#### **Detailed Methodology**

- The fieldwork was carried out by the <u>Institute of Polling & Marketing</u>. The survey was coordinated by Dr. Rasa Alisauskiene of the public and market research company <u>Baltic Surveys/The Gallup Organization</u> on behalf of the <u>Center for Insights in Survey Research</u>.
- Data was collected throughout Georgia between September 13 and October 2, 2022, through face-to-face computer-assisted personal interviewing (CAPI) in respondents' homes.
- The sample consisted of 1,500 permanent residents of Georgia aged 18 and older and eligible to vote. It is representative of the general population by age, gender, region and settlement size.
- A multistage probability sampling method was used with a "random route" protocol to select households and the "last birthday" method to select respondents
  - Stage one: All districts of Georgia are grouped into 10 regions. All regions of Georgia were surveyed (Tbilisi city as a separate region) except for Abkhazeti and Samachablo (South Ossetia), which were excluded due to the political situation.
  - Stage two: selection of the settlements cities and villages.
    - Settlements were selected at random. The number of selected settlements in each region was proportional to the share of population living in a particular type of settlement in each region.
  - Stage three: primary sampling were randomly drawn within each stratum.
- Data were weighted by gender, age, size of the settlement and region. National Statistics Office of Georgia data "Demographic Situation in Georgia, 2019" was used as a source.
- The margin of error does not exceed plus or minus 2.5 percentage points.
- The response rate was 74 percent.
- Charts and graphs may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding.
- The survey was funded by the <u>U.S. Agency for International Development</u>.





## In general, would you say that our country is heading in the right direction or in the wrong direction?




## How would you evaluate the prevailing mood of the Georgian population?\*








## Over the last 12 months, how has the economic situation in Georgia changed?




#### What is the most important problem facing our country today?


#### What is the most important problem facing your town/village today?

(Respondents permitted to provide two spontaneous answers)




#### What is the most important problem facing your household today?

(Respondents permitted to provide two spontaneous answers)




# What do you think are the three biggest challenges for Georgia's democratic development and future?



# How do you feel about the direction of each of the following issues? Have they progressed or regressed over the past year?









## Do you support or oppose the opposition demand for snap parliamentary elections in Georgia?













# Do you agree or disagree with the following statement: "It is healthy for Georgia's democracy to have multiple parties in power"?










#### When you think about Georgian values, which value comes to your mind first?


#### When you think about Georgian values, which value comes to your mind first?

(Respondents permitted to provide one spontaneous response, 5 most often mentioned, disaggregated by party preference)




#### When you think about European values, which value comes to your mind first?


#### When you think about European values, which value comes to your mind first?






# Would you say that our country's politics are moving toward consensus or more polarization?





# How likely is lasting reconciliation - where the ruling party and opposition parties find mutual ground for continuing to govern - to occur in Georgia?








How important or unimportant is it that all members of our country's adult population, including women, young adults, minorities, people with disabilities and etc. are included in political decision making?




# How important or unimportant is it that women are included in political decision making?




# How important or unimportant is it that young adults are included in political decision making?



## How important or unimportant is it that people with disabilities are included in political decision making?




## How important or unimportant is it that ethnic minorities are included in political decision making?






If there are two candidates running for office and they have the same qualifications aside from the fact that one is a man and one is a woman, which candidate are you more likely to support?






# Which of these countries do you consider the most important political partners for Georgia?




# Which of these countries poses the greatest political threat of Georgia?




## Which of these countries do you consider the most important economic partners for Georgia?



# Which of these countries poses the greatest economic threat of Georgia?






### How do you rate the current government's handling of Georgia's relationship with Russia?




### Given the current state of Georgia's relationship with Russia, how secure do you feel living in Georgia?



## Do you think that Russian aggression towards Georgia is over or is it still going on?






#### Which statement, if any, best characterizes your opinion on Russian tourists?




#### Which statement, if any, best characterizes your opinion on Russian tourists?




#### Which sources do you use for information about the current international situation?




#### Which sources do you use for information about the current international situation?

(Users of social media, n=620, respondents permitted to provide multiple responses)




# Which of these information channels do you trust most for information about the current international situation? (Users of media, n=1,380)




#### Which of these information channels do you trust most for information about the current international situation?

(Most trusted social media channels specified by respondents who trust social media as an information channel for international news, n=228)





#### Do you support or oppose Georgia joining the EU?




## If you support joining the EU, would you still support this if it meant cutting trade relations with Russia?

### If you support joining the EU, what is the main benefit of joining the EU?





#### What is biggest obstacle in the way of Georgia joining the EU?






# Have you heard about the EU's 12 recommendations to Georgia, including preconditions for becoming a candidate for EU membership?




### If yes, how likely or unlikely is it that Georgia will fulfill the 12 recommendations given by the EU?




### If Georgia is successful in achieving EU candidate status, who will be responsible for the outcome?



### If Georgia is unsuccessful in achieving EU candidate status, who will be responsible for the outcome?






#### If you support joining NATO, what is the main benefit?






### Which Georgian TV station's news and political information do you trust the most?




#### How often, if ever, do you use the internet or social media?



#### Which social media sites do you use most often?




