
Detailed Methodology

- The survey was conducted on behalf of the International Republican Institute's <u>Center for Insights in Survey Research (CISR)</u> by <u>SIAR Research and Consulting</u>.
- Data was collected between December 21, 2023 January 19, 2024, through face-to-face computer-assisted personal interviewing (CAPI) at respondents' homes.
- The sample consists of n=1,500 residents of Kyrgyzstan, aged 18 and older.
- A multi-stage stratified cluster sample design was used to draw a nationally representative sample
 according to the 2023 Kyrgyz Republic Demographic Yearbook published by the National Statistical
 Committee of Kyrgyzstan. The sample was stratified by oblast/city and urbanicity, and urban and
 rural segments were selected within each stratum.
 - Households were selected using the random-walk method. Respondents were selected using the Kish grid method.
- The sample has been weighted according to age group and gender using the 2023 Demographic Yearbook of Kyrgyzstan.
- The response rate for the survey was 66%.
- The margin of error at the mid-range of the full sample does not exceed ±2.5 points at the 95% confidence level.
- Interviews were conducted in Kyrgyz (79%), Russian (21%), and Uzbek (1%).
- Cited bases are weighted. Charts and graphs may not add up to 100% due to rounding.
- The survey was funded by the <u>U.S. Agency for International Development</u>.




How would you describe the current economic situation of your household?






Over the last 12 months, how has the financial situation of your household changed?






Over the last 12 months, how has the economic situation in Kyrgyzstan changed?
















How satisfied are you with the way democracy is developing in Kyrgyzstan?





How likely or unlikely are ordinary people able to influence decisions made in our country?











What is your opinion of each of the following Kyrgyz and international institutions?









How much do you agree or disagree with the following statement? "I feel the President considers my priorities, interests and aspirations in decision-making."




How much do you agree or disagree with the following statement? "I feel the Parliament considers my priorities, interests and aspirations in decision-making."






Do you think the Kyrgyz government applies enough effort to fight corruption?




Do you think the Kyrgyz government applies enough effort to fight corruption?










Which radio station do you trust most for news and political information?






How often do you use the internet?



Where do you most often access the internet?












How important is it for citizens of Kyrgyzstan to know the Kyrgyz language?













How important or unimportant is it that all members of our country's adult population, including women, young adults, minorities, and people with disabilities, are included in political decision making?




Which sectors of society do you feel are most important for women to play an expanded role?






Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? "Politicians and political parties do not listen to the needs and ideas of women."



How effective, if at all, do you think the gender quota in Parliament and in local councils is in ensuring that women and men are more equally represented?





Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? "Politicians and political parties do not listen to the needs and ideas of young people."







- **Barely subsistence** = "Money does not suffice even for food stuffs" and "Money suffices only for food, but nothing else, it does not suffice to pay the utilities bills"
- Subsistence = "Money suffices for food, but purchase of clothes causes difficulties"
- Adequate = "Income suffices for food and clothes, but purchase of expensive durable things, such as TV set, refrigerator is a problem"
- *More than adequate* = "We can easily get durable things, but purchase of really expensive things, such as car, is a big problem for us" and "At the present time we can afford much a car, a summer residence, travel abroad"
