


Methodology

- The survey was conducted on behalf of the International Republican Institute's <u>Center for Insights in Survey</u> <u>Research</u> by <u>ESTAT</u>.
- Data was collected between September 21 and October 9, 2023, through CAPI administered face-to-face interviews in respondents' homes.
- The sample consisted of n=300 adults, who are 18 years or older, residents of the municipality of Dobrich-City, Bulgaria, and have voting rights. The sample excluded residents detained in custody or currently in prison.
- A multi-stage probability sampling method was used to design a municipally representative sample. The sample was stratified by urban/rural residency, followed by random selection of primary sampling units (PSUs) within each stratum. Households were selected by random walk in each of the 30 PSUs, and respondents were selected by the last birthday method. The sampling frame was based on the 2021 Population and Housing Census.
- The achieved sample was weighted for gender, age group, and type of settlement.
- The response rate was 43 percent.
- The margin of error for the mid-range of the full sample does not exceed ±5.7 points.
- Charts and graphs may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding. Cited bases are weighted.




In general, would you say that Dobrich municipality is heading in the right direction or in the wrong direction?



















How likely or unlikely are ordinary people able to influence decisions made by your municipal council?





To what extent do CSOs impact municipal council policy in Dobrich municipality?




For the following issues, is the municipal government doing a very good, somewhat good, somewhat bad or very bad job?






How would you rate the performance of the municipal administration in communicating with the public about the decisions they take?











On which source do you base your assessment of the level of corruption in Dobrich municipality?






In your experience, what type of corruption is most common in Dobrich municipality?






















Who among municipal authorities is most corrupt, if any?









To what extent, if any, has corruption had a negative impact on you?













In which context did you witness or experience corruption. Did you experience or witness corruption...?







In your dealings with the municipal government, how important are personal contacts and relationships to get things done?








How effective or ineffective is each of the following levels of government in addressing corruption?








Which among the following groups is the most important and the second most important to effectively address corruption in Dobrich municipality?










What channels would you contact to report a corrupt act?




During the past 12 months, have you or anyone in your household reported a corrupt act by a municipal official?









































What are the primary sources you use to learn about the decisions and actions taken by the municipal administration and the council?


Which of the following is your preferred channel of communication with the municipal administration and the council?




Are you aware of any local CSOs, which means a local group that forms around a common goal and is not associated with the government, that work for more transparency in the municipal administration and the council?






Do you think that the transparency of the municipal administration has improved or worsened, or stayed the same over the last 10 years?







Do you think that the transparency of the municipal council has improved or worsened, or stayed the same over the last 10 years?



Do you see political will for improvement of transparency in the municipal administration?








Which of the following do you think is the most important factor for getting a job in the municipal administration?





















Which media platform do you use most frequently and second most frequently to gain political news and information about Dobrich municipality?


