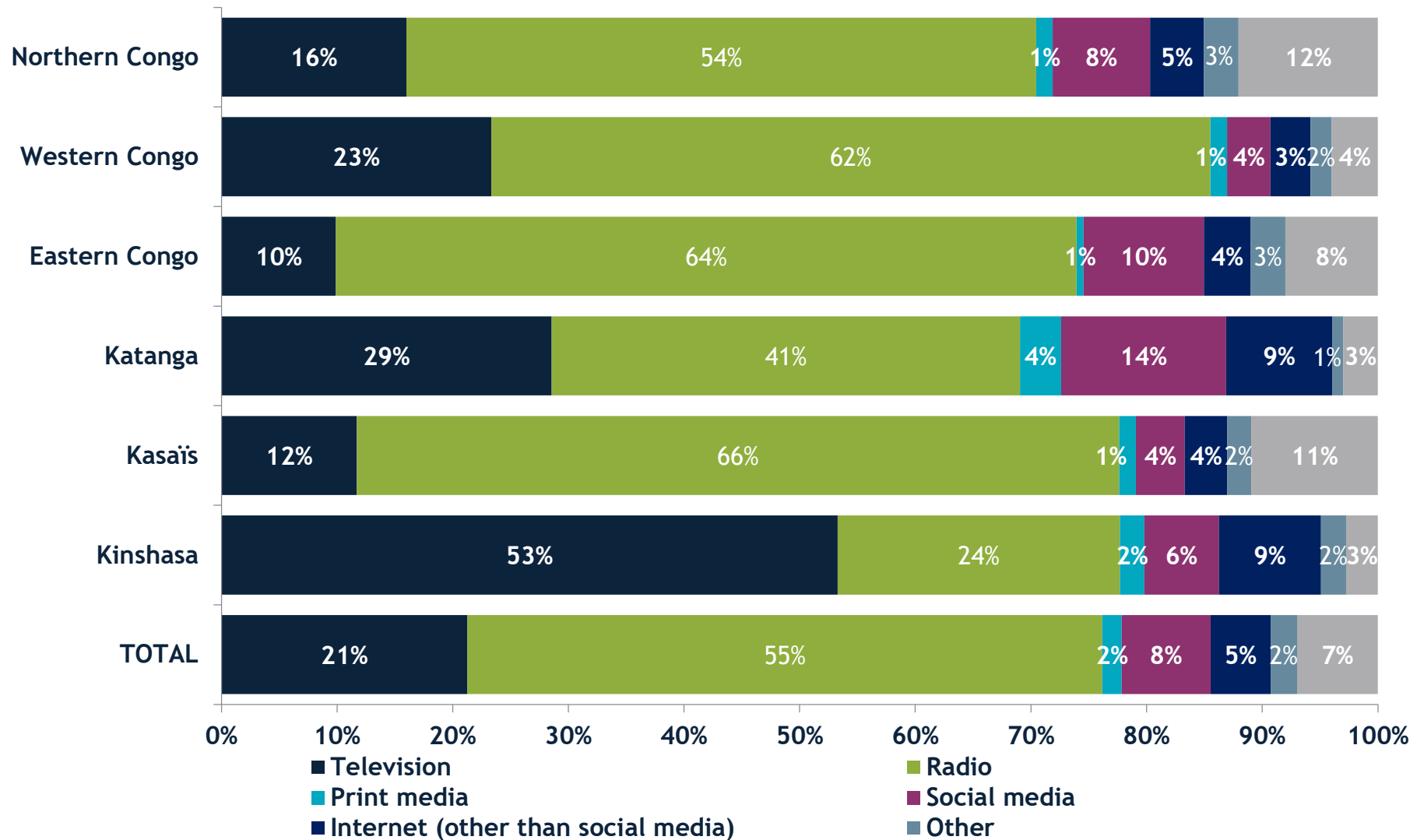
Which media platform do you use most frequently to gain political news and information?



