NATIONAL SURVEY OF NORTH MACEDONIA

Detailed Methodology

- The survey was conducted on behalf of the <u>Center for Insights in Survey Research</u> by <u>Brima</u> market research firm (member of Taylor Nelson Sofres and Gallup International).
- Data was collected between April 8 and May 4, 2023, through CAPI-administered face-to-face interviews at respondents' homes.
- The sample consisted of n=1,204 respondents and is representative of the population of North Macedonia, aged 18 and older. The sample was designed according to data from the 2021 Census from the State Institute of Statistics.
- A multi-stage probability sampling method was used to design a nationally representative sample of North Macedonia. The sample was stratified by regions and urbanicity. Municipalities are primary sampling units and were selected via probability proportionate to size (PPS).
- Households were selected through a random route method that varied depending on the urbanicity of the stratum. Respondents were selected under a nationality quota and by using the 'next birthday' method to select respondents within households.
- The achieved sample was weighted by age, gender, nationality, region, urbanicity, and educational attainment according to data from the 2021 Census.
- The response rate is 74%.
- The margin of error for the midrange of the full sample does not exceed ±2.8 points at the 95% confidence level.
- Figures in charts and tables may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding. Cited bases are weighted.
- Previous surveys cited in this report were conducted using a comparable methodology.
- This poll was conducted with support from the National Endowment for Democracy.

Political Context Timeline


- October 2022 March 2023: A series of fake bomb threats had been sent to schools, state institutions and commercial sites across the country causing temporary closures of these sites by the police to check the validity of the threats.
- November 2022: North Macedonia and the European Commission started the meetings for bilateral negotiations screening on the level of compliance and of harmonization of the Macedonian with the EU legislation. This process is expected to be completed in November 2023.
- **February 2023:** To increase the parliamentary majority Prime Minister Kovachevski welcomed the second largest ethnic Albanian party Alliance for Albanians (AfA) to join the government coalition, which was given three ministerial mandates. This change in the balance of power caused the smaller ethnic Albanian party Alternativa to leave the government coalition.
- April 2023: The Government formed a working group tasked to draft the government's initiative for constitutional amendments that will include the Bulgarian minority in the Constitution. The largest opposition party VMRO-DPMNE has stated that it will not support constitutional changes and will not participate in the working group assessing the process as illegitimate, dictated by Bulgaria and without guarantees for the Macedonian language and identity.
- 2022-2023: European Union and EU Member States officials have issued numerous statements confirming that North Macedonia will not be admitted to the European Union unless constitutional changes to include the Bulgarian minority in its constitution are adopted.
- 2022-2023: The relations between North Macedonia and Bulgaria have become more tense as Bulgaria's Vice-President and Prime Minister started visiting Bulgarian non-governmental organizations in North Macedonia which carry names of historical figures who have affiliation with the World War II Bulgarian government and are negatively perceived in North Macedonia.


In general, would you say that North Macedonia is heading in the right direction or in the wrong direction?






What is the most important problem facing North Macedonia today? And what is the second most important problem?




In your opinion, did Kovacevski's Government dedicate itself to solving the first most important problem facing North Macedonia as you mentioned previously?




How would you describe the current economic situation of your household?






How is your family's economic situation compared to one year ago?




Is your household monthly income sufficient to satisfy monthly needs?



Speaking personally, is your overall quality of life...?






In the next two years, will the economy in North Macedonia get better, get worse, or stay the same?






Is North Macedonia more or less stable today than it was one year ago?




What language(s) do you speak at a level to be able to study and work in that language?




Should all citizens, regardless of ethnic background, be proficient in Macedonian as the official state language?








To what extent do you trust or distrust each of the following?






According to you, to what extent [...]








Which three ministers in the Government are doing the best job?








When you think about people in political life, who is the one person in North Macedonia whom you view most favorably?*



To which, if any, political party do you belong?*




How likely or unlikely are you to vote in the parliamentary elections if they are held this Sunday?












What are the two most serious problems facing Skopje today?

(Respondents from Skopje: n=389; margin of error ±4.97 points)






If you reach out to your municipality to inform it about a local problem in your neighborhood, how likely or unlikely do you think is that the municipality will respond to you?




If your municipality is about to make a decision affecting your neighborhood, how likely or unlikely is it that the opinions of local residents will be considered?




If a municipal service in your municipality is functioning poorly and the municipality is aware of that, how likely or unlikely do you think is that the municipality will improve that service?










How strongly do you agree or disagree with the following statements:

"North Macedonia's interests are best served by maintaining strong relations with...?"






Which one of these countries (including the EU) helps North Macedonia's national interests the most?



Do you support North Macedonia becoming a member of the European Union (EU)?




In how many years do you think North Macedonia will become a member of the EU?













In your opinion, is the Macedonian language protected or jeopardized in North Macedonia's accession negotiations with the EU?



Which EU countries are the biggest supporters of North Macedonia's accession in the EU?




Which EU countries are the biggest opponents of North Macedonia's accession in the EU?




Do you support North Macedonia's membership in NATO? (Before March 2021, the question was "...becoming a member of NATO"?)






How much did you follow political news yesterday?





How much did you follow political news yesterday?




What are your most used sources of political news?






Which television station do you watch most often for political news?

(Spontaneous response; up to three responses accepted)




