

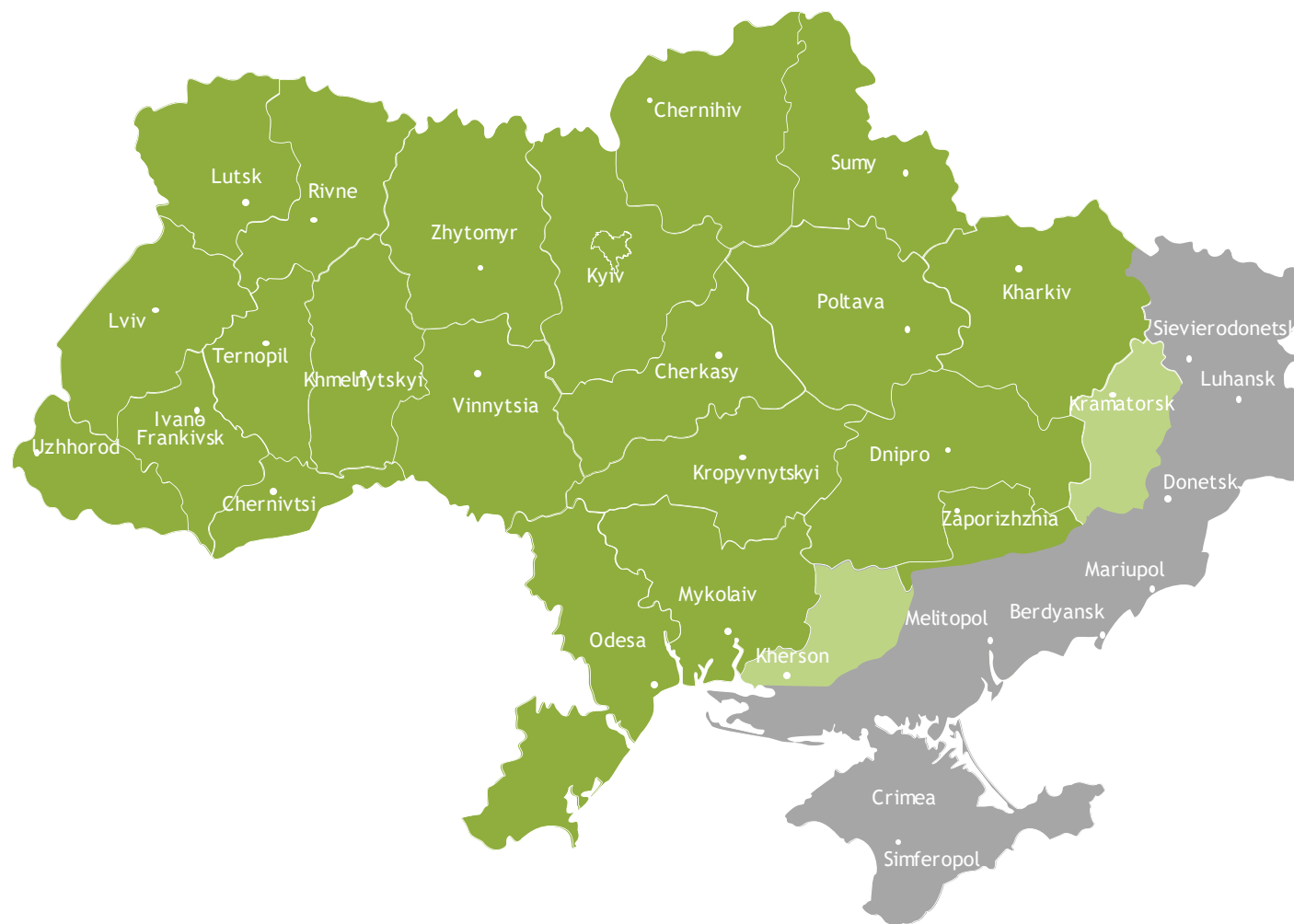
# Ninth Annual Ukrainian Municipal Survey

April - May 2024

## Geographical Key



\*The map represents territories that were under control of the Ukrainian government before February 24, 2022. Due to the Russian occupation of Crimea and ongoing conflict in the East of Ukraine, citizens of Simferopol, Donetsk, and Luhansk did not participate in the survey. This also includes two cities that were covered in previous waves, Mariupol and Sievierodonetsk. These areas are depicted in gray.

\*\*Kherson was excluded from the sample in 2024 due to the security situation that made face to face surveying impossible (light green).

# The Ninth In-Depth Look at Ukrainian Local Governance

- This annual\* survey provides an extensive look at citizen attitudes about local governance and municipal services.
- Polling was conducted in the 21 regional capitals of Ukraine excluding those under the control of Russian or Russian-backed forces. Kherson was excluded due to the security situation that made face to face surveying impossible. The survey is based on a sample size of 16,800 respondents.

\*The survey was not conducted in 2022 due to the war

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- The survey was conducted by Sociological Group “Rating” (Rating Group Ukraine) on behalf of the International Republican Institute’s Center for Insights in Survey Research (CISR).
- The data was collected in 21 cities in Ukraine (Kyiv and oblast centers where the safety situation allowed the survey to be conducted) between April 13 and May 14, 2024 through face-to-face interviews at the respondents’ homes.
- The sample consisted of n=16,800 permanent residents of Ukraine aged 18 and older.
- In order to obtain this representative sample, 800 respondents were interviewed in each city regardless of population size. The geographical coverage of the city area was based on the electoral districts established by the Central Election Commission of Ukraine. Random route and “next birthday” rule were used to select respondents.
- The survey data obtained in each city was weighted by gender and age using national statistical data (as of January 1, 2022), as well as population size of each city for any datapoints presented in aggregate form combining the 21 cities. IRI/ CISR recognizes that the January 1, 2022 weighting parameters are unlikely to precisely reflect the current populations’ demographic make-up in each of the surveyed cities, but opted to maintain this weight to allow better comparison against previous polls.
- The margin of error for each city does not exceed  $\pm 3.5$  points.
- Average response rate is 49%.
- Charts and graphs may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding.
- Due to differences in the number of municipalities interviewed for this year’s survey, as well as shifts in the composition of the Ukrainian population due to the war, trend comparisons should be interpreted with caution.

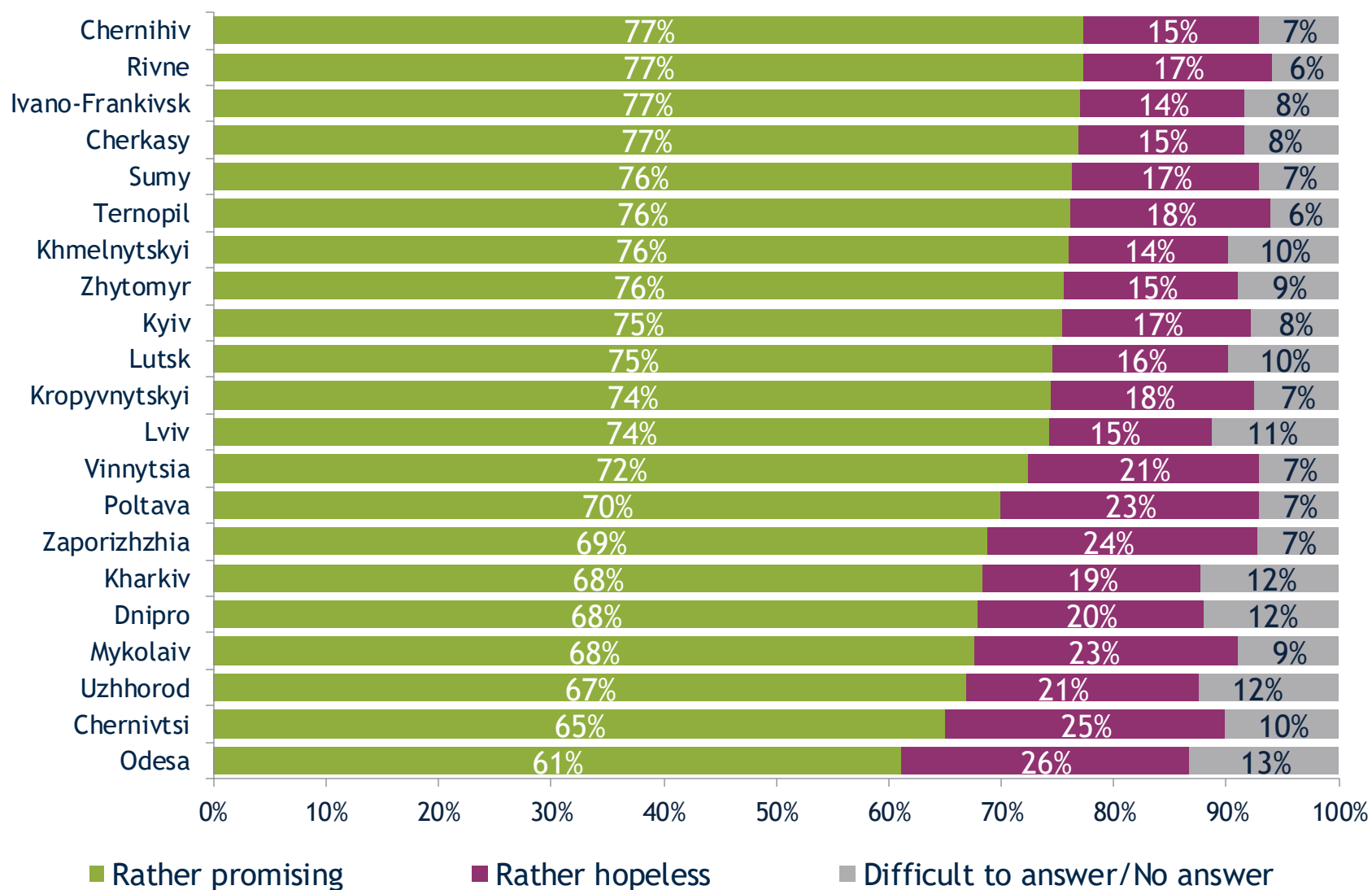

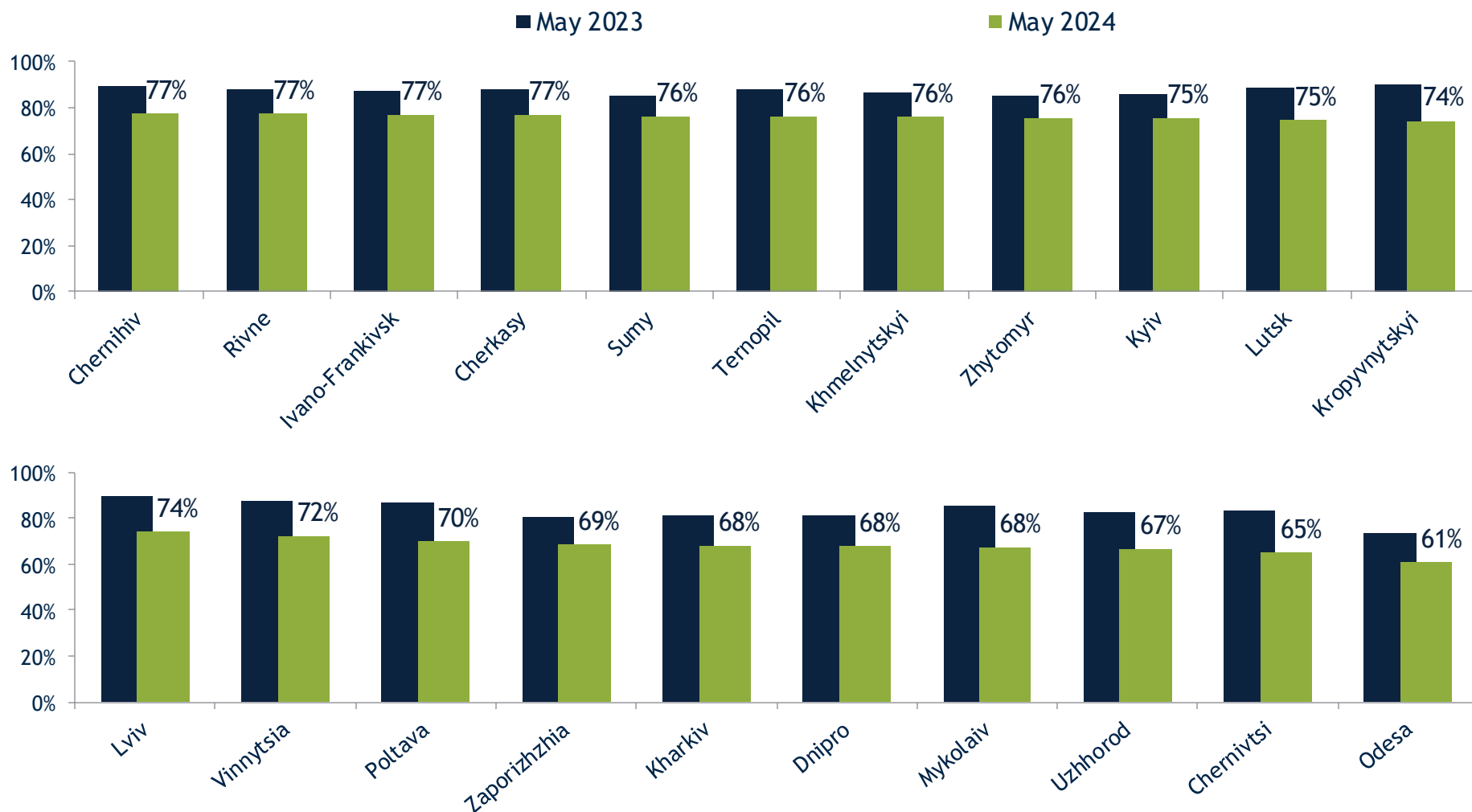






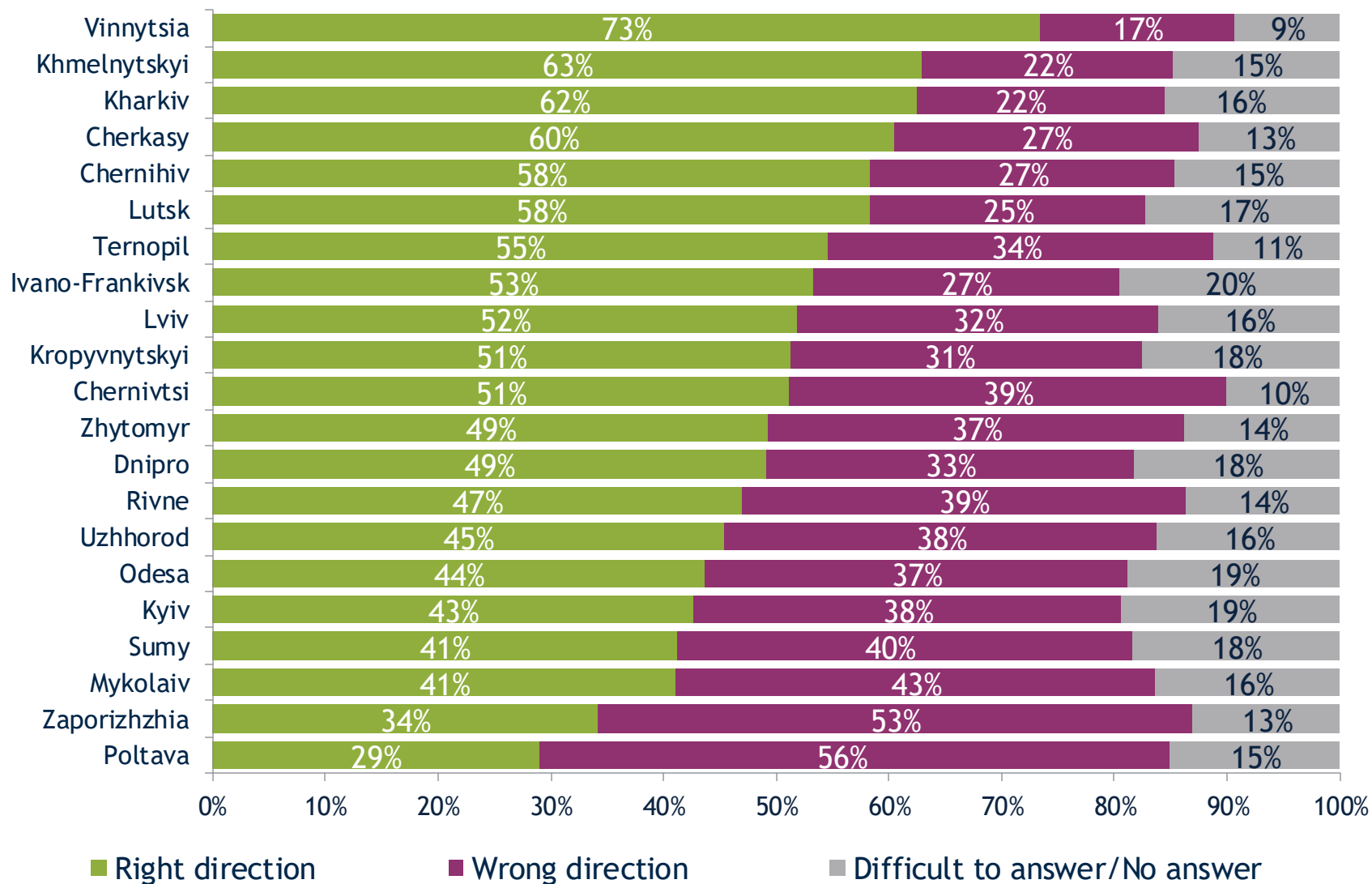
# How do you see the future of Ukraine?

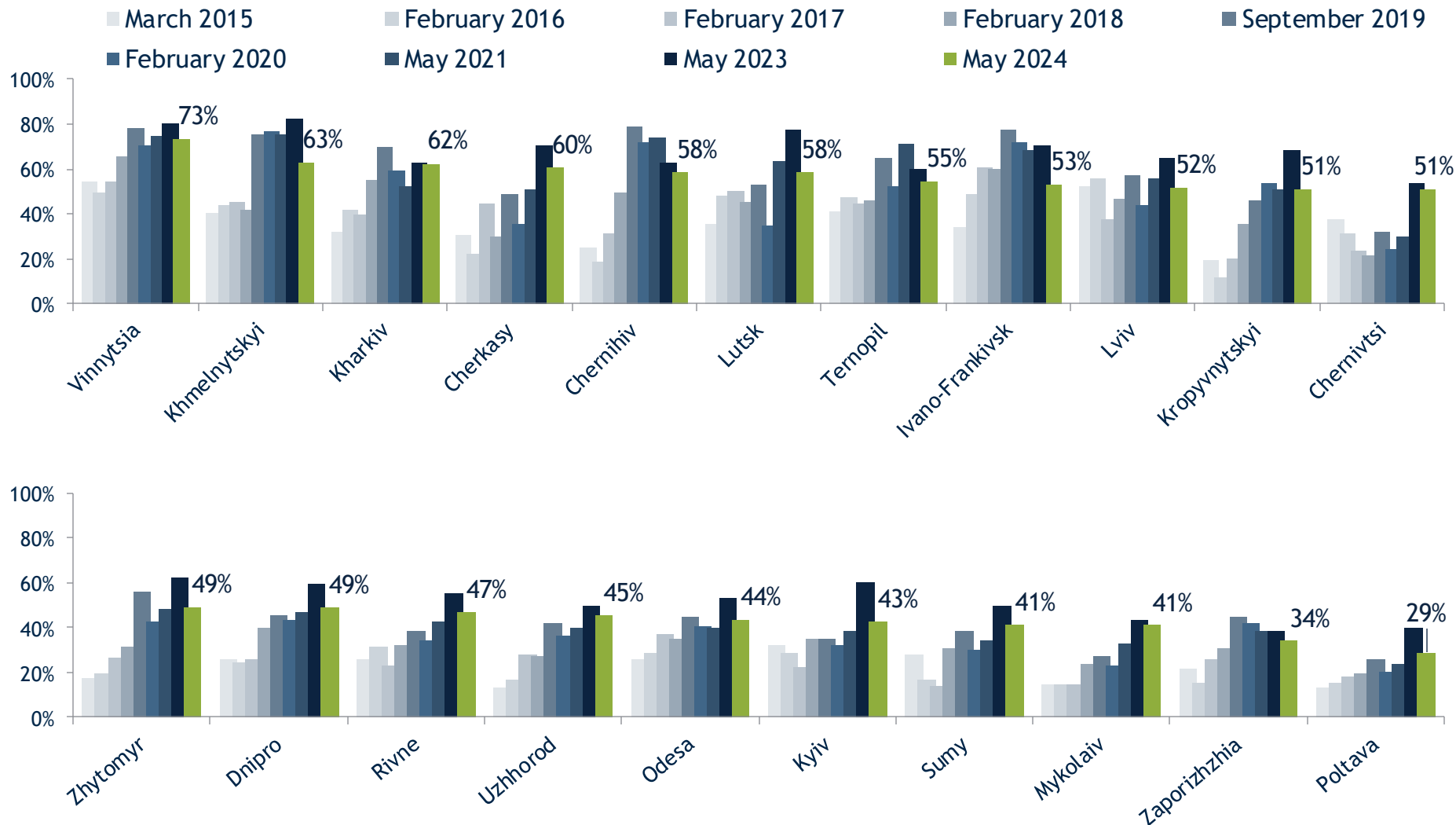
# Generally speaking, do you think that things in your city are going in the right direction or the wrong direction?





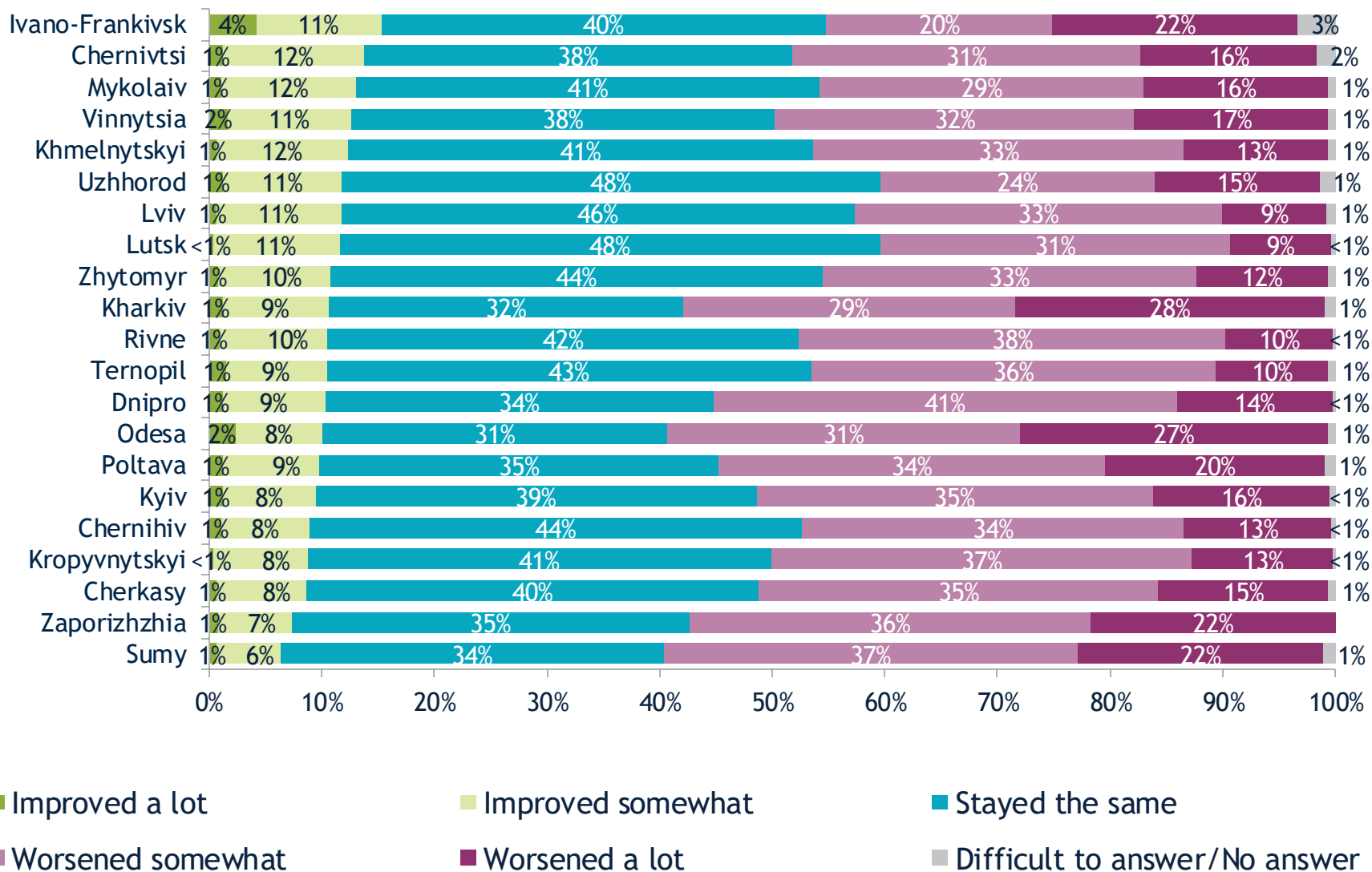
# Generally speaking, do you think that things in your city are going in the right direction or the wrong direction?