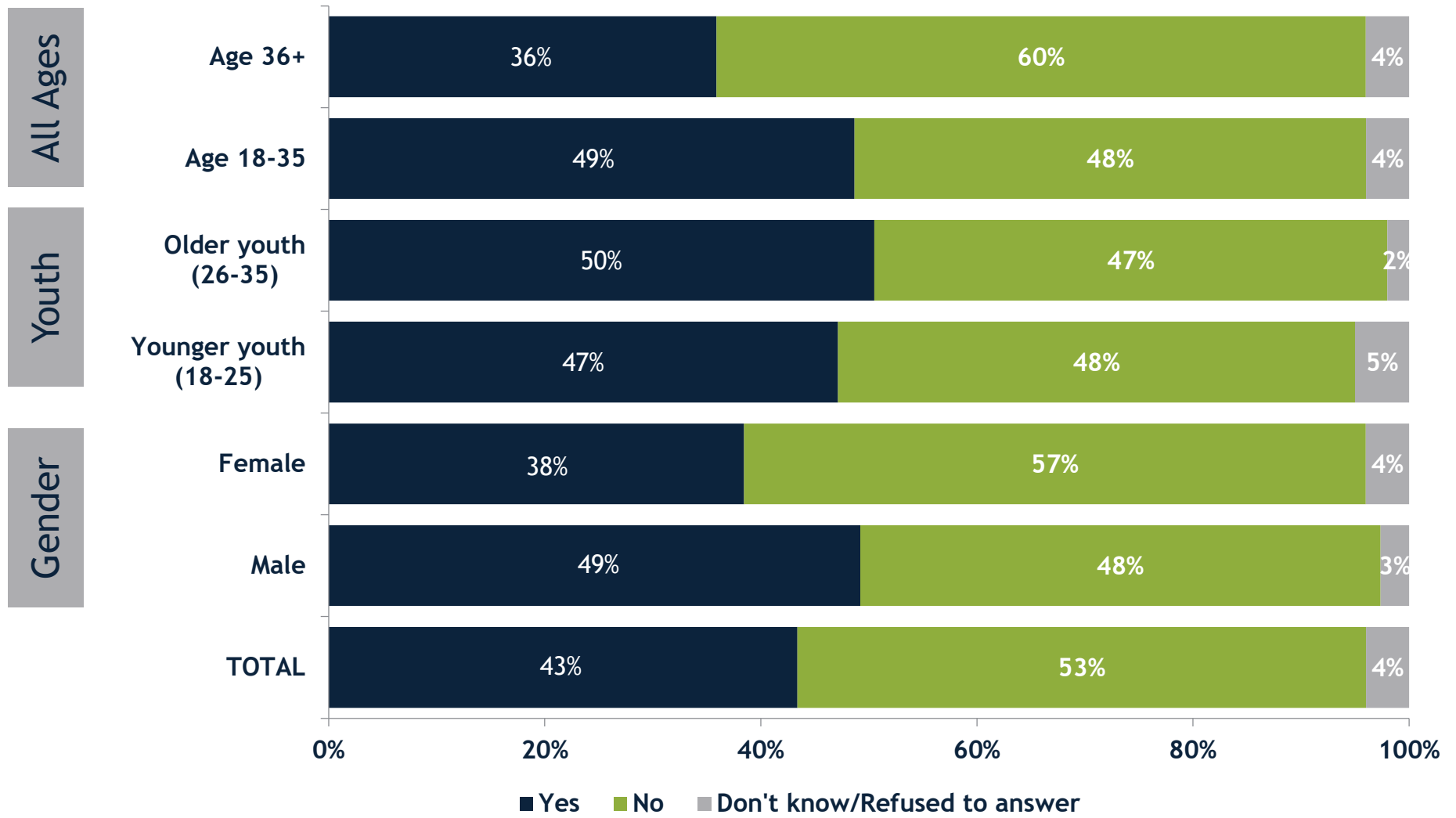

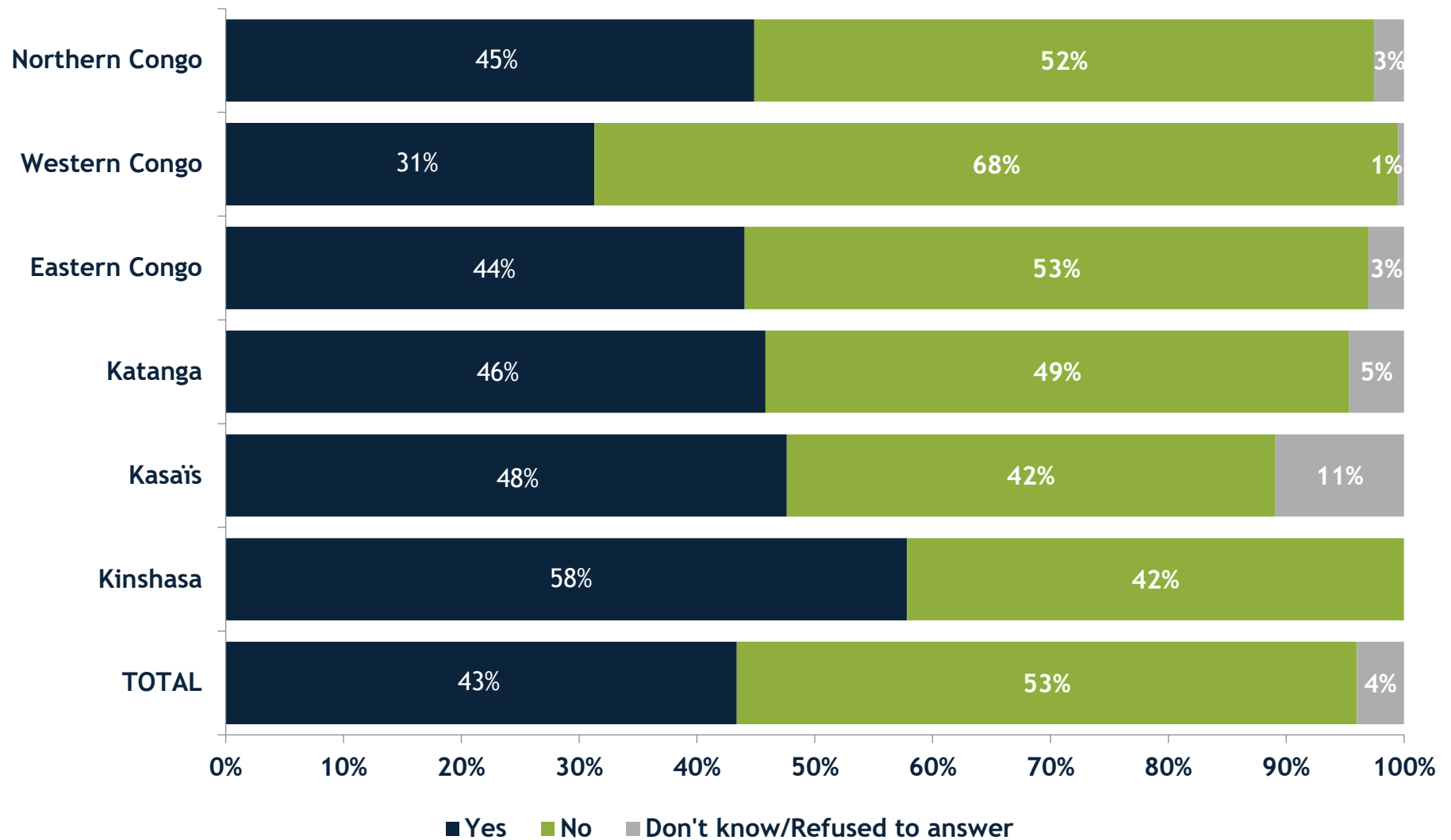

