### Public Opinion Survey: Residents of Sierra Leone

December 16, 2021 - January 16, 2022

### **Detailed Methodology**

- This survey was conducted by <u>Pan African Field Services</u> on behalf of the <u>Center</u> <u>for Insights in Survey Research</u>.
- Data was collected throughout Sierra Leone from December 16, 2021, to January 16, 2022, through CAPI administered face-to-face interviews in respondents' homes.
- The sample consisted of n=1,534 adults in Sierra Leone, aged 18 and older.
- A multi-stage probability sampling method was used. The sample was stratified by region and by urban/rural residency, followed by random selection of primary sampling units (PSUs) within each stratum. Households were selected by random walk in each of the 191 PSUs, and respondents were selected by Kish grid. The sampling frame was based on the 2015 Population and Housing Census of the Statistical Office of Sierra Leone and 2017 Sierra Leone National Electoral Commission Constituency and Delimitation report.
- The achieved sample was weighted for gender, age groups, and formal versus no formal education. The n's cited on the slides are unweighted.
- The response rate was 77 percent.
- The margin of error for the full sample is  $\pm$  2.5 points at 95 percent confidence level.
- Charts and graphs may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding.
- The survey was funded by the <u>United States Agency for International</u> <u>Development</u>.






Generally speaking, would you say that Sierra Leone is heading in the right direction or in the wrong direction?






## Speaking personally, over the past 12 months, how has your overall quality of life changed...?




#### What is the most important problem facing our country today? (Spontaneous response; up to three responses allowed)





### Over the last 12 months, how has the economic situation of your household changed?







### Thinking about our country's current political system, do you believe it is a...?









### Do you agree or disagree that political parties are doing enough to address the needs of voters like you?


















# Would you say the measures taken by the government between 2020-2021 to curb the spread of Covid-19 were too much, just right, or too little?






























# How frequently do you encounter information in social media, for example WhatsApp or Facebook, that you believe is misleading or false?




How often do you see or hear information on TV, the radio, or in newspapers, that you believe is misleading or false?





## How important or unimportant is it for elected officials and candidates to participate in public debates?