# Over the last 12 months, how has the economic situation of your household changed?

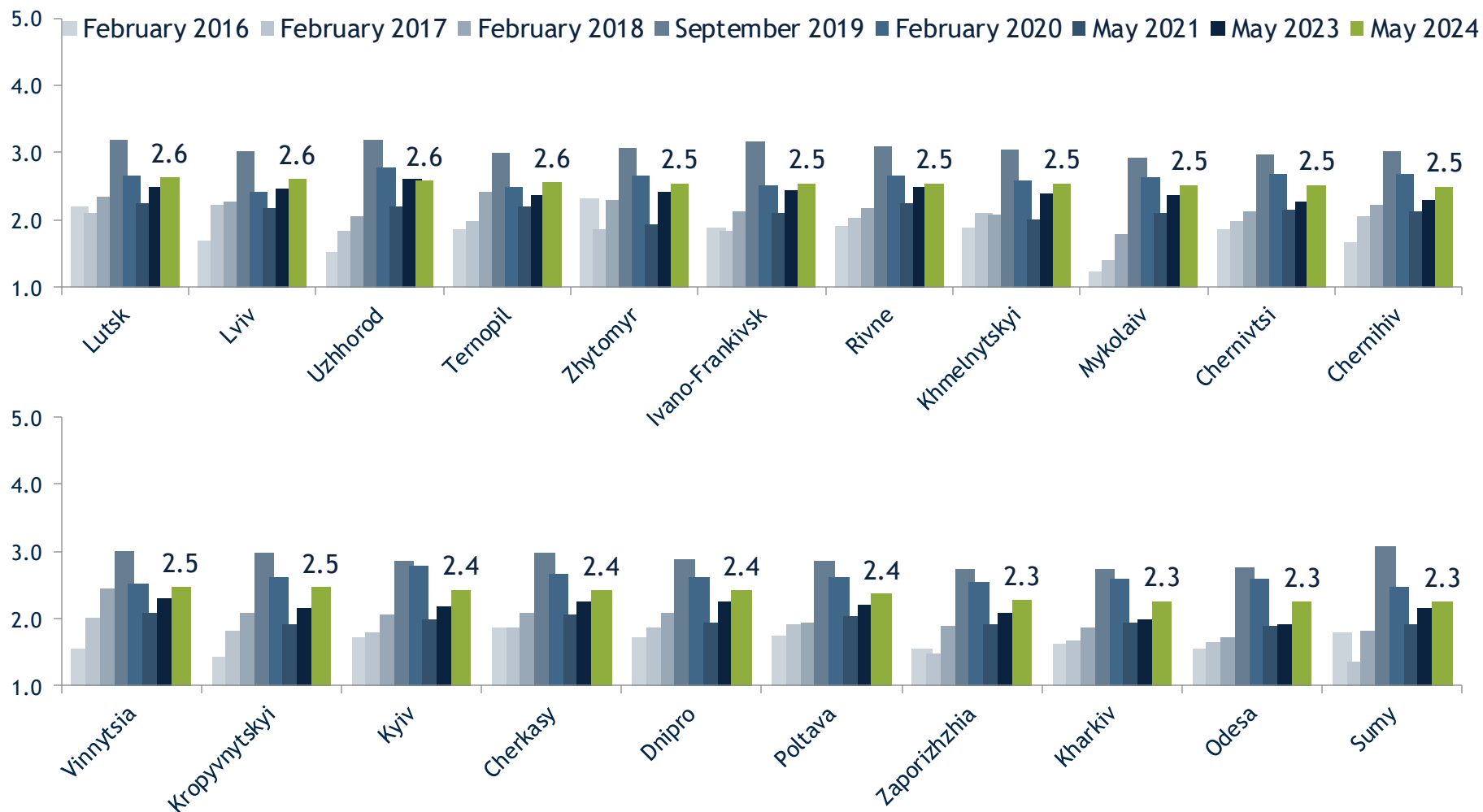

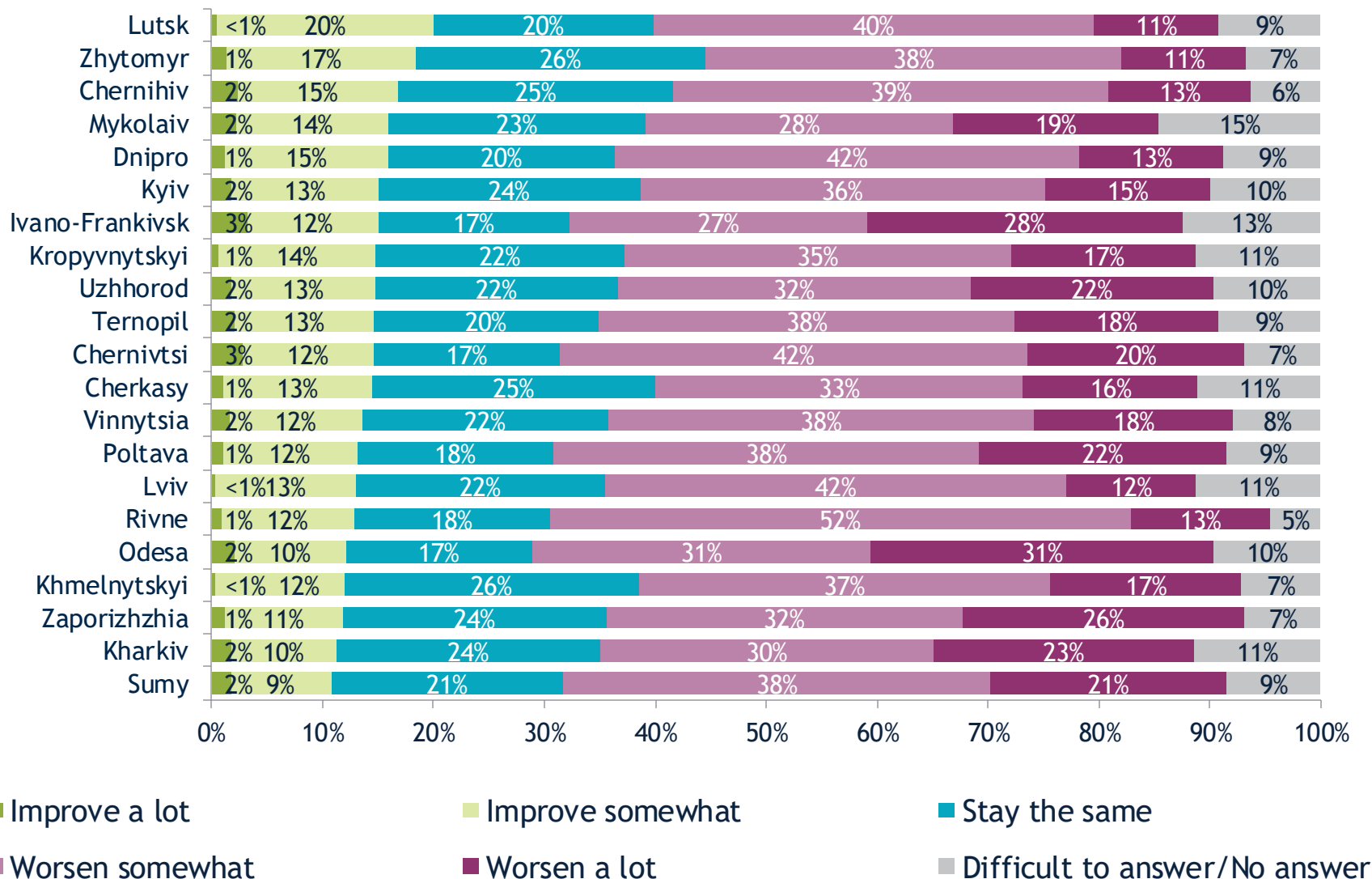

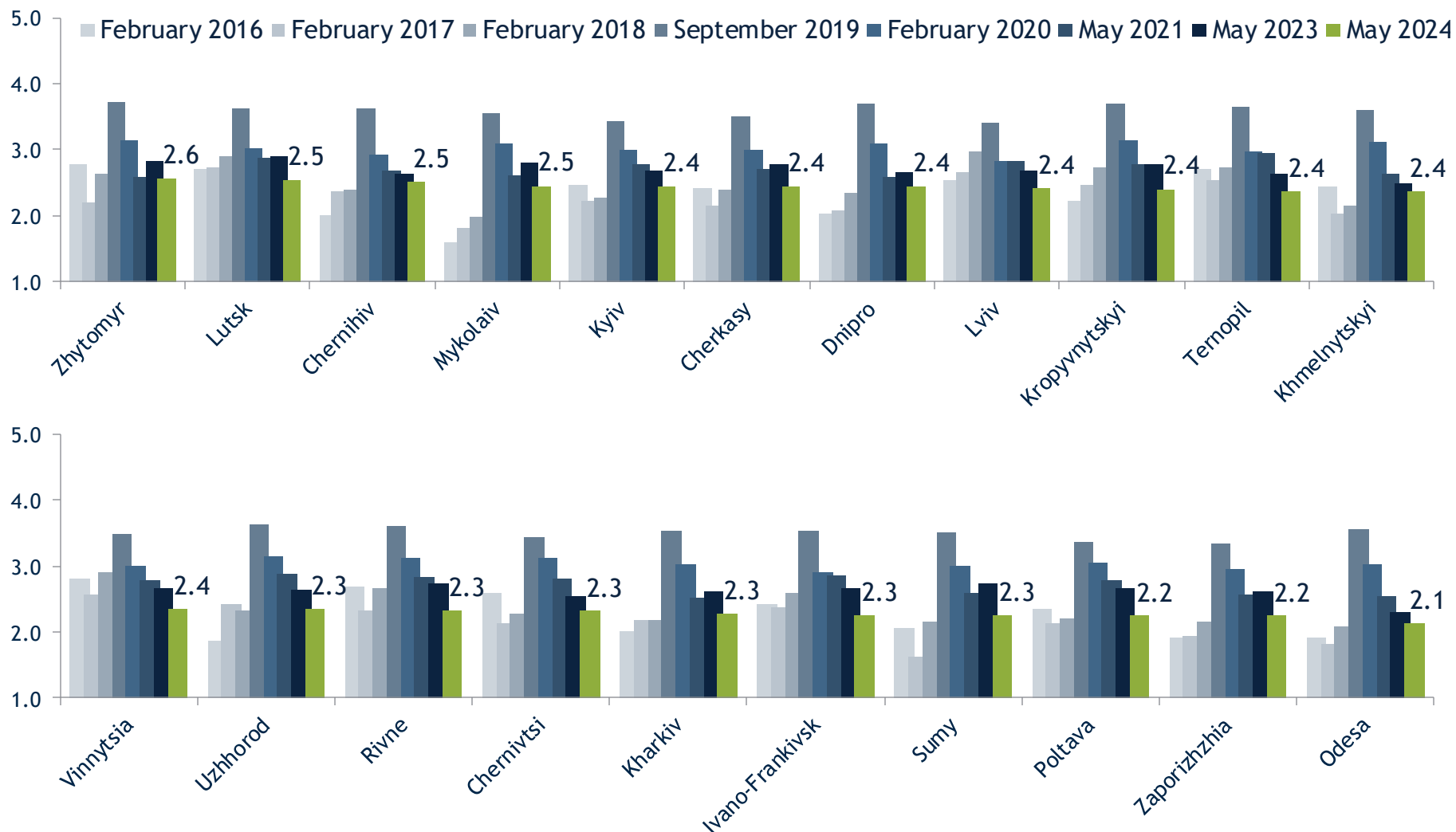

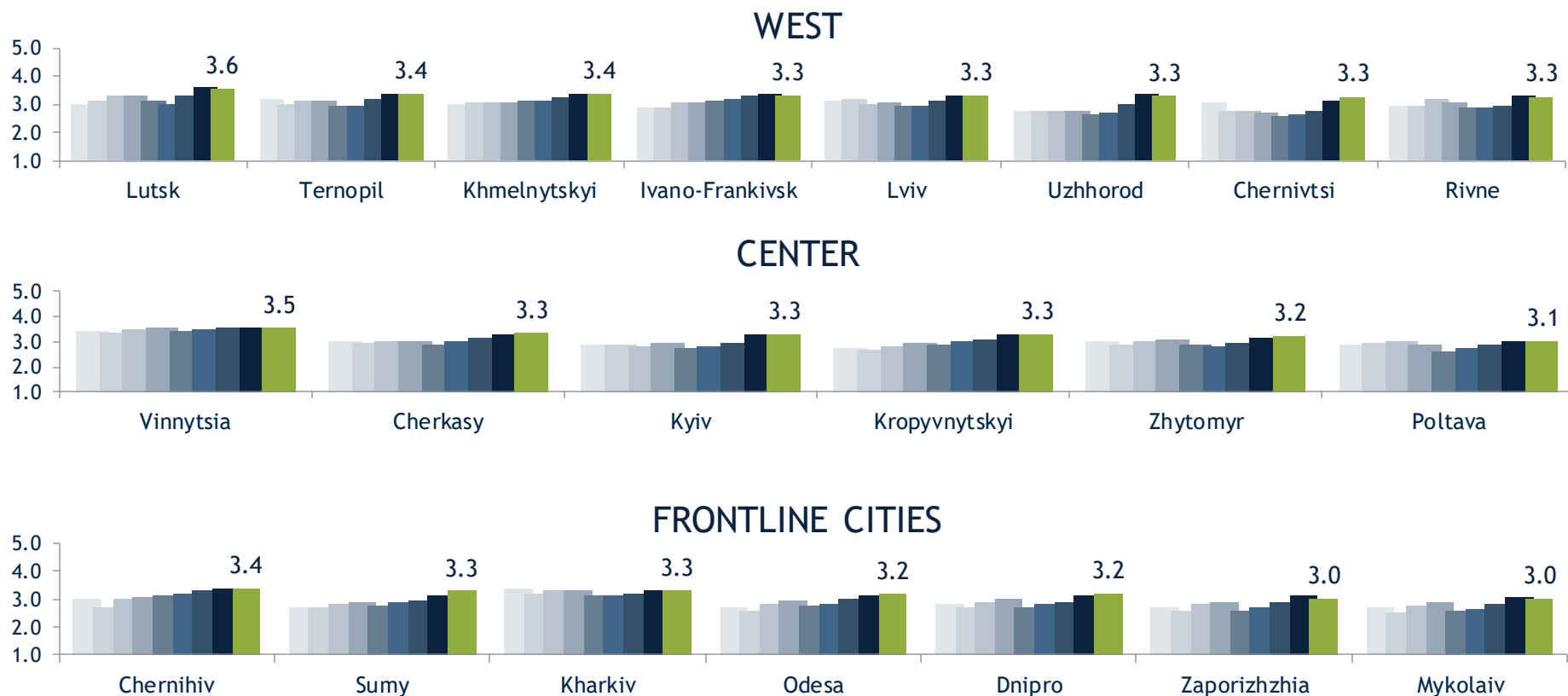




# Quality of Public Goods & Services Index\*

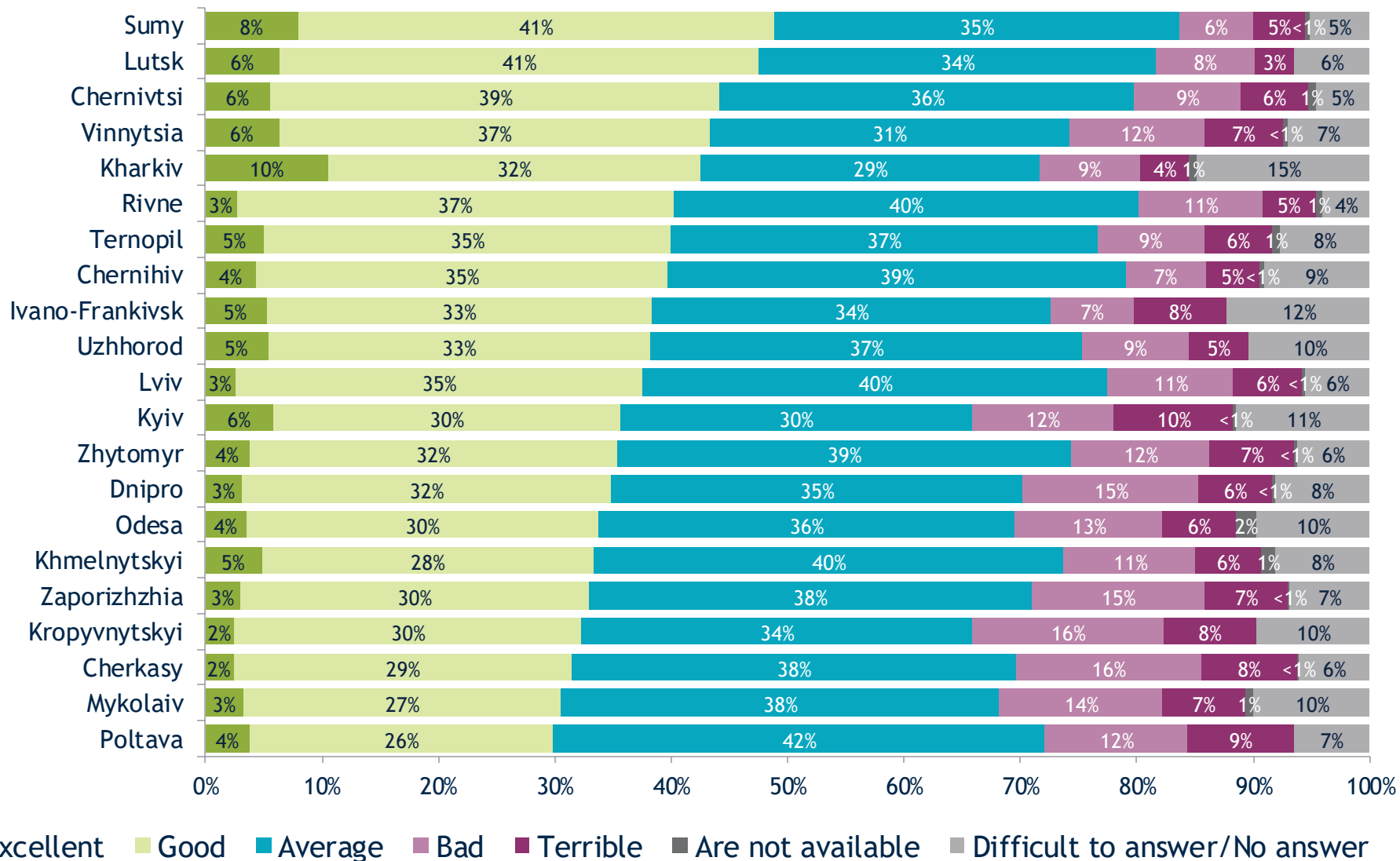

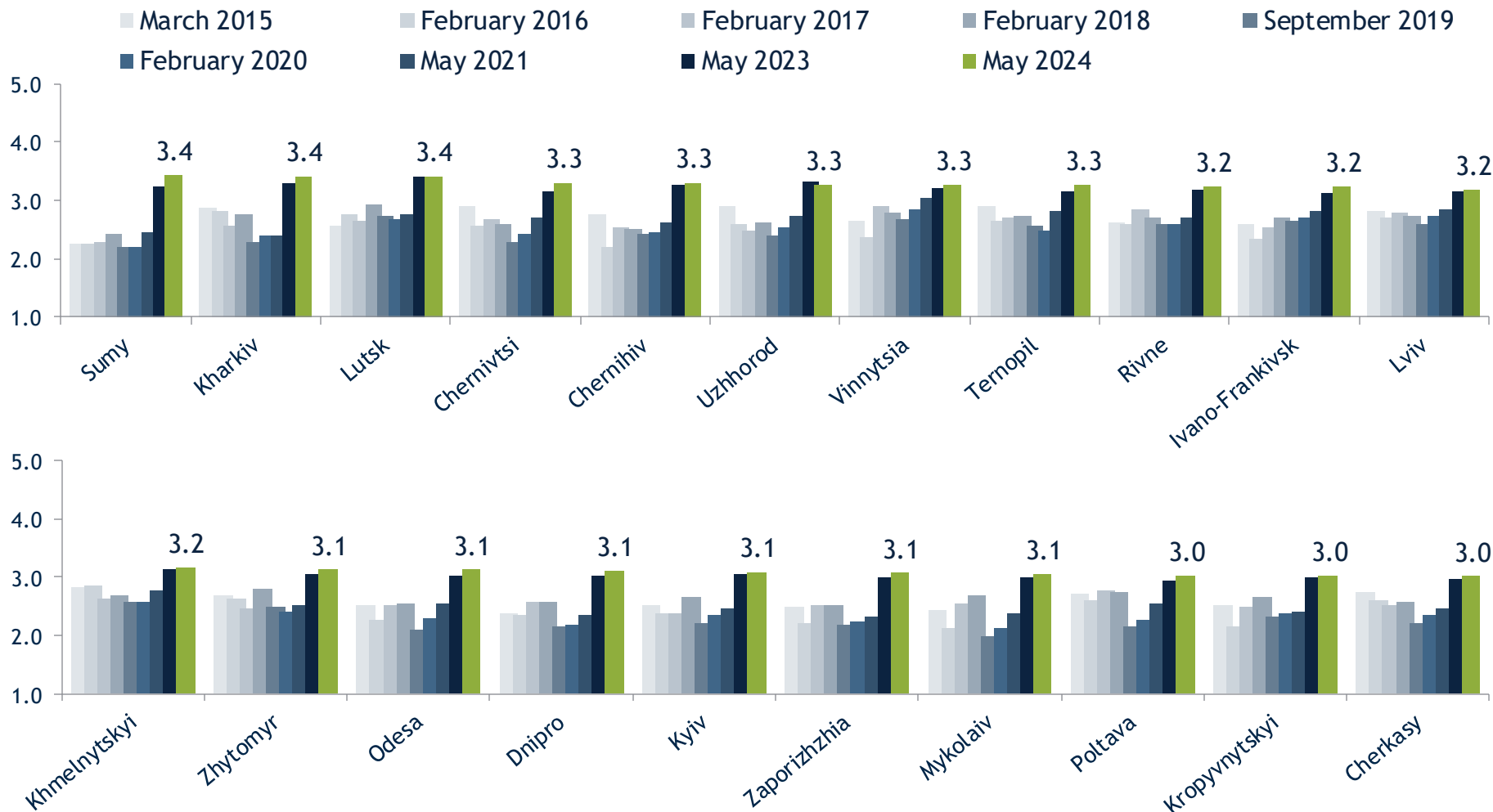

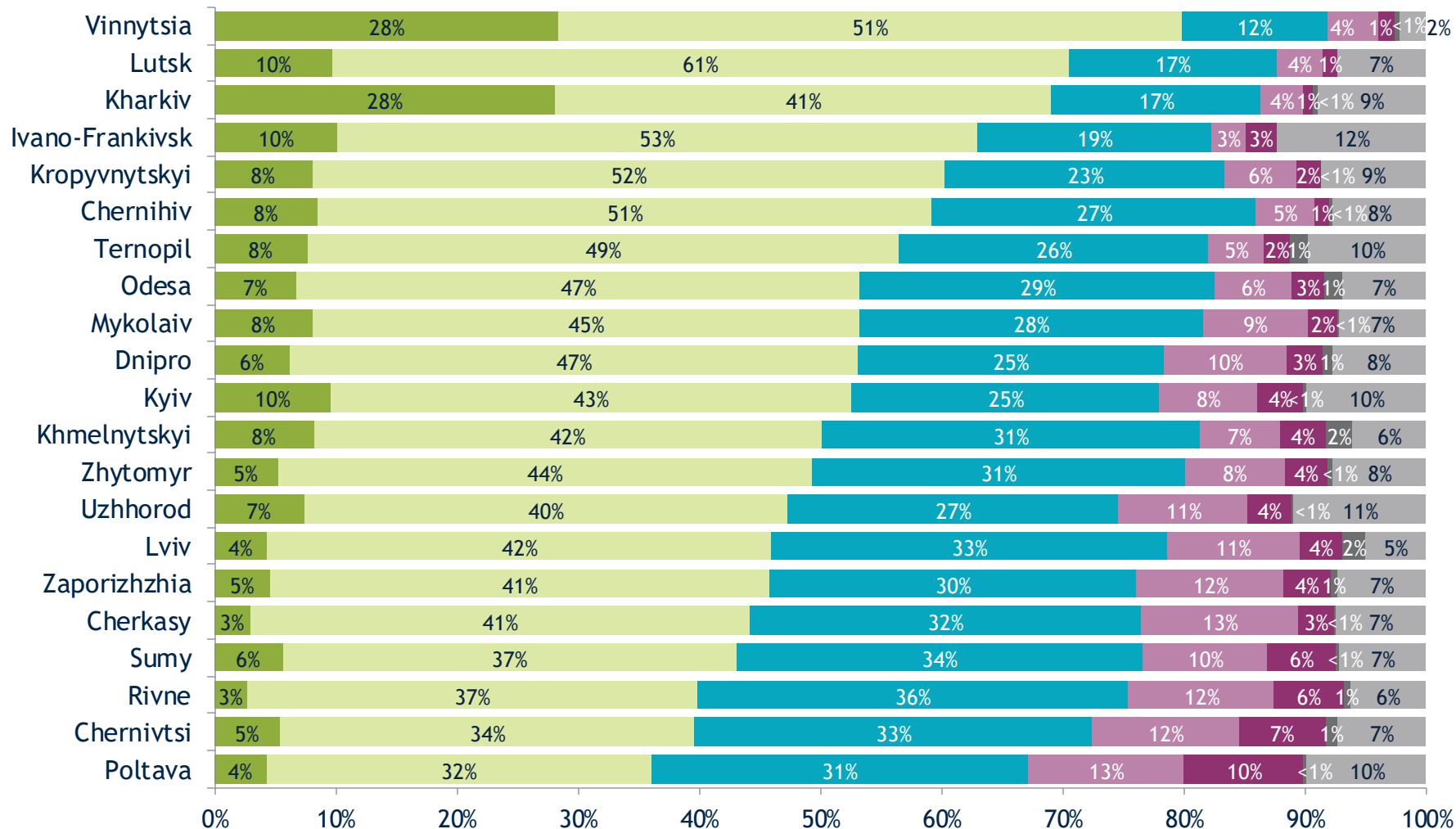

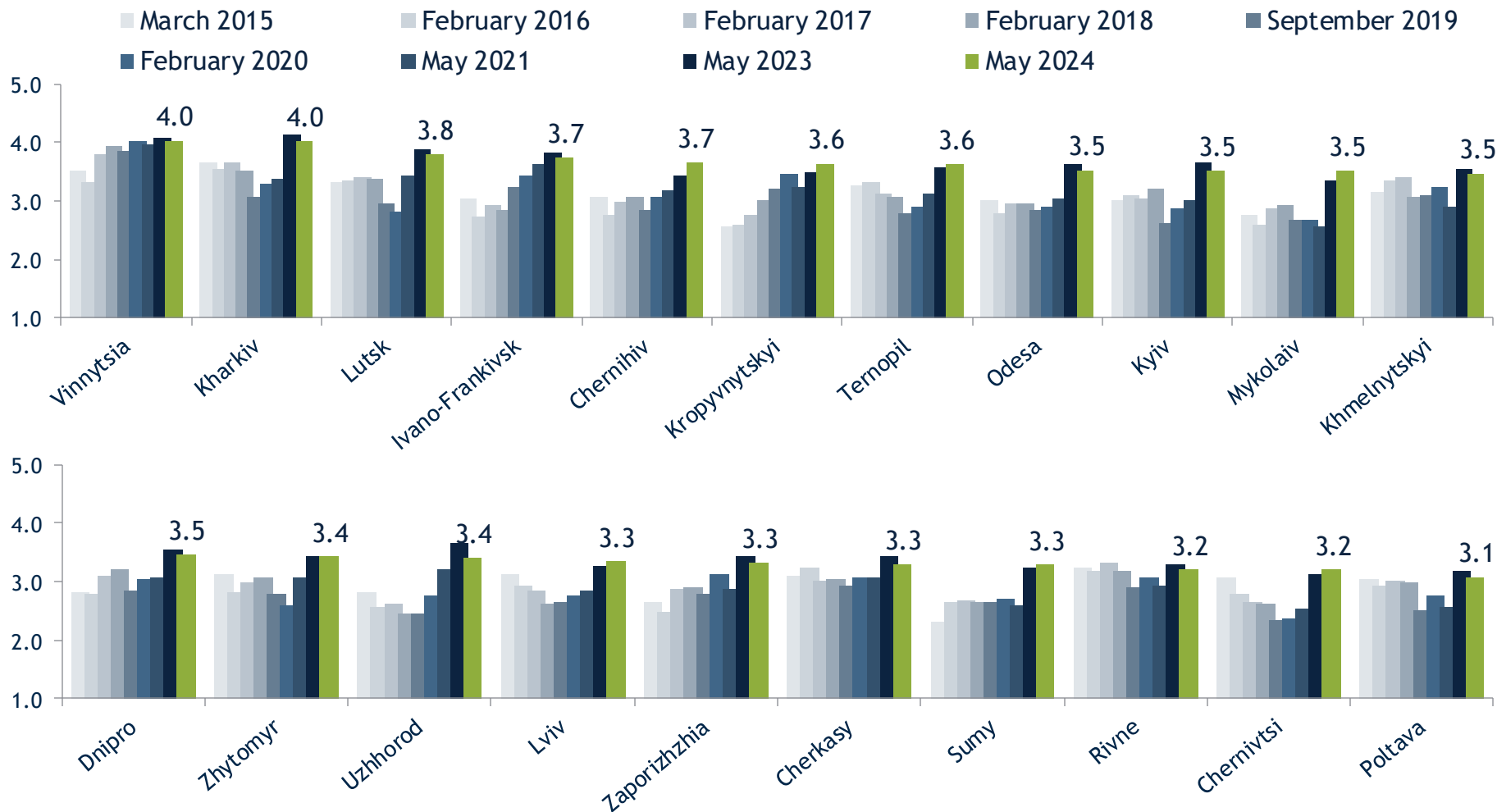

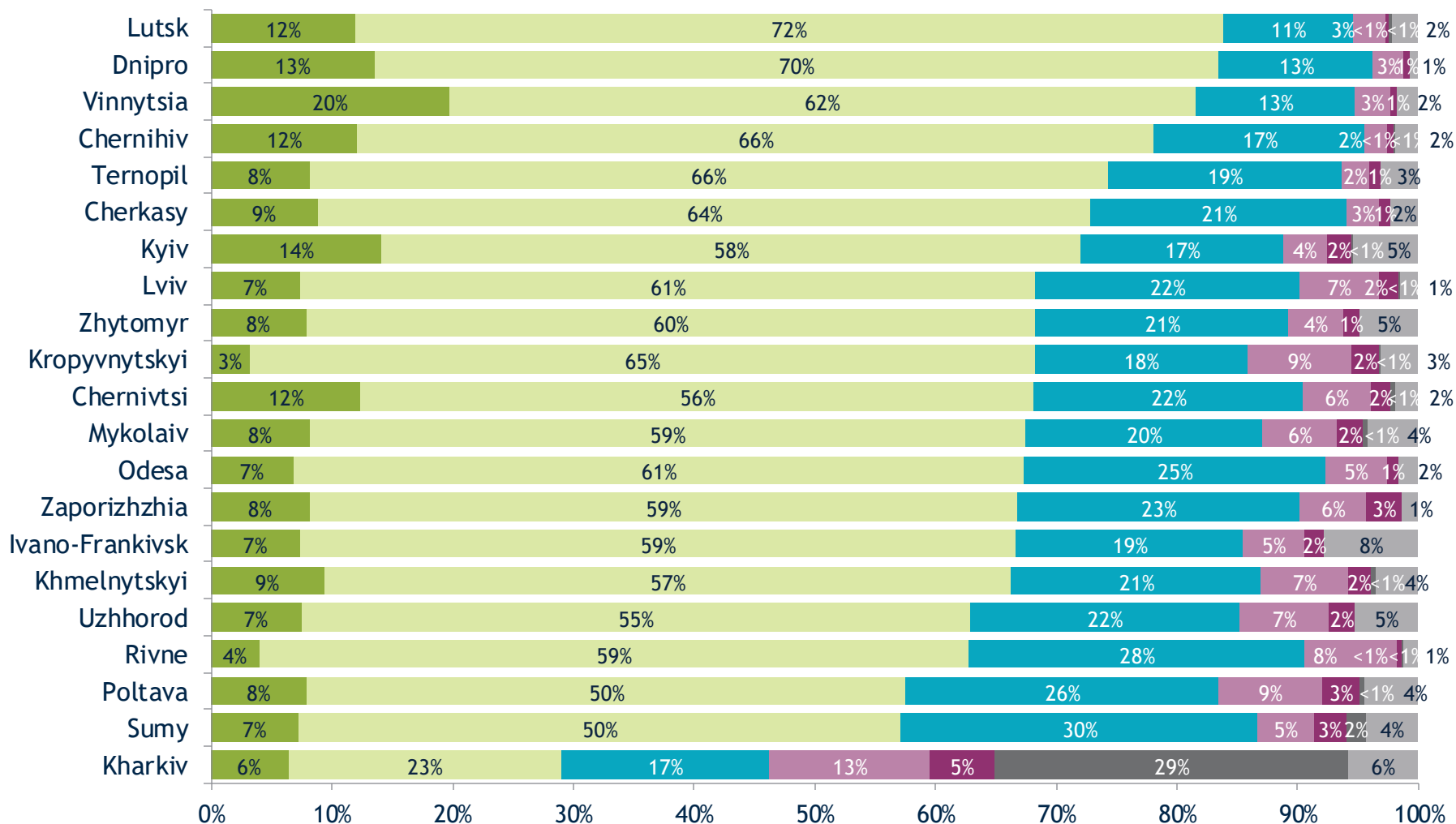

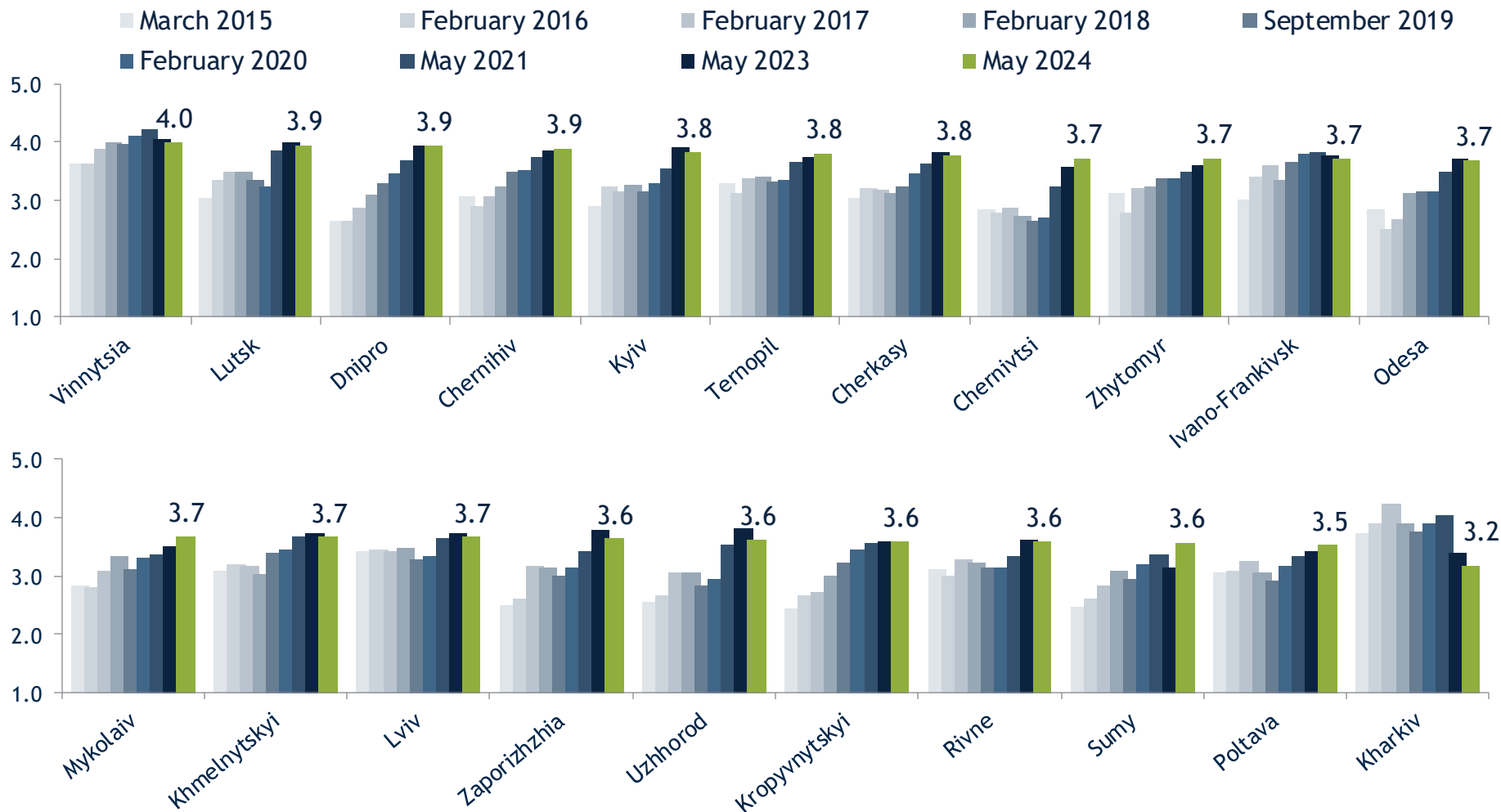

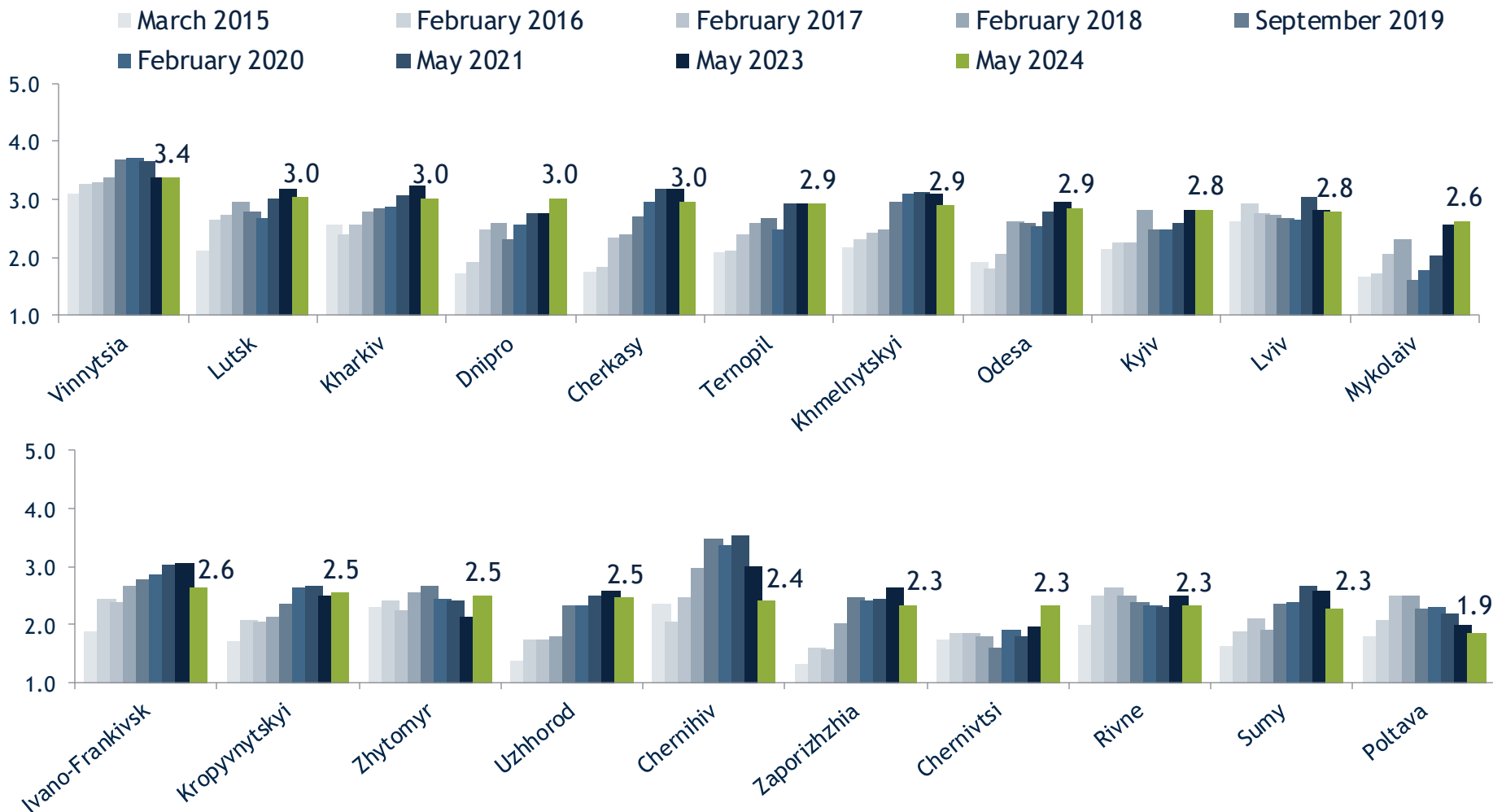

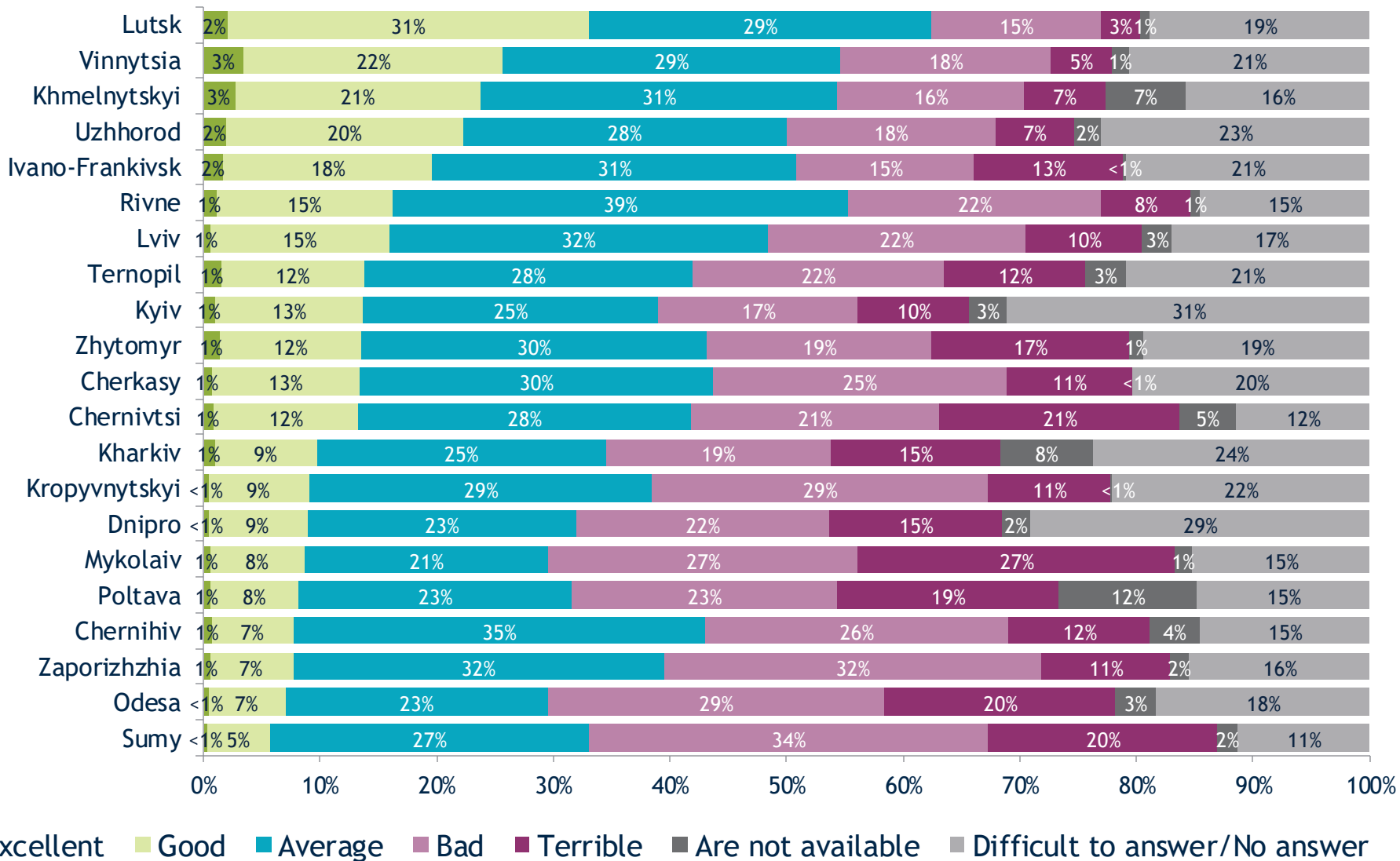

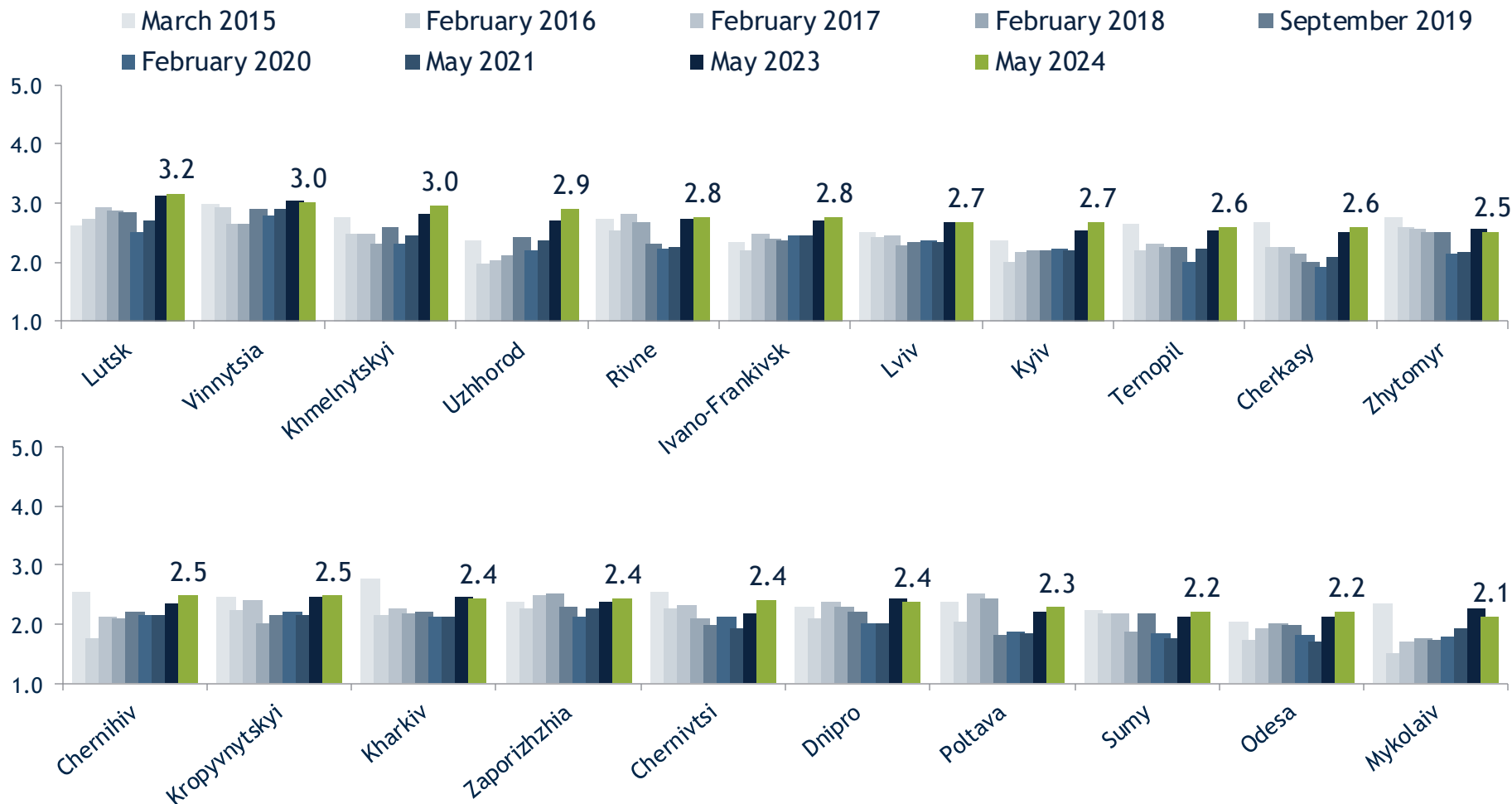