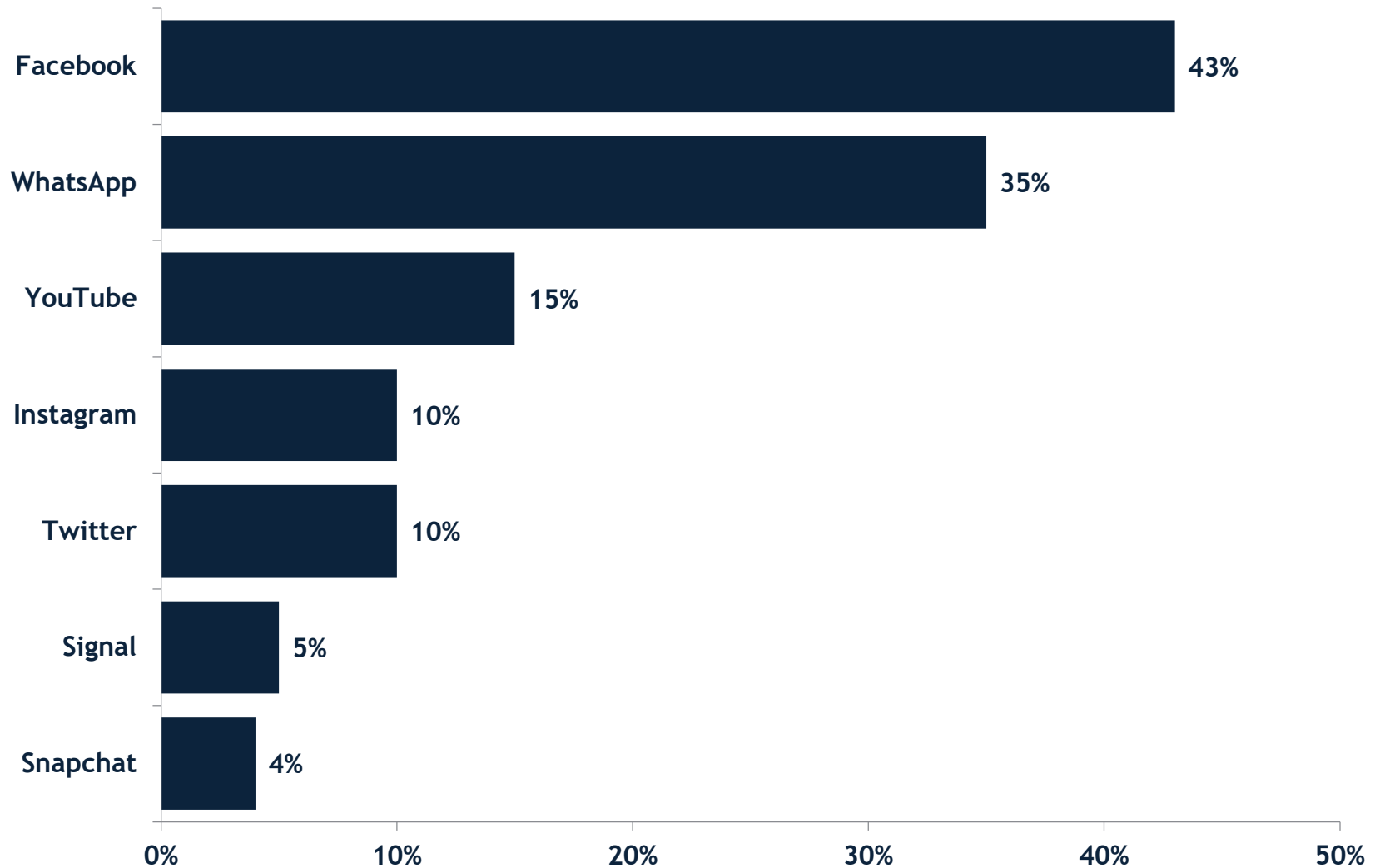

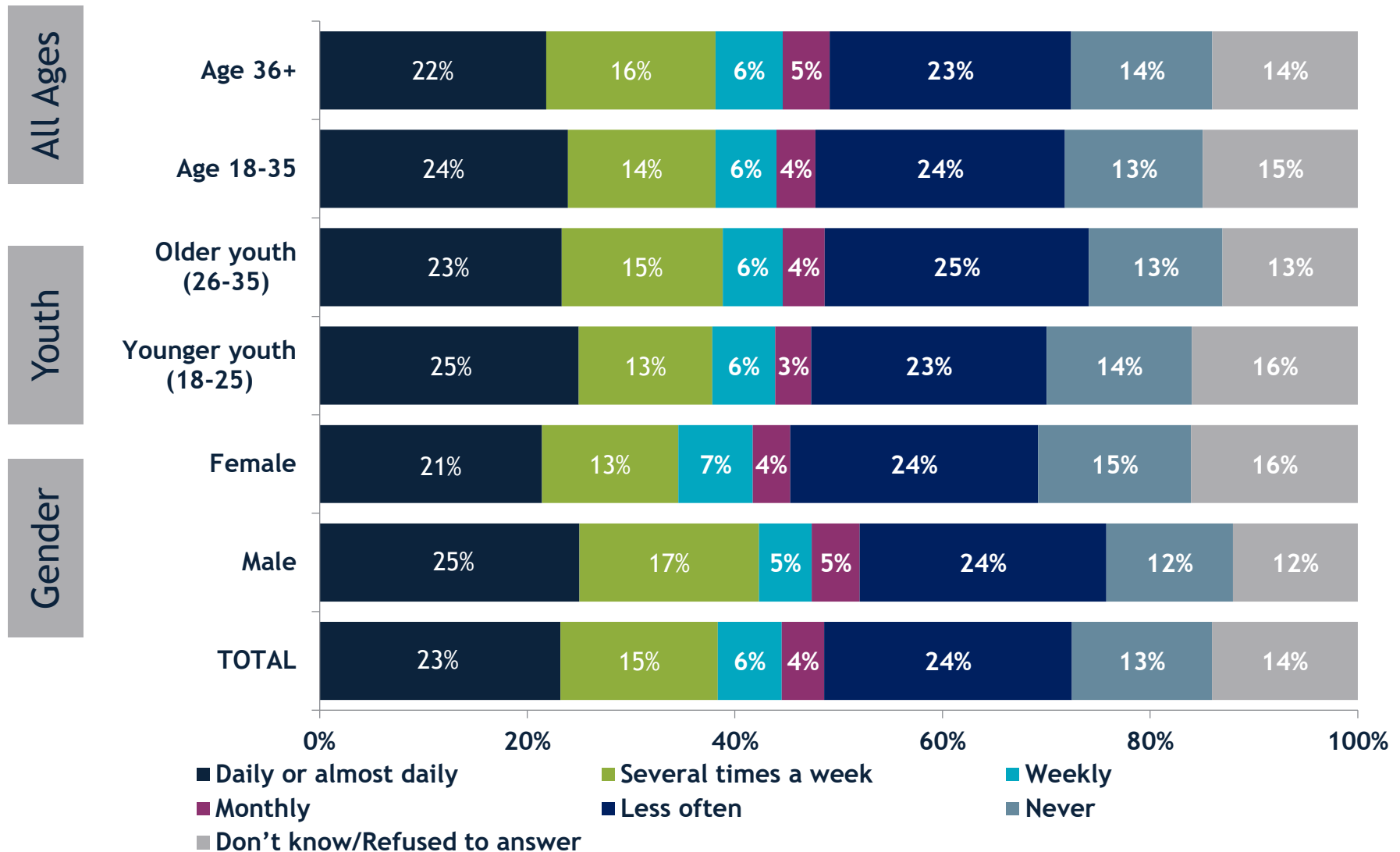

