


METHODOLOGY


- The national representative survey was carried out from February 14 March 2, 2010.
- The survey was conducted on behalf of the International Republican Institute.
 The study was designed, coordinated and analyzed by Baltic Surveys/The
 Gallup Organization (Dr. R. Alisauskiene). The fieldwork was carried out by
 Magenta Consulting.
- The sample consisted of 1,200 Moldovan residents over the age 18 and eligible to vote and is representative of the general population by age, gender and education.
- The sample design was a multi-stage random sample.
 - Stage One: Break country into official administrative regions.
 - Stage Two: Select clusters of sampling points based on settlement population (large, medium, small towns and villages). One sample point = approximately one percent of survey population (7-13 interviews). Sampling points in each region were selected based on the percentage of population living in the various levels of settlement in that same region.
- Respondents were selected by the random route method, using the next birthday rule to select a respondent from within a household.
- Data is collected through face-to-face interviews with respondents. The response rate is 58 percent.
- The margin of error does not exceed three percent.




Over the last 12 months, how has the economic situation in Moldova changed, if at all?




Over the last 12 months, how has the financial situation of your household changed, if at all?



How satisfied are you with the way democracy is developing in Moldova?




Are people in Moldova afraid to openly express their political views?












Which countries are the most important partners for Moldova? Which countries are the greatest political and economic threats to Moldova?








Thinking about Moldova's future, which of the following policies do you think is most important for prosperity and security? (One answer)