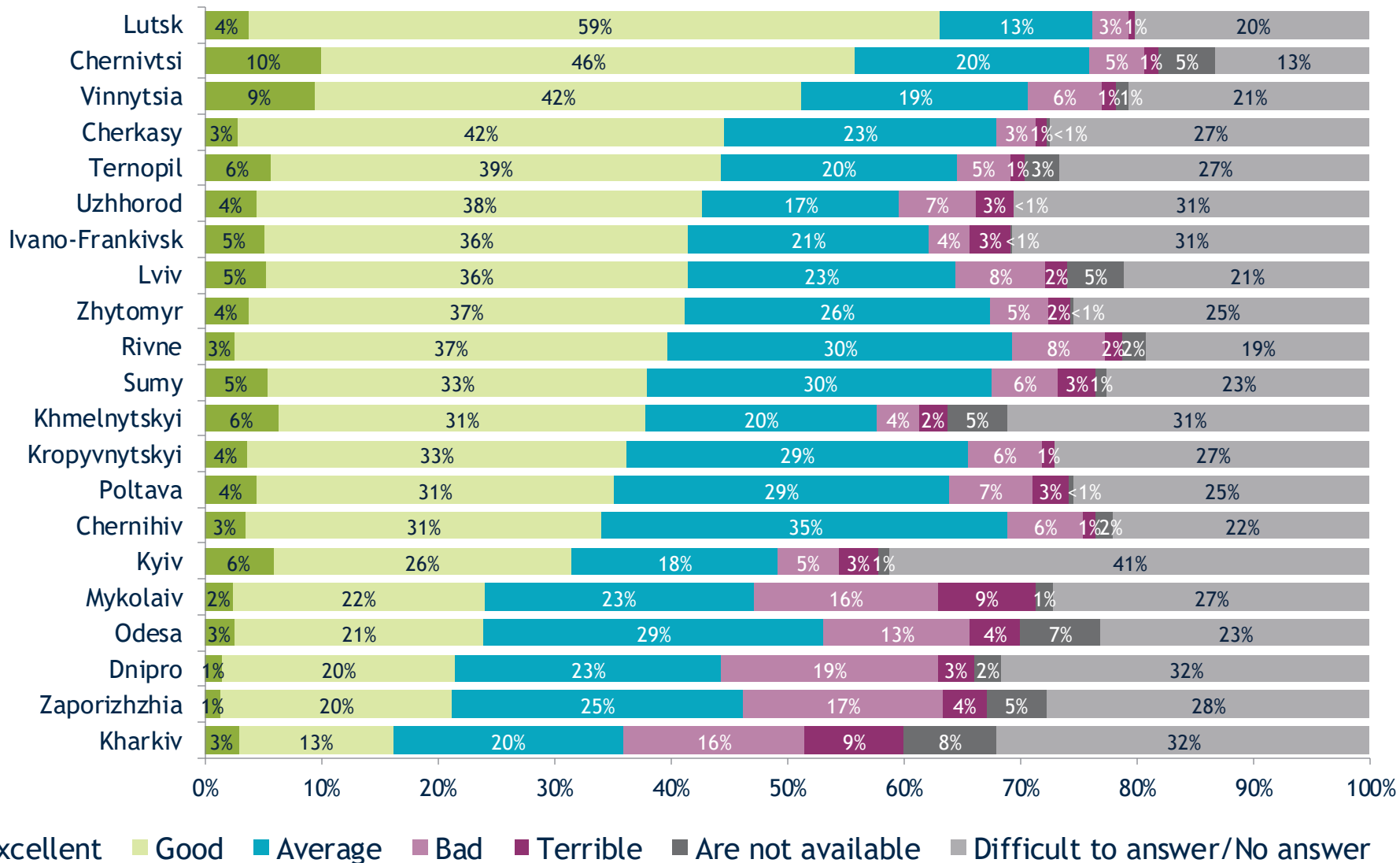

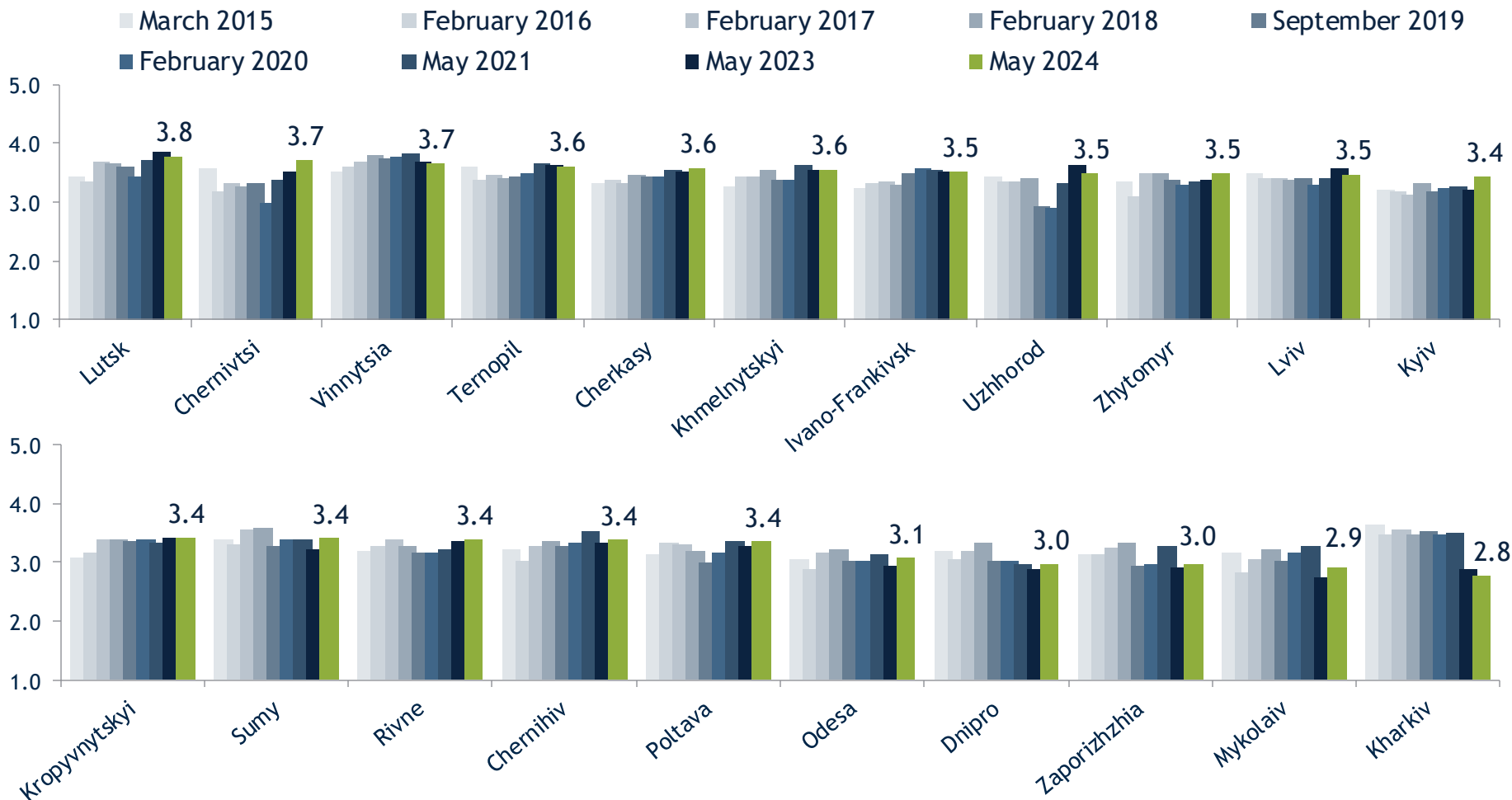

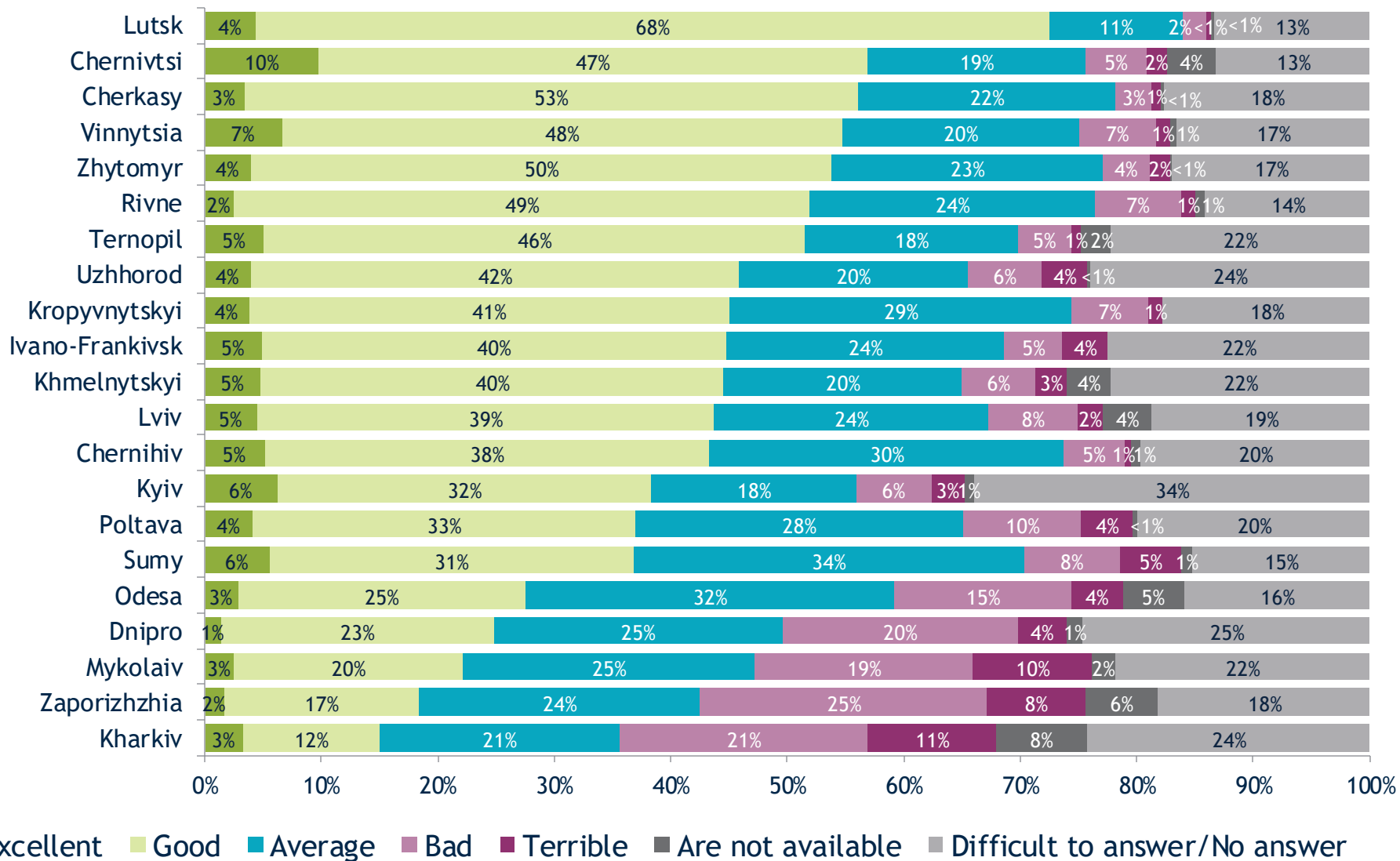

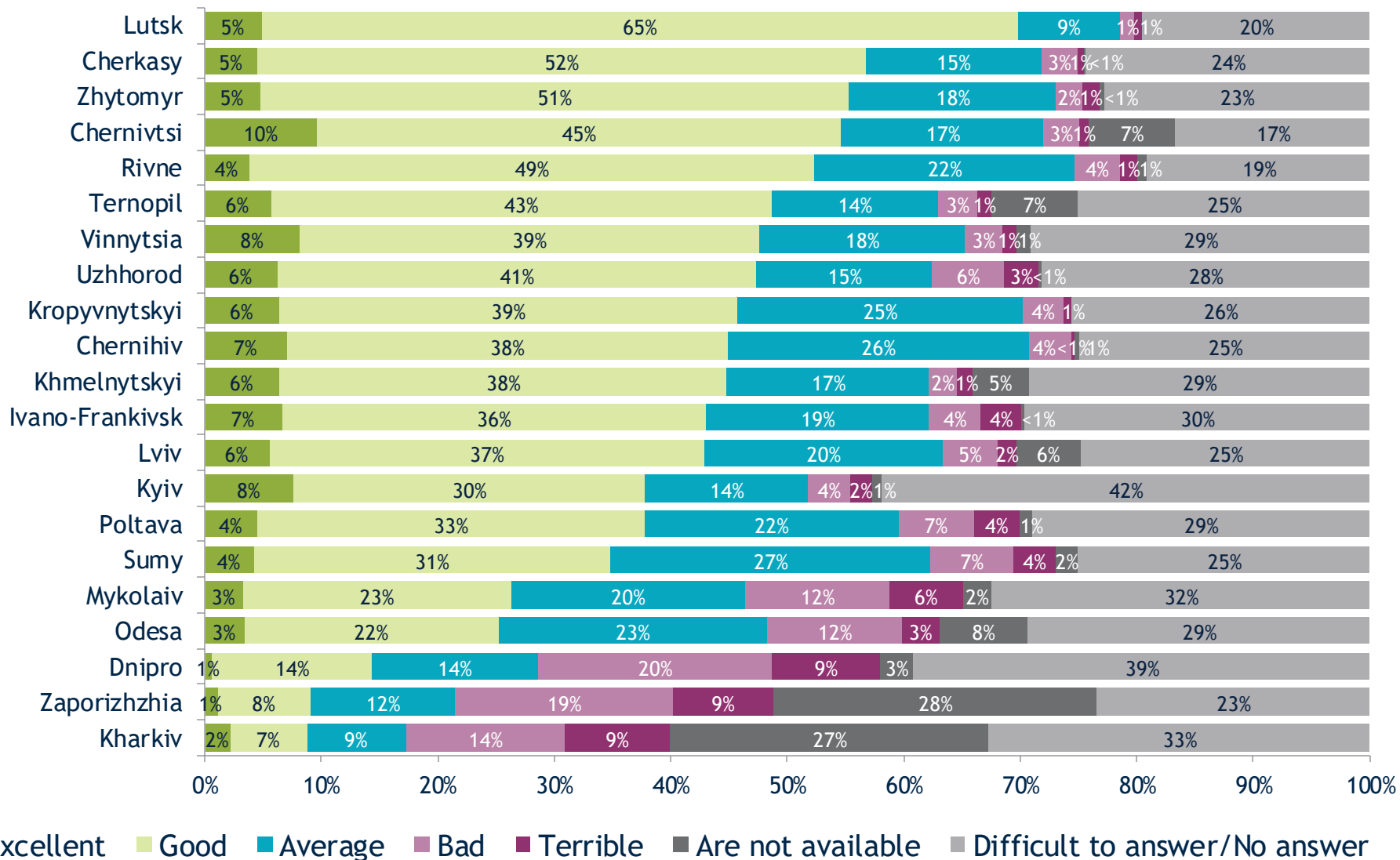

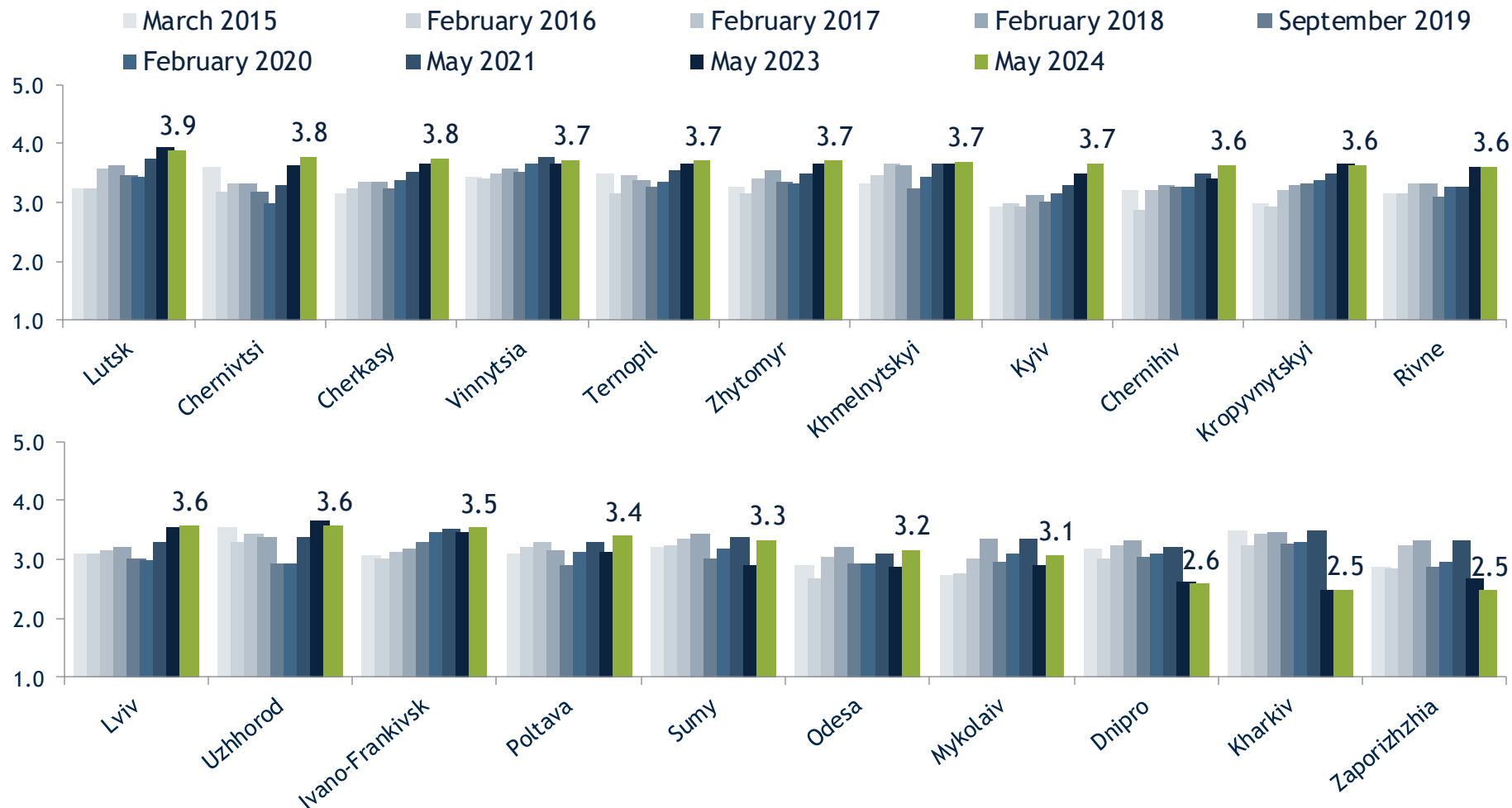

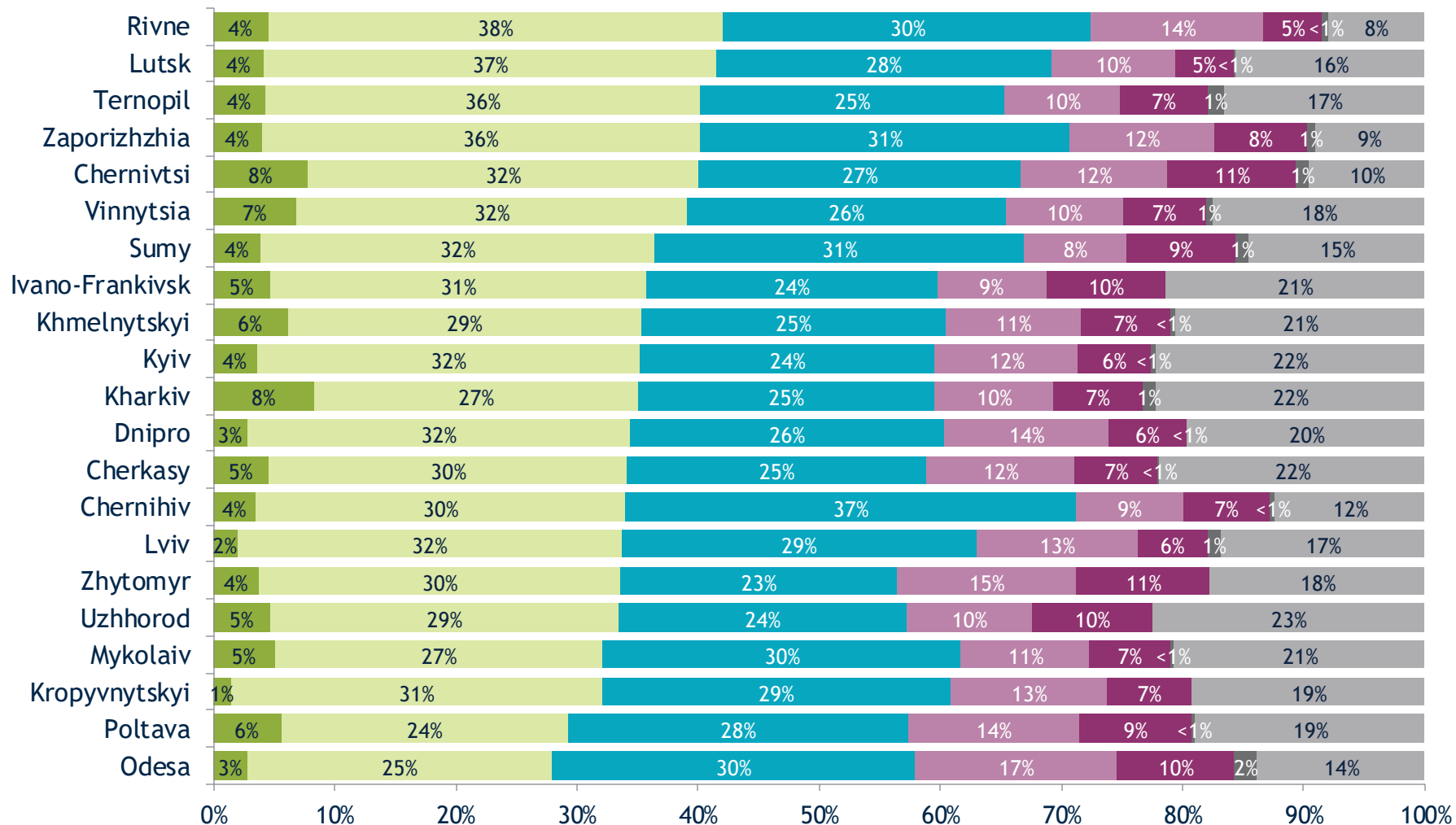

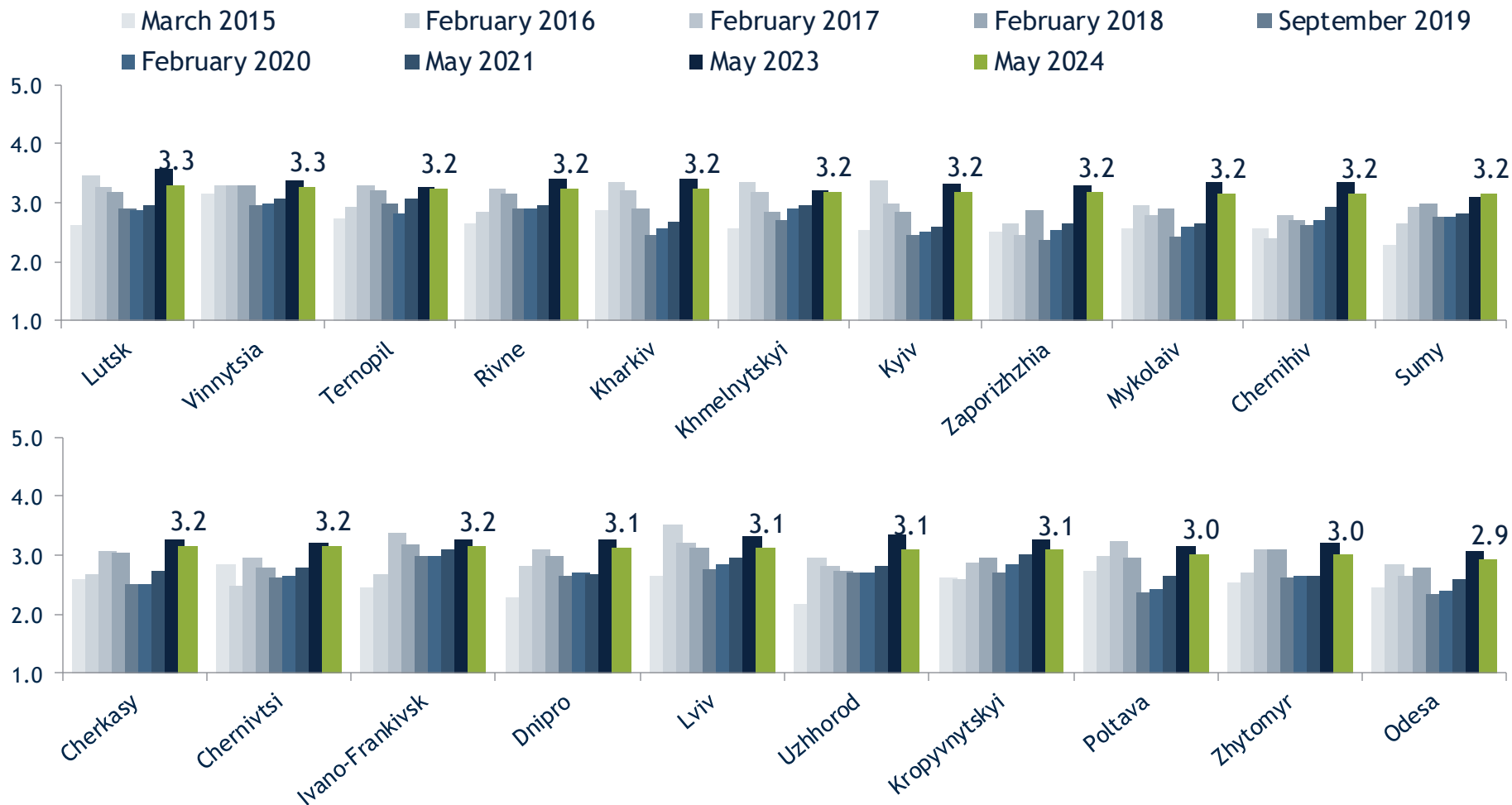

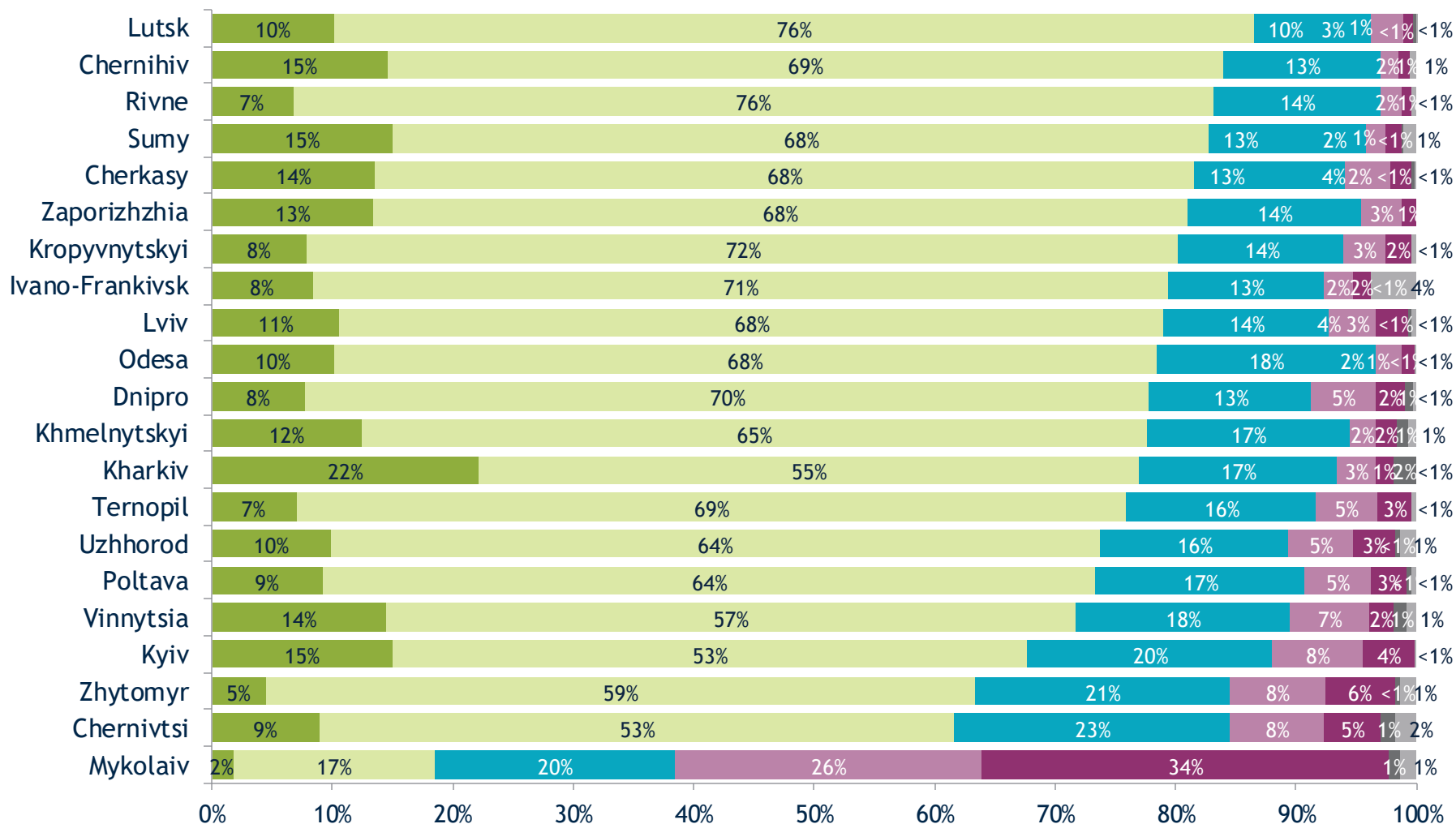

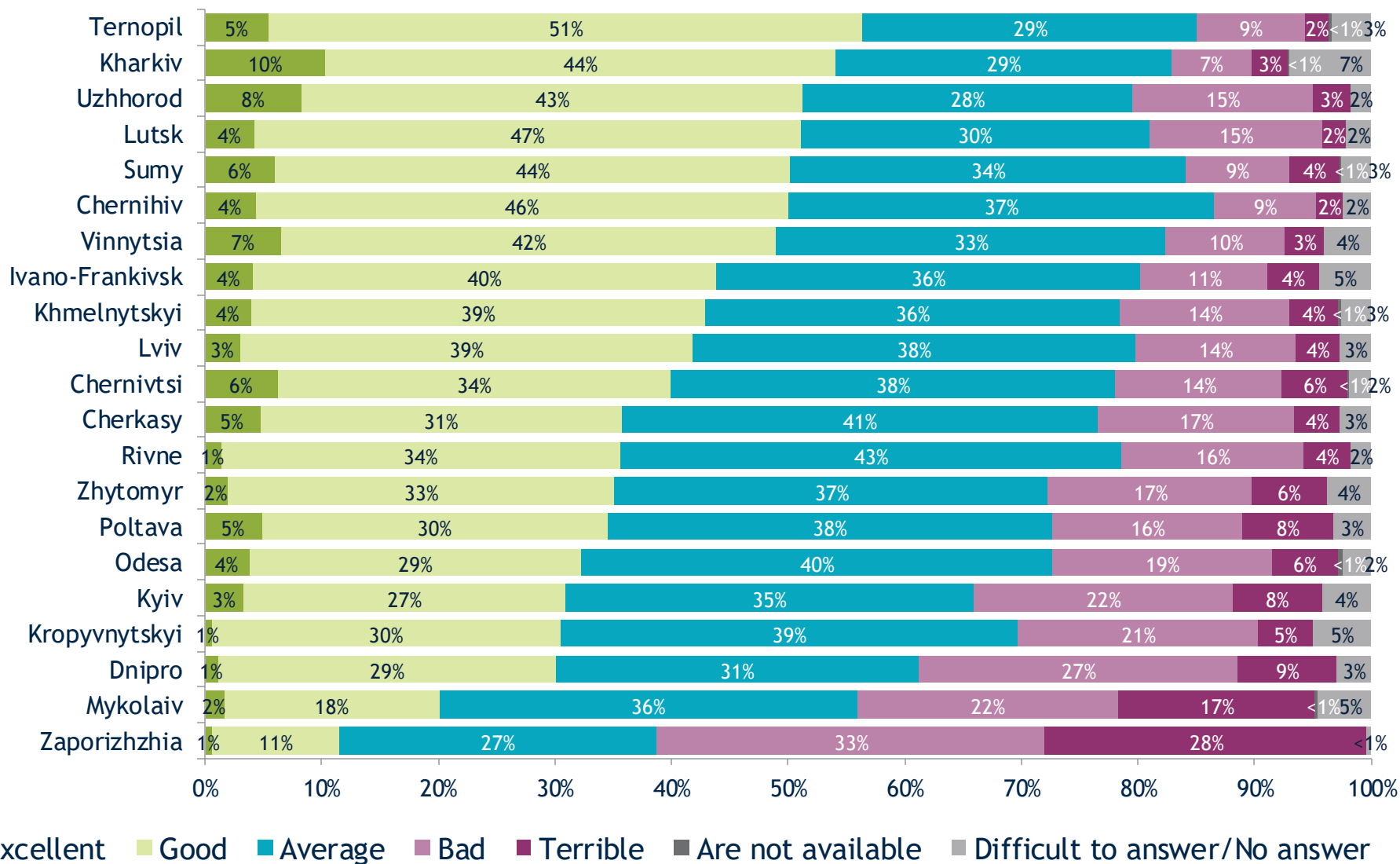

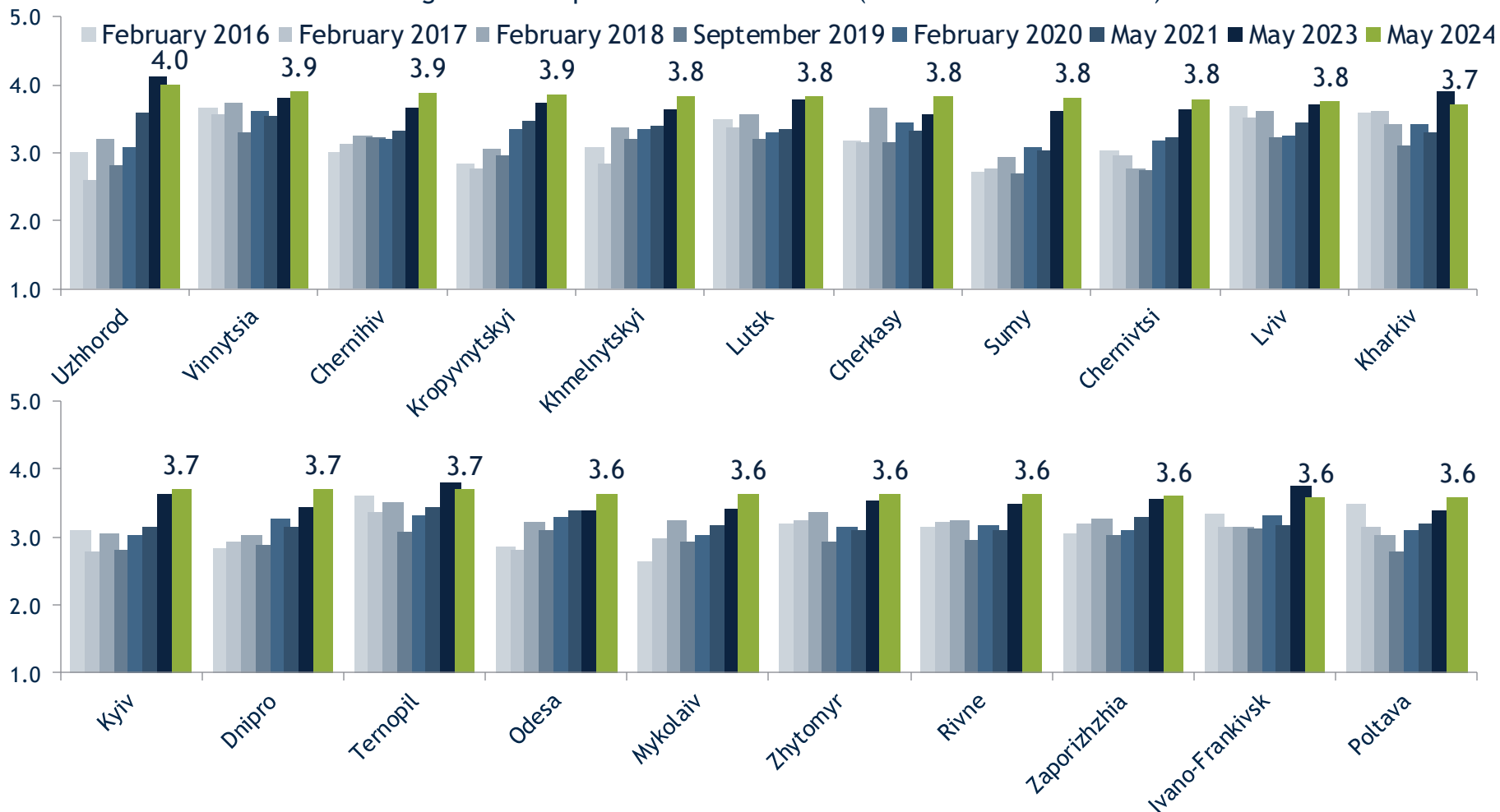

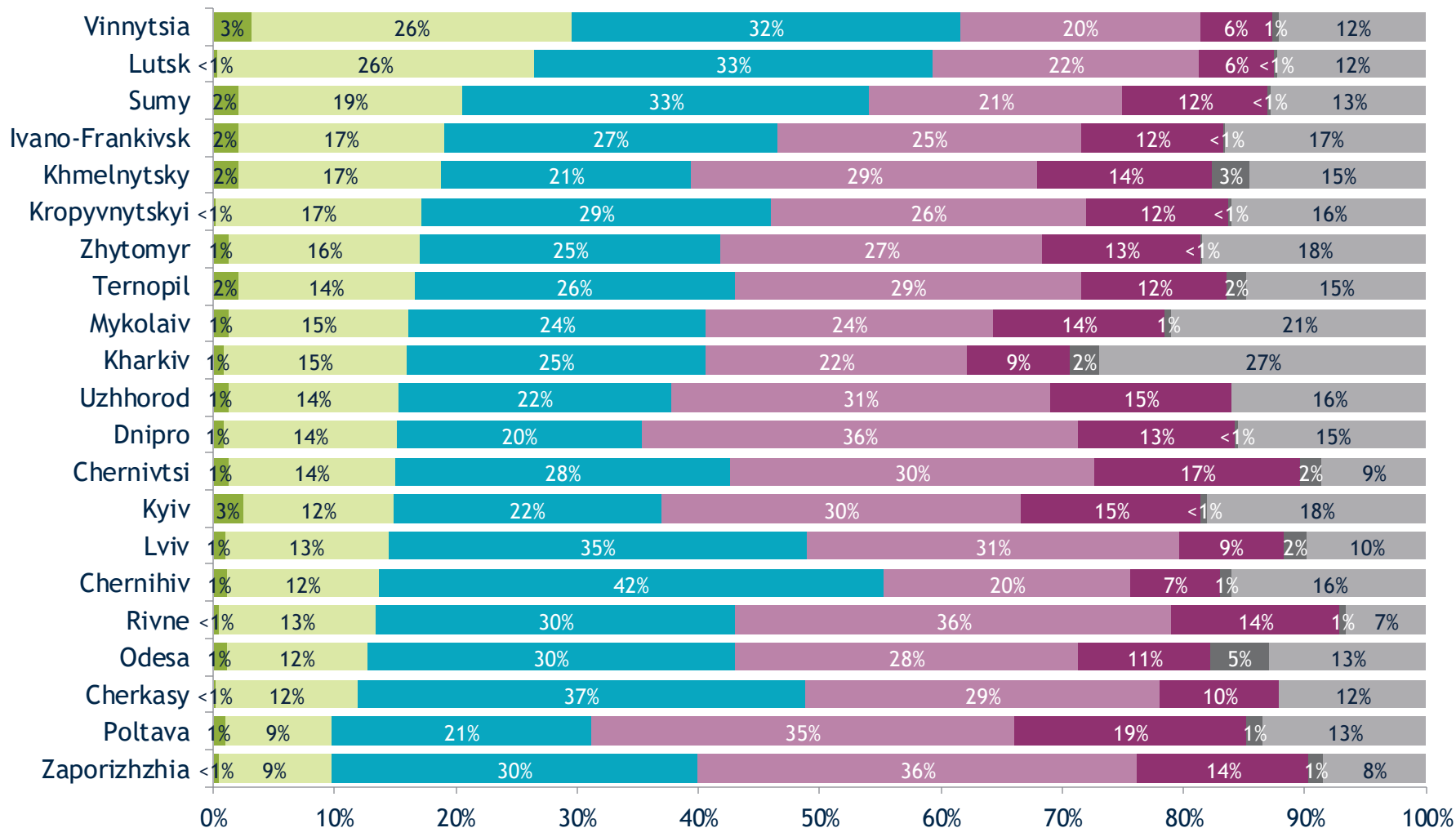

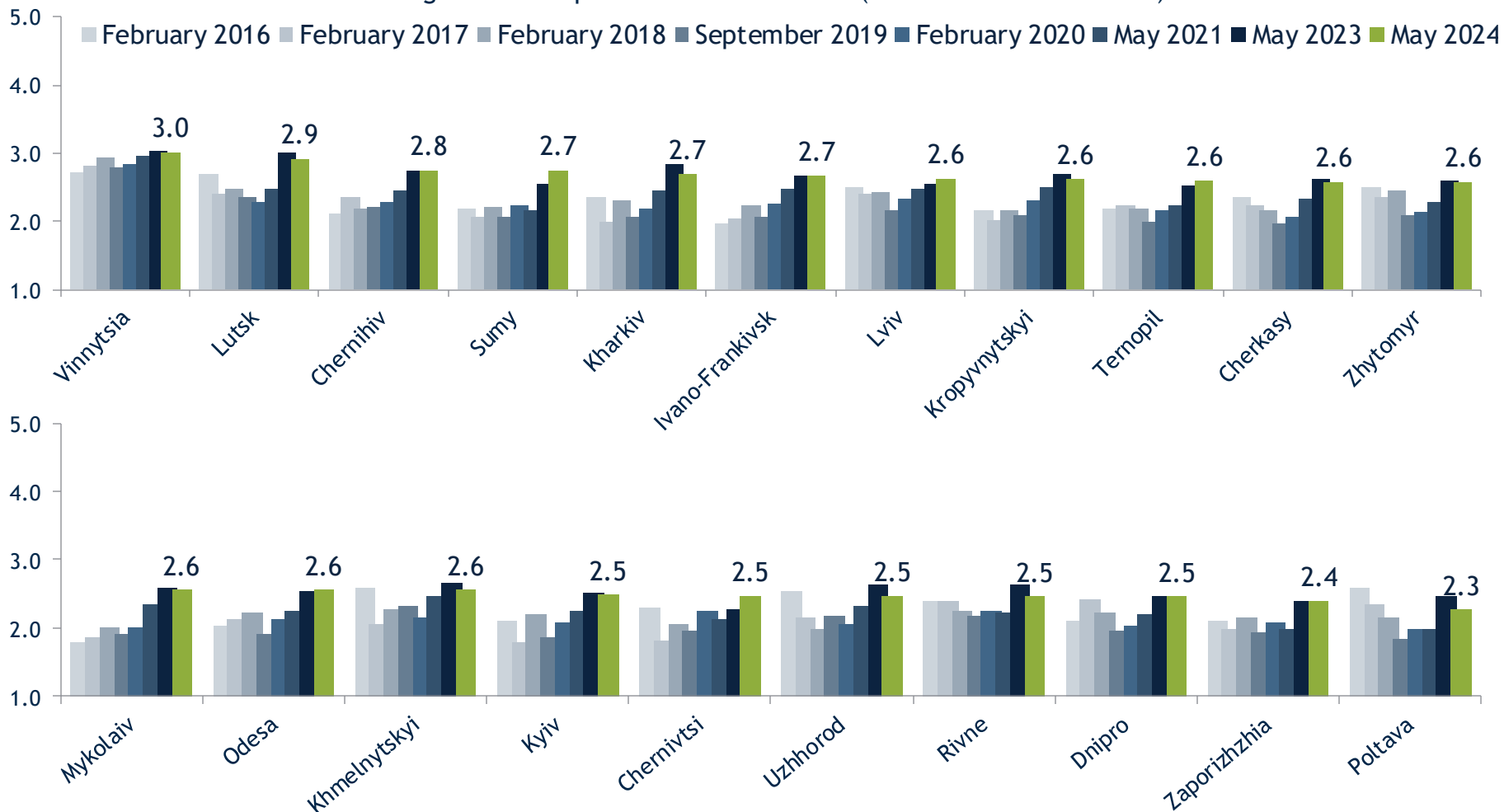

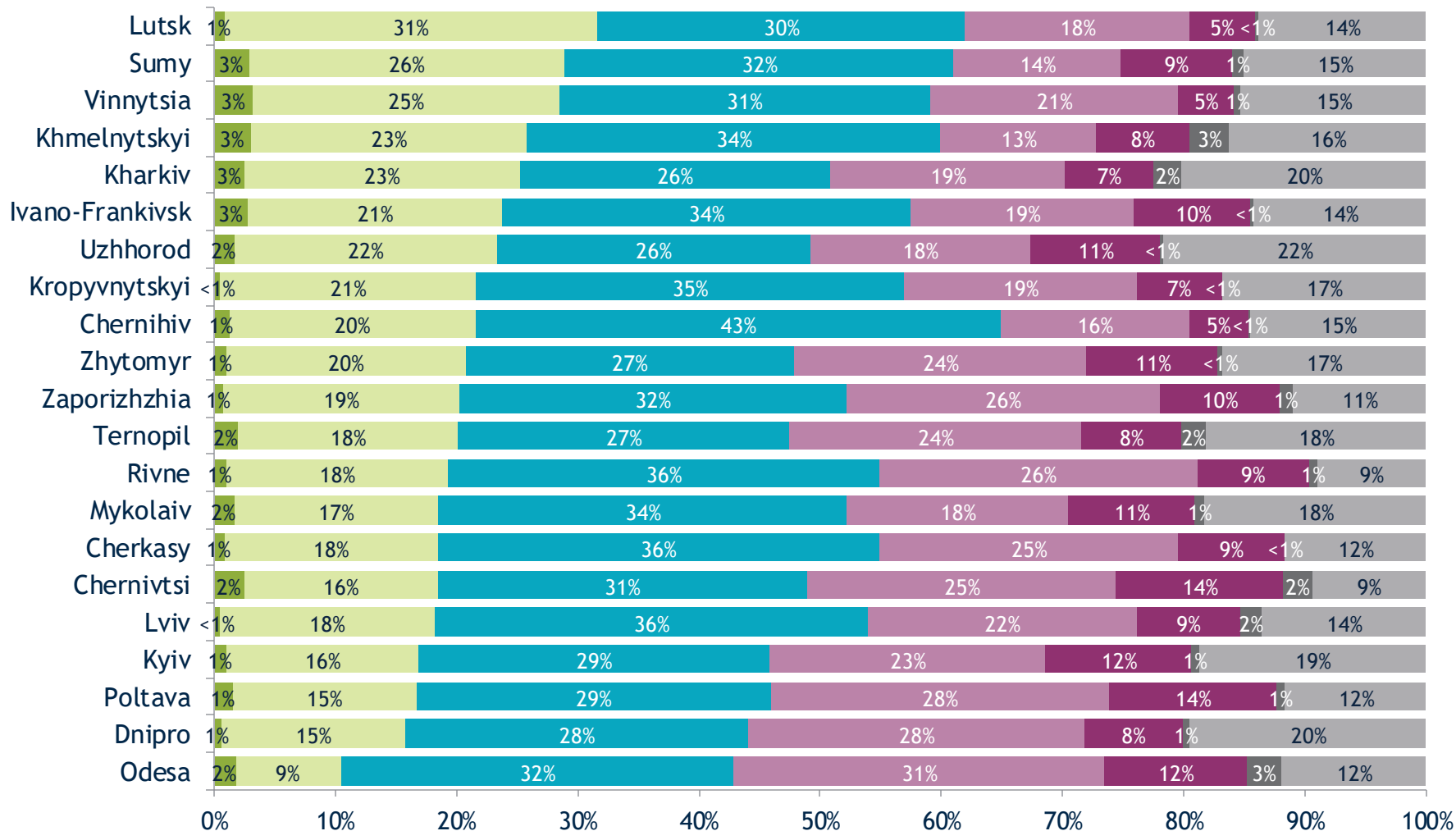

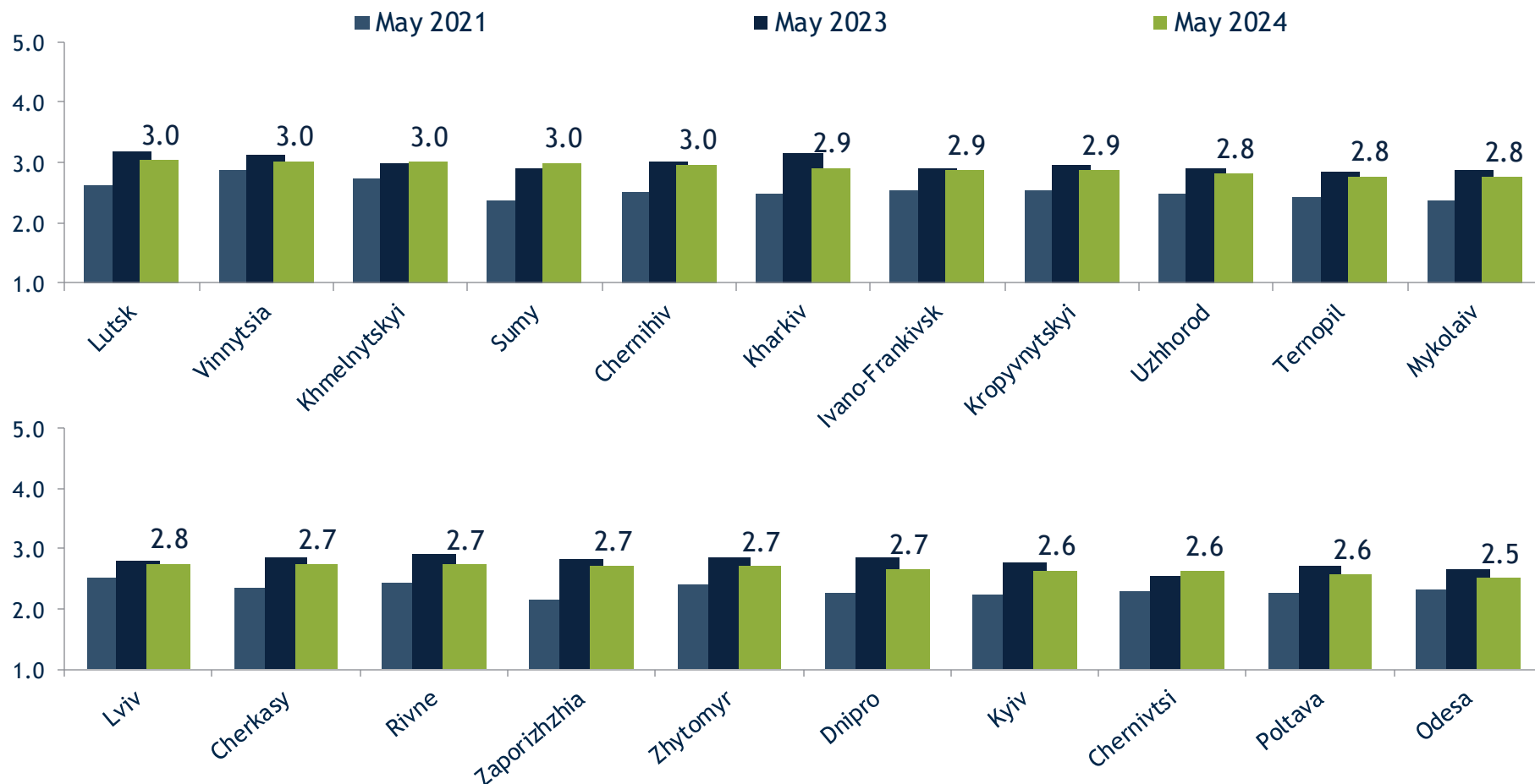

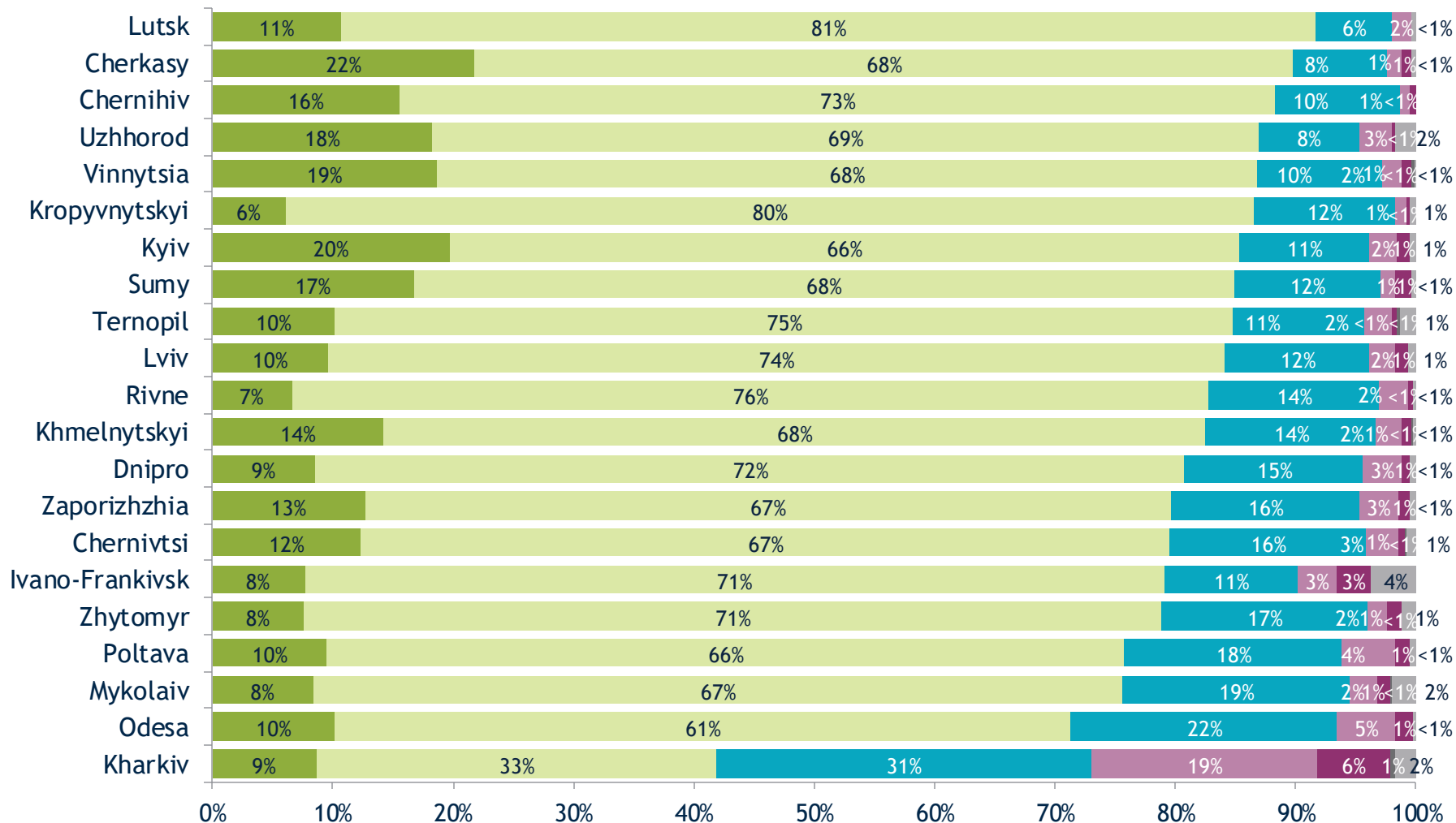

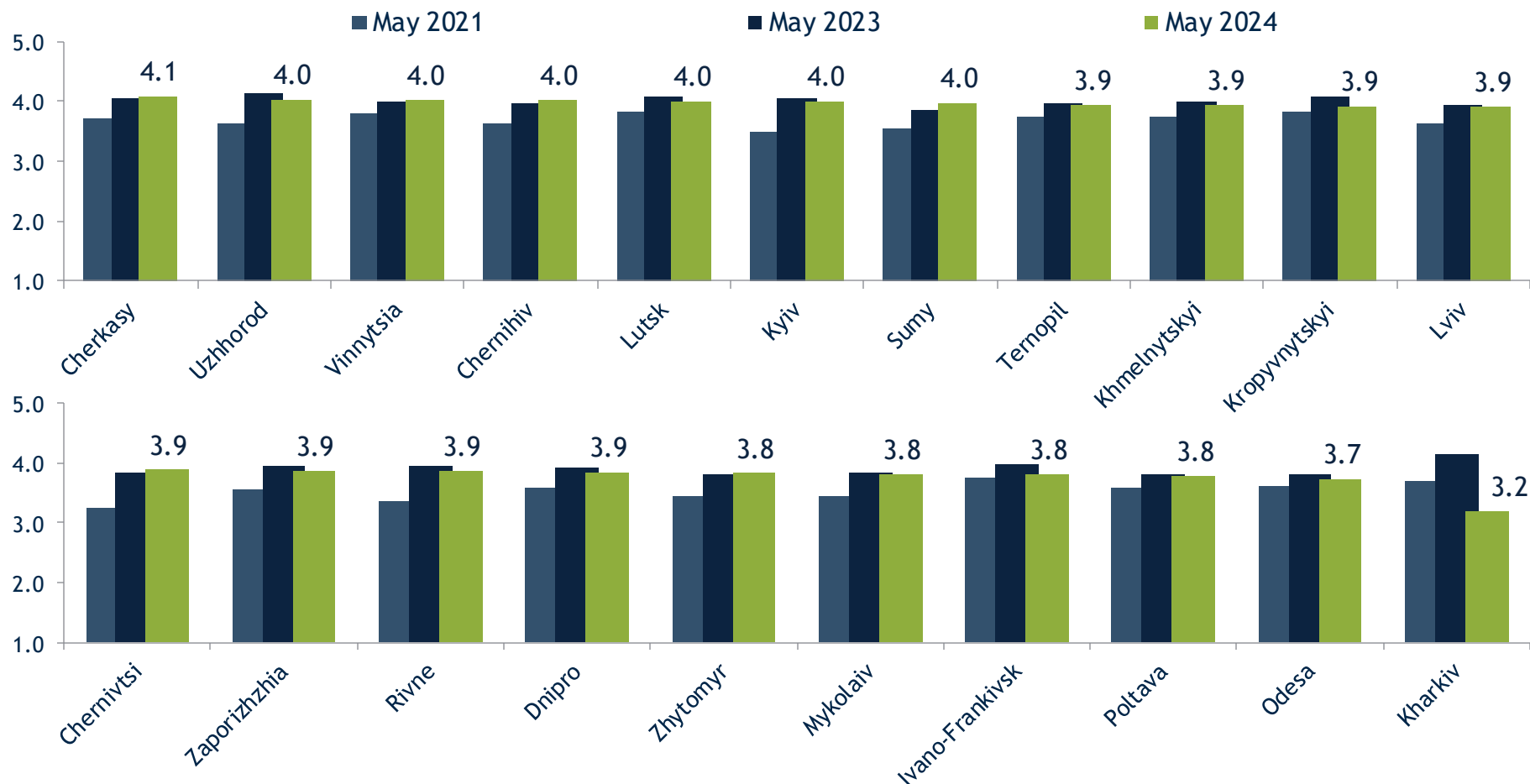

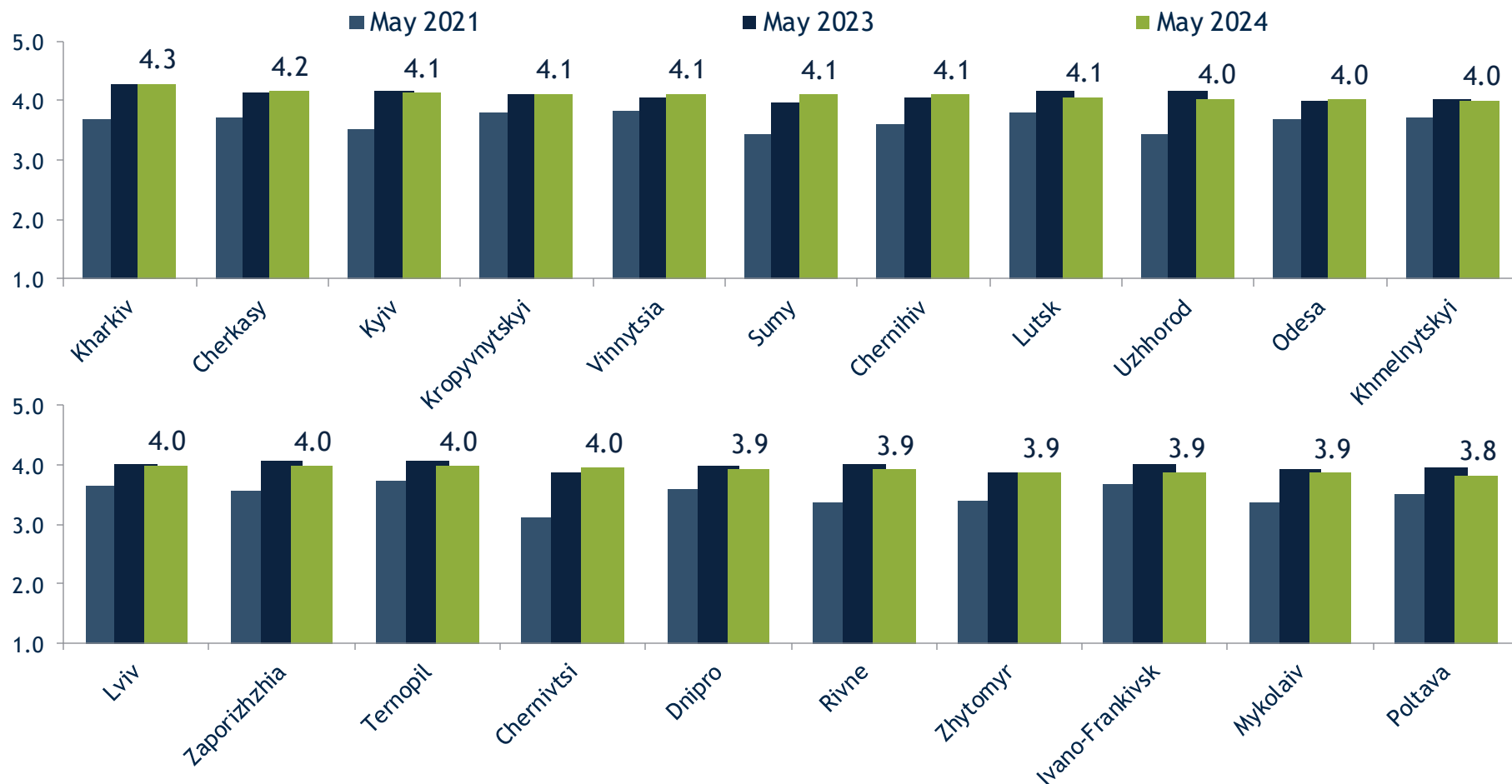