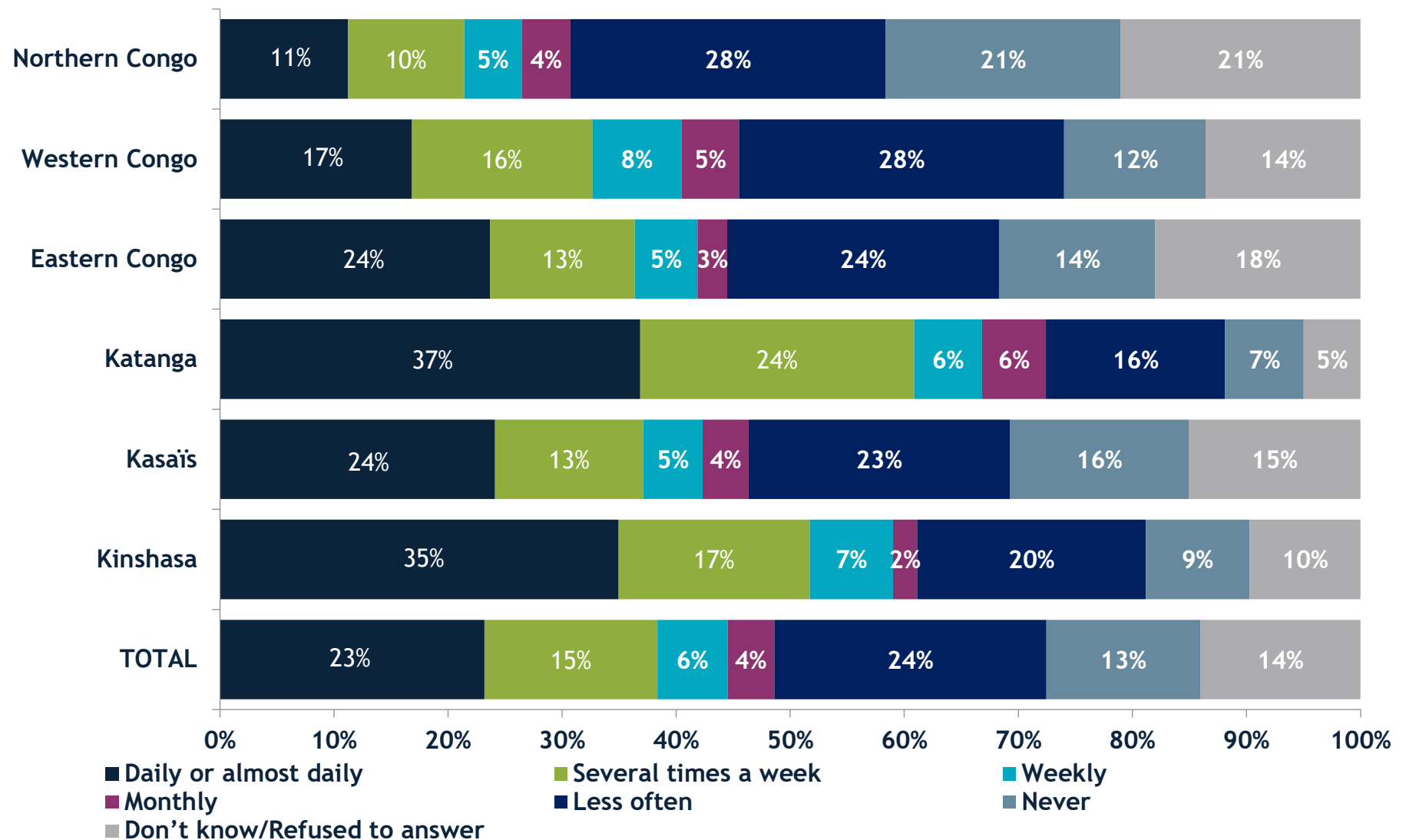
Do you use any of the following