Detailed Methodology

- The survey was conducted on behalf of the International Republican Institute's <u>Center for</u> <u>Insights in Survey Research (CISR)</u> by <u>SIAR Research and Consulting</u>.
- Data was collected between August 10, 2022 and September 5, 2022 through face-to-face computer-assisted personal interviewing (CAPI) at respondents' homes.
- The sample consists of n=1,500 residents of Kyrgyzstan, aged 18 and older.
- A multi-stage stratified cluster sample design was used to draw a nationally-representative sample according to the National Statistical Committee of the Kyrgyz Republic Demographic Yearbook available at the beginning of 2020. The sample was stratified by oblast/city and urbanicity, and urban and rural segments were selected within each stratum.
 - Households were selected using the random-walk method. Respondents were randomly selected from among all eligible household members via the CAPI interviewing system.
- The sample has been weighted according to age group and gender using the National Statistical Committee of the Kyrgyz Republic Demographic Yearbook available at the beginning of 2021.
- The response rate for the survey was 64%.
- The margin of error at the mid-range of the full sample does not exceed ±2.5 points at the 95% confidence level.
- Interviews were conducted in Kyrgyz (78%), Russian (21%), and Uzbek (1%)
- Cited bases are weighted. Charts and graphs may not add up to 100% due to rounding.
- The survey was funded by the U.S. Agency for International Development.

*Household Financial Status brackets are generated from the question "How would you assess the financial position of your family?"

- **Barely subsistence** = "Money does not suffice even for food stuffs" and "Money suffices only for food, but nothing else, it does not suffice to pay the utilities bills"
- Subsistence = "Money suffices for food, but purchase of clothes causes difficulties"
- *Adequate* = "Income suffices for food and clothes, but purchase of expensive durable things, such as TV set, refrigerator is a problem"
- *More than adequate* = "We can easily get durable things, but purchase of really expensive things, such as car, is a big problem for us" and "At the present time we can afford much a car, a summer residence, travel abroad"