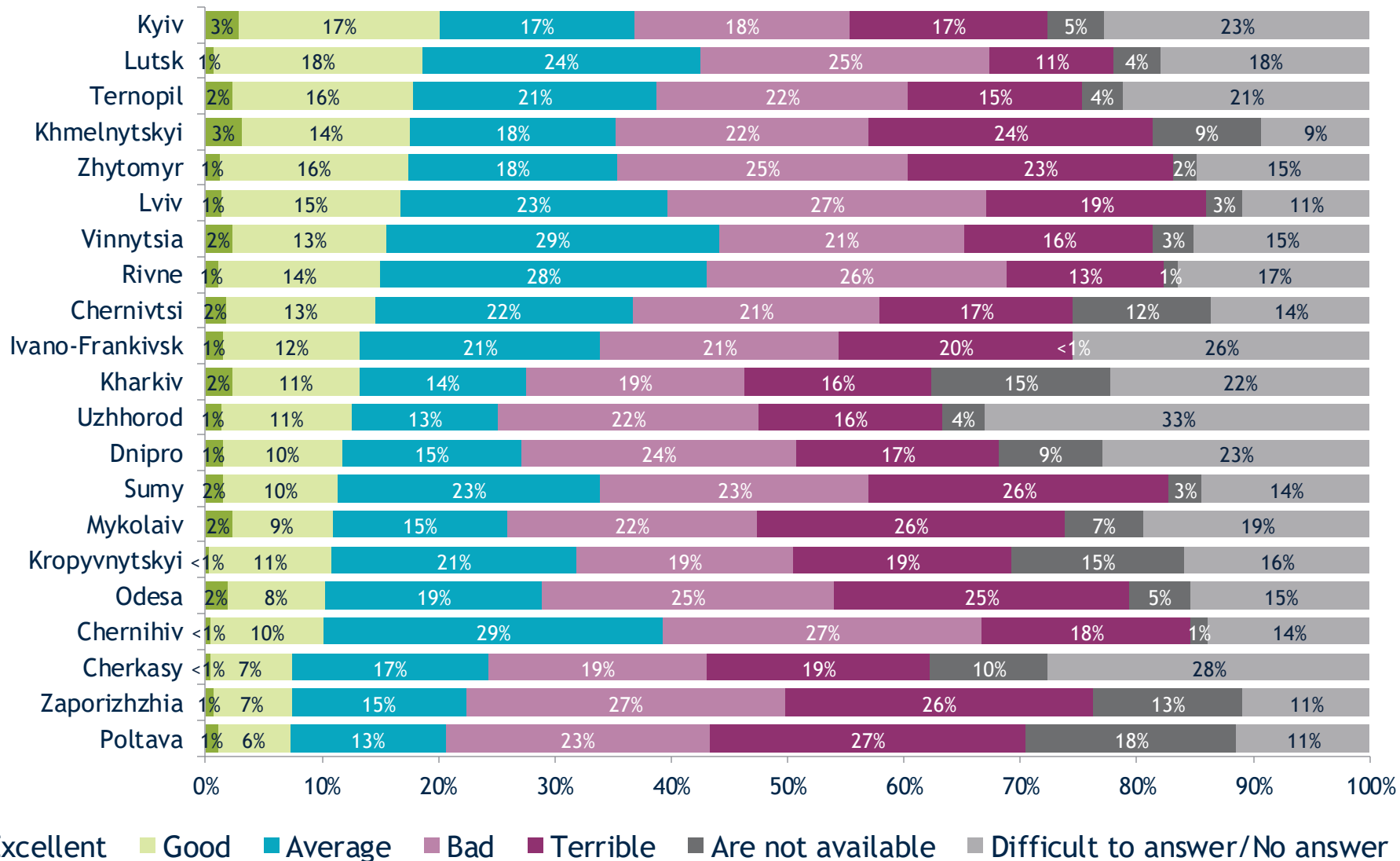

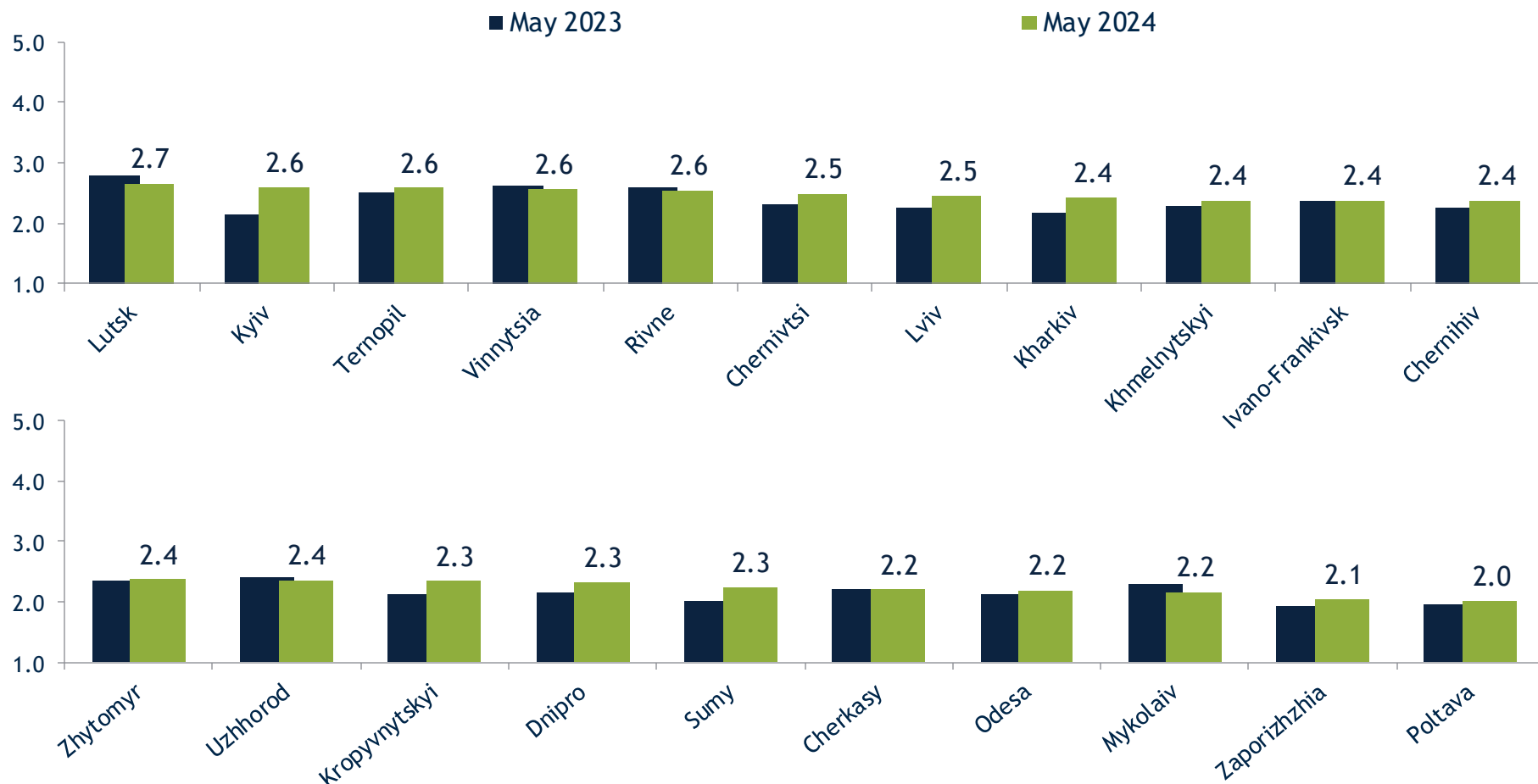

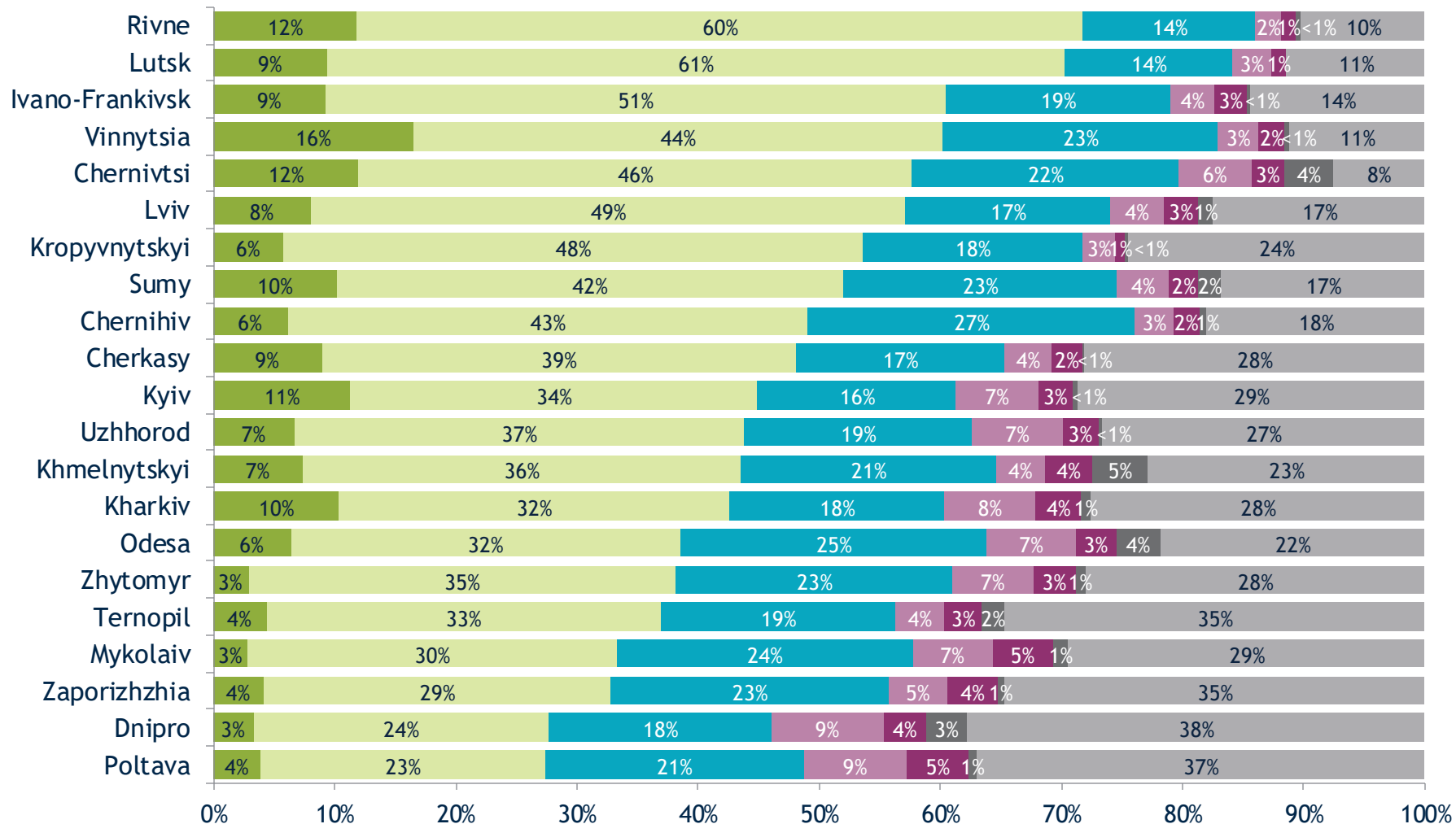

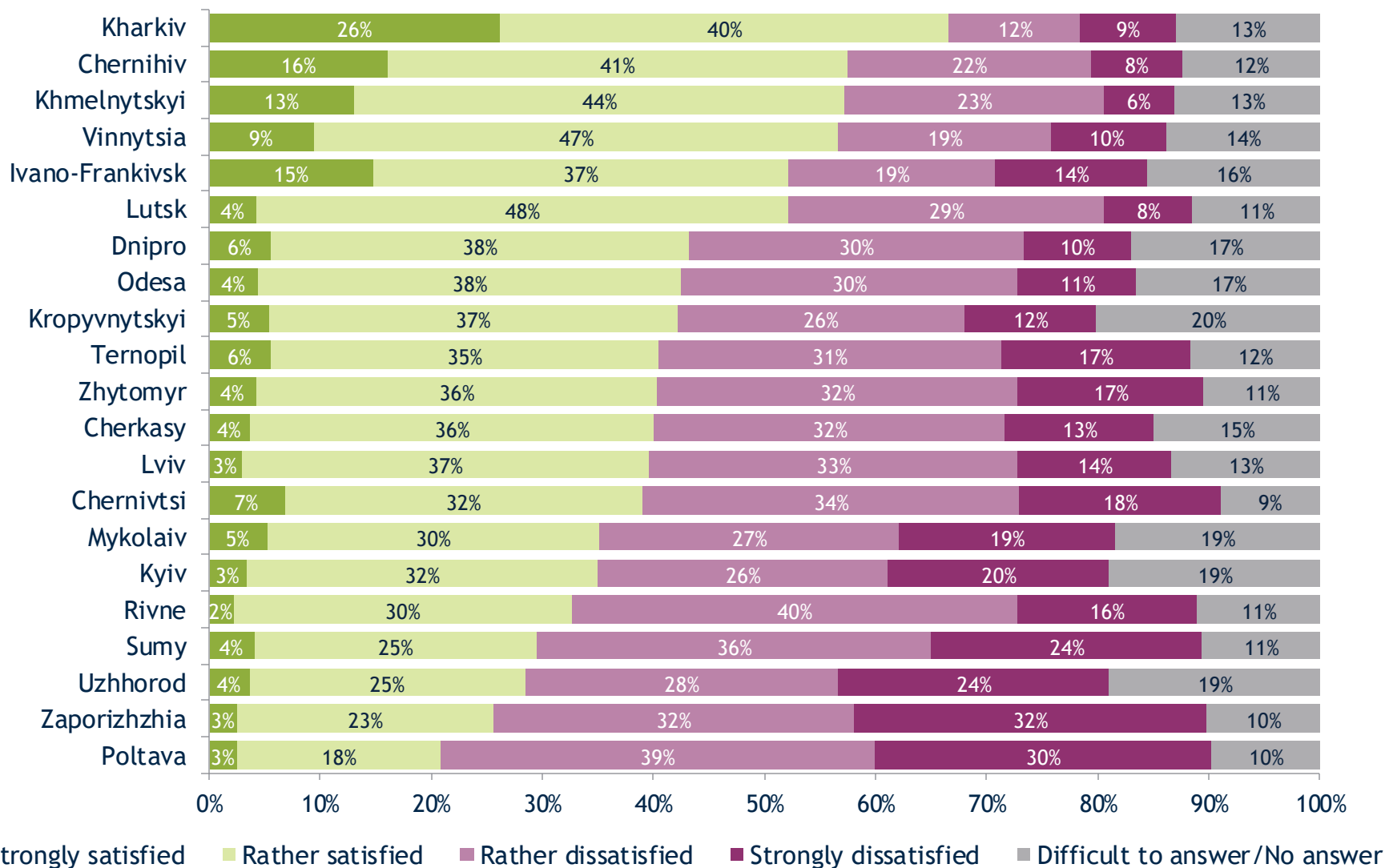

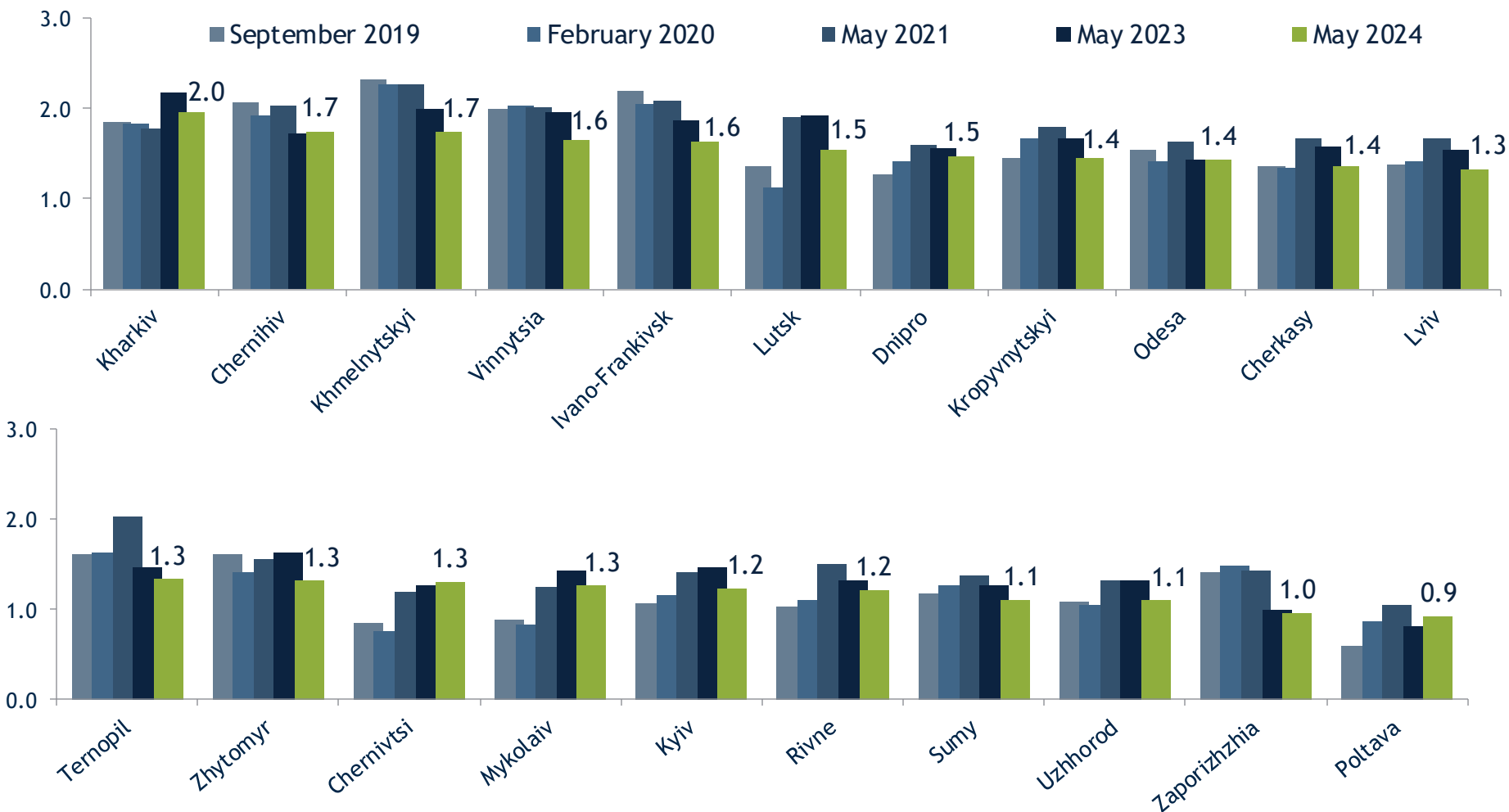
# To what degree are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the activities of your city council?

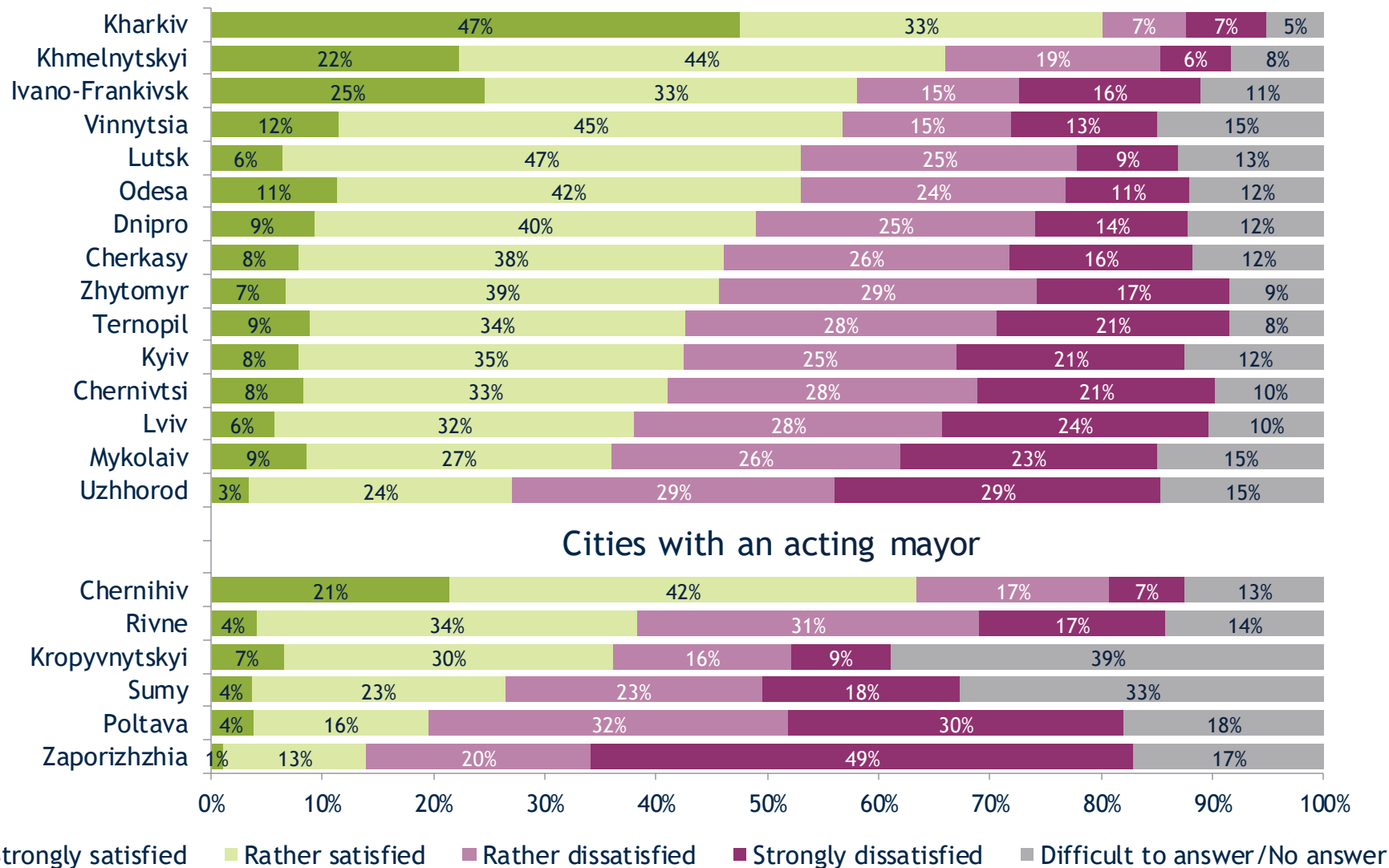

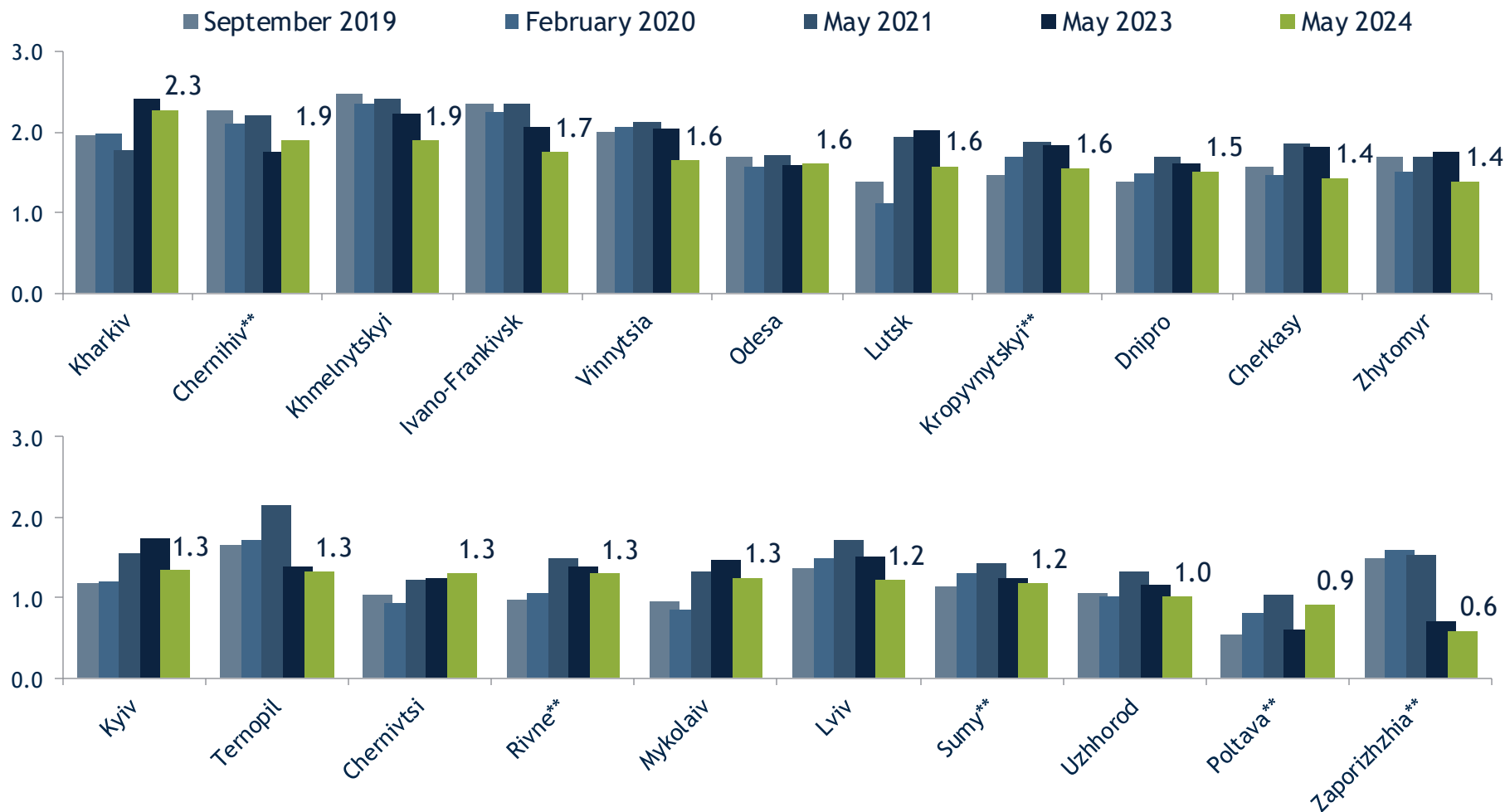

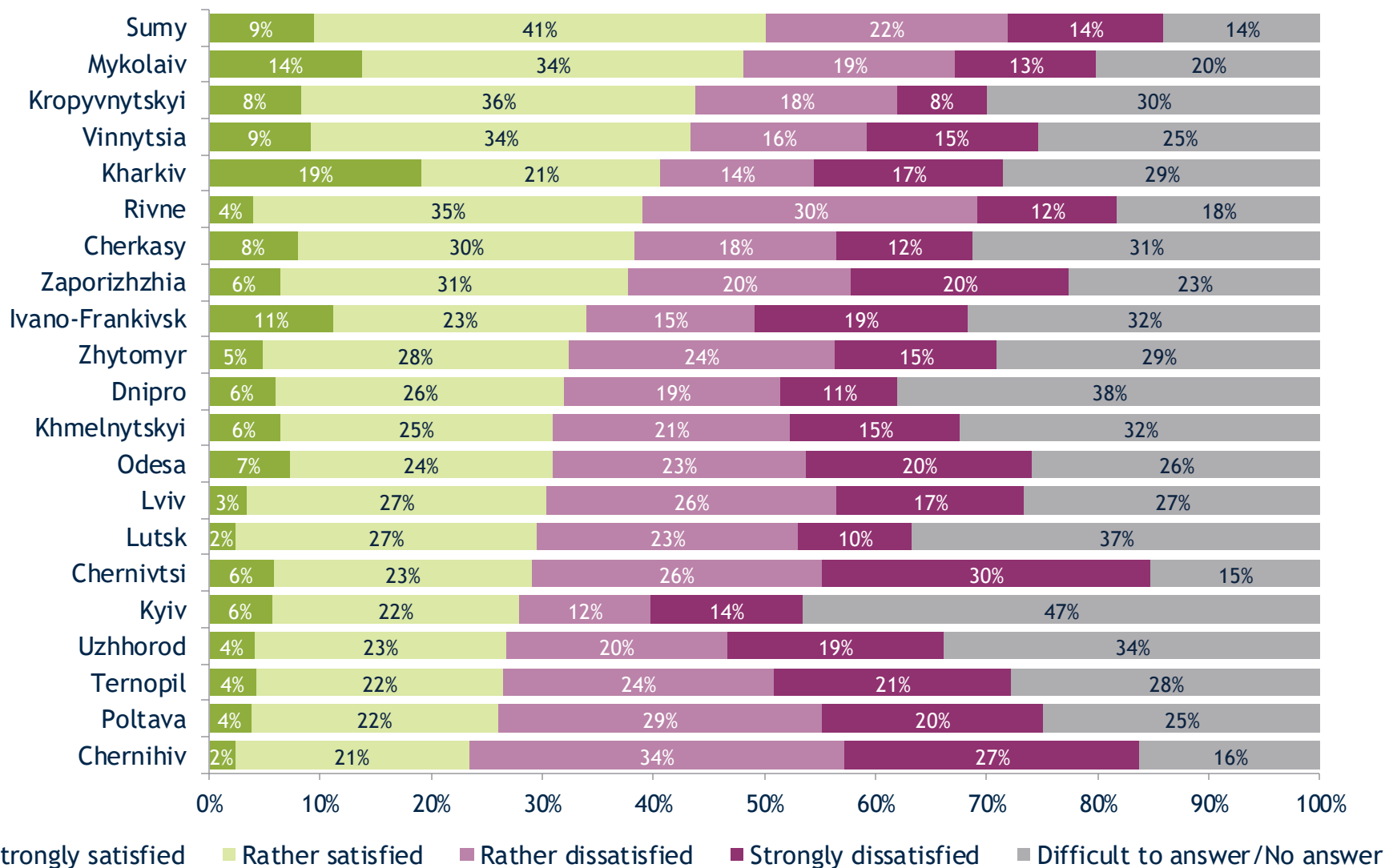

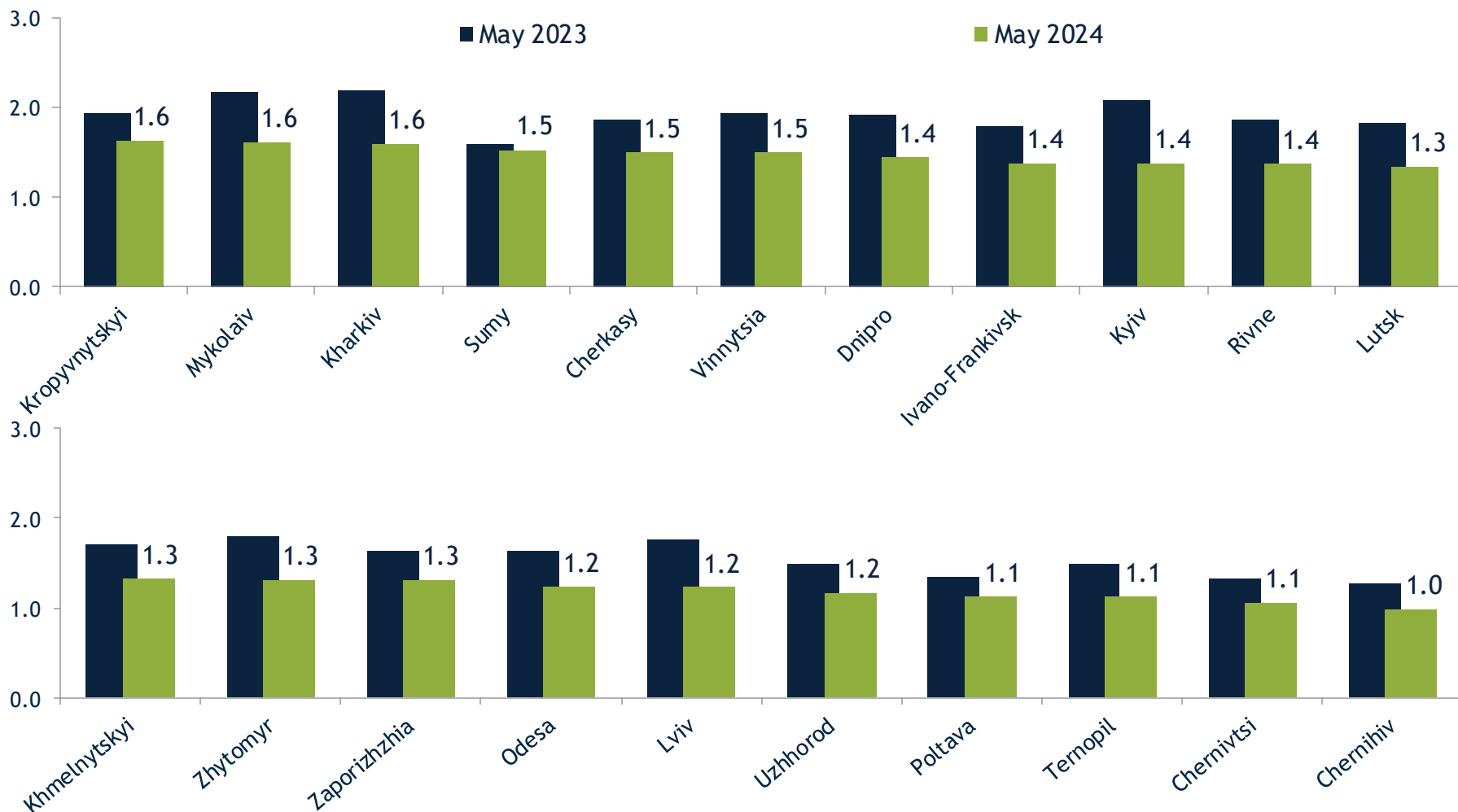

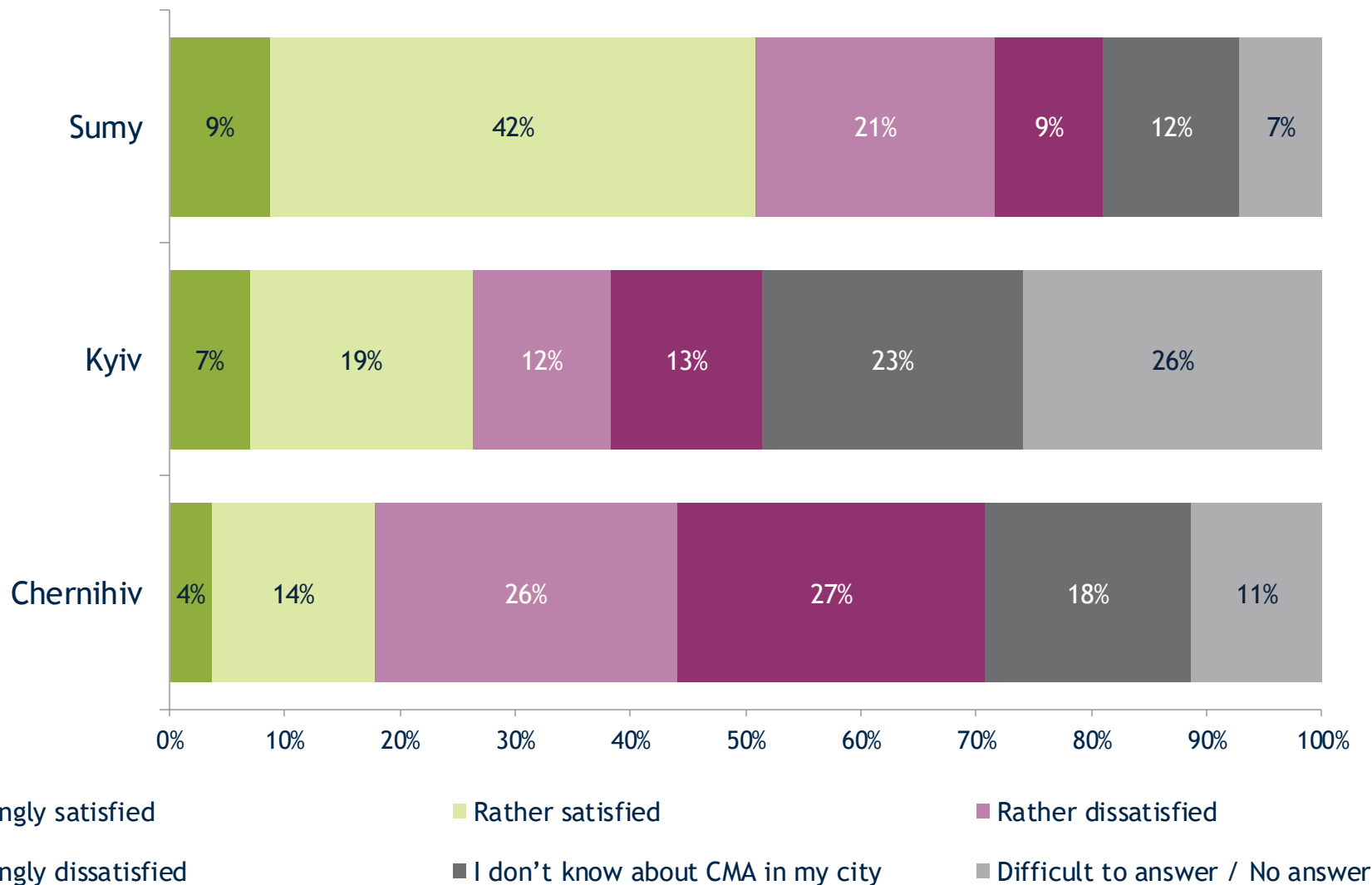

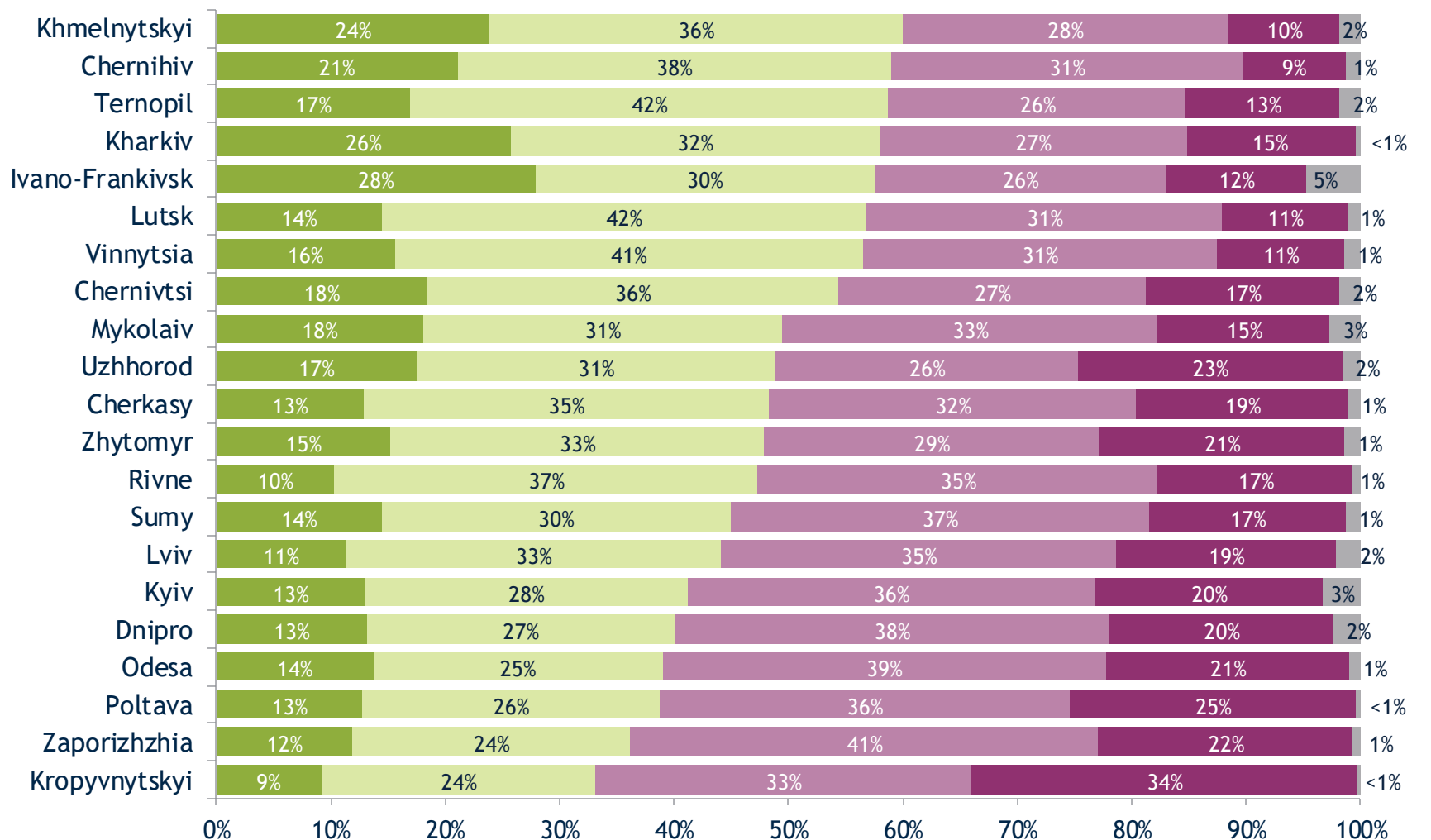




# To what degree are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the activities of your civil military administration?

