### **Detailed Methodology**

### >>>

The survey was conducted on behalf of the International Republican Institute's <u>Center for Insights in Survey Research (CISR)</u> within the scope of the Ukraine National Identity through Youth (UNITY) program in collaboration with the International Research and Exchanges Board (IREX). The field work was conducted by Info Sapiens.

Fieldwork was conducted between June 19 and July 21, 2024, through the CATI (Computer-assisted telephone interviewing) method. The pretest took place on June 15-16 and there were no changes to the questionnaire other than a reduction in the number of questions. Considering that respondent selection and interview protocols for the pretest were identical to the actual survey, it was determined to retain 51 interviews from the pretest and merge them into the main sample.

The survey consists of a national sample of n=1,415 youth aged 16-35, a national sample of n=494 children aged 10-12, and a national sample of n=512 children aged 13-15. These samples are representative of the population of Ukraine for the respective age.

Due to difficulty obtaining current information on the population, the latest available pre full scale invasion data from the State Statistics Service from January 1, 2022, were used to weight the dataset. Weighting parameters were age, gender, region, and settlement size. Respondents were asked to name their current place of residence and their place of residence before February 24, 2022.

The theoretical margin of error does not exceed ±4.4% for youth aged 10-12 and youth aged 13-15. The theoretical margin of error does not exceed ±2.6% for youth aged 16-35.

The overall response rate is 2%.

# Ethical Research Protections

The protocol for Youth Opinion Survey 2024 was assessed through an expedited research ethics review by HML Institutional Review Board. This study's human subjects' protection protocols received research ethics review approval on 06/19/2024 in accordance with the requirements of the US Code of Federal Regulations for the Protection of Human Subjects (45CFR46 & 45CFR46.110) and was expedited by (7) Research on individual or group characteristics or behavior. HML IRB is authorized by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Human Research Protections (IRB #00001211, IORG #0000850), and has DHHS Federal-Wide Assurance approval (FWA #00001102).

Informed verbal consent was received from all respondents. For youth between 10-15 years old, the youngest category within the survey, consent was obtained from parents or legal guardians. A consent form included information on the survey topic, confidentiality, voluntary participation, right to refuse to answer some or any questions and right to opt out at any moment.

Info Sapiens team members have experience surveying minors since 2006. Before the survey, all interviewers received additional training on how to conduct interviews with minors.

Info Sapiens complies with its policies on child protection during research activities, national legislation and European Society for Opinion and Market Research guidelines. An external expert Maryna Ohorodniichuk - a psychologist specializing in client-centered therapy, author and instructor of training courses for psychologists and parents, member of the Ukrainian Association of Psychotherapists, was involved in the development of the data collection tools.


All interviews were conducted using CATI (Computer-assisted telephone interviewing) method. Info Sapiens has not stored personal information on participants.



#### How do you see the future of Ukraine?






#### Have you moved to another settlement or country since the fullscale invasion on February 24, 2022?










### How often do you use each of the following social media platforms and messengers? %













### What are the main reasons that prevent you from getting a job?






