social media platforms? (% of “yes” responses displayed)



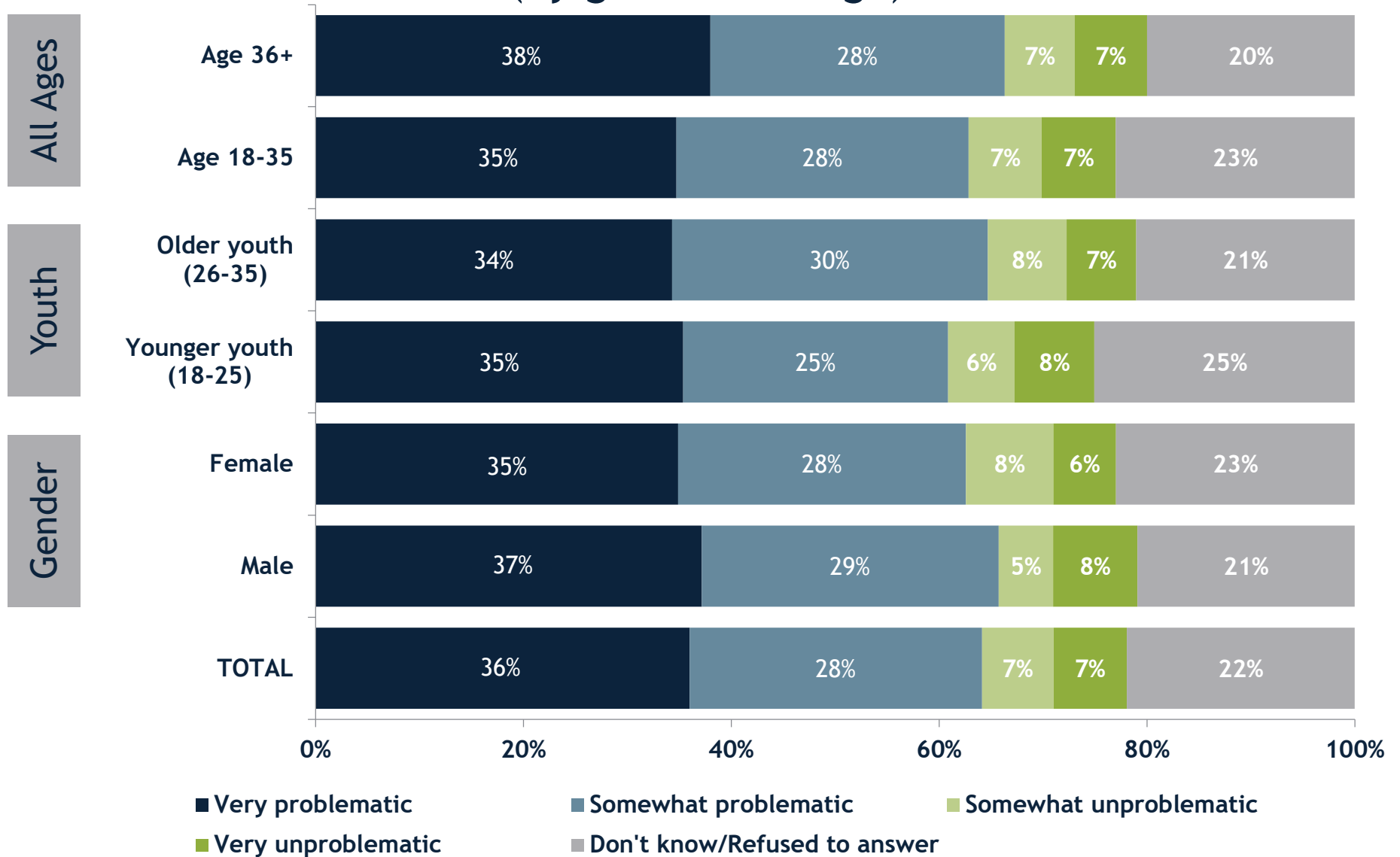