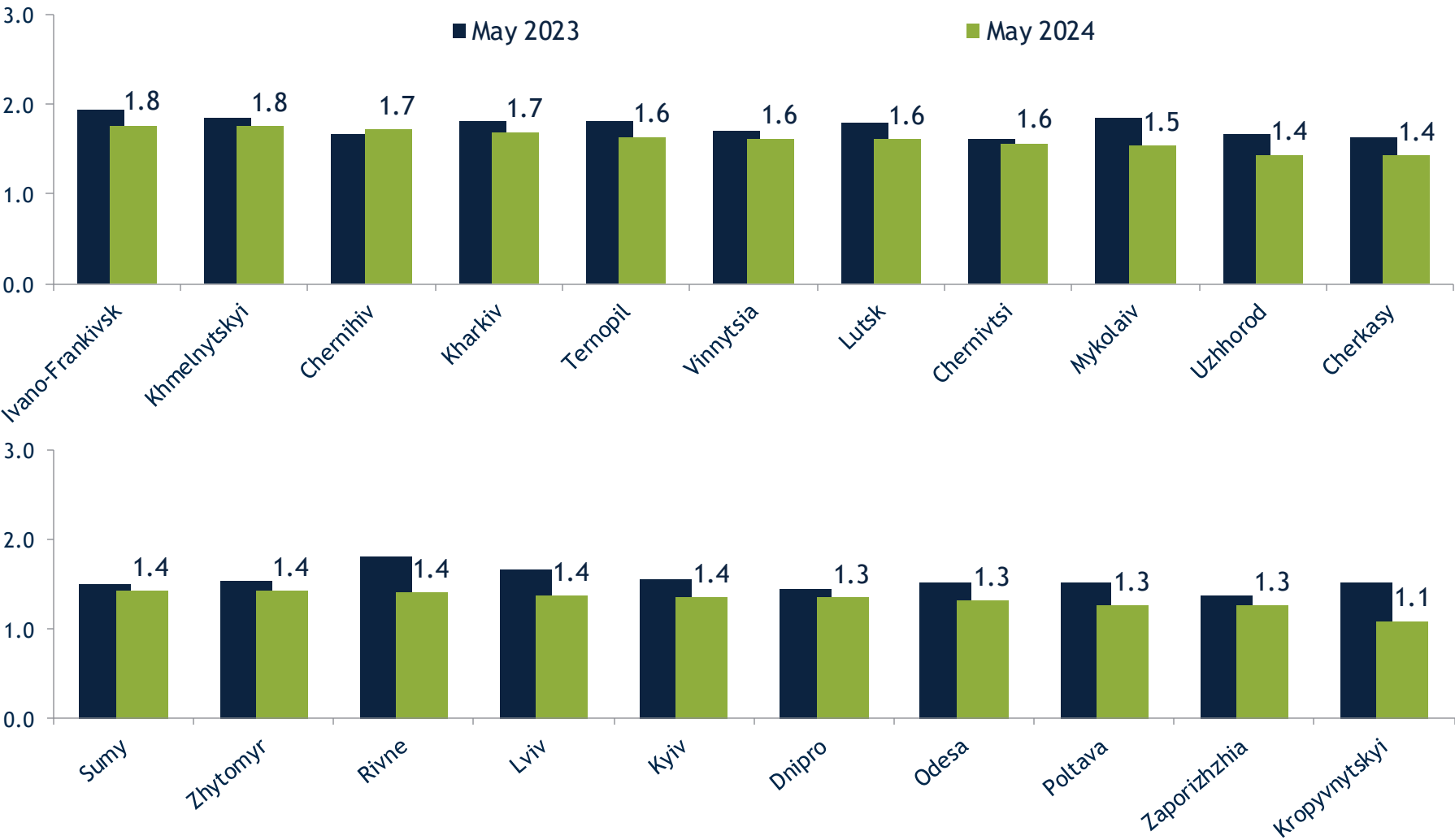

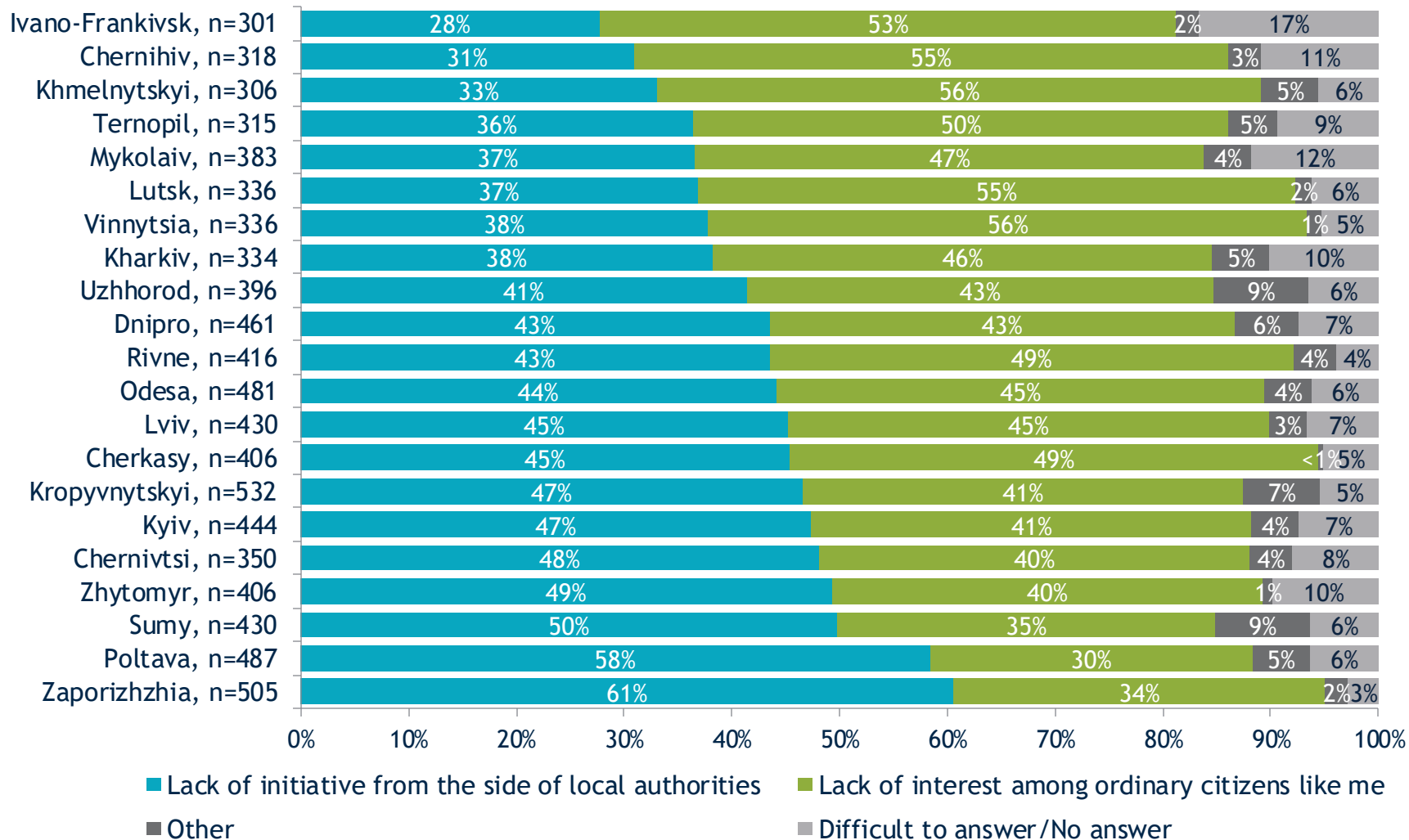
# To what extent do you consider yourself to be informed about the activities of local authorities in your city?

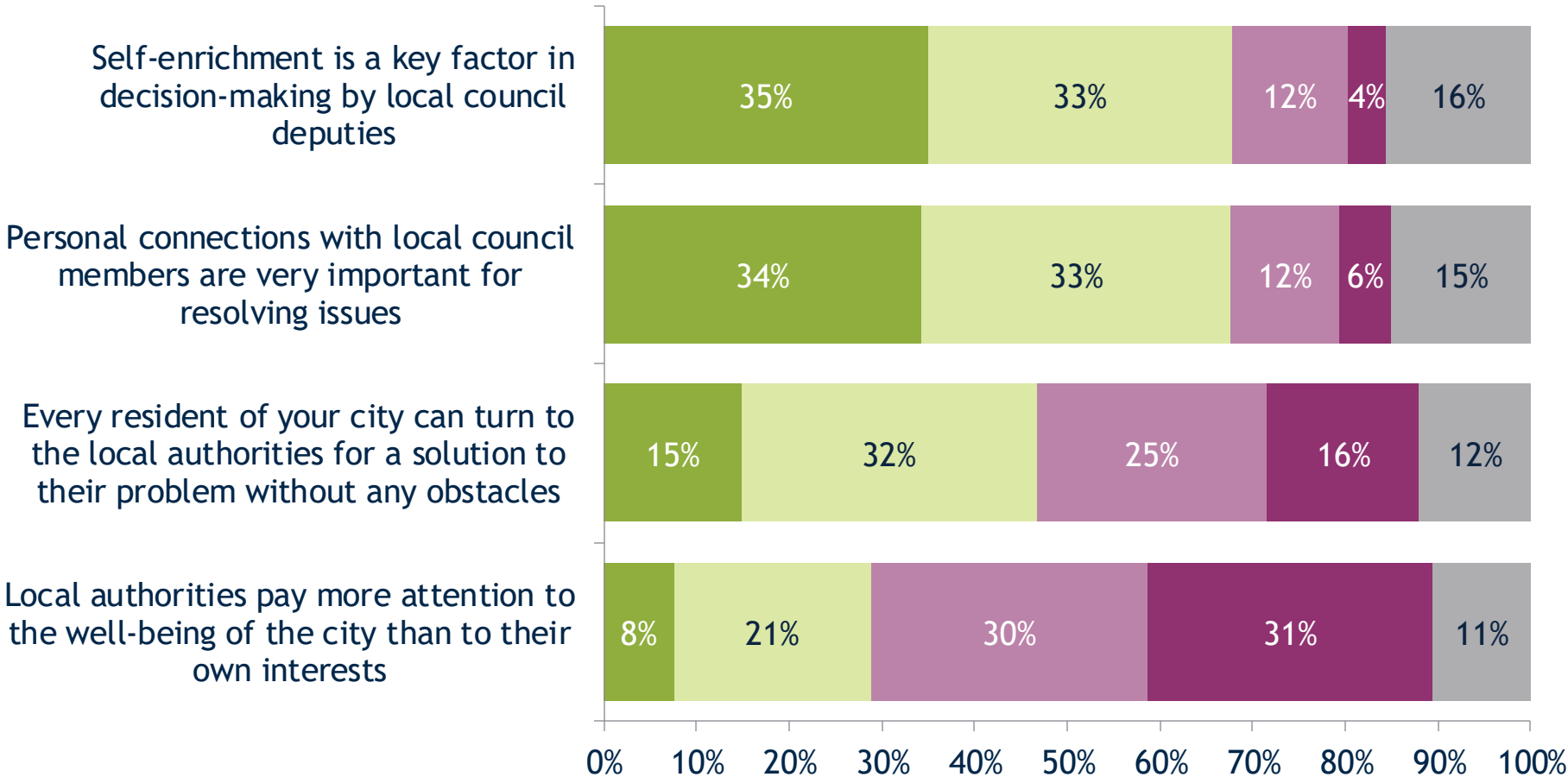

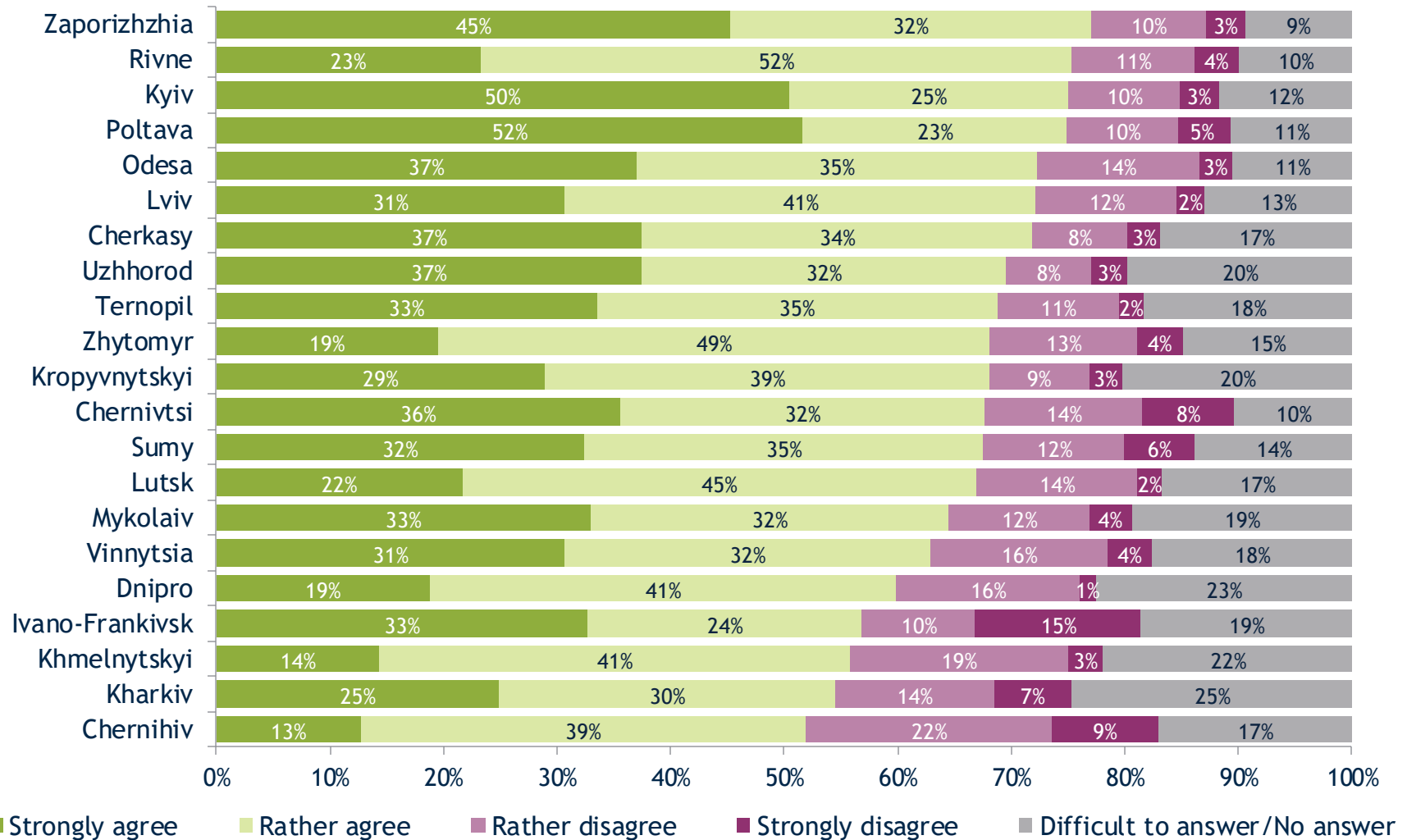

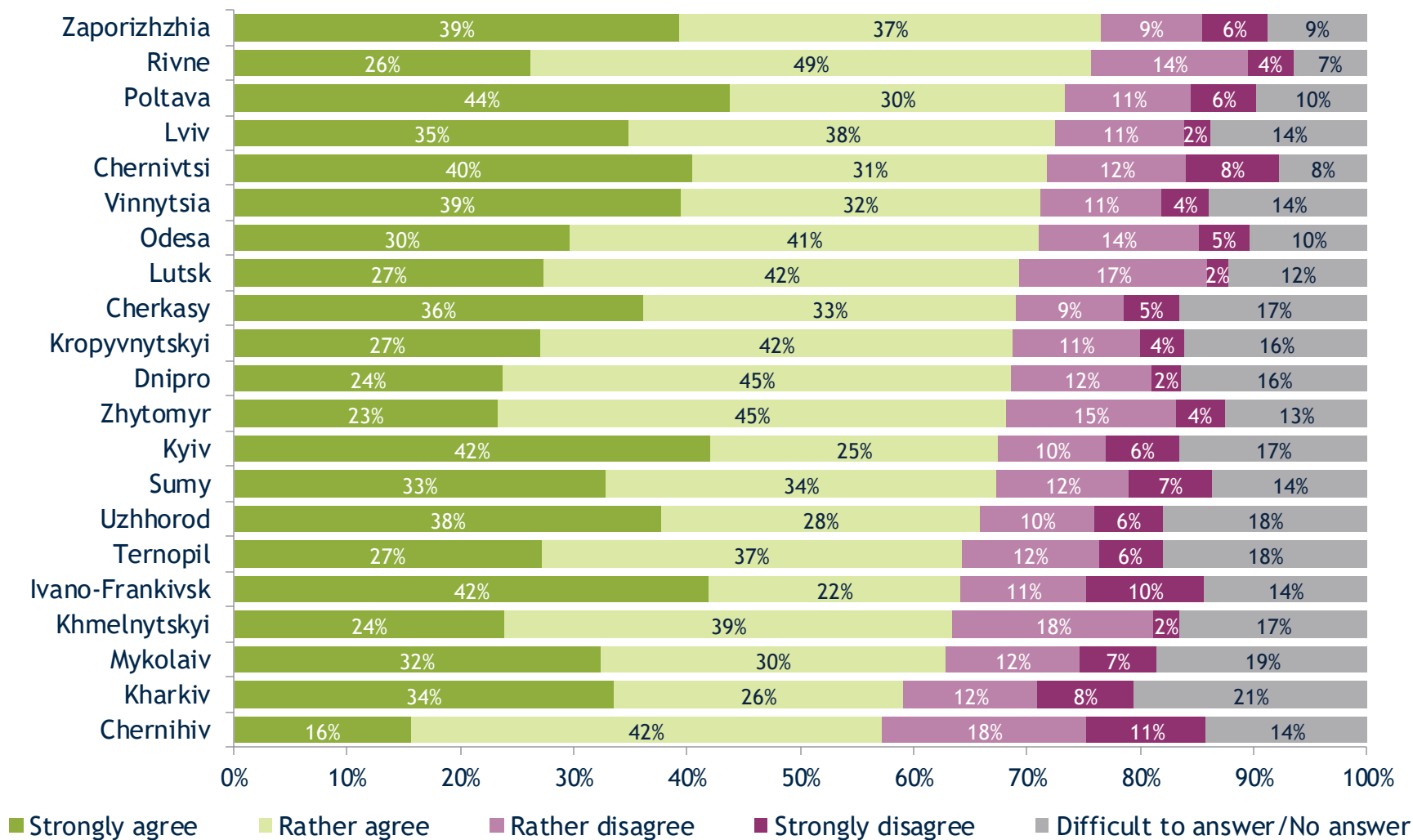

Self-enrichment is a key factor in decision-making by local council deputies



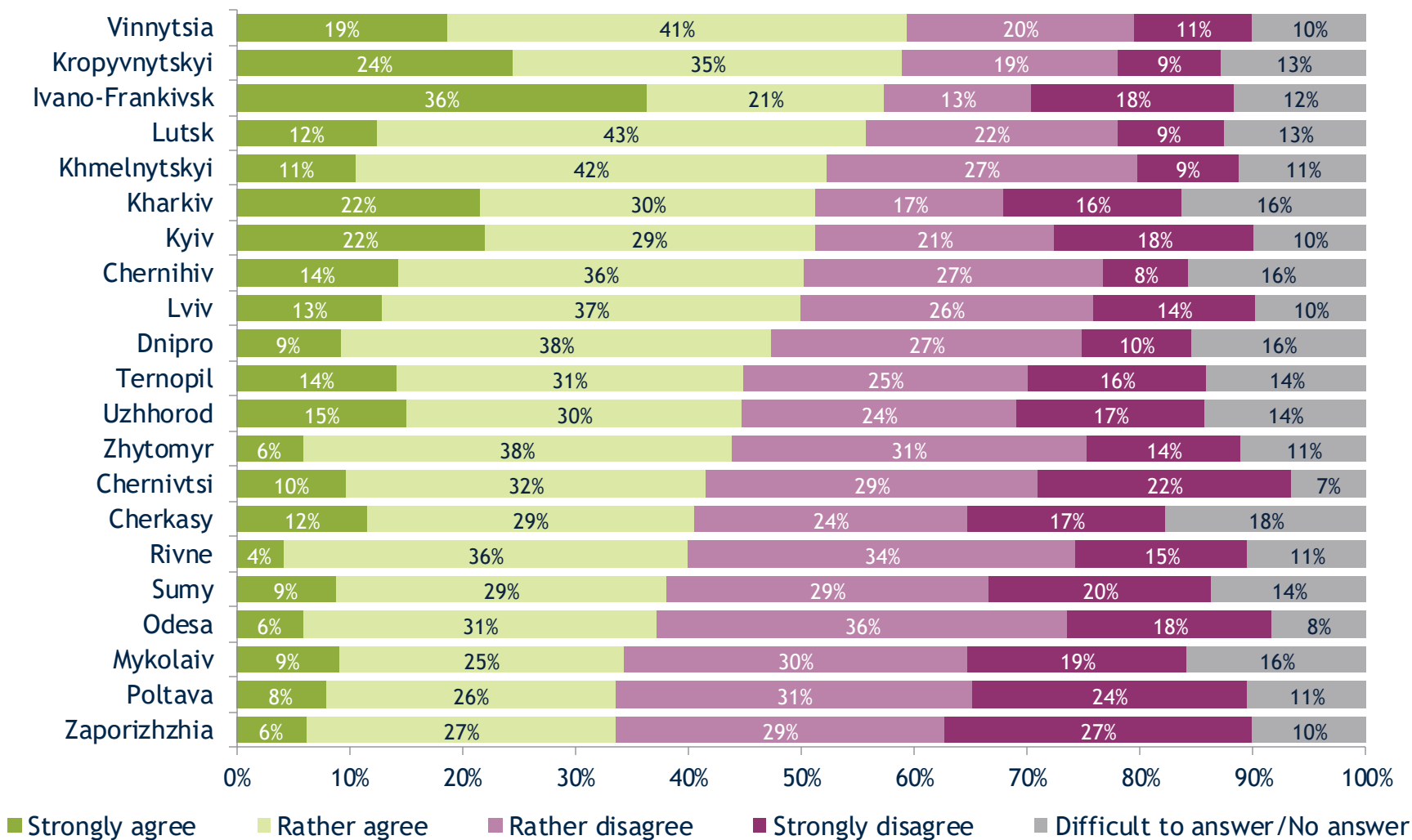
# To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements?

Personal connections with local council members are very important for resolving issues



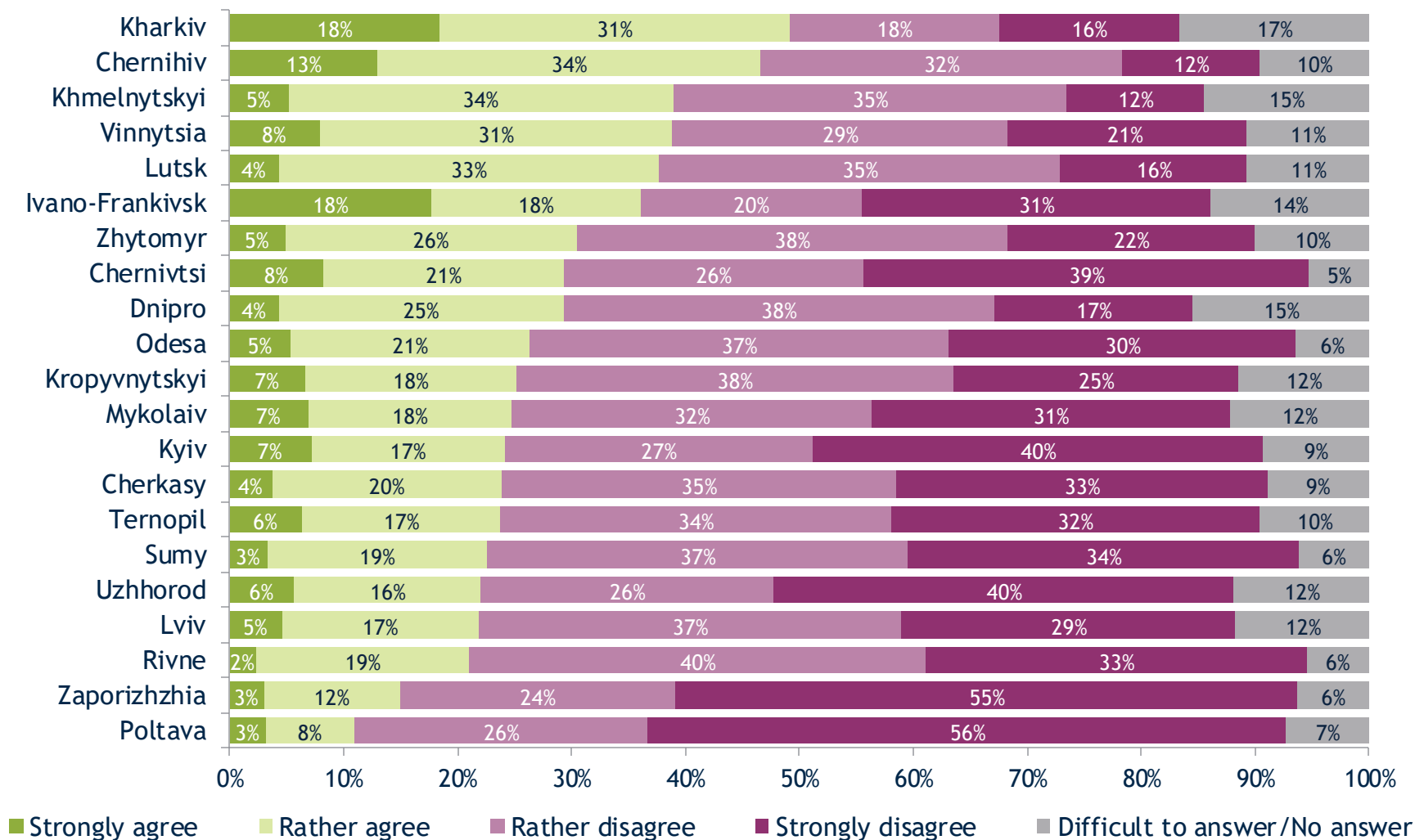

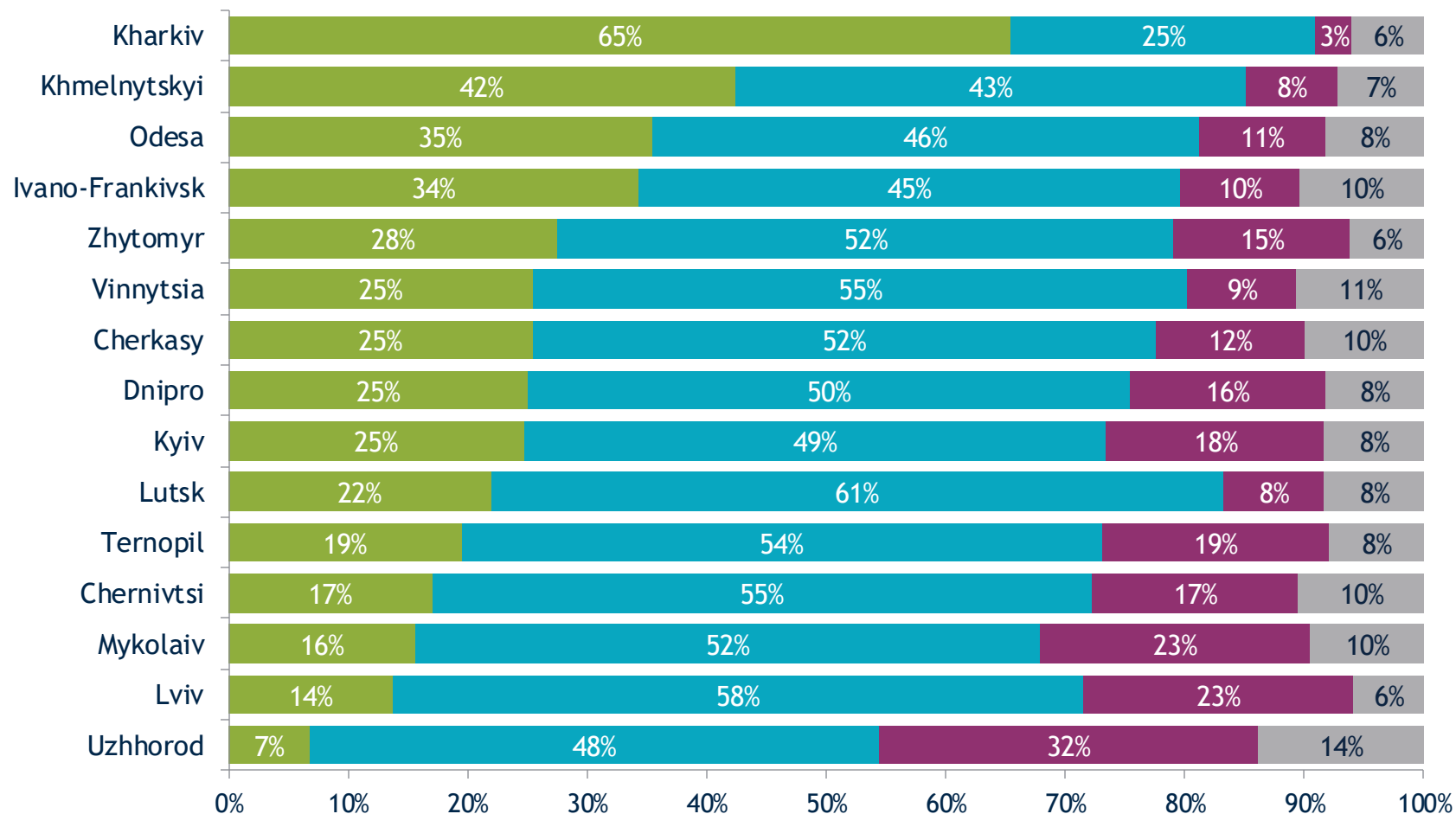

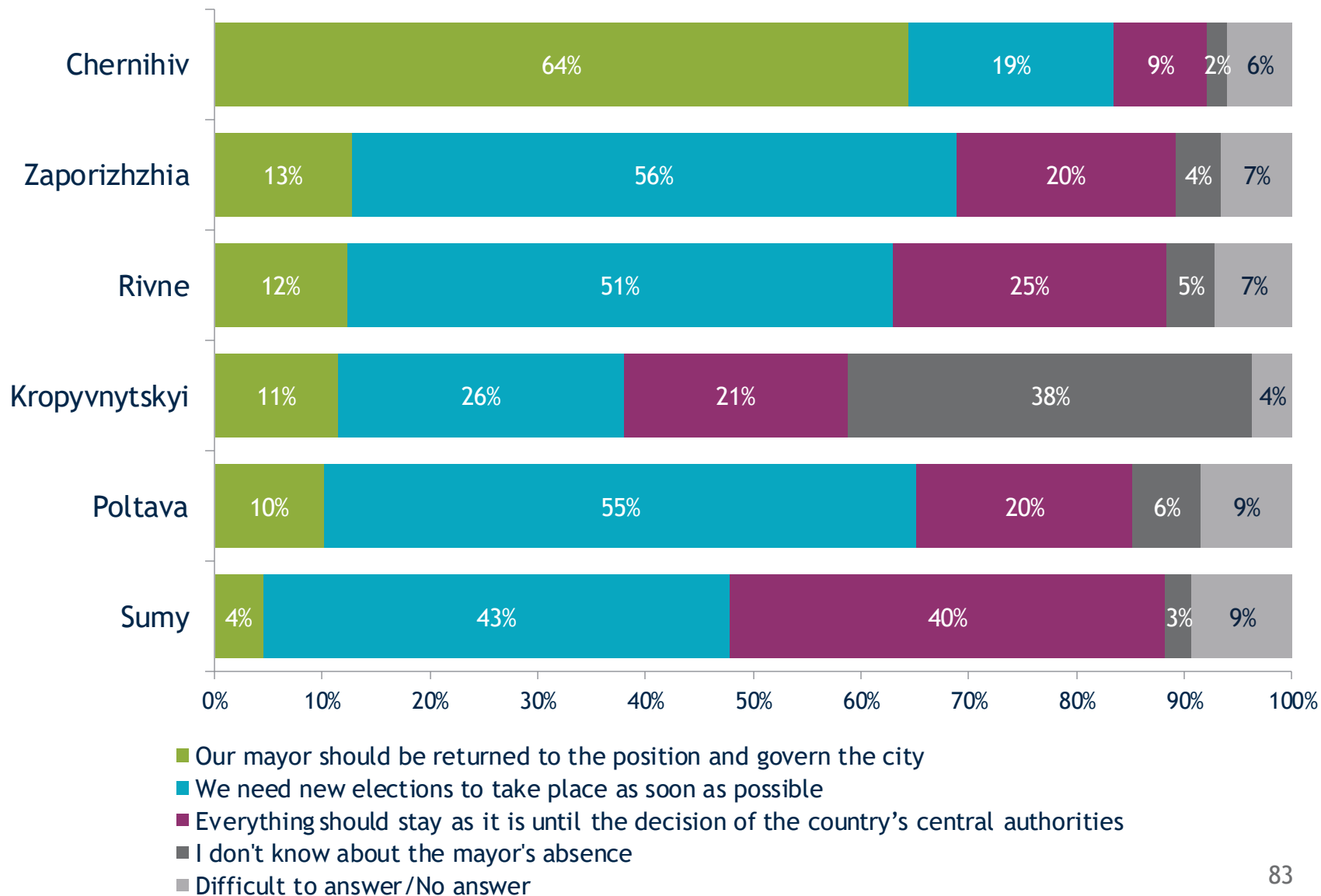

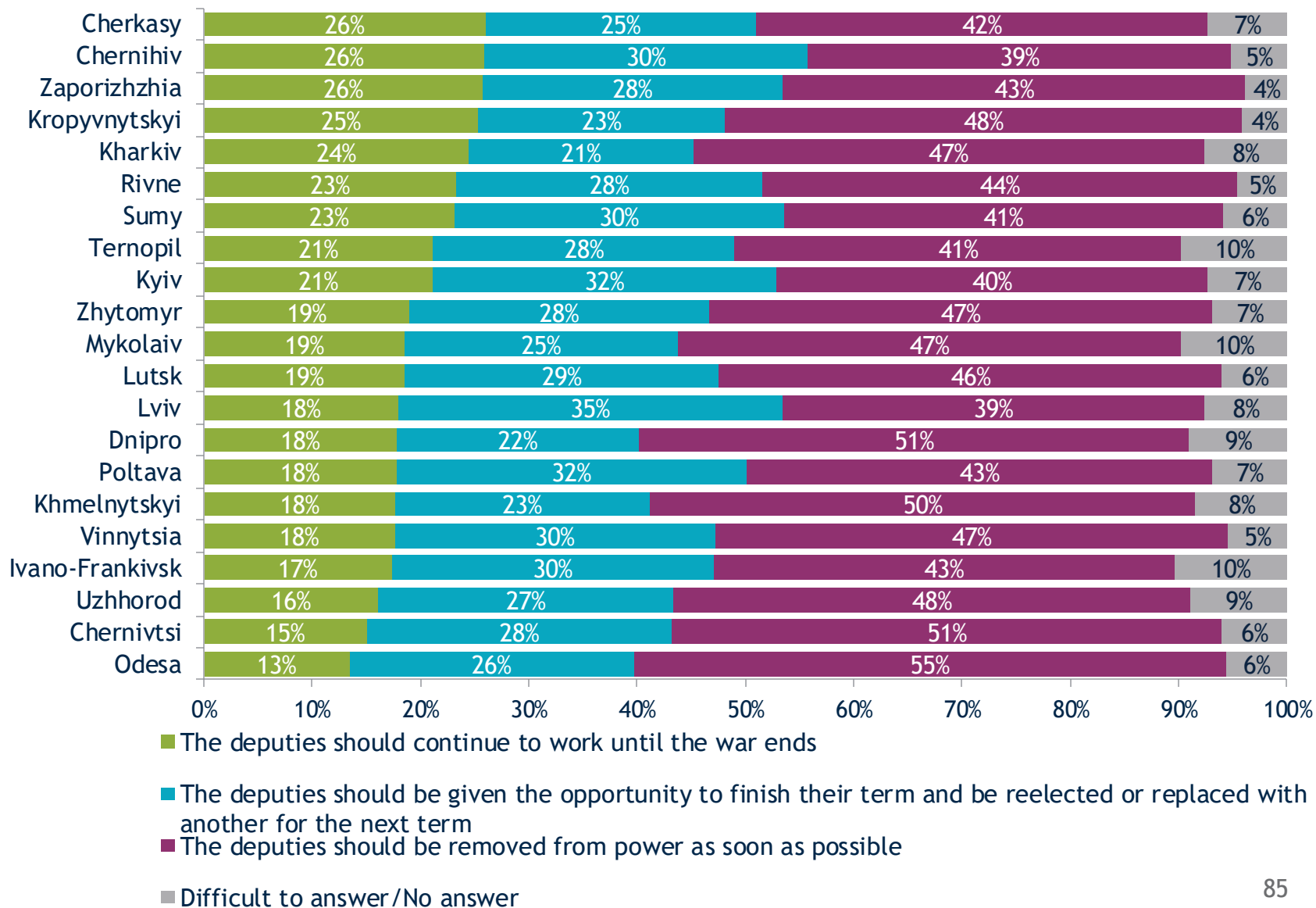

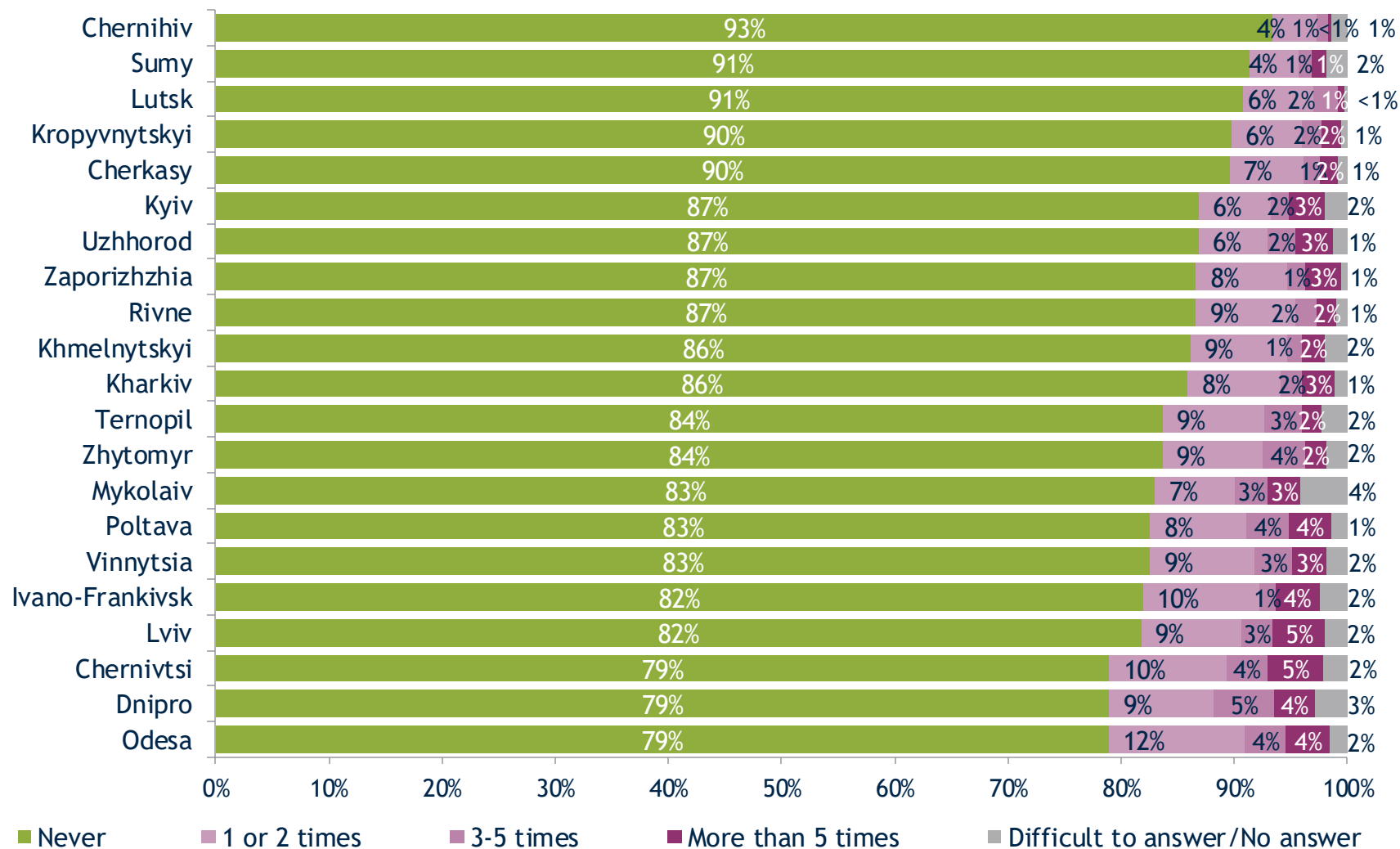

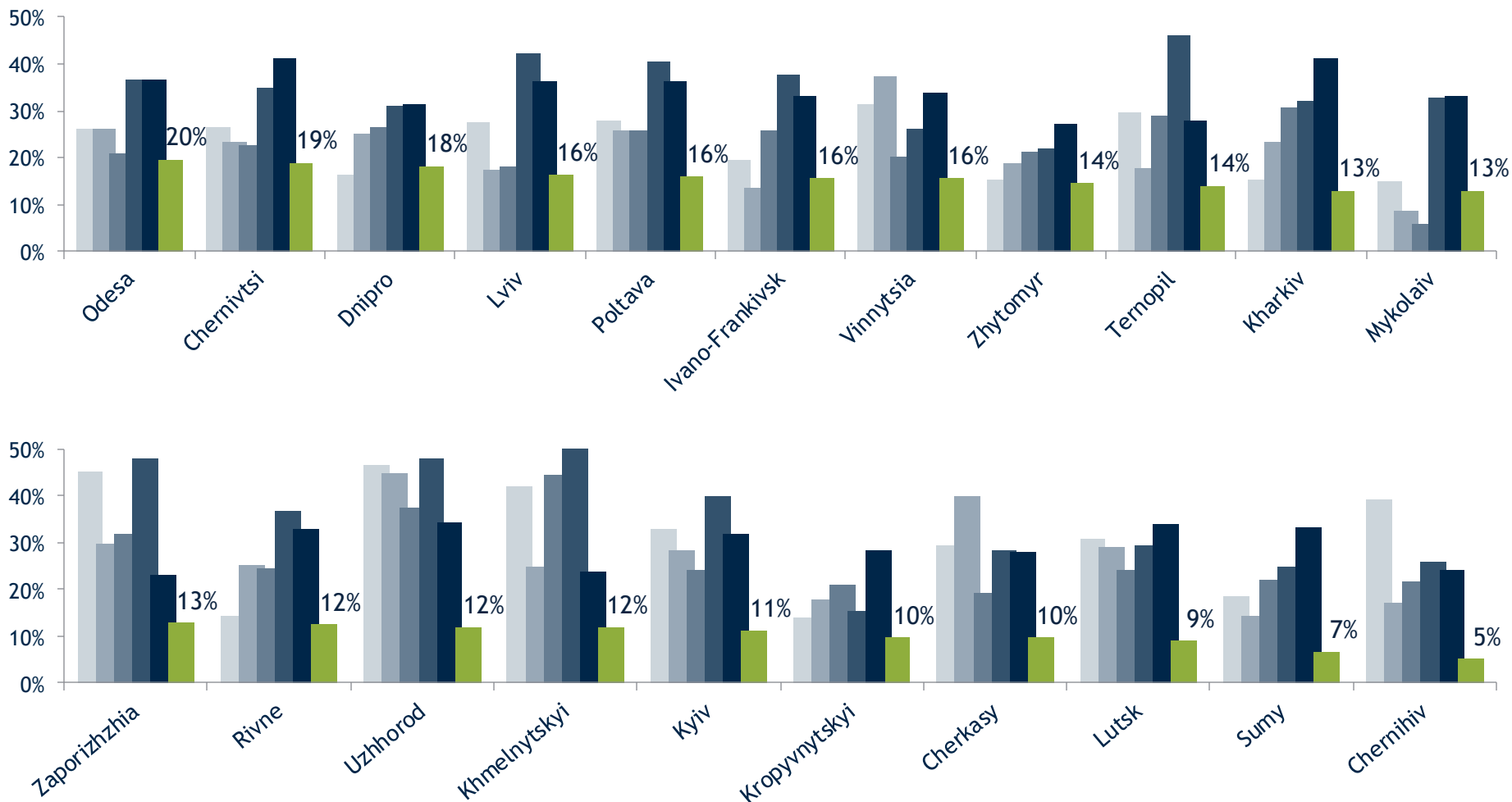

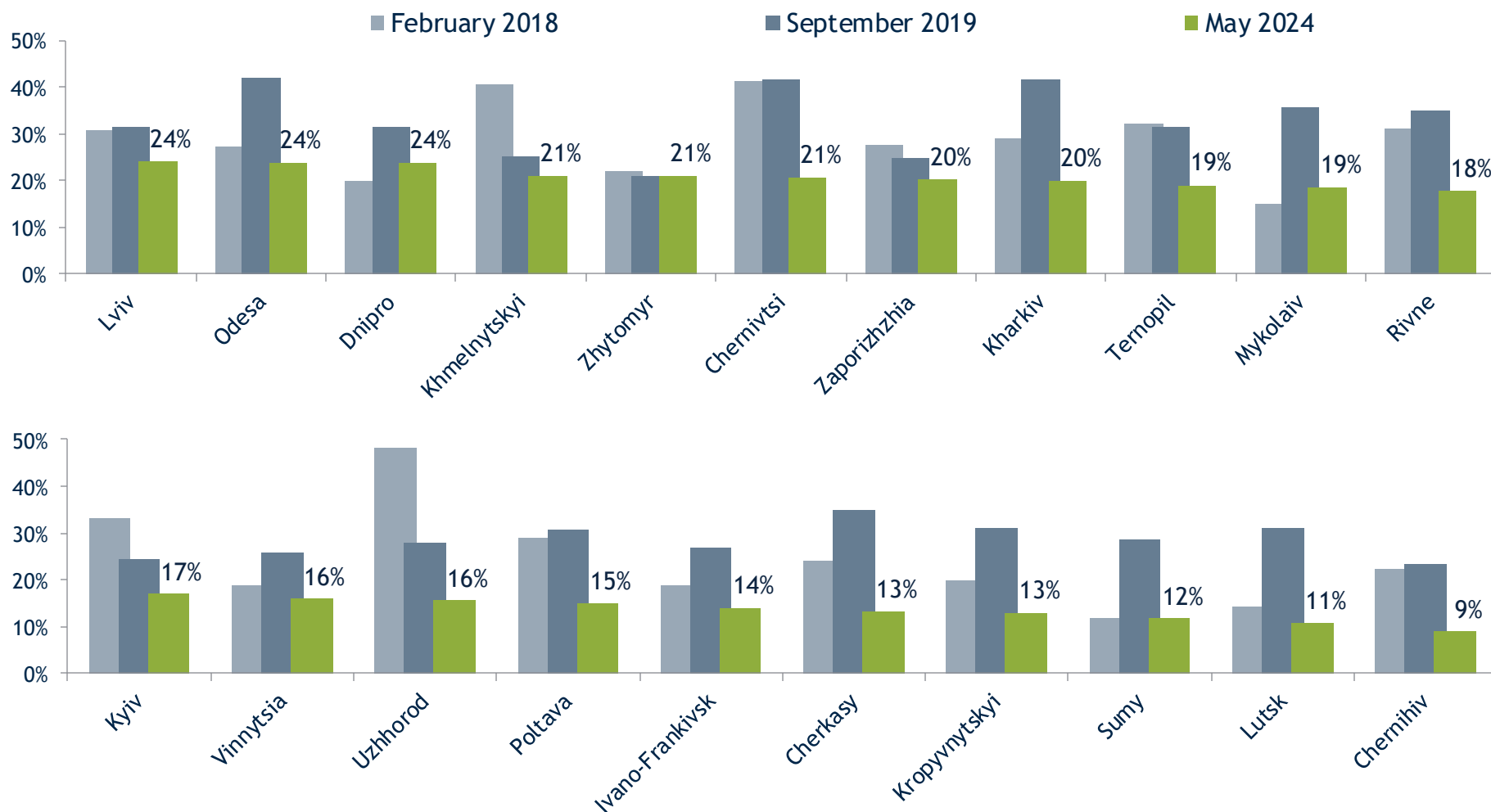

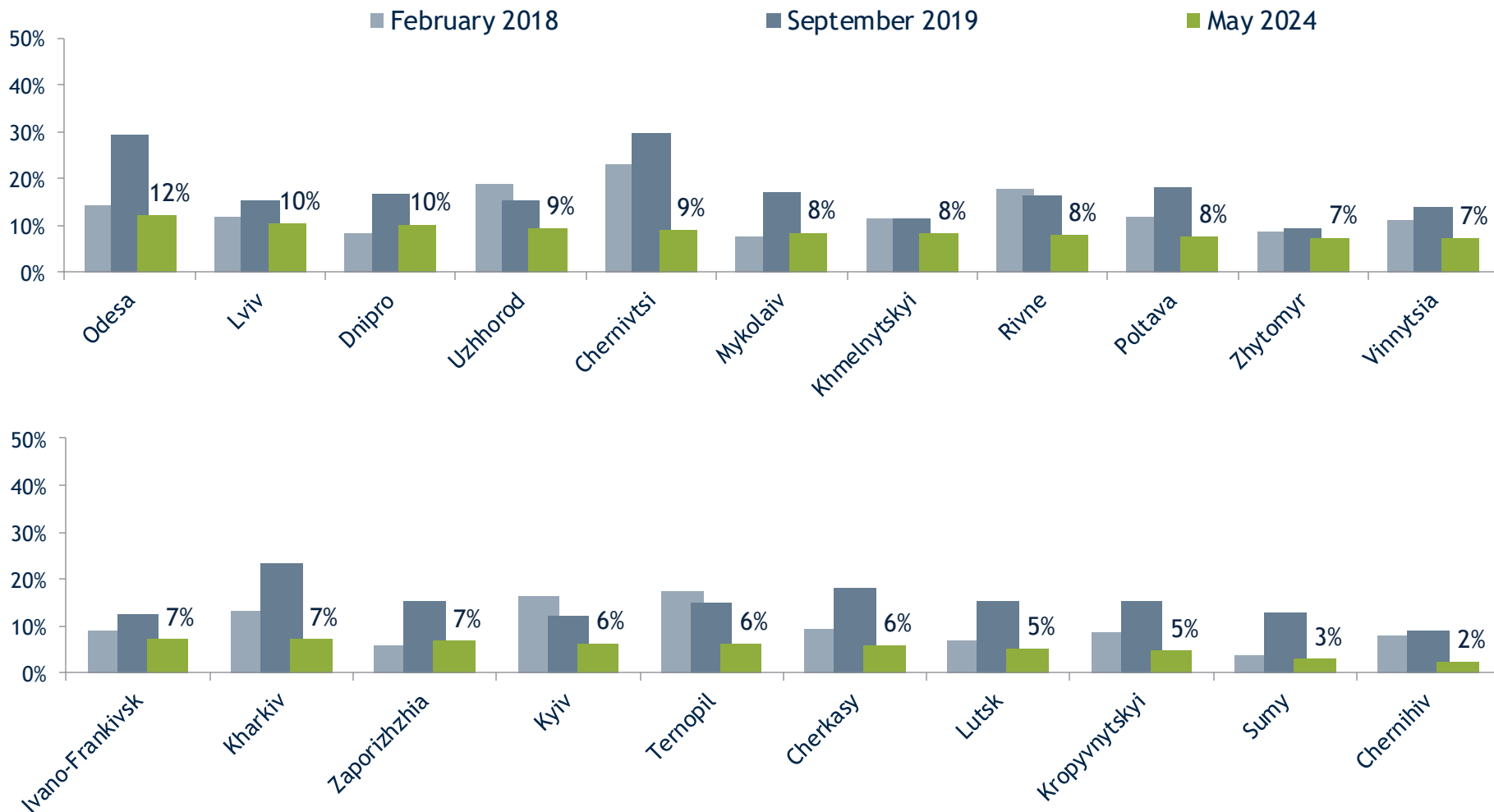

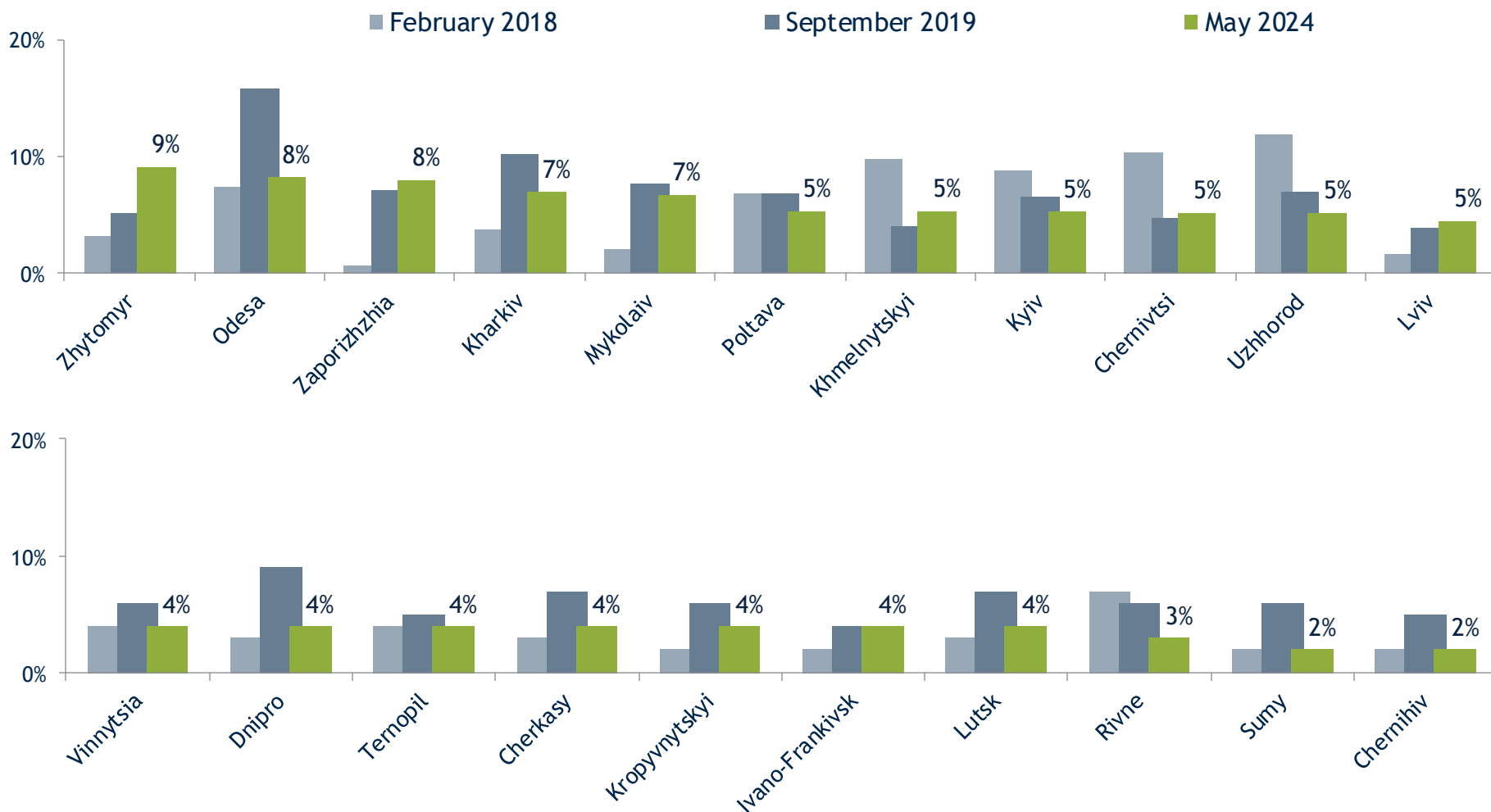

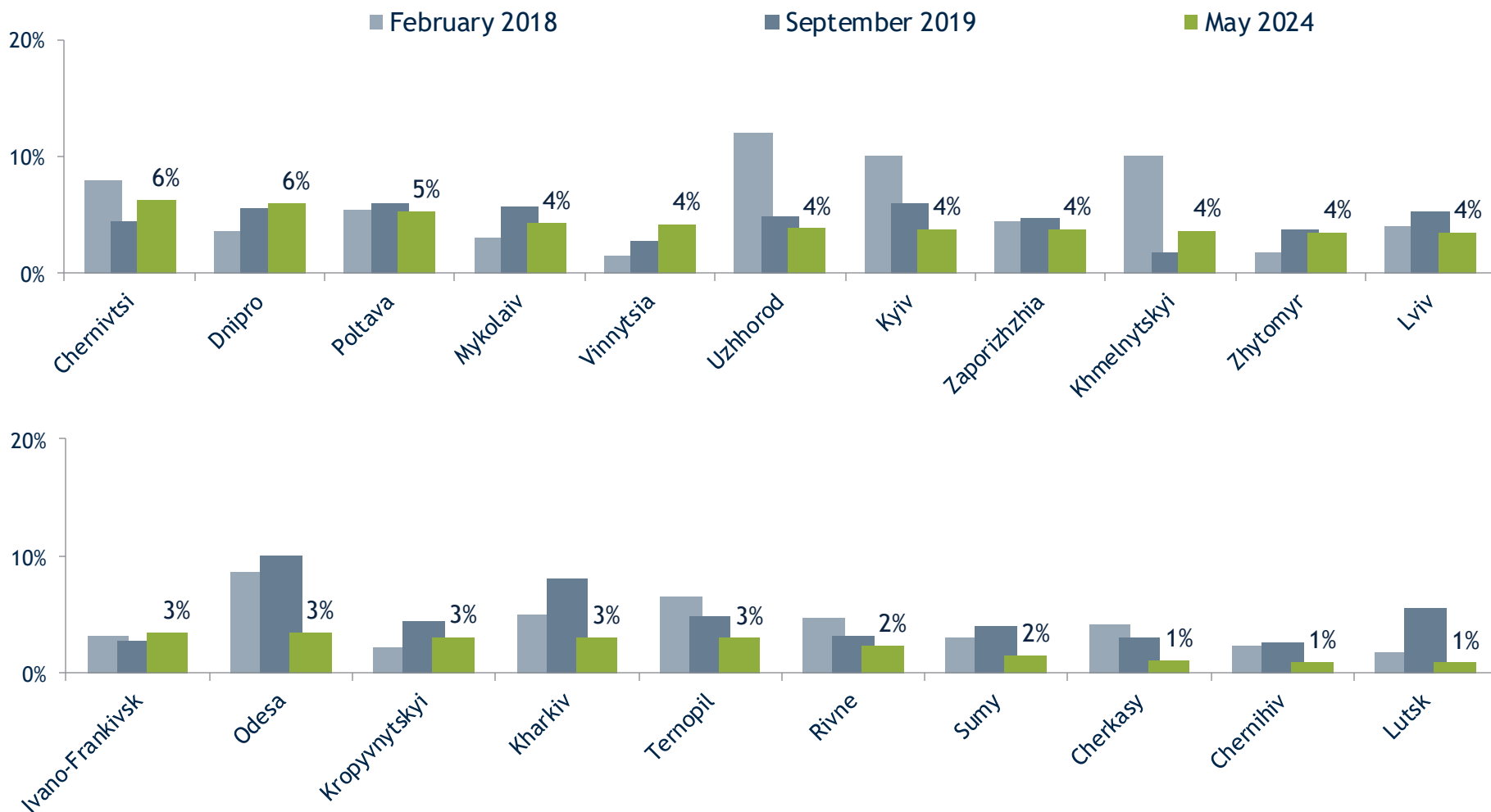

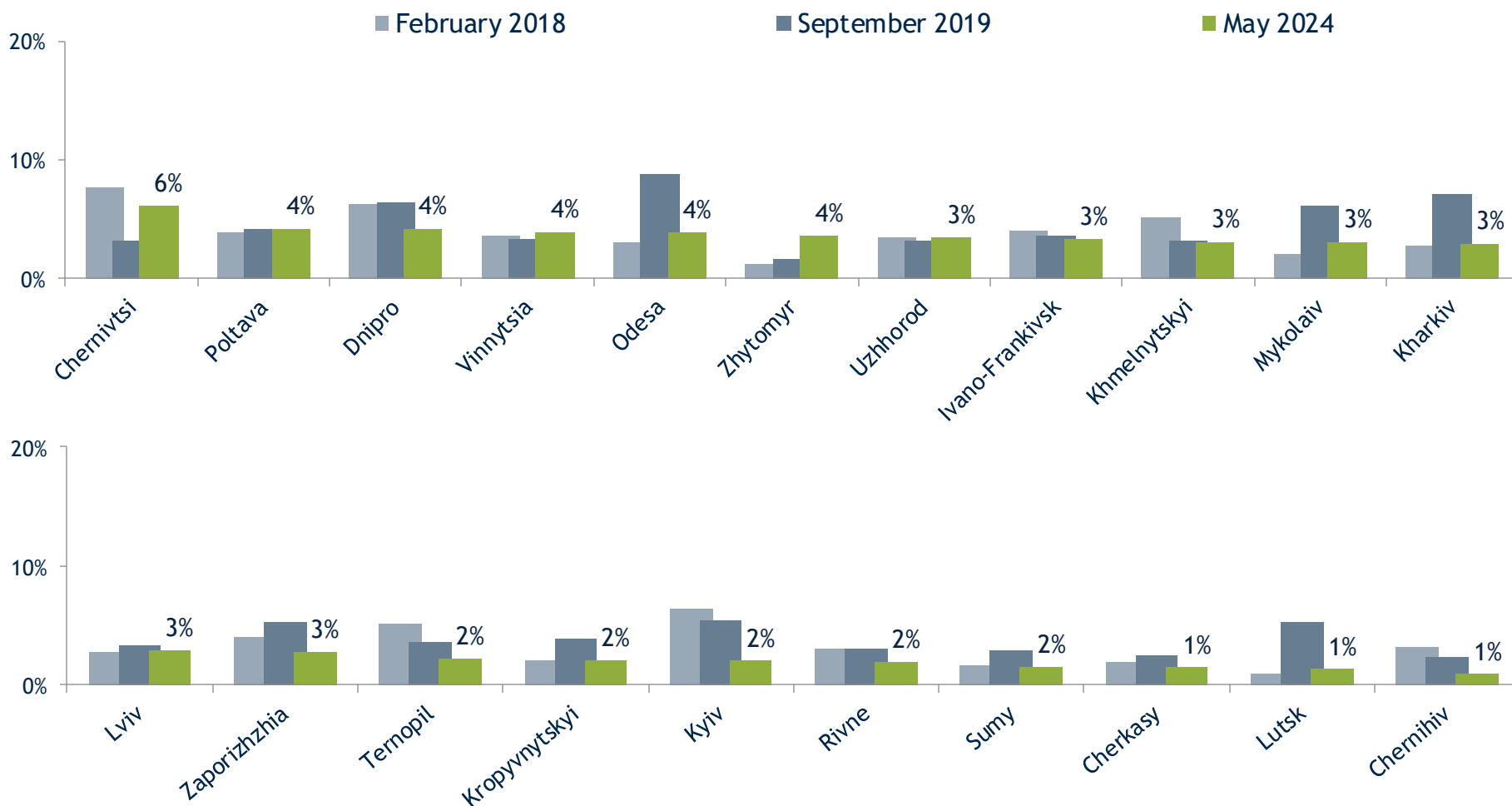

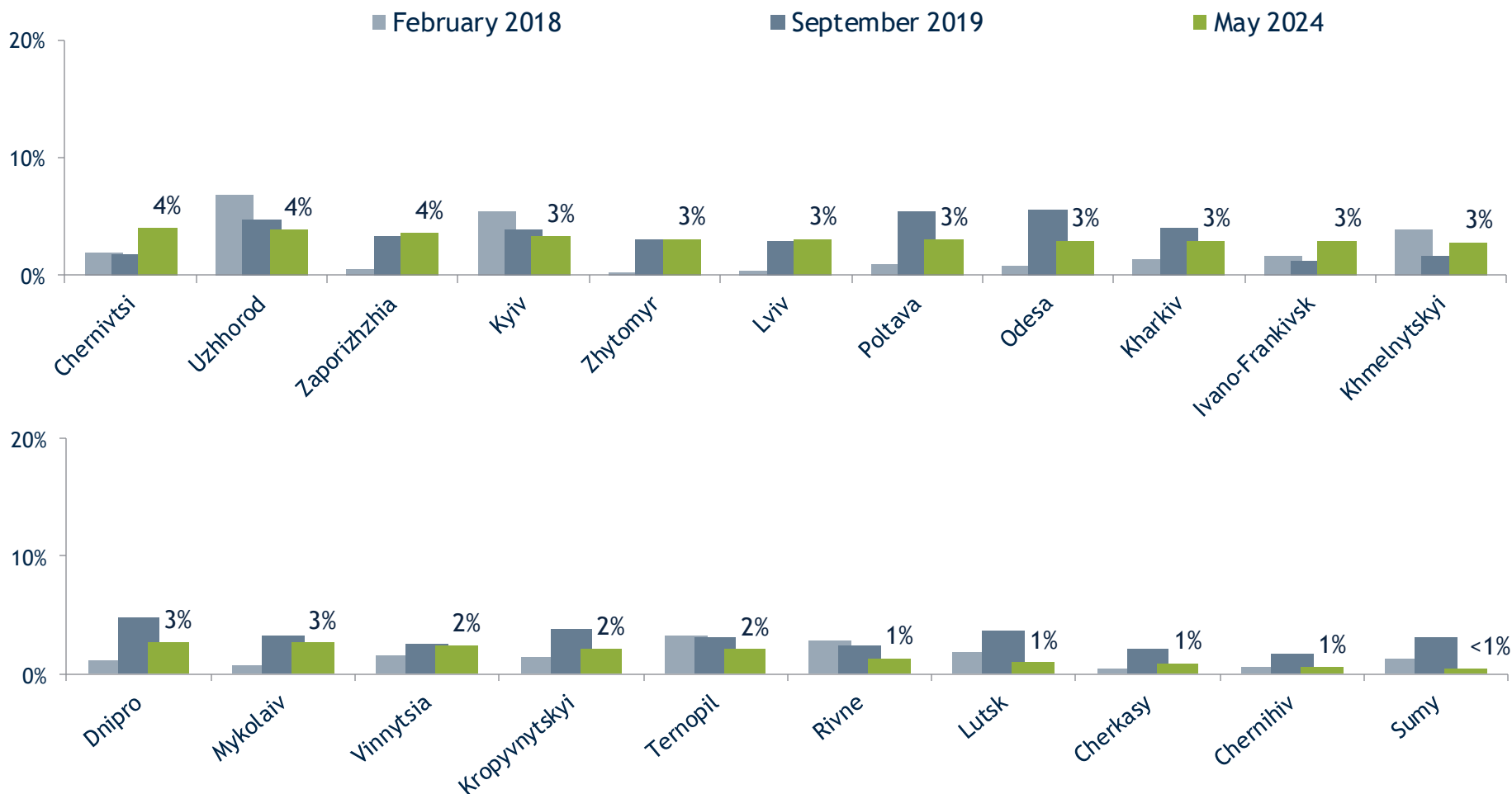

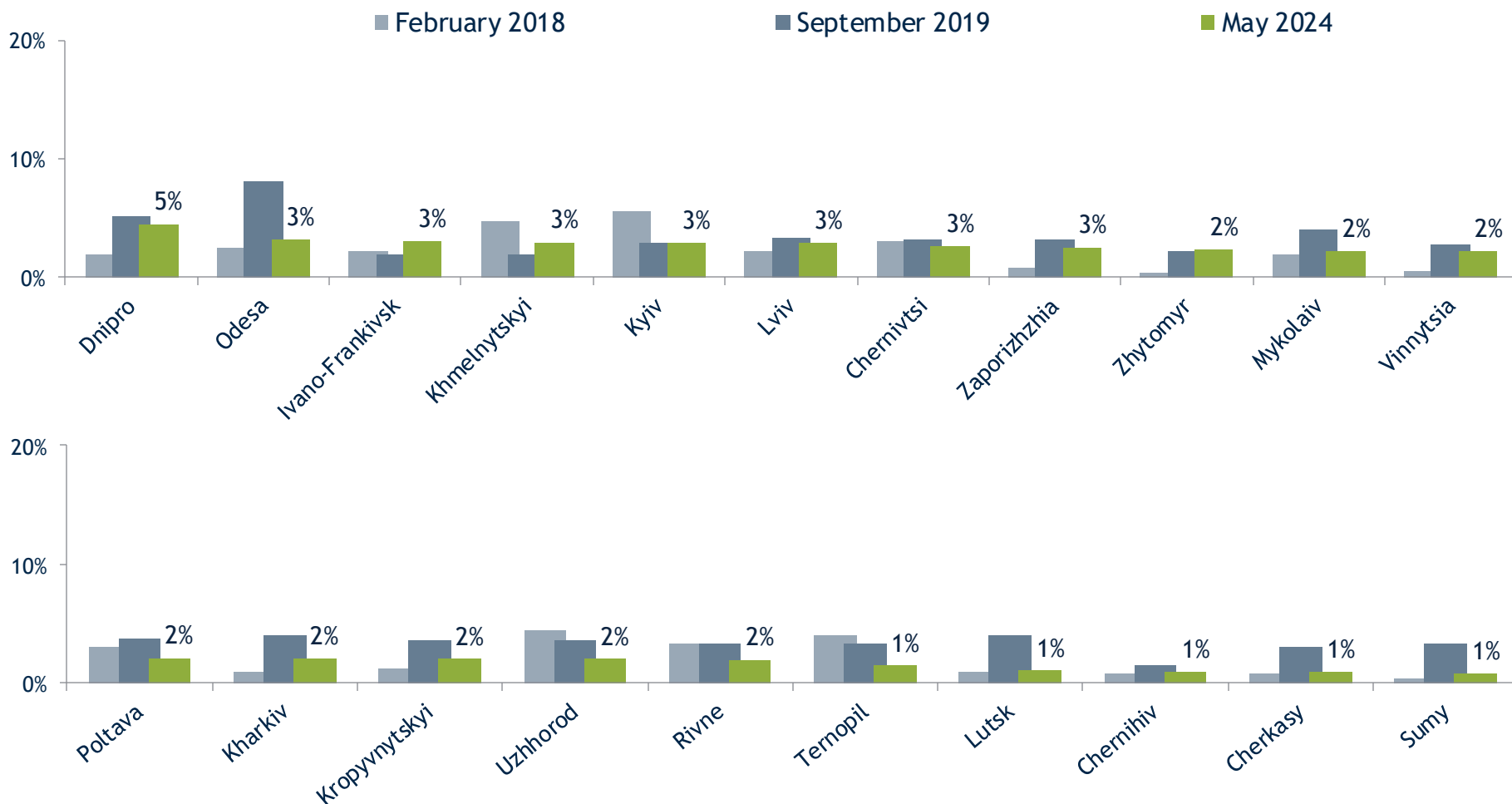

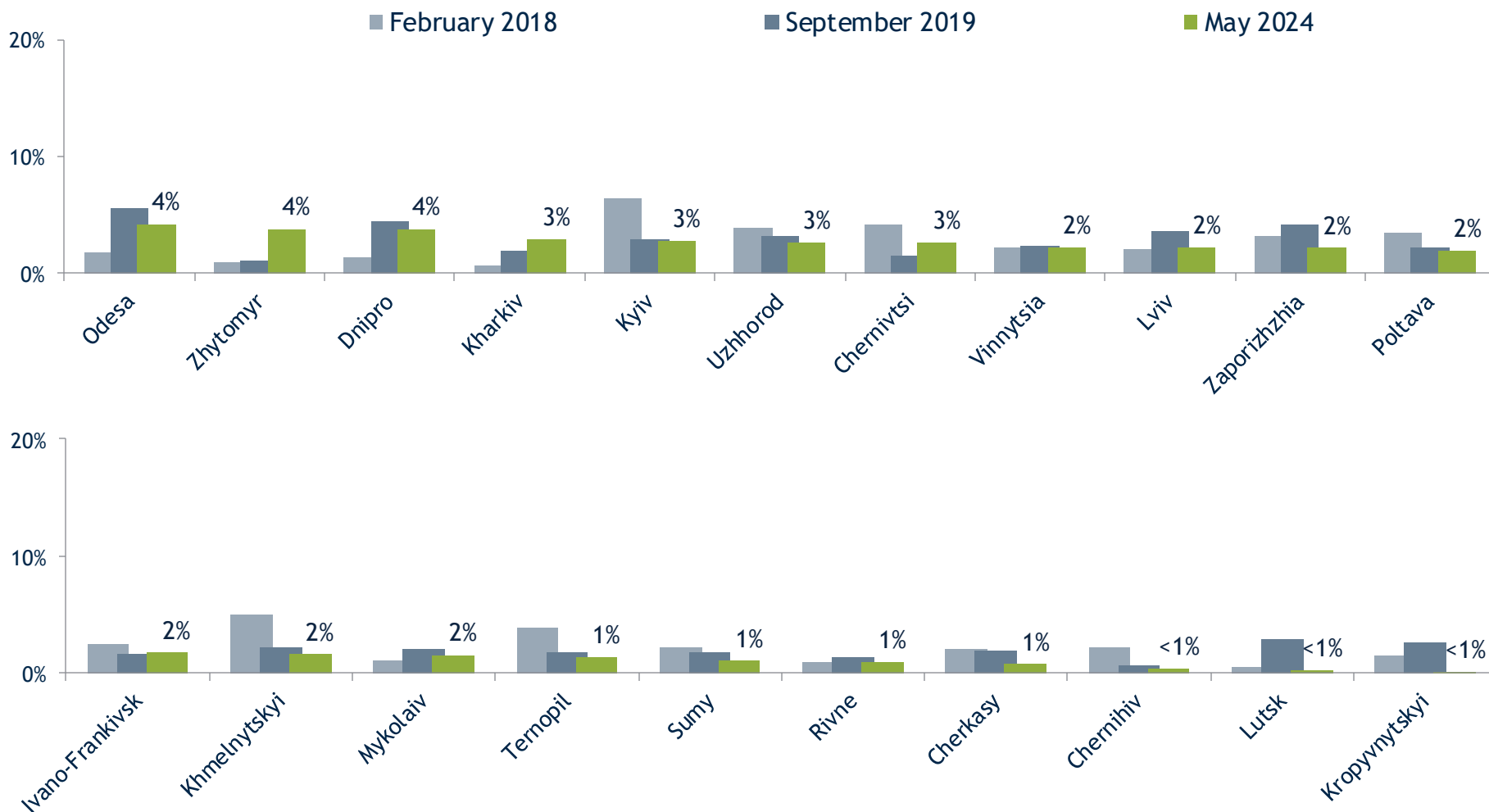

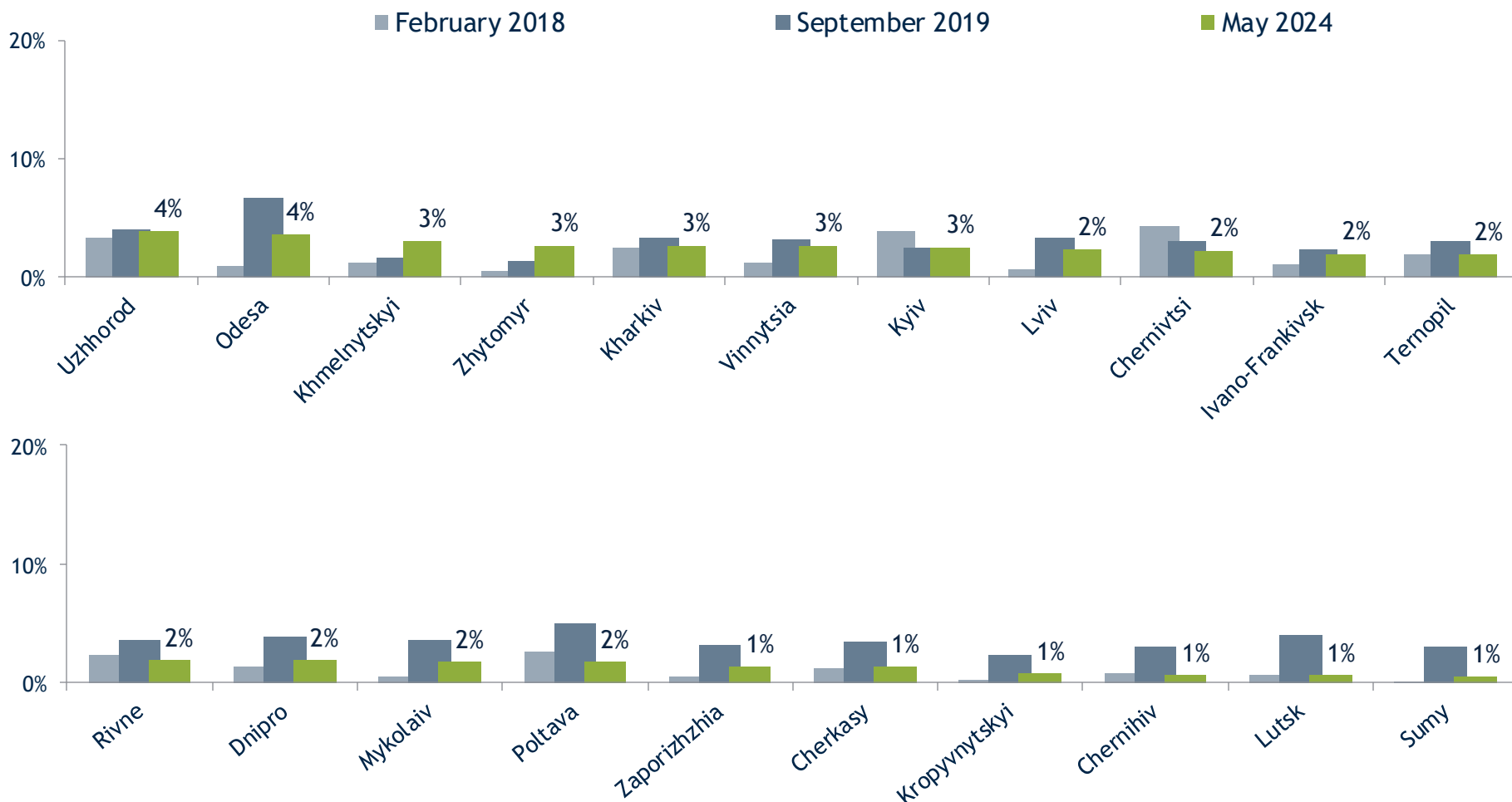