How frequently do you encounter information in the media, including social media, that you believe is misleading or false? (By gender and age)



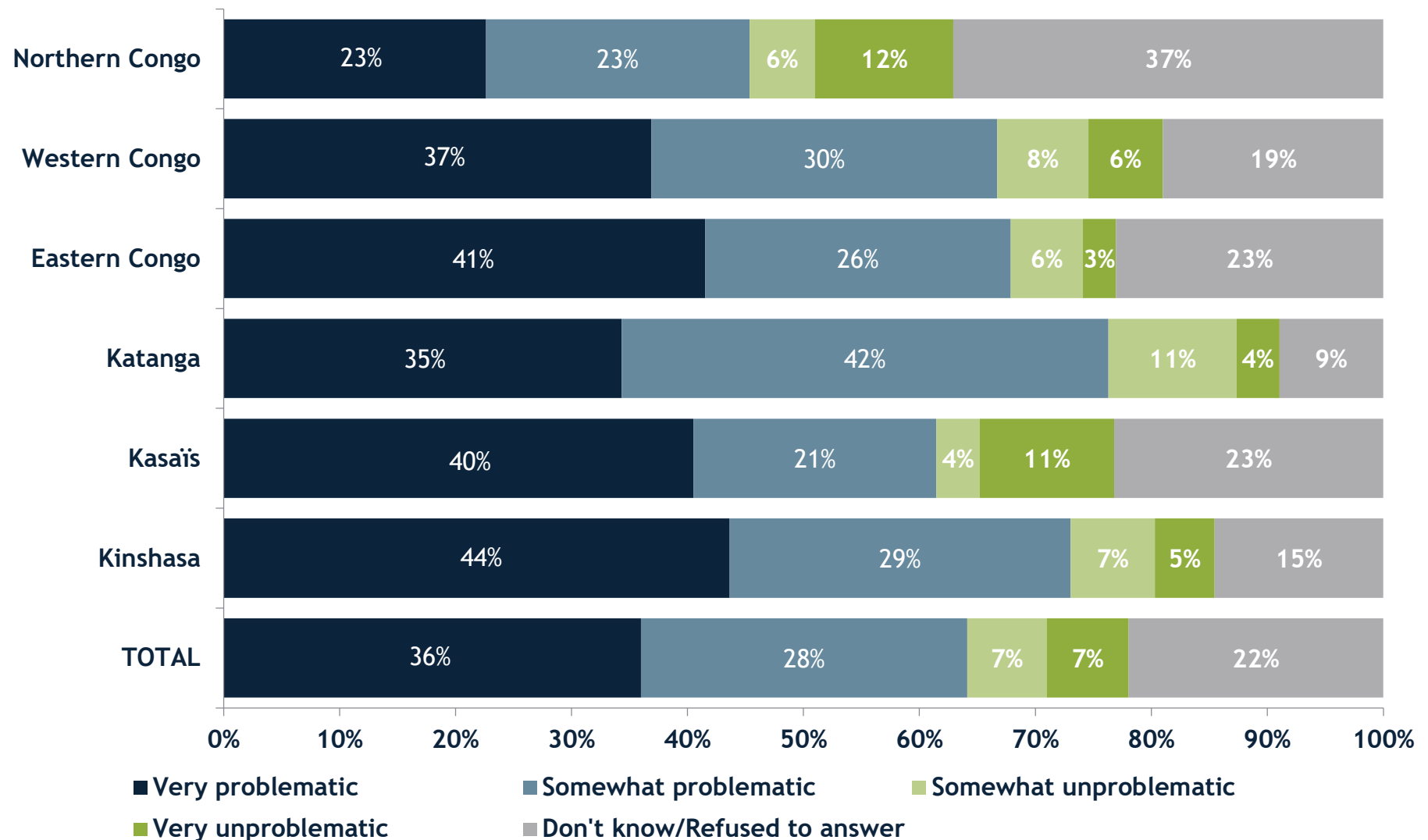

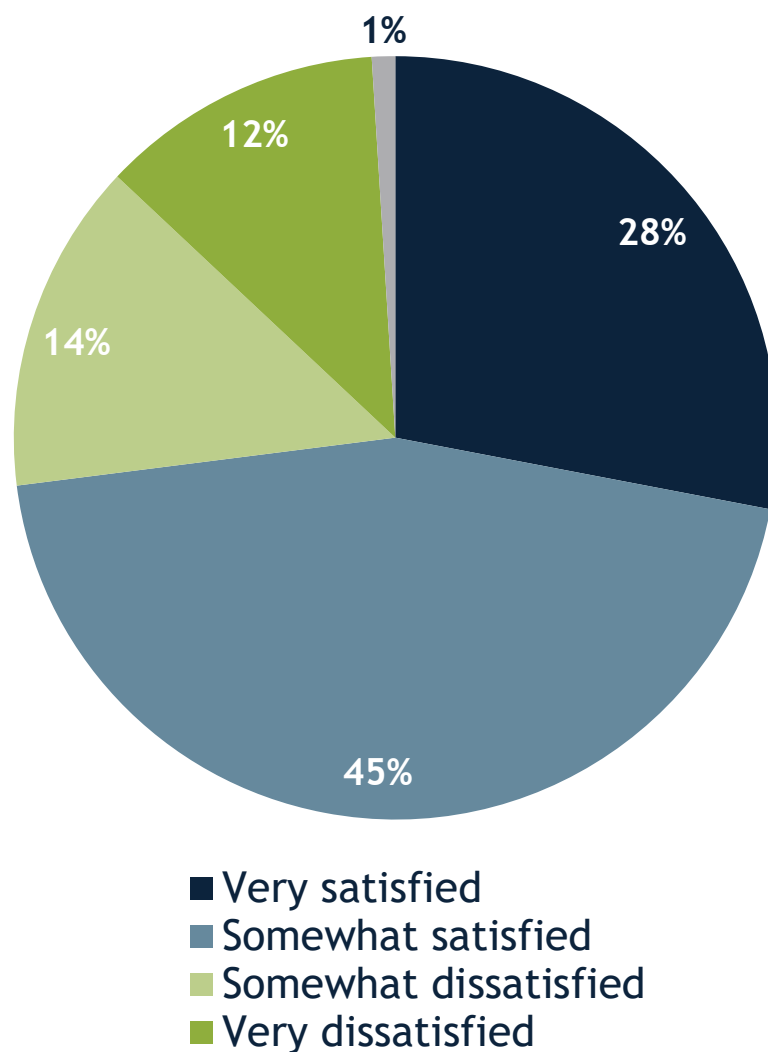