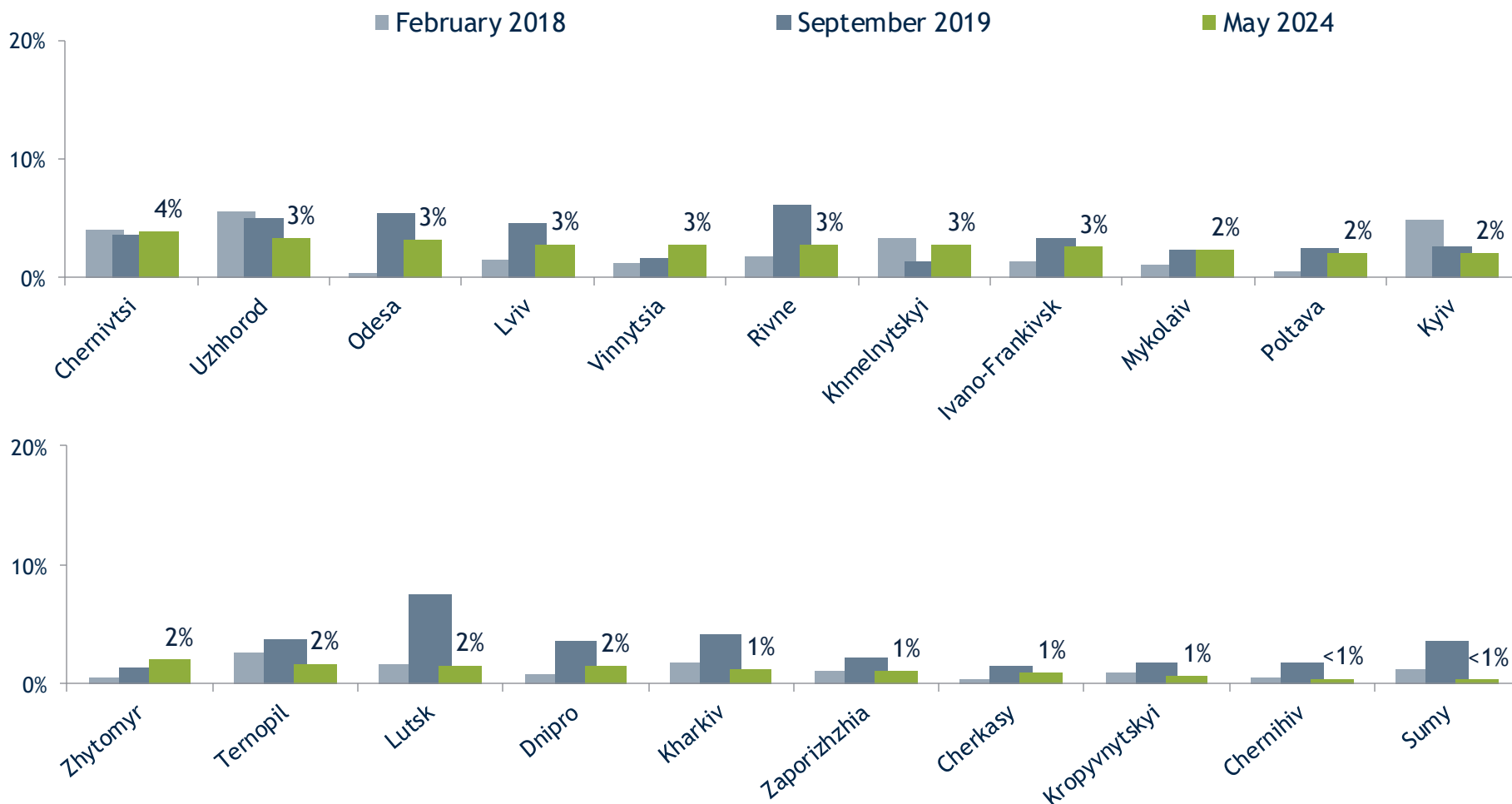

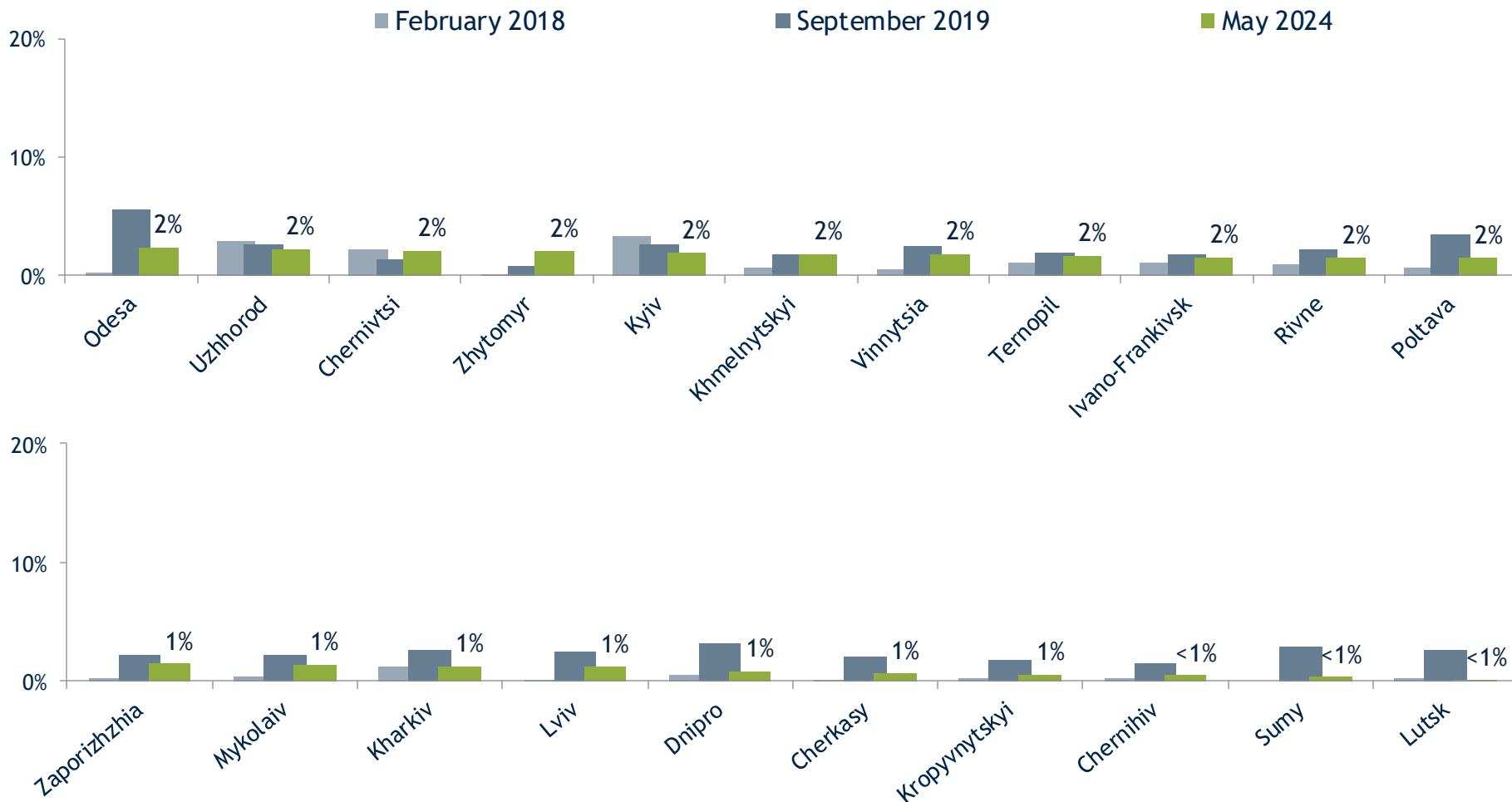

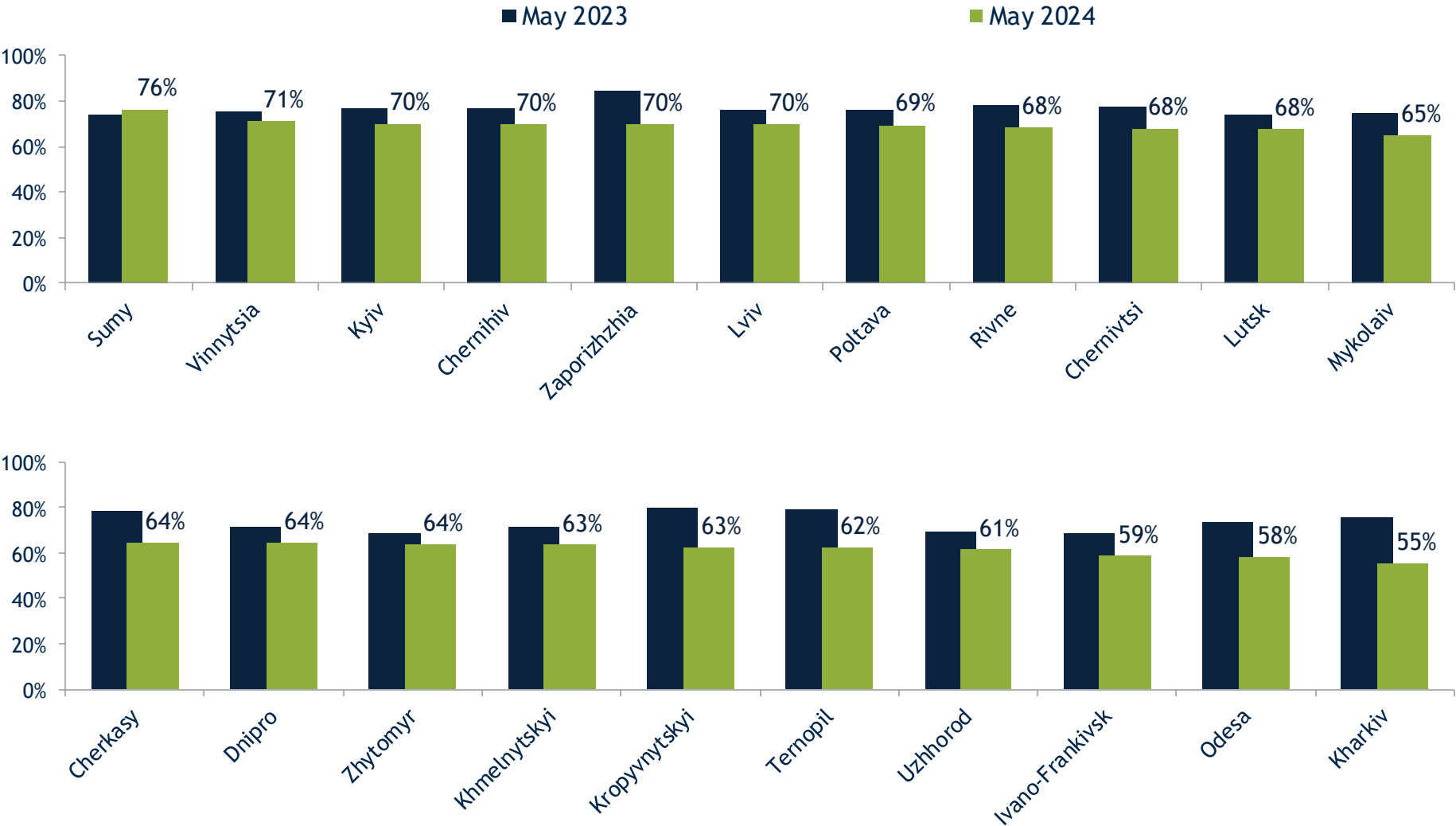
# To what extent are you interested or not interested in understanding how much money the local government received for reconstruction and how they spent those funds?





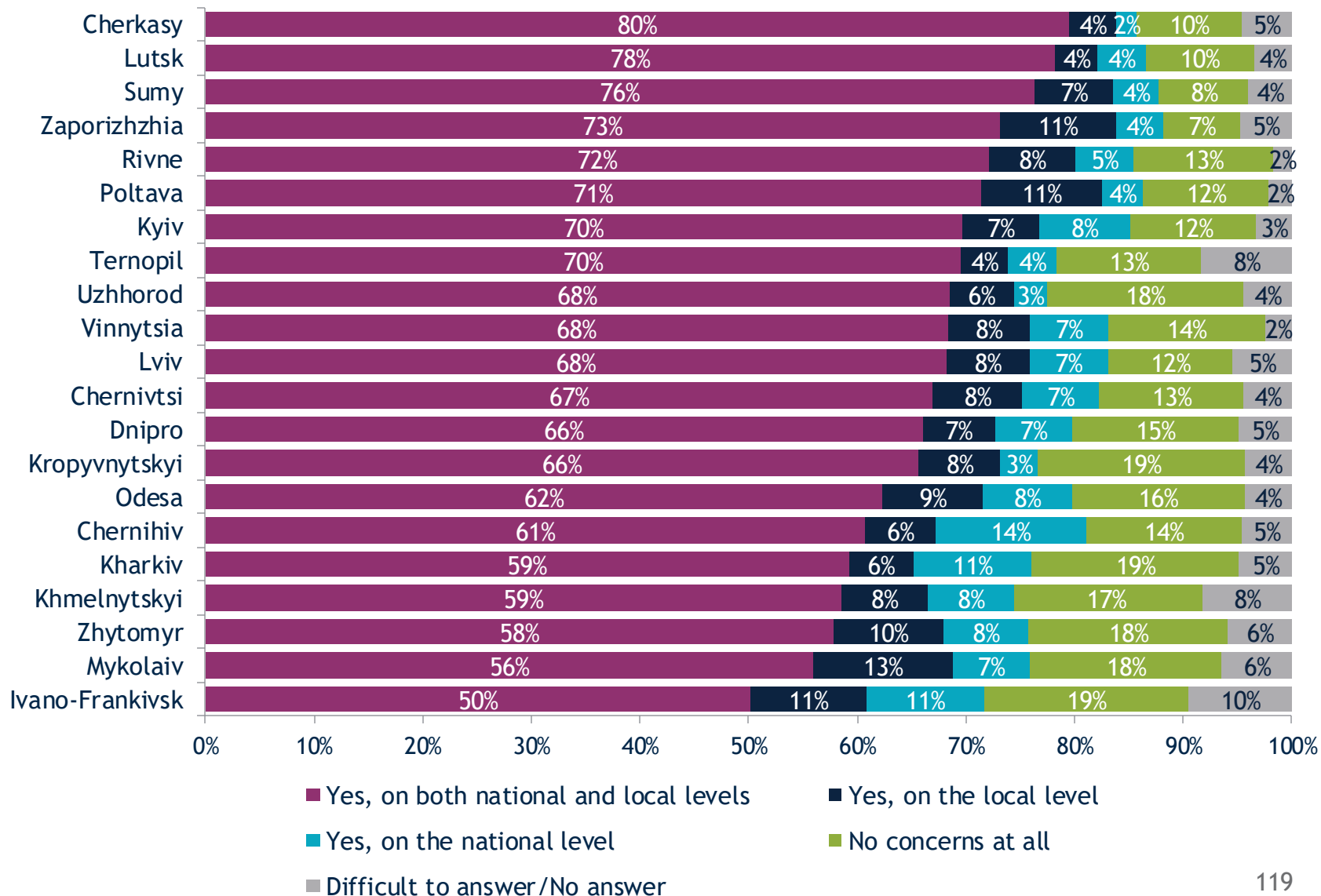

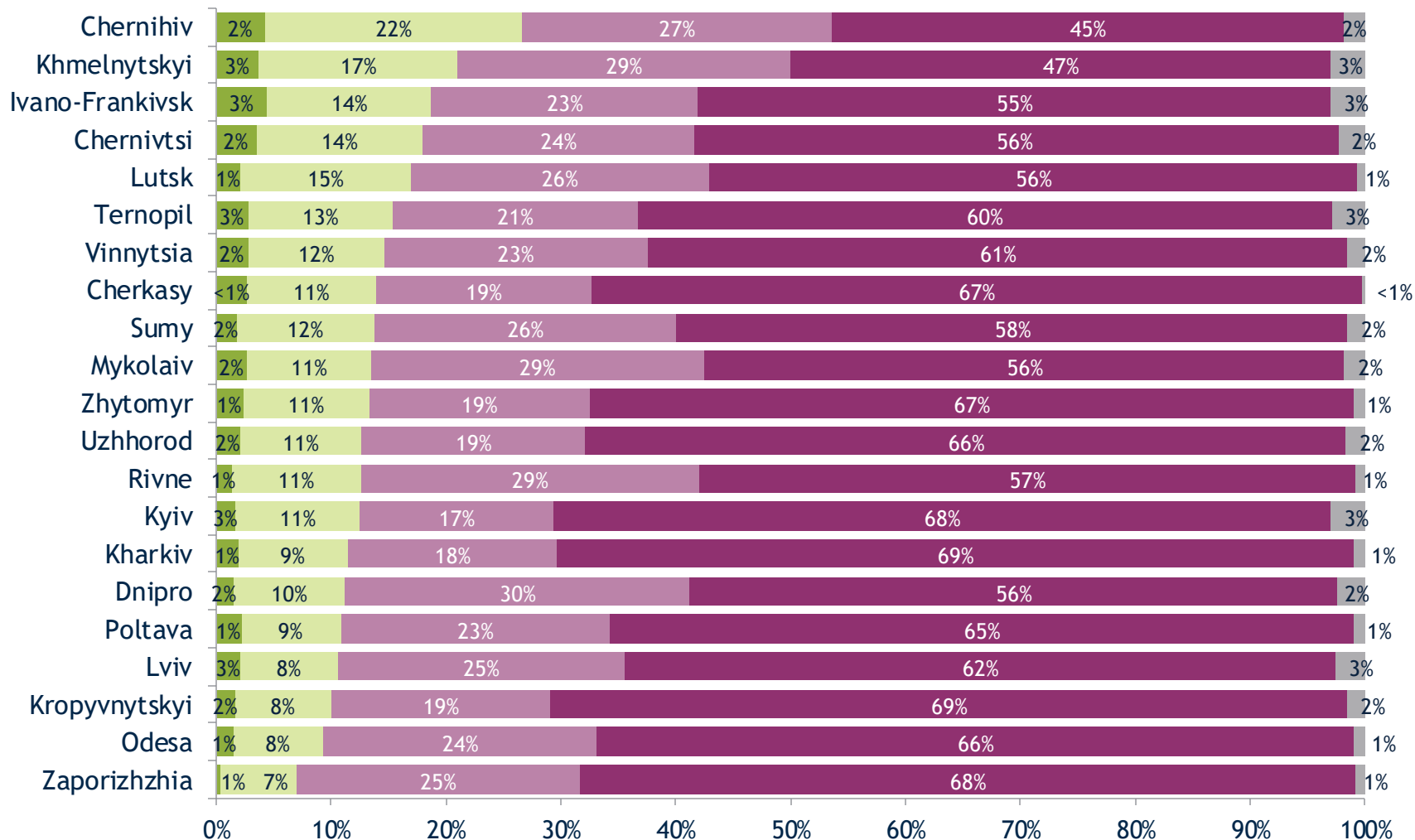


# To what extent has your city's economy adapted or not adapted to the conditions of war?

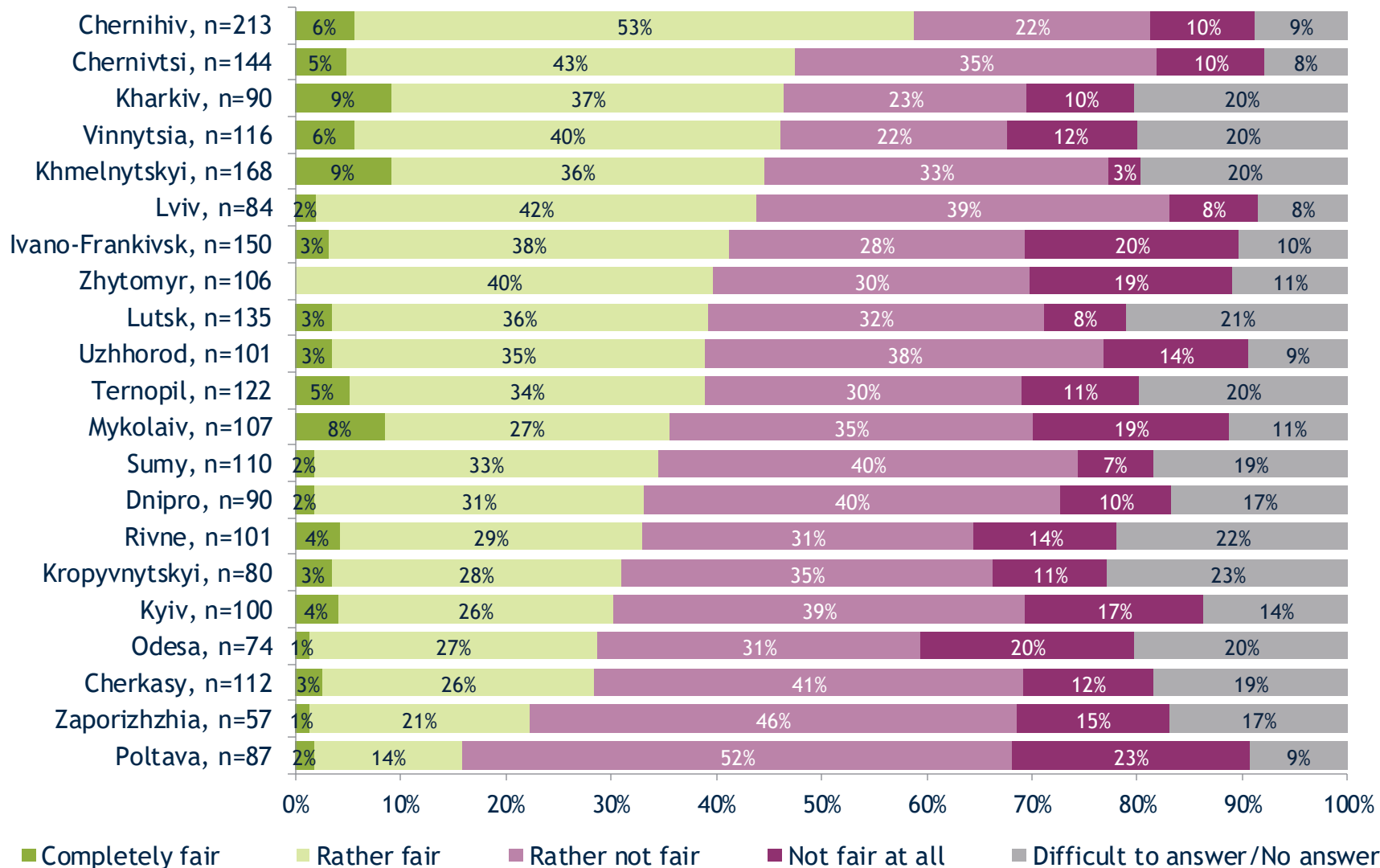
# To what extent do you consider yourself to be informed or not informed about the activities of the local budget distribution in your city?

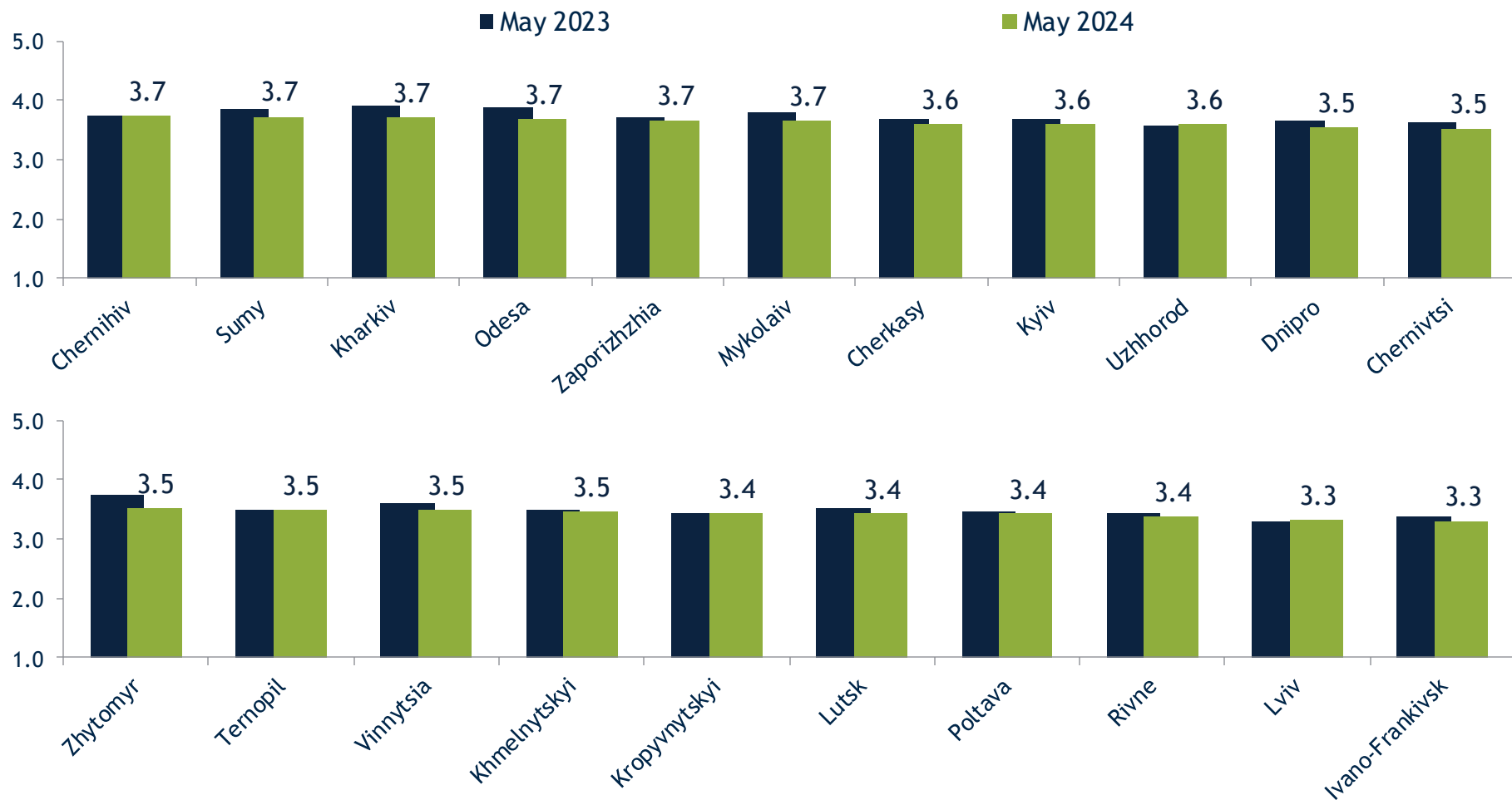

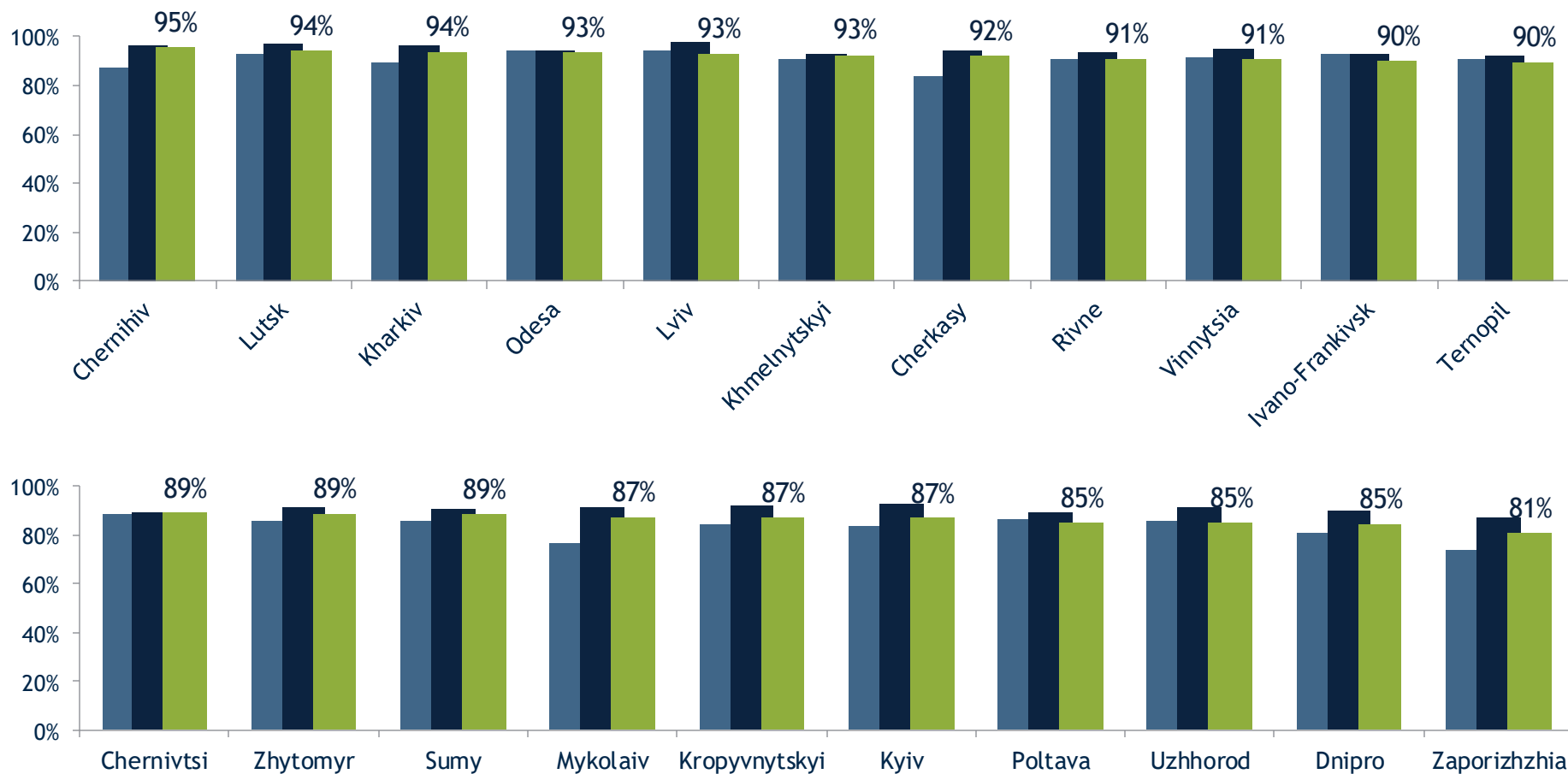

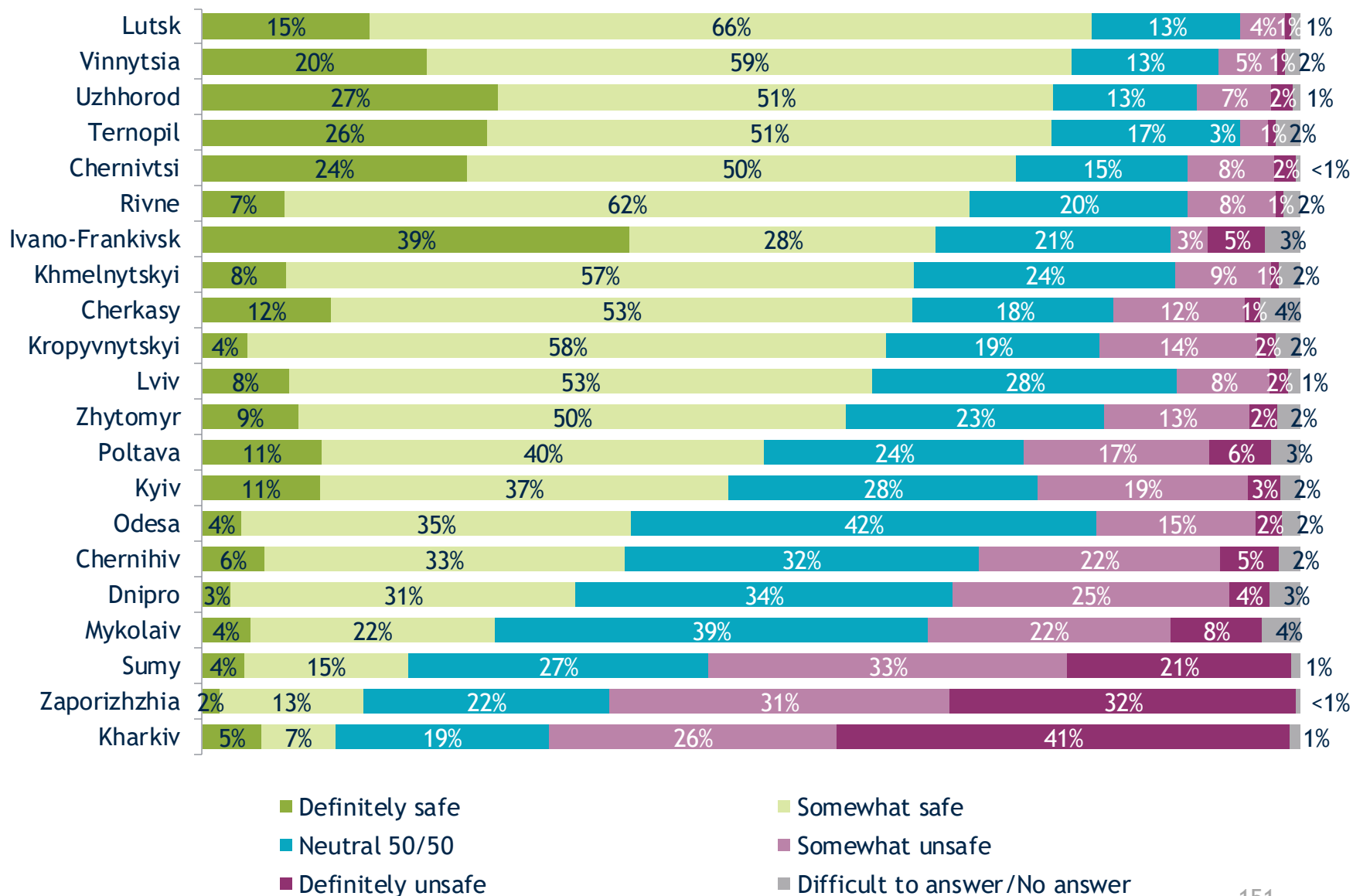

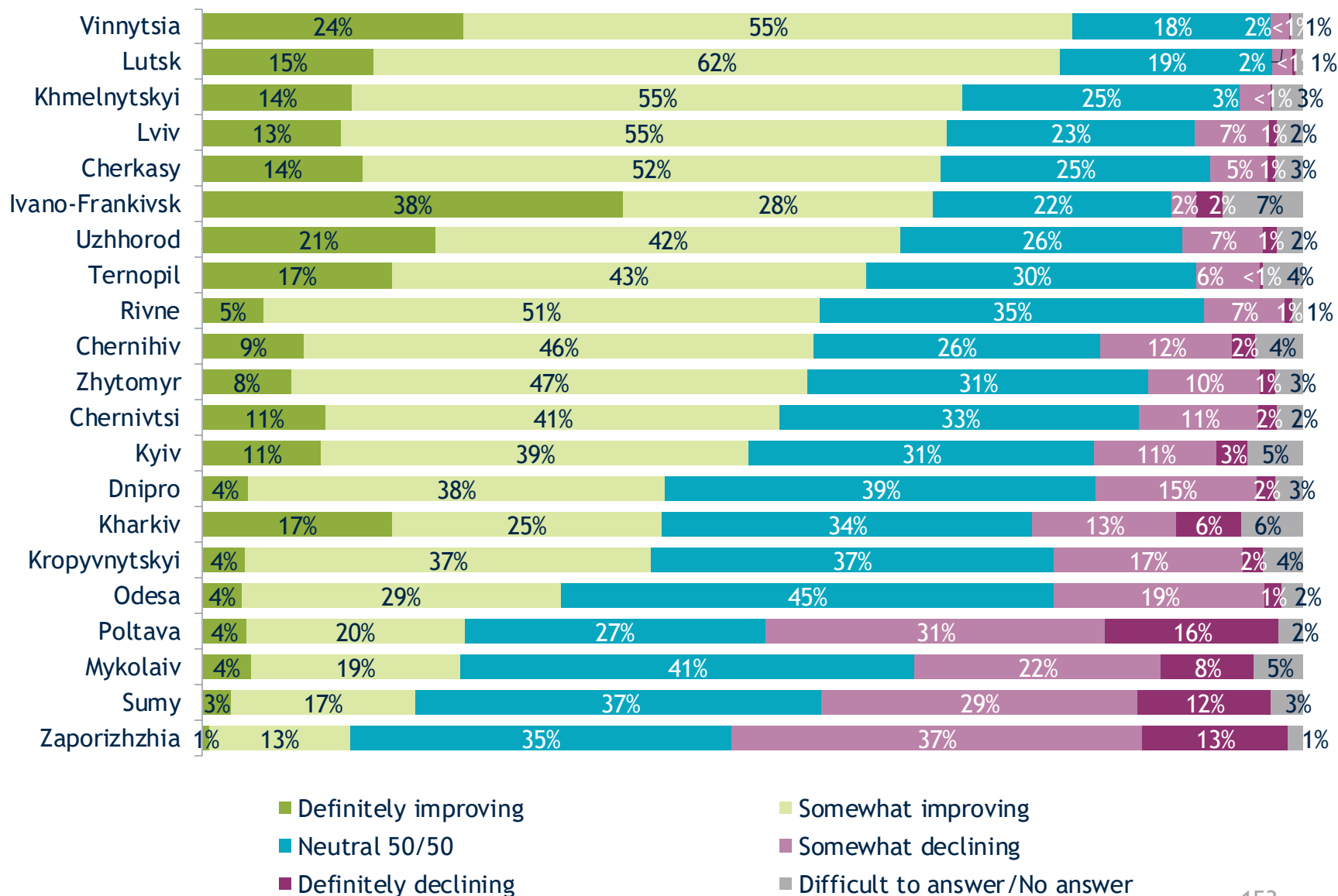

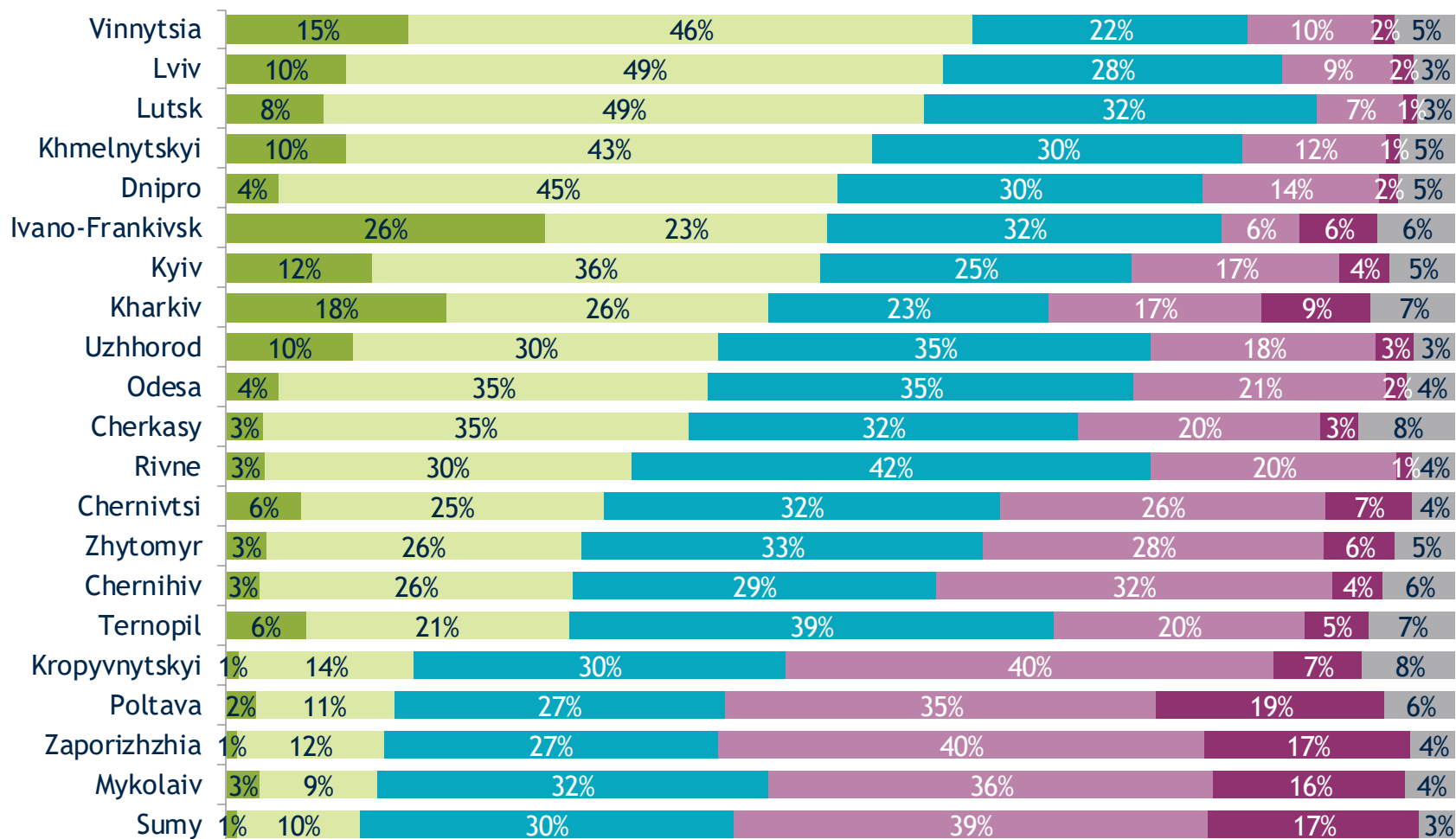

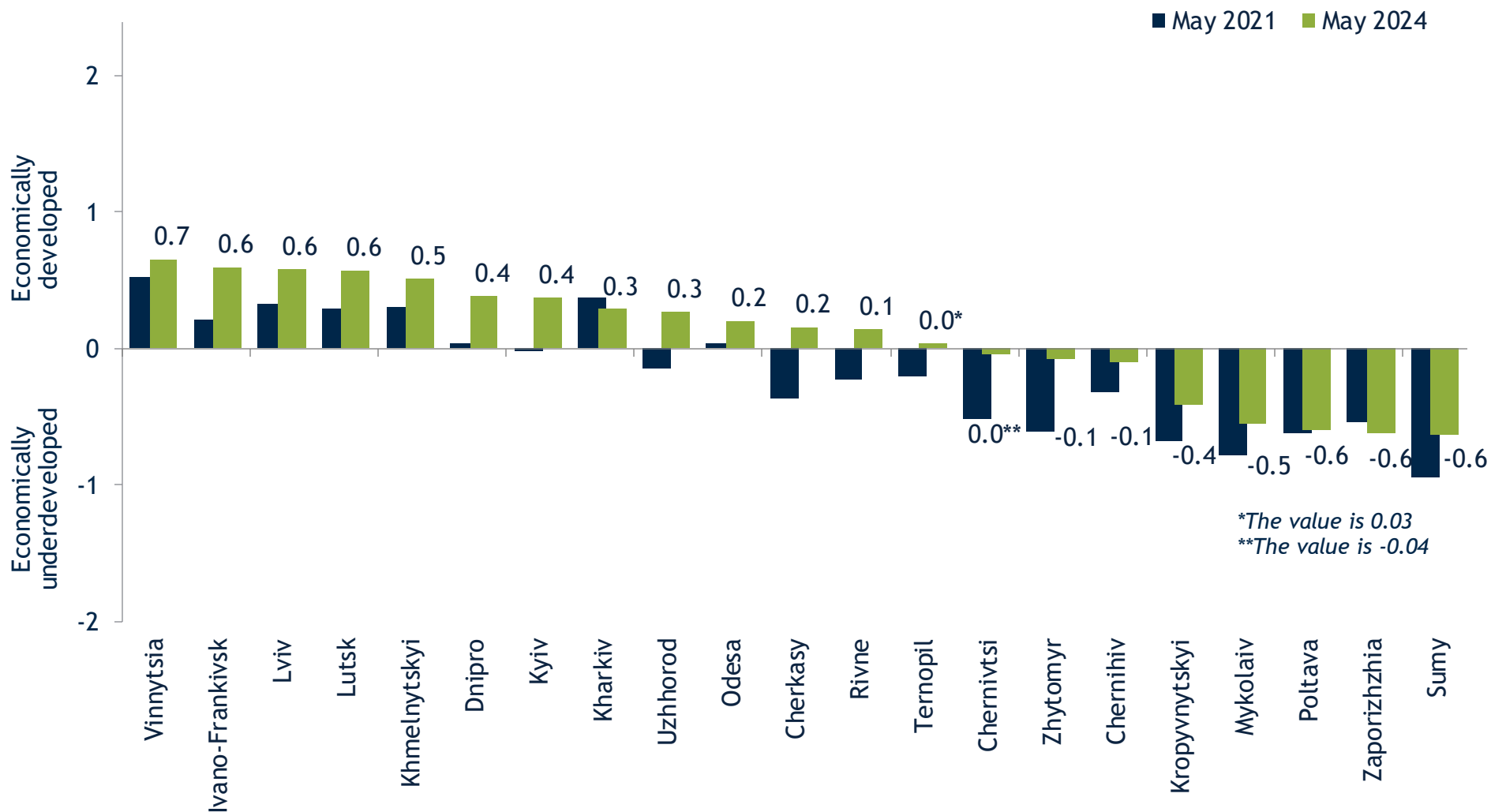

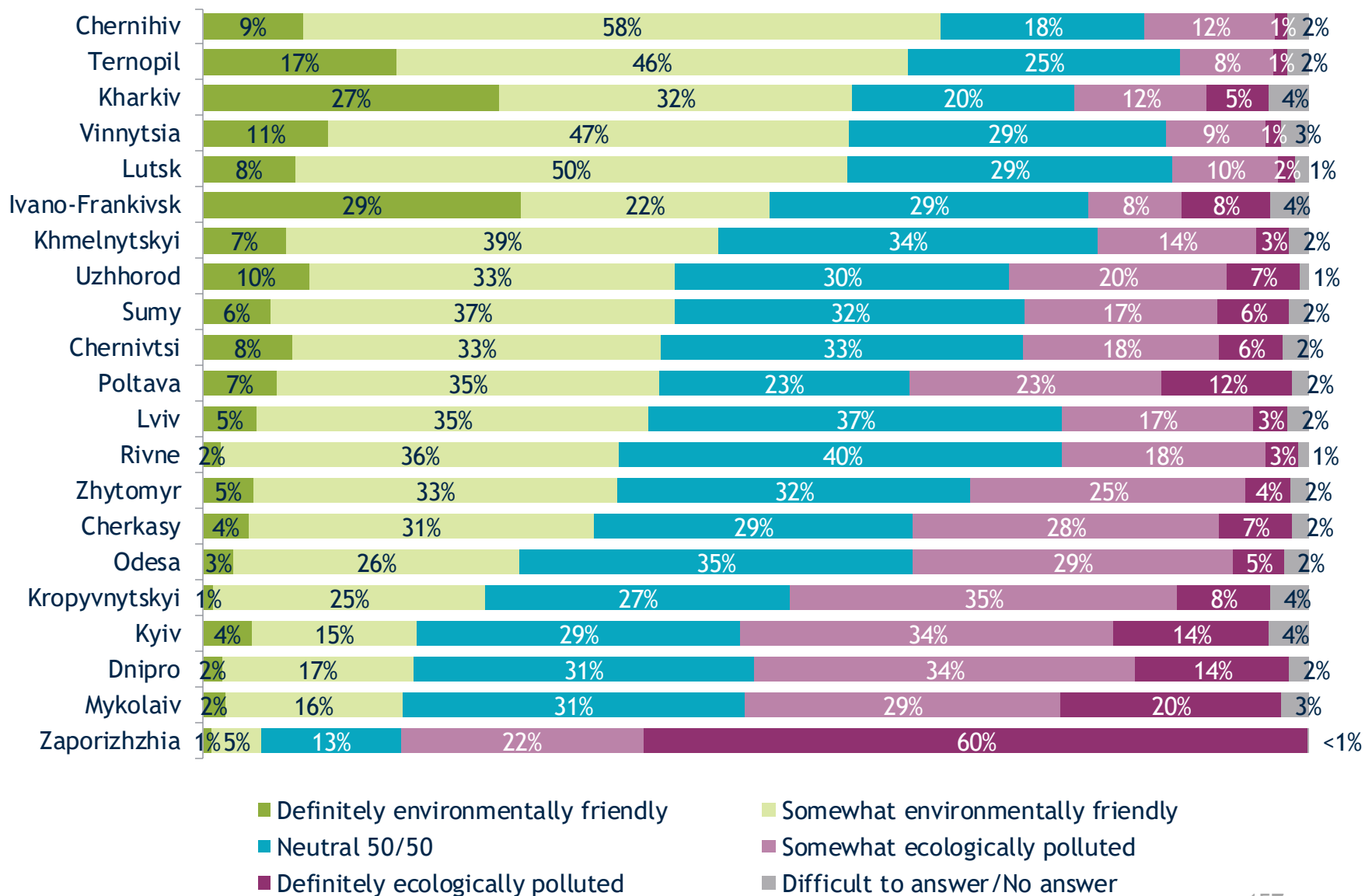

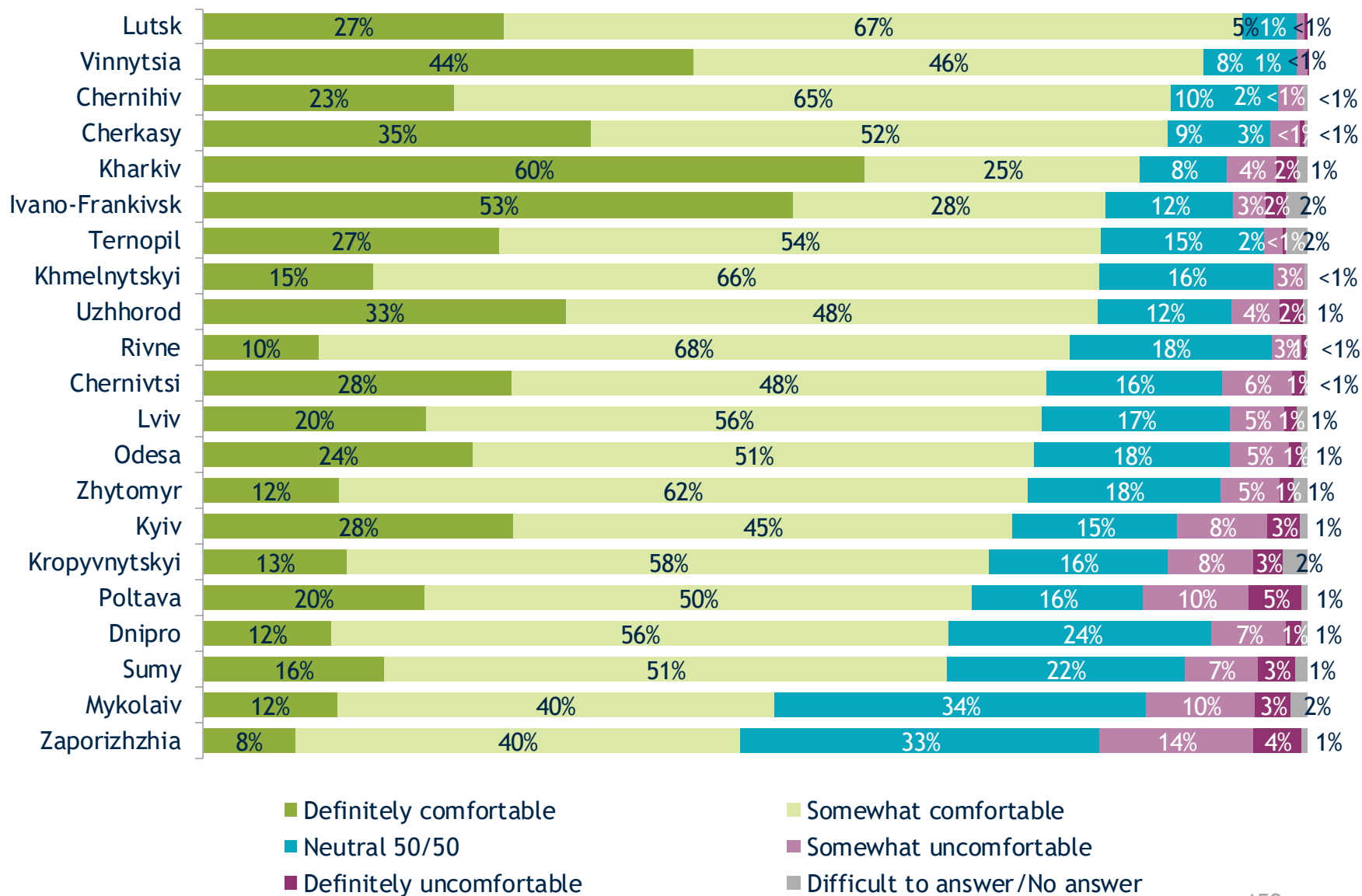

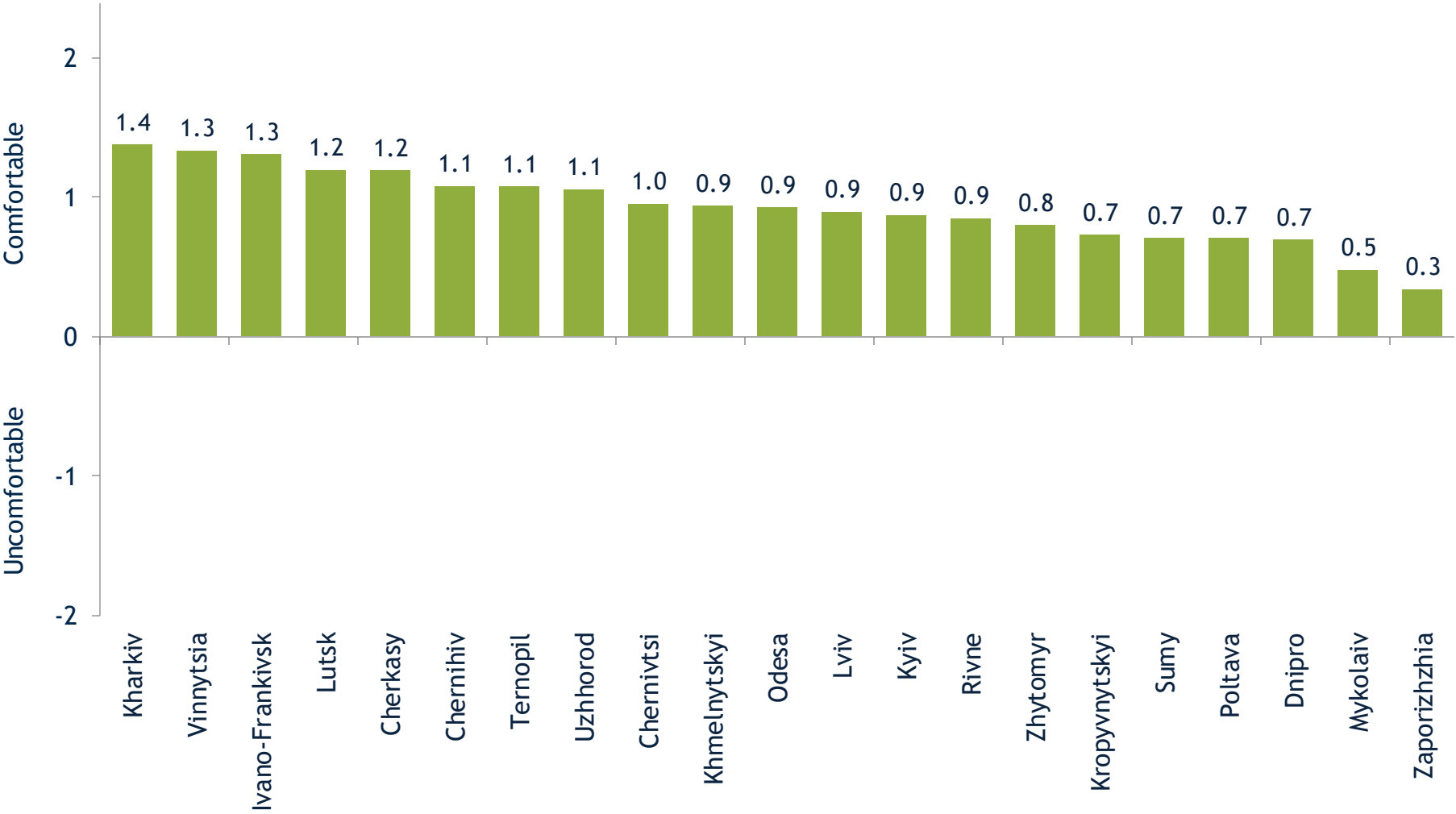

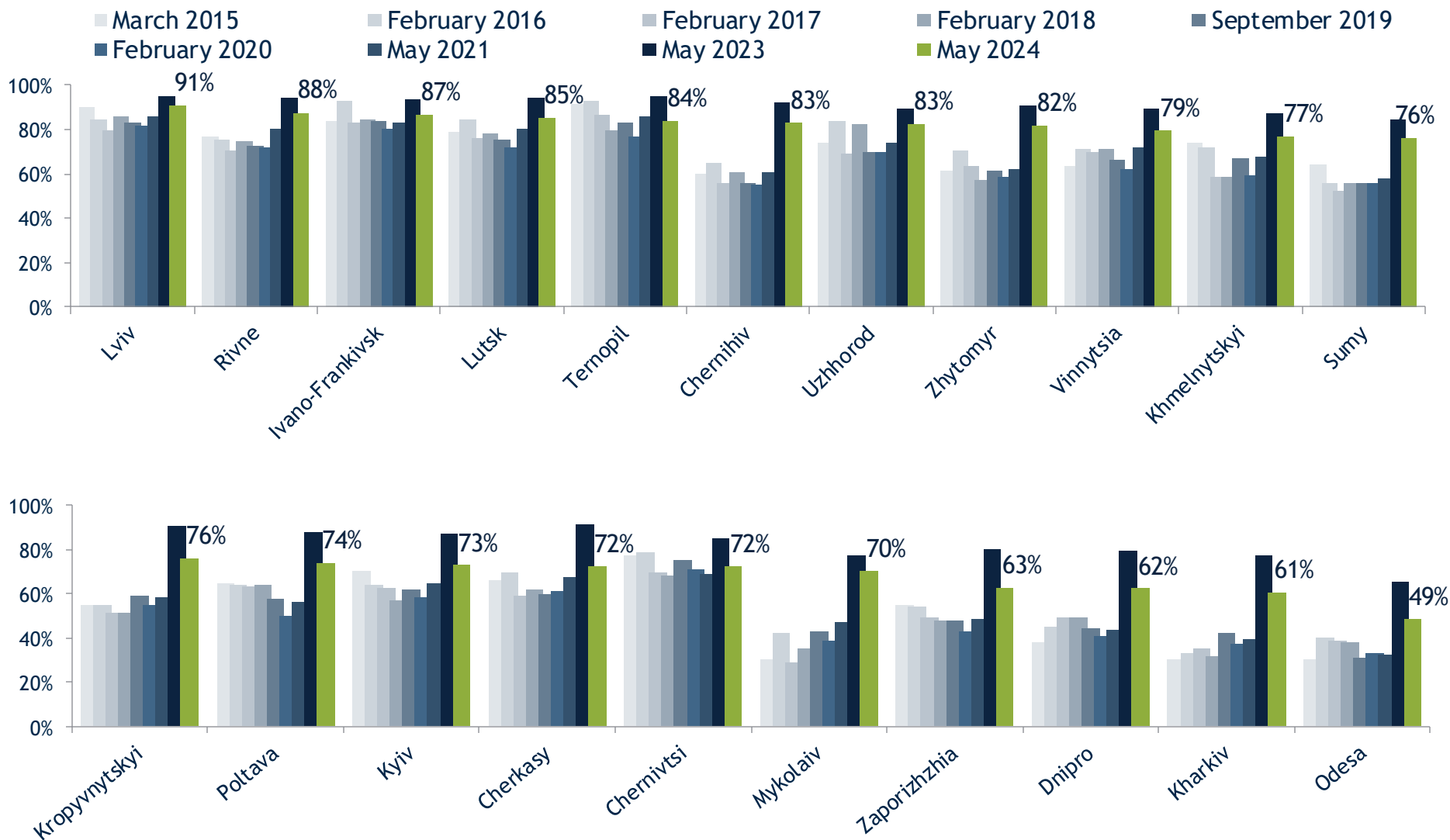
# If Ukraine could only enter one international economic union, which of the following should it be?





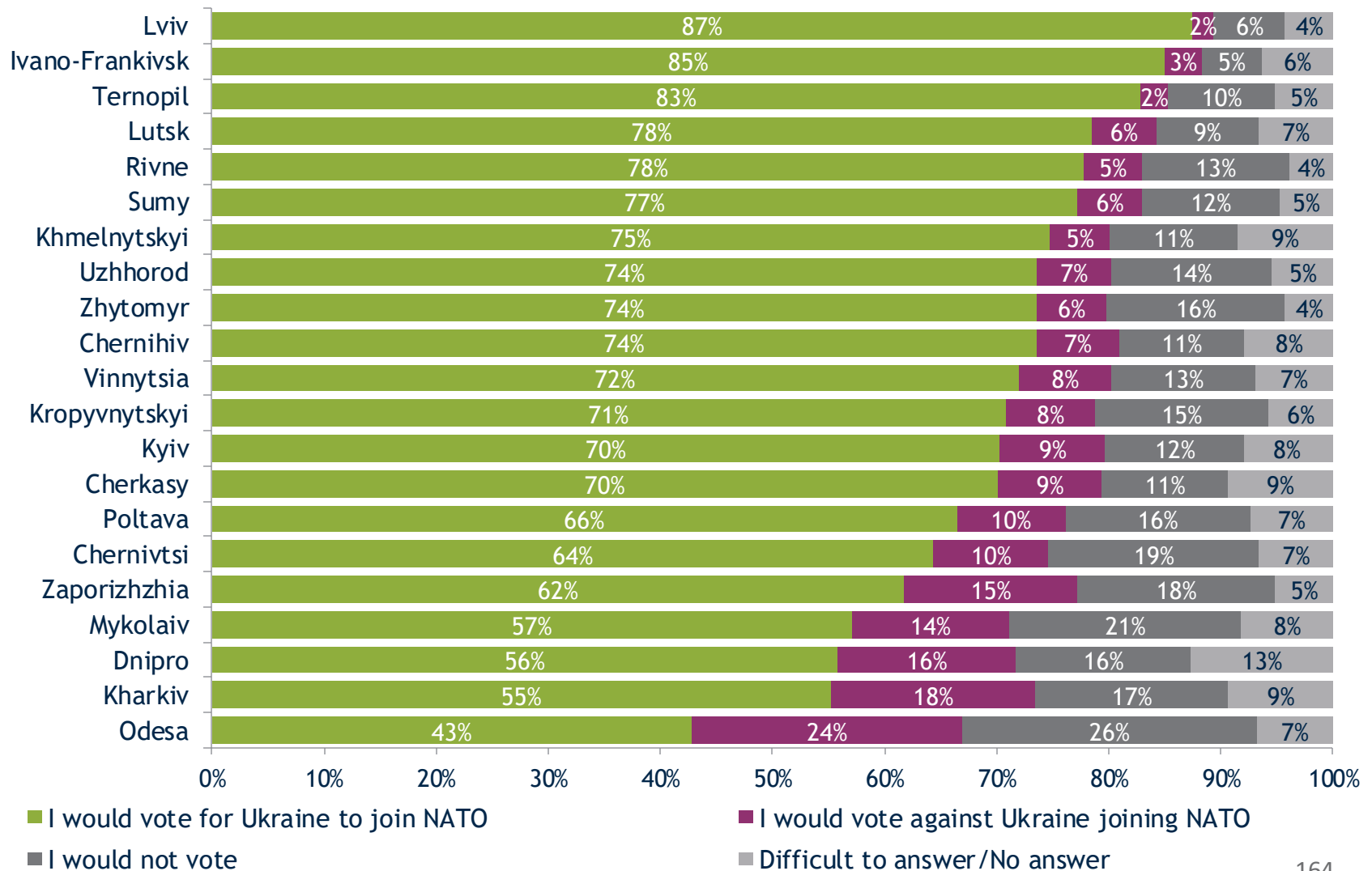
# If Ukraine could only enter one international economic union, which of the following should it be?

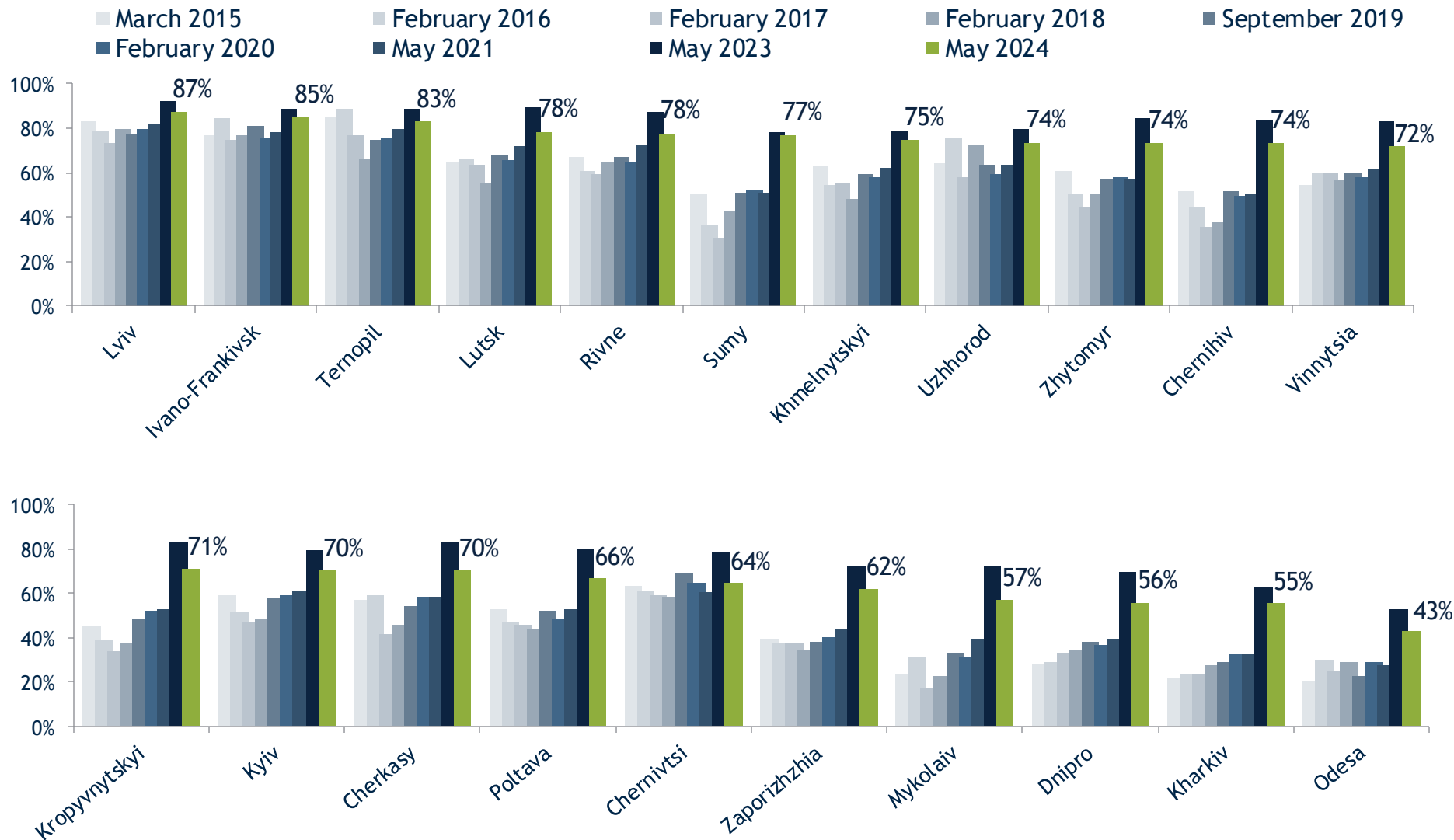
# If a referendum were held today on Ukraine joining NATO, how would you vote?

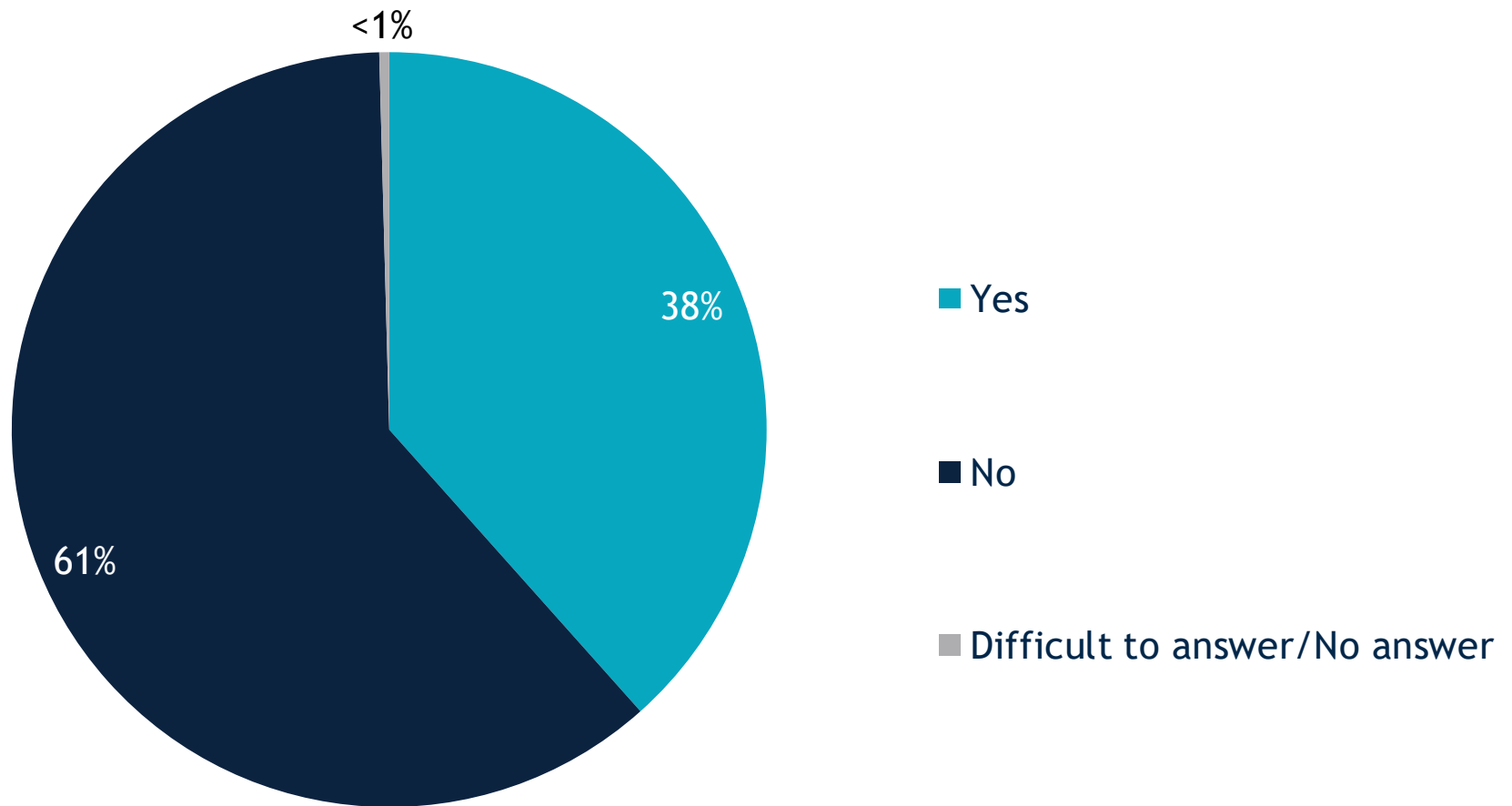

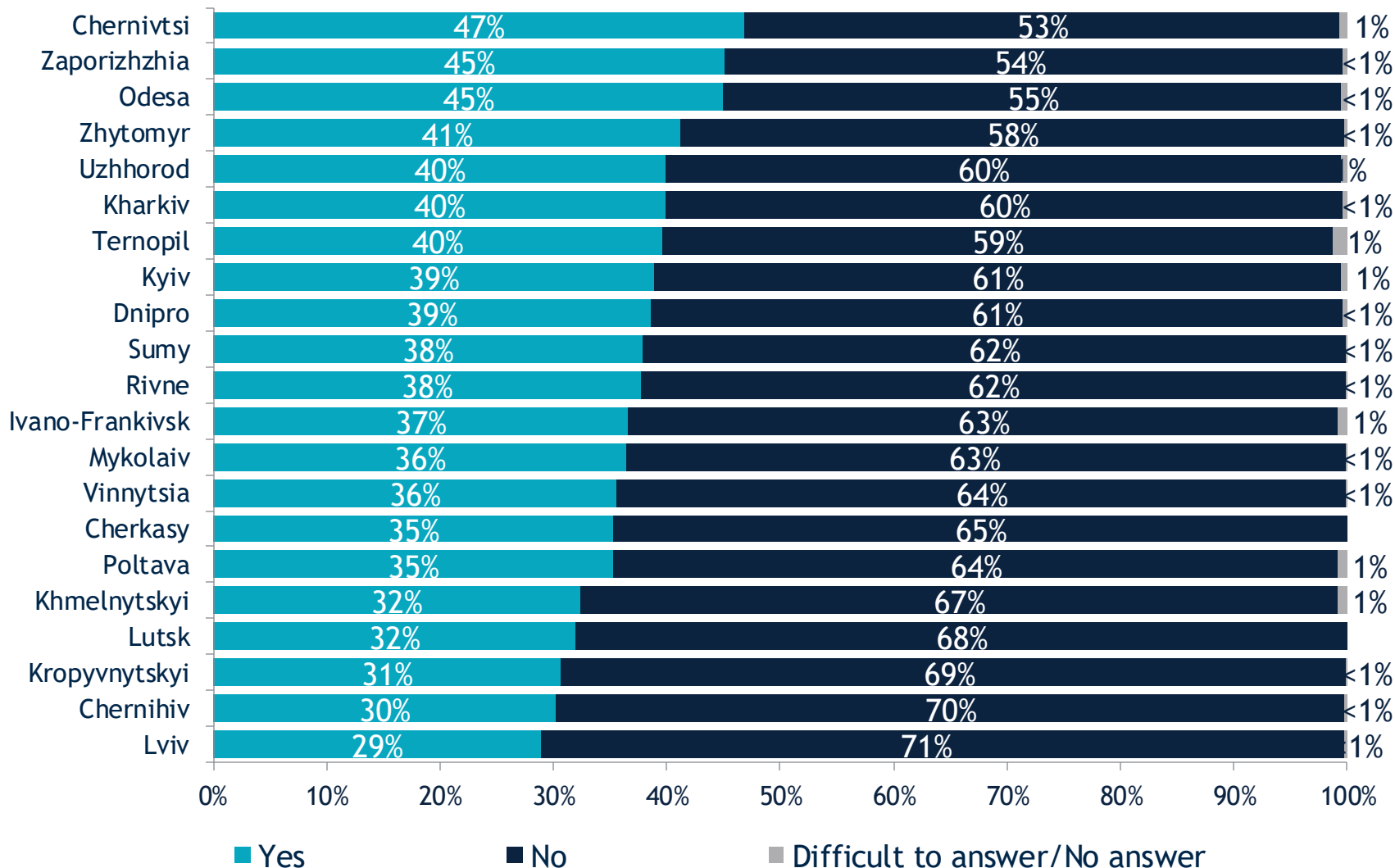


Do you have close relatives for example like husband, wife, parents or children, who are currently abroad due to Russia's full-scale invasion of Ukraine?

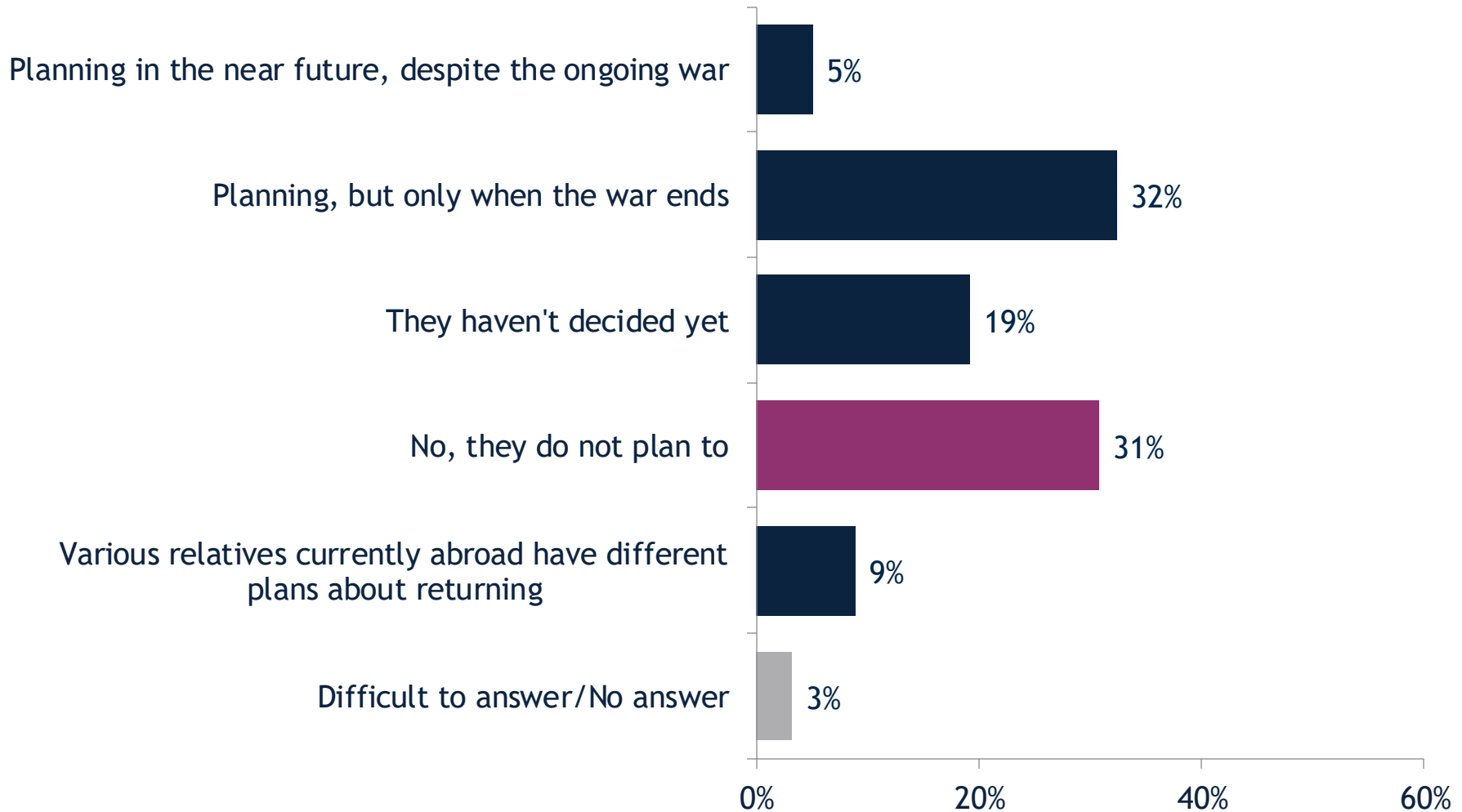

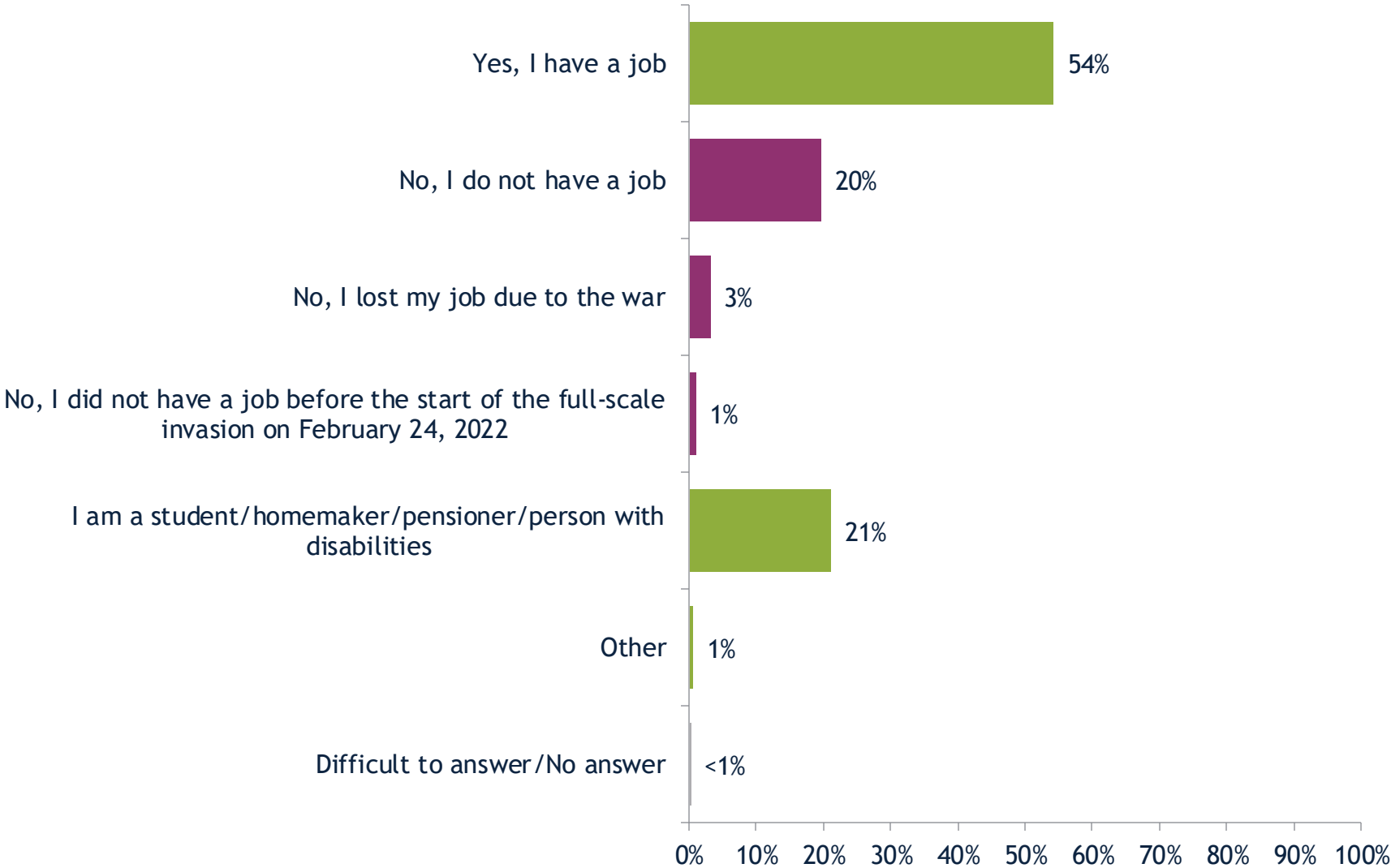

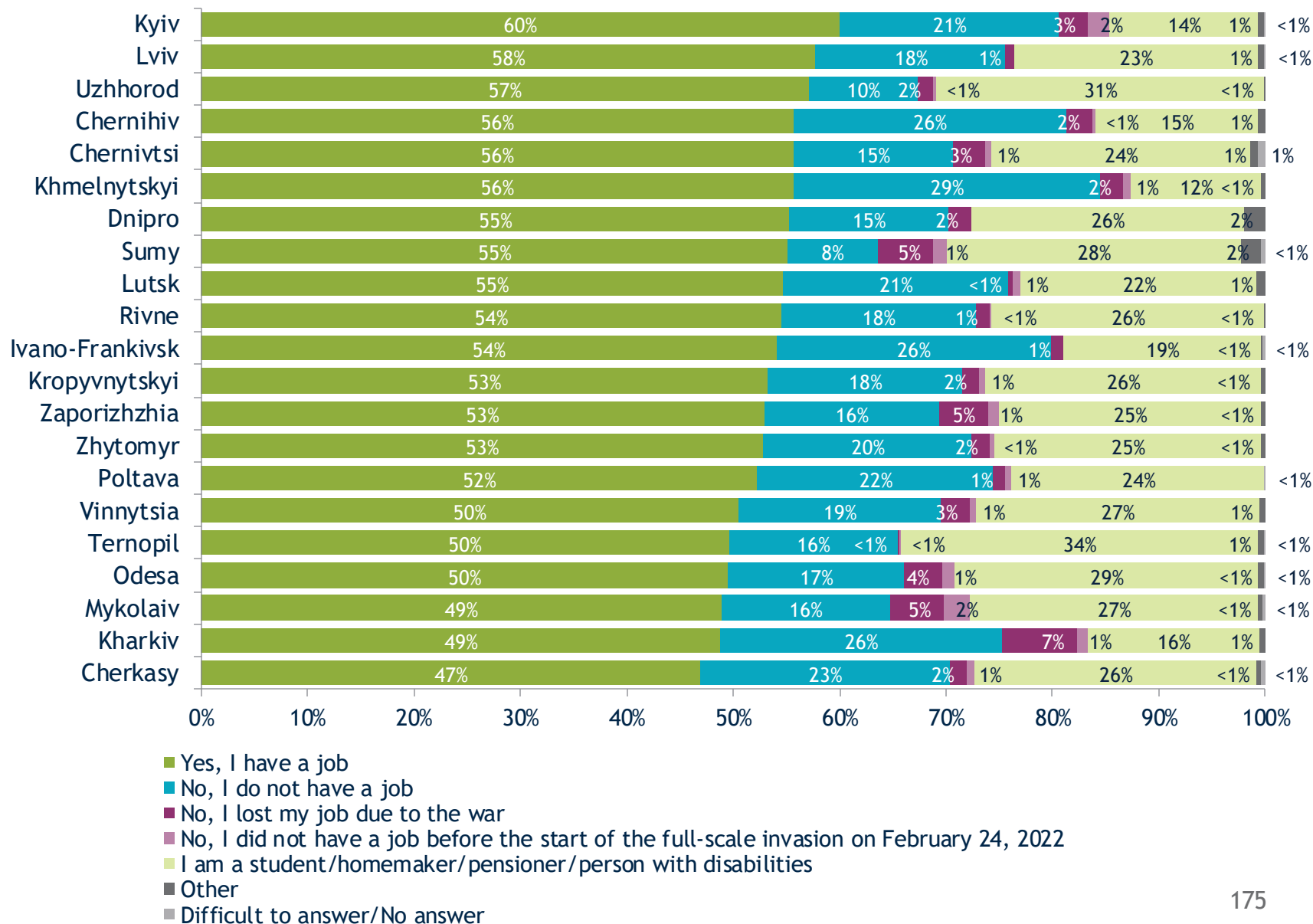
